TORAH PORTION

Genesis 28:1-5 And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said unto him, You shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan.

Genesis 28:8,9 And Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father, Then went Esau unto Ishmael, and took unto the wives which he had Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife.

Genesis 28:10,11 And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran. And he <u>lighted</u> (came to) on <u>a certain place</u>, and tarried there all night, because the <u>sun was set</u>, and he <u>took of the stones</u> of that place, and put them for his pillows, and lay down in <u>that place</u> to sleep.

Genesis 28:12,13 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: And behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it. And, behold, the LORD stood above it(HIM), and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: The land where on thou lie, to you will I give it, and to your seed.

John 1:49-51 Nathanael said to him, Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are King of Israel! In answer Jesus said to him, You have faith because I said to you, I saw you under the fig-tree. You will see greater things than these. And he said to him, Truly I say to you all, You will see heaven opening and God's angels going up and coming down on the Son of man.

Isaiah 33:22 For the LORD is our Judge, the LORD is our Lawgiver, the LORD is our King, He will save us.

John 3:13 And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even **the Son of man** which is in heaven.



Proverbs 30:4 Who hath ascended up into heaven, and descended? Who hath gathered the wind in his fists? Who hath bound the waters in his garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou knowest?

Genesis 28:15 And, behold, <u>I am with you</u>, and will keep you in all places where you go, and will <u>bring you again into this land</u>, for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to you of.

Genesis 28:17-19a And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is this place! This is none other but the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven. And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it. And he called the name of that place Bethel.

Genesis 28:20-22 Then Jacob took an oath, and said, If God will be with me, and keep me safe on my journey, and give me food and clothing to put on, So that I come again to my father's house in peace, then I will take the Lord to be my God, And this stone which I have put up for a pillar will be God's house: And of all you give me, I will give a tenth part to you.

Genesis 29:1,2 Then Jacob went on his journey, and came into the land of the people of the east. And he looked, and behold a well in the field, and, lo, there were three flocks of sheep lying by it, for out of that well they watered the flocks: And a great stone was upon the well's mouth.

Genesis 29:4-6 And Jacob said unto them, My brethren, whence be ye? And they said, Of Haran are we. And he said to them, Have you any knowledge of Laban, the son of Nahor? And they said, We have. And he said to them, Is he well? And they said, He is well, and here is Rachel his daughter coming with the sheep.

Genesis 29:10,11 And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother. And Jacob kissed Rachel, and lifted up his voice, and wept.

Genesis 29:15 And Laban said unto Jacob, Because thou art my brother, shouldest thou therefore serve me for nought? Tell me, what shall thy wages be?

Genesis 29:18-20 And Jacob loved Rachel, and said, I will serve thee seven years for Rachel thy younger daughter. And Laban said, It is better that I give her to thee, than that I should give her to another man: Abide with me. And Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the love he had to her.

Genesis 29:22,23 And Laban gathered together <u>all the men of the place</u> and made a **feast**. And it came to pass in the evening, that he took Leah his daughter, and brought her to him, and he went in unto her.

Genesis 29:25-27 And in the morning Jacob saw that it was Leah: And he said to Laban, What have you done to me? Was I not working for you so that I might have Rachel? Why have you been false to me? And Laban said, In our country we do not let the younger daughter be married before the older. Let the week of the bride-feast come to its end and then we will give you the other in addition, if you will be my servant for another seven years. And Jacob did so, and fulfilled her week, and he gave him Rachel his daughter to wife.

Genesis 29:33 And she conceived again, and bare a son, and said, Because the LORD hath heard **that I was hated**, he hath therefore given me this son also: And she called his name **Simeon.**

Genesis 29:34,35 And she was with child again, and gave birth to a son, and said, Now at last my husband will be united to me, because I have given him three sons: So he was named Levi. And she was with child again, and gave birth to a son: And she said, This time I will give praise to the Lord: So he was named Judah, after this she had no more children for a time.

Genesis 30:5-8 And Bilhah became with child, and gave birth to a son. Then Rachel said, God has been my judge, and has given ear to my voice, and has given me a son, so he was named Dan. And again Bilhah, Rachel's servant, was with child, and gave birth to a second son. And Rachel said, I have had a great fight with my sister, and I have overcome her: And she gave the child the name Naphtali.


Genesis 30:9-13 When it was clear to Leah that she would have no more children for a time, she gave Zilpah, her servant, to Jacob as a wife. And Zilpah, Leah's servant, gave birth to a son. And Leah said, It has gone well for me: And she gave him the name Gad. And Zilpah, Leah's servant, gave birth to a second son. And Leah said, Happy am I! and all women will give witness to my joy: And she gave him the name Asher.

Genesis 30:18,19 Then Leah said, God has made payment to me for giving my servant-girl to my husband: So she gave her son the name Issachar. And again Leah became with child, and she gave Jacob a sixth son.

Genesis 30:20,21 And she said, God has given me a good brideprice, now at last will I have my husband living with me, for I have given him six sons: And she gave him the name Zebulun. After that she had a daughter, to whom she gave the name Dinah.

Genesis 30:24 And she gave him the name Joseph, saying, May the Lord give me another son.

Genesis 31:41 These twenty years I have been in your house, I was your servant for fourteen years because of your daughters,



and for **six years** I kept your flock, and ten times was my payment changed.

Genesis 32:1-4 And on his way Jacob came face to face with the angels of God. And when he saw them he said, This is the army of God: So he gave that place the name of Mahanaim. Now Jacob sent servants before him to Esau, his brother, in the land of Seir, the country of Edom, And he gave them orders to say these words to Esau: Your servant Jacob says, Till now I have been living with Laban.

Simeon - The Month of AV

Genesis 29:33 And she conceived again, and bare a son, and said, Because the LORD hath **heard** that <u>I was hated</u>, he hath therefore given me this son also: And she called his name Simeon.

Genesis 34:25,26 And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males. And they slew Hamor and Shechem his son with the edge of the sword, and took Dinah out of Shechem's house, and went out.

Genesis 49:5-7 Simeon and Levi are brethren, instruments of cruelty are in their habitations. O my soul, come not thou into their secret, unto their assembly, mine honor, be not thou united: For in their anger they slew a man, and in their self will they dug down a wall. Cursed be their anger, for it was fierce, and their wrath, for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob, and scatter them in Israel.

Joshua 19:1 And the second lot came out for Simeon, even for the tribe of the children of Simeon according to their families, and their inheritance was in the midst of the inheritance of the children of Judah.



Joshua 19:9 Out of the allotment of the children of Judah was the inheritance of the children of Simeon, for the portion of the children of Judah was too much for them, therefore the children of Simeon had inheritance in the midst of their inheritance.

Judges 1:3 And **Judah said unto Simeon** his brother: Come up with me into my lot, that we may fight against the Canaanites, and I likewise will go with thee into thy lot. So Simeon went with him.

Genesis 37:20 Come now therefore, and let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast hath devoured him: And we shall see what will become of his dreams.

Genesis 37:24 And they took him, and cast him into a pit.

Genesis 42:21-24 And they said one to another, We are verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear, therefore is this distress come upon us. And Reuben answered them, saying, Spoke I not unto you, saying, Do not sin against the child, and ye would not hear? Therefore, behold, also his blood is required. And they knew not that Joseph understood them, for he spoke unto them by an interpreter. And he turned himself about from them, and wept, and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them <u>Simeon</u>, and bound him before their eyes.

Zechariah 7:11-13 But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear. Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: Therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts. Therefore it is come to pass, that as he cried, and they would not hear, so they cried, and I would not hear, saith the LORD of hosts.



Numbers 33:38 And Aaron the priest went up into mount Hor at the commandment of the LORD, and died there, in the fortieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the fifth month, on the first day of the month. And Aaron was a hundred and twenty and three years old when he died in mount Hor.

Psalm 133:1,2 A Song of Ascents, of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together <u>in unity</u>! It is like the precious oil upon the head, coming down upon the beard, even <u>Aaron's beard</u>, that cometh down upon the collar of his garments.

Malachi 2:6 The law of truth was in his mouth, and unrighteousness was not found in his lips, he walked with Me in peace and uprightness, and did turn many away from iniquity.

Genesis 8:3-12 And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: In the tenth month, on the first day of the month, (1st of Tammuz!) were the tops of the mountains seen. And it came to pass at the **end of forty days**, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: And he sent forth a raven, and it went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth. And he **sent forth a dove** from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground, but the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him to the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: And he put forth his hand, and took her, and brought her in unto him into the ark. (11th of AV) And he staved yet other seven days, and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark, and the dove came in to him at eventide, and, lo, in her mouth an olive-leaf plucked off: (18th of AV) so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth. And he stayed yet other seven days, and sent forth the dove; (25th of AV) and she returned not again unto him anymore.

Olive tree represents Redemption!



Job 1:7 And the LORD said to Satan, From where come you? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, <u>From going to and fro in the earth</u>, and from walking up and down in it.

2 Kings 25:8-14 And in the fifth month, on the seventh day of the month, which is the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem: And he burnt the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every great man's house burnt he with fire.

Jeremiah 52:12,13 Now in the fifth month, in the tenth day of the month, which was the nineteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, which served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem, And burned the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all the houses of Jerusalem, and all the houses of the great men, burned he with fire.

Ezekiel 20:1-3 And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month, that certain of the elders of Israel came to enquire of the LORD, and sat before me. Then came the word of the LORD unto me, saying, Son of man, speak unto the elders of Israel, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD, Are ye come to enquire of me? As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will not be enquired of by you.

Ezra 7:8,9 And he came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king. For upon the first day of the first month began he to go up from Babylon, and on the first day of the fifth month came he to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him.

Psalm 103:13,14 Like as a father hath compassion upon his children, so hath the LORD compassion upon them that fear Him. For He knoweth our frame, He remembereth that we are dust.



Judges 21:18 Howbeit we may not give them wives of our daughters. For the children of Israel had sworn, saying: Cursed be he that giveth a wife to Benjamin.

Judges 21:20 And they commanded the children of Benjamin, saying: Go and lie in wait in the vineyards, and see, and, behold, if the daughters of Shiloh come out to dance in the dances, then come ye out of the vineyards, and catch you every man his wife of the daughters of Shiloh, and go to the land of Benjamin.

Judges 21:25 In those days there was no king in Israel, every man did that which was right in his own eyes.

Zechariah 8:19 Thus saith the LORD of hosts: The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful seasons, therefore love ye truth and peace.

Revelation 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: And out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword

Genesis 45:1-6 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried: Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren. And he wept aloud, and the Egyptians heard, and the house of Pharaoh heard. And Joseph said unto his brethren: I am Joseph, doth my father yet live? And his brethren could not answer him, for they were affrighted at his presence. And Joseph said unto his brethren: Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said: I am Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt. And now be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither, for God did send me before you to preserve life. For these two years hath the famine been in the land, and there are yet five years, in which there shall be neither plowing nor harvest.
