TORAH PORTION

Obadiah 1:10-12 For thy **violence** against thy brother Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off forever. In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even **thou wast as one of them**. But thou shouldst not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither **shouldst thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction**, neither **shouldst thou have spoken proudly** in the day of distress.

Obadiah 1:14,15 Neither shouldst thou **have stood in the crossway**, to cut off those of his that did escape, neither shouldst thou have **delivered up those of his that did remain in the day of distress**. For the day of the LORD is near upon all the heathen: **As thou hast done, it shall be done unto thee**: Thy reward shall return upon thine own head.

Genesis 32:3 And **Jacob sent messengers** before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

Genesis 32:6 And the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, We came to thy brother Esau, and also he cometh to meet thee, **and four hundred men with him**.

Genesis 32:7 Then Jacob was **greatly afraid and distressed**: And he **divided the people that was with him, and the flocks, and herds, and the camels, into two bands**.

Genesis 31:41 **These twenty years** have I been in thy house: I served thee fourteen years for thy two daughters, and six years for thy flock, and thou hast changed my wages ten times.

Genesis 32:22-25 And he rose up that night, and took his **two wives**, and his **two women servants**, and his **eleven sons**, and passed **over the ford Jabbok**. And he took them, and sent them over the brook, and sent over that he had. **And Jacob was left alone**, and there

wrestled a man with him **until the breaking of the day**. And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh, and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.

Deuteronomy 21:15,16 **If a man have two wives**, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he maketh his sons to inherit that which he hath, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn.

Hosea 12:2-4 The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways; According to his doings will he recompense him. He took his brother **by the heel in the womb**, and **by his strength he had power with God**. Yes, he wept and cried to Him, and he had **power over the Angel** and **overcame**.

Genesis 32:26-30 And He said, Let Me go, for the day breaks. And he said, I will not let You go except You bless me. And He said to him, What is your name? And he said, Jacob. And **He said, Your name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel**, for as a prince have you **power with God** and with men, and have prevailed. And Jacob asked him and said, Tell me, I pray You, Your name. And He said, Why is it that you do ask after My name? And **He blessed him** there. And Jacob called the name of the place **Peniel**, for **I have seen God face to face**, and my life is preserved.

Revelation 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him **the name** of my God, and the **name of the city** of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: And I will write upon him **my new name**.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches, To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone

a **new name** written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Genesis 33:4 And Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck, and **kissed him**: And **they wept**.

Genesis 33:18 And Jacob came in peace to the **city of Shechem**, which is in the land of Canaan, when he came from Paddan-aram, and encamped before the city.

Genesis 33:19,20 And for a **hundred bits of money he got from the children of Hamor**, the builder of Shechem, **the field in which he had put up his tents**. And there he put up an altar, naming it El, the God of Israel.

Genesis 36:2 Esau took his wives of the daughters of Canaan, Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and **Aholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite**.

Genesis 34:1,2 Now **Dinah**, the daughter whom Leah had by Jacob, went out to see the women of that country. And when **Shechem**, the son of **Hamor the Hivite** who was the chief of that land, saw her, he **took her by force** and had connection with her.

Genesis 34:5 Now **Jacob had word** of what Shechem had done to **his daughter**; but his sons were in the fields with the cattle, and **Jacob said nothing till they came**.

Genesis 34:11-16 And Shechem said to her father and her brothers, If you will give ear to my request, whatever you say I will give to you. However great you make the bride-price and payment, I will give it, only let me have the girl for my wife. But the sons of Jacob gave a false answer to Shechem and Hamor his father, because of what had been done to Dinah their sister. And they said, It is not possible for us to give our sister to one who is without circumcision, for that would be a cause of shame to us: But on this condition only will we come to an agreement with you: **if every male among you becomes like us and undergoes circumcision**; (Then we will give

our daughters to you and take your daughters to us and go on living with you as one people.)

Genesis 34:18-22 And their words were pleasing to Hamor and his son Shechem. And without loss of time the young man did as they said, because he had delight in Jacob's daughter, and **he was the noblest** of his father's house. Then Hamor and Shechem, his son, went to the meeting-place of their town, and said to the men of the town, It is the desire of these men to be at peace with us, let them then go on living in this country and doing trade here, for the country is wide open before them, let us take their daughters as wives and let us give them our daughters. Only herein will the men consent unto us for to dwell with us, to be one people, if every male among us be circumcised, as they are circumcised.

Genesis 34:23 Then will not their cattle and their goods and all their beasts be ours? So let us come to an agreement with them so that they may go on living with us.

Genesis 34:24,25 Then all the men of the town gave ear to the words of Hamor and Shechem his son, and every male in the town underwent circumcision. And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Deuteronomy 21:10-13 When thou goest forth to war against thine enemies, and the LORD thy God hath delivered them into thine hands, and thou hast taken them captive, And seest among the captives a beautiful woman, and hast a desire unto her, that thou wouldest have her to thy wife, Then thou shalt bring her home to thine house, and she shall shave her head, and pare her nails, And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother a full month: And after that thou shalt go in unto her, and be her husband, and she shall be thy wife.

Genesis 34:29 And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and **their wives took they captive**, and spoiled even all that was in the house.

Genesis 34:30,31 And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi: Ye have troubled me, to make me odious unto the inhabitants of the land, even unto the Canaanites and the Perizzites, and, I being few in number, they will gather themselves together against me and smite me, and I shall be destroyed, I and my house. And they said: Should one deal with **our sister** as with a harlot?

Genesis 35:1 And God said to Jacob, Arise, **go up to Bethel**, and dwell there: And **make there an altar to God**, that appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother.

Genesis 35:2-5 Then Jacob said to his household, and to all that were with him, **Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments.** And let us arise and go up to Bethel, and I will make there an altar to God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went. And they gave to Jacob all the strange gods which were in their hand, and all their earrings which were in their ears. And Jacob hid them under the **oak which was by Shechem.** And they journeyed. And the terror of God was on the cities that were round about them, **and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob.**

Genesis 35:10-12 And **God said** to him, Your name is Jacob: Your name shall not be called any more Jacob, but **Israel** shall be your name: And **He called his name Israel.** And God said to him, I am God Almighty: Be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of you, and kings shall come out of your loins, And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to you I will give it, and to your seed after you will I give the land.

Genesis 35:16-18 And they journeyed from Bethel, and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: And Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour. And it came to pass, when she was in hard labour, that the midwife said unto her, Fear not, thou shalt have this son also. And it came to pass, as her soul was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name **Benoni:** But his father called him **Benjamin.**

Genesis 35:19-21 And **Rachel died** and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which is Bethlehem. And Jacob set a pillar on her grave: That is the pillar of Rachel's grave to this day. And Israel journeyed, and spread his tent beyond the **tower of Edar**.

Genesis 35:22 And it came to pass, while Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his **father's concubine**, and Israel heard of it. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve.

Genesis 35:29 And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, being old and full of days: And his sons **Esau and Jacob** buried him.

Genesis 37:2 These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was feeding the flock with his brethren, being still a lad even with **the sons of Bilhah, and with the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives**.

Exodus 1:7 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty, and the land was filled with them.

Exodus 38:26 A bekah for every man, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that went to be numbered, from **twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.**

Month of Return and Repentance

Genesis 30:11 And Leah said, **Good fortune has come!** so she called his name **Gad**.

Proverbs 18:22 He who finds a wife finds a good thing and obtains favor from the Lord.

Deuteronomy 33:20,21 Of Gad he said, A blessing be on him who makes **wide the limits of Gad**: He takes his rest like a she-lion, taking for himself the arm and the crown of the head. He kept for himself the first part, for his was the ruler's right: **He put in force the righteousness of the Lord**, and **His decisions for Israel**.

Genesis 49:19 Gad, an army will come against him, but he will come down on them in their flight.

Exodus 34:28 And he was there with the LORD **forty days and forty nights**, he did **neither eat bread, nor drink water**. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

Exodus 34:6,7 And the Lord went past before his eyes, saying, The Lord, the Lord, a God full of pity and grace, slow to wrath and great in mercy and faith, Having mercy on thousands, overlooking evil and wrongdoing and sin, he will not let wrongdoers go free, but will send punishment on children for the sins of their fathers, and on their children's children to the third and fourth generation.

Matthew 4:1,2 Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. **And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights**, afterward he was hungry.

Jonah 3:4-6 And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, **Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown**. So the people of Nineveh believed God, **and proclaimed a fast**, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

Mark 4:29 But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he puts in the sickle, because **the harvest** is come.

Revelation 14:15-18 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy

sickle, and reap: For the time is come for thee to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe. And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped. And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire, and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather **the clusters of the vine** of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe.

Jeremiah 31:20,21 Is Ephraim my dear son? Is he a darling child? For as often as I speak against him, I do earnestly remember him still: Therefore my heart yearns for him, **I will surely have mercy** on him, says the LORD. **Set up road signs, make guideposts**, set your heart toward the highway, even the way by which you went: **Turn again, virgin** of Israel, **turn again** to these your cities.

SOS 2:15 Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: For our vines have tender grapes.

Nehemiah 6:15,16 So the wall was finished in the twenty and fifth day of the month Elul, in fifty and two days. And it came to pass, when all our enemies heard thereof, that all the nations that were about us feared, and were much cast down in their own eyes, for they perceived that this work was wrought of our God.

Ezekiel 8:1-3 Now in the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day of the month, when I was in my house and the responsible men of Judah were seated before me, the hand of the Lord came on me

there. And looking, I saw a form like fire, from the middle of his body and down there was fire: And up from the middle of his body a sort of shining, like electrum. And he put out the form of a hand and took me by the hair of my head, and the wind, lifting me up between the earth and the heaven, took me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the way into the inner door facing to the north; where was the seat of the image of envy.

Haggai 1:1-5 In the second year of Darius the king, **in the sixth month, on the first day of the month**, came the word of the Lord by Haggai the prophet to Zerubbabel, the son of Shealtiel, ruler of Judah, and to Joshua, the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, saying, These are the words of the Lord of armies: **These people say, The time has not come for building the Lord's house. Then the word of the Lord came by Haggai the prophet, saying, Is it a time for you to be living in roofed houses while this house is a waste?** For this cause the Lord of armies has said, Give thought to your ways.

Haggai 1:13-15 Then Haggai, whom the Lord had sent to give his words to the people, said, I am with you, says the Lord. And the spirit of Zerubbabel, the son of Shealtiel, ruler of Judah, was moved by the Lord, as was the spirit of Joshua, the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the rest of the people, and they came and did work in the house of the Lord of armies, their God. **On the twenty-fourth day of the month, in the sixth month**, in the second year of Darius the king.

Daniel 3:16,17 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego, answering Nebuchadnezzar the king, said, There is no need for us to give you an answer to this question. If our God, whose servants we are, **is able to keep us safe** from the burning and flaming fire, and from your hands, O King, he will keep us safe.

Romans 13:11,12 And that, **knowing the time**, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: For now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness and let us put on the armor of light.

Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways give ear to him, and he will make straight your footsteps.

1 Chronicles 21:28 At that time when David saw that the LORD had answered him in the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite, then he sacrificed there. **For the tabernacle of the LORD, which Moses made in the wilderness, and the altar of the burnt offering, were at that season in the high place at Gibeon.**

Jeremiah 28:1 And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the fourth year, and in **the fifth month**, that **Hananiah** the son of Azur **the prophet, which was of Gibeon, spoke unto me in the house of the LORD**, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying,

Jeremiah 28:15-17 Then said **the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet**, Hear now, Hananiah, The LORD hath not sent thee, but thou makes this people to trust in a lie. Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: **This year thou shalt die**, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. So Hananiah the prophet **died the same year in the seventh month.**
