

TORAH PORTION

Genesis 5:28,29 Lamech lived one hundred eighty-two years, and became the father of a son, and he named him **Noah**, saying, This same will <u>comfort</u> us in our work and in the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed.

Genesis 6:6 The LORD was sorry that he had made man on the earth, and **it grieved him in his heart.**

Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Hebrews 11:7 By <u>faith</u> Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house, by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the <u>righteousness which is by faith</u>.

Genesis 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and <u>perfect</u> in his generations, and <u>Noah walked with God.</u>

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Deuteronomy 8:6 Therefore you shall <u>keep the commandments</u> of the LORD your God, to <u>walk in his ways</u>, and to fear him.

Genesis 6:22 Thus Noah did. According to all <u>that God commanded</u> <u>him</u>, so he did.

Genesis 7:9 There went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah.

Genesis 7:2 Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two, the male and his female.

Genesis 7:16 Those who went in, went in male and female of all flesh, <u>as God commanded him</u>, and the **LORD shut him in**.

Genesis 7:4 For **yet seven days**, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights, and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

Genesis 7:7-12 And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons wives with him, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood. Of clean beasts, and of beasts that are not clean, and of fowls, and of everything that creeps upon the earth, there went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah. And it came to pass <u>after seven days</u>, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth. In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the <u>second month. the seventeenth day of the</u> <u>month</u>, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. The rain was on the earth <u>forty days and forty nights</u>.

1 Kings 6:38 And in the eleventh year, **in the month Bul, which is the eighth month,** was the house finished throughout all the parts thereof, and according to all the fashion of it. So was he seven years in building it.

Genesis 7:17 And the flood was forty days on the earth, and the waters increased, and bore up <u>the ark, and it was lift up above the earth</u>.

Genesis 8:3,4 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: And after the end of the <u>hundred and fifty days</u> the waters were abated. And <u>the ark rested</u> in the <u>seventh month</u>, on <u>the seventh day of the month</u>, on the mountains of Ararat.

Genesis 8:5 And the waters decreased continually until the <u>tenth</u> <u>month</u>: In the tenth month, on <u>the first day of the month</u>, were the tops of the mountains seen.

Genesis 8:6-9 And it came to pass at **the end of forty days**, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: And he sent forth <u>a raven, which went forth to and fr</u>o, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. Also **he sent forth a dove** from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground, But **the dove found no rest** for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: Then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

Matthew 3:16 Yeshua, when he was immersed, went up directly from the water: And behold, the heavens were opened to him. He saw <u>the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming on him.</u>

Genesis 8:10,11 And he stayed yet <u>other seven days</u>, and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark, And the dove came in to him in the evening, and, see, in her mouth was <u>an olive leaf plucked off</u>: So Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

Isaiah 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and <u>a Branch</u> shall grow out of his roots.

Genesis 8:12 And he stayed yet other <u>seven days</u>; and sent forth the dove, which returned not again to him anymore.

Genesis 8:13 And it came to pass in the <u>six hundredth and first year</u>, in <u>the first month</u>, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: And Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

Genesis 8:14-17 In the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month, the earth was dry. God spoke to Noah, saying, Go out of the ship, you, and your wife, and your sons, and your sons' wives with you. Bring out with you every living thing that is with you of all flesh, including birds, livestock, and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply on the earth.

Genesis 9:14,15 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that **the bow shall be seen in the cloud:** And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every

living creature of all flesh, and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.

Isaiah 54:7-10 For a small moment have I forsaken thee, but with great mercies will I gather thee. In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment, but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer. For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath mercy on thee.

Genesis 10:21 Unto Shem also, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder, even to him were children born.

Genesis 10:32 These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: And by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

Genesis 11:1,2 And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar, and they dwelt there.

Genesis 11:8 So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: And they left off to build the city. Therefore is the name of it called Babel, because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: And from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

Genesis 11:10 These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood.

Genesis 11:26 And Terah lived seventy years, and begat Abram, Nahor, and Haran.

Genesis 11:28 And Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his nativity, in Ur of the Chaldees.

Joshua 24:2 And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, even Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: And they served other gods.

Genesis 11:29,30 And Abram and Nahor took them wives: The name of Abram's wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor's wife, Milcah, the daughter of Haran, the father of Milcah, and the father of Iscah. But Sarai was barren; she had no child.

Genesis 11:31,32 And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife, and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan, and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there. And the days of Terah were two hundred and five years: And Terah died in Haran.

Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee.

Genesis 12:4 So Abram departed, as the LORD had spoken unto him, and Lot went with him: And Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

New Moon

Genesis 1:14 And God said: Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days and years.

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food, **the tree**

of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Revelation 22:1,2 He showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb, in the middle of its street. On this side of the river and on that was the tree of life, bearing **twelve kinds of fruits, yielding its fruit every month.**

Ezekiel 46:1 Thus saith the Lord GOD: The gate of the inner court that looks toward the east shall be shut the six working days, but on the sabbath day it shall be opened, and in the <u>day of the new moon</u> it shall be opened.

Ezekiel 46:3 Likewise the people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate **before the LORD in the sabbaths and** <u>in the new</u> <u>moons</u>.

Isaiah 66:22,23 For as the **new heavens and the new earth**, which I will make, shall remain before me, says the LORD, so your seed and your name shall remain. It shall happen, that from **one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another**, shall all flesh come to worship before me, says the LORD.

Leviticus 20:7,8 Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the Lord your God. And you shall keep My statutes, and perform them: I am the Lord who sanctifies you.

Leviticus 20:26 And you shall be holy to Me, for I the Lord am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.

Ephesians 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we **should be holy and without blame before him in love.**

1 Peter 1:15,16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation, Because it is written, Be ye holy, for I am holy.

Psalm 104:19-21 He made the moon to mark the seasons (Moadim) the sun knoweth his going down. You make darkness, and it is night: Wherein all the beasts of the forest do creep forth. The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their meat from God.

Psalm 81:3,4 Blow the horn **at the new moon**, on **Rosh HaShanah** for our feast-day. For it is a statute for Israel, an ordinance of the God of Jacob.

Psalm 89:20 I have found David My servant, with My holy oil have I anointed hi, With whom My hand shall be established, Mine arm also shall strengthen him.

Psalm 89:23,24 And I will beat to pieces his adversaries before him, and smite them that hate him. But **My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him, and through My name** shall his horn be exalted.

Psalm 89:28,29 Forever will I keep for him My mercy, and My covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure forever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

Psalm 89:33-37 Nevertheless My lovingkindness I will not utterly take from him, Nor allow My faithfulness to fail. **My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips**. Once I have sworn by My holiness, I will not lie to David: His seed shall endure forever, And his throne as the sun before Me, It shall be **established forever like the moon, Even like the faithful witness in the sky**.

Jeremiah 33:25,26 Thus says the Lord: If My covenant is not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of

heaven and earth, then I will cast away the descendants of Jacob and David My servant.

Numbers 10:9,10 And when ye go to war in your land against the adversary that oppresses you, then ye shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies. Also in the day of your gladness, and in your appointed seasons, and in your <u>new</u> <u>moons</u>, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt-offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace-offerings, and they shall be to you for a memorial before your God: I am the LORD your God.

1 Chronicles 12:31 And to offer all burnt sacrifices unto the LORD in the sabbaths, in the new moons, and on the set feasts, by number, according to the order commanded unto them, continually before the LORD.

2 Chronicles 2:4 Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate it to him, and to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and <u>on the new moons</u>, and on the solemn feasts of the LORD our God. This is an ordinance for ever to Israel.

Ezra 3:5 And afterward offered the continual burnt offering, both of <u>the new moons</u>, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, and of everyone that willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.

Exodus 12:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying: This month shall be unto you the beginning of months, it shall be the first month of the year to you.

Isaiah 53:7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

Ecce 8:4 Where the word of a king is, there is power: And who may say unto him, What doest thou?

Exodus 40:1,2 And the Lord spoke unto Moses, saying, **On the first day of the first month** shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

Exodus 12:18 In **the first month**, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.

Leviticus 9:22 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and blessed them, and came down from offering of the sin offering, and the burnt offering, and peace offerings.

Psalm 133:1,2 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: That went down to the skirts of his garments.

Leviticus 9:23,24 And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: And the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the people. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed upon the altar the burnt offering and the fat: Which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Numbers 20:1 Then came the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the first month: And the people abode in Kadesh, and Miriam died there, and was buried there.

Joshua 4:19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

2 Chronicles 29:17 Now they began on the first day of the first month to sanctify, and on the eighth day of the month came they to the porch of the LORD: So they sanctified the house of the LORD in eight days, and in the sixteenth day of the first month they made an end.

Ezekiel 29:17 And it came to pass in the seven and twentieth year, in the first month, in the first day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me.

Ezekiel 30:20 And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in the first month, in the seventh day of the month, that the word of the LORD came unto me.

Daniel 10:4-6 And in the four and twentieth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, which is Hiddekel, Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz: His body also was like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in colour to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.

Esther 3:12a Then were the king's scribes called **on the thirteenth day of the first month,** and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants.


Esther 3:13 And the letters were sent by posts into all the king's provinces, to destroy, to kill, and to cause to perish, all Jews, both young and old, little children and women, in one day, even upon the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, which is the month Adar, and to take the spoil of them for a prey.

Esther 2:5 Now in Shushan the palace there was a certain Jew, whose name was Mordecai, the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite.

Zephaniah 3:12 I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and **poor** people, and they shall trust **in the name of the LORD.**

Numbers 1:7 Of Juda, Nahshon the son of Amminadab.

Numbers 10:13,14 And they first took their journey according to the commandment of the LORD by the hand of Moses. In the first




place went the standard of the camp of the children of Judah according to their armies: And over his host was Nahshon the son of Amminadab.
