TORAH PORTION

Genesis 25:7 And these are the days of the years of Abraham's life which he lived, an hundred threescore and fifteen years.

Genesis 25:19,20 And these are the generations stories of Isaac, Abraham's son: Abraham begat Isaac: And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan—aram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

Genesis 25:26 And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel, and his name was called Jacob: And Isaac was **three score years old** when she bore them.

Genesis 9:28,29 And Noah lived after the flood three hundred and fifty years. And all the days of Noah were <u>nine hundred and fifty</u> years: And he died.

Genesis 11:10,11 These are the generations of Shem: Shem was an 100 years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood: And Shem lived after he begat Arphaxad <u>five hundred</u> years, and begat sons and daughters.

Genesis 25:21-23 Isaac entreated the LORD for his wife, because she was barren. The LORD was entreated by him, and Rebekah his wife conceived. The children struggled together within her. She said, If it be so, why do I live? She went to inquire of the LORD. The LORD said to her, Two nations are in your womb. Two peoples will be separated from your body. The one people will be stronger than the other people. The elder will serve the younger.

Genesis 25:27,28 And the boys grew: And Esau was a cunning hunter, a man of the field, and Jacob was a plain man, dwelling in tents. Now Isaac loved Esau, because he did eat of his venison, and Rebekah loved Jacob.



Genesis 25:31-33 And Jacob said, Sell me this day your birthright. And Esau said, Behold, I am at the point to die: And what profit shall this birthright do to me? And Jacob said, Swear to me this day, and he swore to him: and he sold his birthright to Jacob.

Genesis 25:34 Jacob gave Esau <u>bread and stew of lentils.</u> He ate and drank, rose up, and went his way. So Esau despised his birthright.

Genesis 14:18,19 And Melchizedek <u>king of Salem</u> brought forth bread and wine: And <u>he was the priest</u> of the Most High God. And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth.

Exodus 19:6 And you shall be to me a <u>kingdom of priests</u>, and an holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.

Genesis 26:34 And when Esau was forty years old, he took to wife Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and Basemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite. And they were a bitterness of spirit unto Isaac and to Rebekah.

Genesis 26:1-5 And there was <u>a famine</u> in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And **Isaac** went to Abimelech king of the Philistines to Gerar. And the LORD appeared to him, and said, <u>Go not down into Egypt</u>, dwell in the land which I shall tell you of: Sojourn in this land, and I will be with you, and will bless you, for to you, and to your seed, I will give all these countries, and <u>I will perform the oath which I swore to Abraham your father</u>, And I will make your seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give to your seed all these countries, and in your seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, <u>Because that Abraham obeyed my voice</u>, <u>and kept my charge</u>, <u>my commandments</u>, <u>my statutes</u>, <u>and my laws</u>.

Genesis 26:12-15 Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year one hundred times what he planted. The LORD blessed him. The man grew great, and grew more and more until he became very



great. He had possessions of flocks, possessions of herds, and a great household. The Philistines envied him. Now all the wells which his father's servants had dug in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped, and filled with earth.

Genesis 26:16,17 Abimelech said to Isaac, <u>Go from us</u>, for you are much mightier than we. Isaac departed from there, encamped <u>in the valley of Gerar</u>, and lived there.

Genesis 26:18 <u>Isaac dug again the wells of water</u>, which they had dug in the days of Abraham his father. For the <u>Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham</u>. He called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Genesis 27:1 And it came to pass, that when Isaac was old, and <u>his</u> eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called Esau <u>his</u> oldest son, and said to him, My son: And he said to him, Behold, here am I.

Genesis 48:10 Now the eyes of Israel were dim for age, so that he could not see. And he brought them near unto him and he kissed them, and embraced them.

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brothers, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own conceits, **that blindness** <u>in part</u> is happened to Israel, until the <u>fullness</u> of the Gentiles be come in.

1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly, but then face to face: Now I know in part, but then shall *I know even as also I am known*.

Matthew 7:22,23 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: Depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Isaiah 42:19-21 Who is blind, but my servant? Or deaf, as my messenger that I sent? Who is blind as he that is perfect, and blind as the LORD's servant? Seeing many things, but you observe not, opening the ears, but he hears not The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake, he will magnify the law, and make it honorable.

Luke 24:15,16 It happened, while they talked and questioned together, that Yeshua himself came near, and went with them. But their eyes were kept from recognizing him.

Genesis 27:2-4 And he said: Behold now, I am old, I know not the day of my death. Now therefore take, I pray thee, thy weapons, thy quiver and thy bow, and go out to the field, and take me venison, and make me savory food, such as I love, and bring it to me, that I may eat, that my soul may bless thee before I die.

Genesis 27:5-10 And Rebekah heard when Isaac spoke to Esau <u>his</u> <u>son</u>. And Esau went to the field to hunt for venison, and to bring it. And Rebekah spoke unto Jacob <u>her son</u>, saying: Behold, I heard thy father speak unto Esau thy brother, saying: Bring me venison, and make me savory food, that I may eat, and bless thee before the LORD before my death. Now therefore, my son, hearken to my voice according to that which I command thee. Go now to the flock, and fetch me from thence two good kids of the goats, and I will make them savory food for thy father, such as he loveth, and thou shalt bring it to thy father, that he may eat, **so that he may bless thee before his death.**

Genesis 27:15 And Rebekah took goodly raiment of her oldest son Esau, which were with her in the house, and put them on Jacob her younger son.

Genesis 27:19 And Jacob said unto his father: I am Esau thy first-born, I have done according as thou badest me. Arise, I pray thee, sit and eat of my venison, that thy soul may bless me.

Genesis 27:27-29 And he came near, and kissed him: And he smelled the smell of his raiment, and blessed him, and said, See, the



smell of my son is as the smell of a field, which the LORD has blessed: Therefore God give you of the <u>dew of heaven</u>, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine: Let <u>people serve</u> you, and <u>nations bow down to you</u>: Be <u>lord over your brothers</u>, and let <u>your mother's sons bow down to you</u>: Cursed be every one that curses you, and blessed be he that blesses you.

Hebrews 11:20 By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

Isaiah 26:19 Your dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, you that dwell in dust: For your **dew** is as the dew of herbs, and the **earth shall cast out the dead.**

Genesis 27:32-34 And Isaac his father said unto him: Who art thou? And he said: I am thy son, thy first-born, Esau. And Isaac trembled very exceedingly, and said: Who then is he that hath taken venison, and brought it me, and I have eaten of all before thou camest, and have blessed him? Yea, and he shall be blessed. When Esau heard the words of his father, he cried with an exceeding great and bitter cry, and said unto his father: Bless me, even me also, O my father.

Tammuz the Fourth Month A month of vision Reuben – See a son - Ruby

Genesis 29:32 And Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name **Reuben**: For she said, Surely the **LORD hath** <u>looked</u> upon my affliction, now therefore my husband will love me. *See, a son!*

Exodus 32:4,5 And he received the gold from their hand and fashioned it with a graving tool and made **a golden calf**. And they said, These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt! When Aaron saw this, he built an altar before it. The 17th of Tammuz July 4th 1776 golden calf

Numbers 13:25-28 They returned from **spying** out the land at the end of forty days. They went and came to Moses, and to Aaron, and to all the congregation of the children of Israel, to the wilderness of



Paran, to Kadesh, and brought back word to them, and to all the congregation, and **showed them** the fruit of the land. They told him, and said, We came to the land where you sent us, and surely it flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. However the people who dwell in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large. Moreover, **we saw** the children of Anak there.

Numbers 13:32,33 And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that **eateth up the inhabitants thereof**, and all the people that we saw in it are men of a great stature. And there we **saw** the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: And we were in our own **sight** as grasshoppers, and so we were in their **sight**.

Numbers 15:38,39a Speak to the children of Israel, and tell them that they should **make themselves fringes** in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put on the fringe of each border **a cord of blue**: And it shall be to you for a fringe, that you may **look on it**, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them, and that you not follow after **your own heart** and **your own eyes**,

Numbers 16:14 Moreover you haven't brought us into a land flowing with milk and honey, nor given us inheritance of fields and vineyards: Will you put out **the eyes** of these men? We won't come up.

Numbers 17:8 It happened on the next day, that Moses went into the tent of the testimony, and **behold**, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and put forth buds, and produced blossoms, and bore ripe almonds.

Numbers 21:6-9 The LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, and many people of Israel died. The people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, because we have spoken against the LORD, and against you. Pray to the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. Moses prayed for the people. The LORD said to Moses, Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a standard: And it



shall happen, that everyone who is bitten, when he <u>sees it</u>, shall live. Moses made a serpent of brass, and set it on the standard: And it happened, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he <u>looked</u> to the serpent of brass, he lived.

Numbers 22:2 Balak the son of Zippor <u>saw</u> all that Israel had done to the Amorites.

Numbers 22:23 The donkey <u>saw</u> the angel of the LORD standing in the way,

Numbers 22:31 Then the LORD <u>opened the eyes</u> of Balaam, and <u>he saw</u> the angel of the LORD standing in the way.

Numbers 25:6,7 Behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought to his brothers a Midianite woman <u>in the sight of Moses</u>, <u>and in the sight</u> of all the congregation of the children of Israel, while they were weeping at the door of the Tent of Meeting. When Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, <u>saw it</u>, he rose up from the midst of the congregation, and took a spear in his hand.

Esther 3:5 And when Haman <u>saw</u> that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

Isaiah 11:3 He will not judge by the sight of his eyes, neither decide by the hearing of his ears.

Genesis 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked, and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons.

2 Kings 25:1-4 And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, that



Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he, and all his host, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it, and they built forts against it round about. And the city was besieged unto the **eleventh year** of **king Zedekiah**. And on the **ninth day of the fourth month** the famine prevailed in the city, and there was **no bread** for the people of the land.

Jeremiah 52:6,7 And in the <u>fourth month</u>, in the <u>ninth day of the month</u>, the famine was sore in the city, so that there was **no bread** for the people of the land. Then the city was broken up, and all the men of war fled, and went forth out of the city by night by the way of the gate between the two walls, which was by the king's garden, (now the Chaldeans were by the city round about:) and they went by the way of the plain.

2 Kings 25:6,7 So they took the king, and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah, and they gave judgment upon him. And they **slew the sons of Zedekiah before** <u>his eyes</u>, and **put out the** <u>eyes</u> **of Zedekiah**, and bound him with fetters of brass, and carried him to Babylon.

Ezekiel 1:1-3 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, <u>in the</u> <u>fourth month</u>, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the heavens were opened, and I <u>saw visions</u> of God. In the fifth day of the month, which was the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity, The word of the LORD came expressly unto Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the river Chebar; and the hand of the LORD was there upon him.

Zechariah 8:19 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, The **fast of the fourth month**, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts, therefore love the truth and peace.

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: But he that keepeth the law, happy is he.



Lamentations 2:9 Her gates are sunk into the ground, he hath destroyed and broken her bars: Her king and her princes are among the Gentiles: The **law is no more**, her prophets also **find no vision** from the LORD.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light.

Mark 8:22-25 And he cometh to Bethsaida, and they bring a blind man unto him and besought him to touch him. And he took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town, and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought. And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: And he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly, but then face to face: Now I know in part, but then shall I know even as also I am known.

Romans 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits, that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Revelation 3:17,18 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing, and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and **blind**, and naked: I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich, and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear, and anoint thine eyes with eye salve, that thou mayest see.

1 John 2:9-11 He that saith he is in the light, and <u>hateth</u> his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness <u>hath blinded</u> his eyes.



2 Peter 1:5-9 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, and to virtue knowledge, And to knowledge temperance, and to temperance patience, and to patience godliness, And to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness charity. For *if these things be in you, and abound*, they make you that *ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful* in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacketh these things *is blind*, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Isaiah 6:9 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not, and see ye indeed, but perceive not.

2 Kings 6:15-17 And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host compassed the city both with horses and chariots. And his servant said unto him, Alas, my master! How shall we do? And he answered, Fear not: For they that be with us are more than they that be with them. And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw: And, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

Genesis 35:19-22 And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which is Bethlehem. And Jacob set a pillar upon her grave: That is the pillar of Rachel's grave unto this day. And Israel journeyed, and spread his tent beyond the tower of Edar. And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: And Israel heard it.

Genesis 49:3,4 Reuben, you art my first-born, my might, and the first-fruits of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power. Unstable as water, you have not the excellency, because you went up to your father's bed, then defiled it.

James 1:6-8 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavers is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.
