### **TORAH PORTION**

Genesis 20:1,2 And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in <u>Gerar</u>. And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She is my sister: And Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

**Genesis 20:**12 And, in fact, she is my sister, the daughter of my father, but not the daughter of my mother, and she became my wife.

Genesis 20:17 Then Abraham made prayer to God, and God made Abimelech well again, and his wife and his women-servants, so that they had children. For the Lord had kept all the women of the house of Abimelech from having children, because of Sarah, Abraham's wife.

**Genesis 22:19** So Abraham returned to his young men, and they rose up and went together to **Beersheba**. Abraham lived at Beersheba.

Genesis 24:67 Then Isaac brought her into the tent of Sarah his mother and took Rebekah, and she became his wife, and he loved her. So Isaac was comforted after his mother's death.

Genesis 25:20 and Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah.

Genesis 23:1,2 Sarah lived one <u>hundred twenty-seven years</u>. This was the length of Sarah's life. <u>Sarah died in Kiriath Arba (the same is Hebron</u>), in the land of Canaan. <u>Abraham came to mourn</u> for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Genesis 14:13 And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew, for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: And these were confederate with Abram.



**Genesis 23:3,4** And Abraham stood up from before his dead, and spoke to the **sons of Heth**, saying, I am <u>a stranger and a sojourner</u> with you: Give me a possession of a <u>burial plot</u> with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

**Hebrews 11:13** In faith died all these, not having received the promises, but from afar having seen them, and having been persuaded, and having saluted them, and having confessed that strangers and sojourners they are upon the earth,

**Ephesians 2:19** Now, therefore, you are no more <u>strangers and foreigners</u>, but fellow citizens with the saints and of the household of God,

While Abraham was considered a stranger and foreigner among the Gentiles, those Gentiles who come to the faith of Abraham were no longer to be considered strangers and foreigners to the God of Abraham.

Genesis 23:7 And Abraham stood up and bowed (prostrate) himself to the people of the land, even to the children of Heth.

Genesis 23:10-16 And Ephron עפרון dwelled among the children of Heth: And Ephron עפרון the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, even of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying, No, my lord, hear me: the field give I you, and the cave that is therein, I give it you, in the presence of the sons of my people give I it you: Bury your dead. And Abraham bowed down himself before the people of the land. And he spoke unto Ephron עפרון in the audience of the people of the land, saying, But if you will give it, I pray you, hear me: I will give you money for the field, take it of me, and I will bury my dead there. And Ephron עפרון answered Abraham, saying to him, My lord, listen to me: The land is worth four hundred shekels of silver, what is that between me and thee? Bury therefore your dead. And Abraham listened to Ephron עפרון; and Abraham weighed to Ephron עפרן the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current money with the merchant.



Genesis 24:3,4 And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that you shall not take a wife to my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell: But you shall go to my country, and to my kindred, and take a wife to my son Isaac.

Genesis 24:12,13 And he made the camels kneel down outside the city by the well of water at the time of evening, the time when women go out to draw water. And he said, O LORD, God of my master Abraham, please grant me success today and show steadfast love to my master Abraham.

Genesis 24:14 Let the young woman to whom I shall say, Please let down your jar that I may drink, and who shall say, Drink, and I will water your camels' let her be the one whom you have appointed for your servant Isaac. By this I shall know that you have shown steadfast love to my master.

Genesis 24:17-20 And the servant <u>ran to meet her</u>, and said, Let me, I pray you, drink a <u>little water</u> of **your pitcher**. And she said, Drink, my lord: **And she hurried**, and let down her pitcher on her hand, and gave him drink. And when she had done giving him drink, she said, <u>I will draw water for your camels also</u>, until they have done drinking. **And she hurried**, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and **ran** again to the well to draw water, and drew for all his camels.

**Exodus 30:12,13a** When you are taking the number of the children of Israel, let every man who is numbered give to the Lord a price for his life, so that no disease may come on them when they are numbered. And this is what they are to give; let every man who is numbered give **half a shekel.** 

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a **golden** earring of <u>half a shekel</u> weight, and <u>two bracelets</u> for her hands of <u>ten shekels</u> weight of gold.



**Exodus 32:19** And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and **brake them** beneath the mount.

**Psalms 119:72** The law of Thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver.

Exodus 38:25,26 And the <u>silver</u> of them that were numbered of the congregation was a hundred talents, and a thousand seven hundred and three-score and fifteen shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: <u>a beka קצ a head</u>, that is, <u>half a shekel</u>, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

**Matthew 27:33** And when they were come unto a place called Golgotha, that is to say, a place of a skull.

Genesis 25:7-10 And these are the days of the years of Abraham's life which he lived, an hundred threescore and fifteen years. Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full of years, and was gathered to his people. And his sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, which is before Mamre, The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Nehemiah 9:6-8a You are the LORD, even You alone, You made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and all things that are thereon, the seas and all that is in them, and <u>You preserve them all</u>, and <u>the host of heaven worships You</u>. You are the LORD the God, who chose Abram, and brought him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees and gave him the name of Abraham, and found his heart faithful before You and made a covenant with him.



### NEW MOON IYAR

Issachar – Sapphire

Genesis 49:9-15 Judah is a lion's cub. From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He stooped down, he crouched as a lion, as a lioness. Who will rouse him up? The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs. To him will the obedience of the peoples be. Binding his foal to the vine, his donkey's colt to the choice vine, he has washed his garments in wine, his robes in the blood of grapes. His eyes will be red with wine, his teeth white with milk. Zebulun will dwell at the haven of the sea. He will be for a haven of ships. His border will be on Sidon. Issachar is a strong donkey, lying down between the saddlebags. He saw a resting place, that it was good, the land, that it was pleasant. He bows his shoulder to the burden, and becomes a servant doing forced labor.

1 Chronicles 12:32 And of the children of Issachar, men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do.

Genesis 15:5 And He brought him forth abroad, and said: Look now toward heaven, and count the stars, if thou be able to count them, and He said unto him: So shall thy seed be.

**Exodus 28:18** And the second row shall be an emerald, a sapphire, and a diamond.

**Exodus 24:19** Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel: And they saw the God of Israel: And there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a **sapphire stone**, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness.

**Deuteronomy 33:18,19** Of Zebulun he said, Rejoice, Zebulun, in your going out, and Issachar, in your tents. They shall call the peoples to the mountain. There they will offer sacrifices of righteousness, for they shall **draw out the abundance of the seas, the hidden treasures of the sand.** 



**Exodus 15:24-26** The people murmured against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? Then he cried to the LORD. The LORD showed him a tree, and he threw it into the waters, and the waters were made sweet. There he made a statute and an ordinance for them, and there he tested them, and he said, If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and will do that which is right in his eyes, and will pay attention to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you, which I have put on the Egyptians, for **I am the LORD who heals you.** 

Exodus 16:1,2 They took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came to the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt. The whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron in the wilderness.

**Exodus 16:4-6** Then the LORD said to Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from the sky for you, and the people shall go out and gather a day's portion every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in my law, or not. It shall come to pass on the sixth day, that they shall prepare that which they bring in, and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily. Moses and Aaron said to all the children of Israel, At evening, then you shall know that the LORD has brought you out from the land of Egypt.

**Exodus 16:8** Moses said, Now the LORD shall give you meat to eat in the evening, and in the morning bread to satisfy you, because the LORD hears your murmurings which you murmur against him. And who are we? Your murmurings are not against us, but against the LORD.

**Exodus 17:1** And all the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, by their stages, according to the commandment of the LORD, and encamped in Rephidim, and there was no water for the people to drink.

Exodus 17:3 And the people thirsted there for water, and the people murmured against Moses, and said: Wherefore hast thou



brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?

**Exodus 17:7,8** And the name of the place was called Massah, {That is, Trying.} and Meribah, {That is, Strife.} because of the striving of the children of Israel, and because they tried the LORD, saying: Is the LORD among us, or not? **Then came Amalek and fought with Israel in Rephidim.** 

**Numbers 9:**11 The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it, and eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.

Numbers 10:11,12 And it came to pass on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the testimony. And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of Sinai, and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

**Numbers 10:14,15** In the first place went the standard of the camp of the children of Judah according to their armies: And over his host was Nahshon the son of Amminadab.

**Numbers 11:1** And when the people complained, it displeased the LORD: And the LORD heard it, and his anger was kindled, and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp.

**Numbers 11:4** And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?

**Numbers 11:19,20** Ye shall not eat one day, nor two days, nor five days, neither ten days, nor twenty days, But even a whole month, until it come out at your nostrils, and it be loathsome unto you: Because that ye have despised the LORD which is among you, and have wept before him, saying, Why came we forth out of Egypt?



# The Month of Sivan Zebulun - Diamond

Deuteronomy 33:18,19 Of Zebulun he said, <u>Rejoice, Zebulun</u>, in your going out, and Issachar, in your tents. They shall call the peoples to the mountain. There they will offer sacrifices of righteousness, for they shall draw out the abundance of the seas, the hidden treasures of the sand.

Genesis 49:13 Zebulun shall dwell at the shore of the sea, he shall become a haven for ships, and his border shall be at Sidon.

**Habakkuk 2:14** For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.

Judges 5:18 Zebulun is a people who risked their lives to the death,

**Revelation 14:14** And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the **Son of man**, having on his head a **golden crown**, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

**1 Samuel 21:3,4** Now therefore what is under thine hand? Give me five loaves of bread in mine hand, or what there is present. And the priest answered David, and said, There is no common bread under my hand, but there is hallowed bread.

Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and <u>the sword</u> of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.

**Revelation 19:13-15** And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: And his name is called The **Word of God**. And **the armies** which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And **out of his mouth goes a sharp sword,** that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron.

Malachi 2:6,7 The law of truth was in his mouth, and unrighteousness was not found in his lips, he walked with Me in



peace and uprightness and **did turn many away from iniquity**. For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should **seek the law at his mouth**, for he **is the messenger of the LORD of hosts.** (armies)

**Exodus 19:1** In **the third month**, when the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt, the same day came they **into the wilderness of Sinai.** 

- **2 Chronicles 15:1-4** And the Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded: And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin, The LORD is with you, while ye be with him, and if ye seek him, he will be found of you, but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you. Now for a long season Israel hath been without the true God, and without a teaching priest, and without <u>law.</u> But when they in their trouble did turn unto the LORD God of Israel, and sought him, he was found of them.
- 2 Chronicles 15:10-15 So they gathered themselves together at Jerusalem in the third month, in the fifteenth year of the reign of Asa. And they offered unto the LORD the same time, of the spoil which they had brought, seven hundred oxen and seven thousand sheep. And they entered into a covenant to seek the LORD God of their fathers with all their heart and with all their soul, That whosoever would not seek the LORD God of Israel should be put to death, whether small or great, whether man or woman. And they swore unto the LORD with a loud voice, and with shouting, and with trumpets, and with cornets. And all Judah rejoiced at the oath: For they had sworn with all their heart, and sought him with their whole desire, and he was found of them: And the LORD gave them rest round about.
- 2 Chronicles 15:16-19 And also concerning Maachah the mother of Asa the king, he removed her from being queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: And Asa cut down her idol, and stamped it, and burnt it at the brook Kidron. But the high places were not taken away out of Israel: Nevertheless, the heart of Asa was perfect all his days. And he brought into the house of God the things that his father had dedicated, and that he himself had dedicated, silver,



and gold, and vessels. And there was no more war unto the five and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa.

- 2 Chronicles 16:1-3 In the six and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa Baasha king of Israel came up against Judah, and built Ramah, to the intent that he might let none go out or come in to Asa king of Judah. Then Asa brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying, There is a league between me and thee, as there was between my father and thy father: Behold, I have sent thee silver and gold, go, break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.
- 2 Chronicles 16:7-10 And at that time Hanani the seer came to Asa king of Judah, and said unto him, Because thou hast relied on the king of Syria, and not relied on the LORD thy God, therefore is the host of the king of Syria escaped out of thine hand. Were not the Ethiopians and the Lubims a huge host, with very many chariots and horsemen? Yet, because thou didst rely on the LORD, he delivered them into thine hand. For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: Therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars. Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house, for he was in a rage with him because of this thing. And Asa oppressed some of the people the same time.
- 2 Chronicles 16:12 And Asa in the thirty and ninth year of his reign was diseased in his feet, until his disease was exceeding great: Yet in his disease he sought not to the LORD, but to the physicians.

**Esther 8:7** Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

Esther 8:9 Then were the king's scribes called at that time in the third month, that is, the month Sivan, on the three and twentieth



day thereof, and it was written according to all that Mordecai commanded unto the Jews,

**Esther 8:11**a Wherein the king granted the Jews which were in every city to gather themselves together, and to stand for their life, to destroy, to slay, and to cause to perish, all the power of the people and province that would assault them.

**Ezekiel 31:1** And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in **the third month**, in the **first day of the month**, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude, Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Malachi 4:4,5 Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.

**Exodus 17:16** For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have **war** with Amalek from generation to generation.

Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread,

John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
