TORAH PORTION

Genesis 41:1-3 And it came to pass at <u>the end</u> of <u>two full years</u>, that Pharaoh dreamed: And behold, he stood by the river. And behold, there came up out of the river seven well-favored cows and fat, and they fed in a meadow. And behold, seven other cows came up after them out of the river, ill-favored and skinny; and stood by the other cows on the brink of the river.

Exodus 23:14-16 Three times you shall keep a feast to me in the year. You shall keep the feast of unleavened bread: You shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, in the time appointed of the month Abib,(*Spring*) for in it you came out from Egypt: And none shall appear before me empty: And the feast of harvest, (*Summer*) the first fruits of your labors, which you have sown in the field: And the feast of ingathering, (*Fall*) which is in **the end of the year**, when you have gathered in your labors out of the field.


Genesis 41:9 Then the chief butler spoke to Pharaoh, saying, <u>I do</u> remember <u>my faults</u> this day.

Leviticus 23:24 Speak to the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall you have a sabbath, <u>a memorial</u> of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.

Genesis 41:40,41 You shall be over my house, and according to your word shall all my people be ruled: Only in the throne will I be greater than you. And Pharaoh said to Joseph, See, <u>I have set you over all the land of Egypt</u>.

Genesis 41:14a Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him <u>hastily</u> out of the dungeon.

Isaiah 56:1 Thus said the LORD, Keep you judgment, and do justice: For <u>my salvation (Yeshua) is near to come</u>, and my righteousness to be revealed.



Revelation 3:11 Behold, <u>I come quickly</u>: Hold that fast which you have, that no man take your crown.

Malachi 3:1 Behold, I will send <u>my messenger</u>, and he shall prepare the way before me: And the Lord, whom ye seek, shall <u>suddenly</u> <u>come to his temple</u>, <u>even the messenger of the covenant</u>, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

1 Corinthians 15:52 <u>In a moment</u>, in the <u>twinkling of an eye</u>, at the <u>last trump</u>: For the trumpet shall sound, and <u>the dead shall be raised</u> incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Daniel 12:1,2 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: And there shall **be a time of trouble**, such **as never was** since there was a nation even to that same time: And at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found **written in the book**. And many of them that **sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake**, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Genesis 41:38,39 And Pharaoh said to his servants, Can we find such a one as this, a man in <u>whom the Spirit of God is</u>? And Pharaoh said to Joseph, For as much as God has showed you all this, there is none so <u>discreet and wise</u> as you are.

Genesis 41:42,43 And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck, And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had, and they cried before him, **Bow the knee:** And he made him ruler over all the land of Egypt.

Philippians 2:10 That at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth.

Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.

Isaiah 45:23 Give the word, put forward your cause, let us have a discussion together: Who has given news of this in the past? Who made it clear in early times? Did not I, the Lord? And there is no God but me, a true God and a Savior, there is no other. Let your hearts be turned to me, so that you may have salvation, all the ends of the earth: For I am God, and there is no other. By myself have I taken an oath, a true word has gone from my mouth, and will not be changed, **that to me every knee will be bent, and every tongue will give honor.**

Genesis 41:45a And Pharaoh called Joseph's name Zaphnathpaaneah.

Genesis 41:49,50 And Joseph gathered grain <u>as the sand of the sea</u>, very much, until he left numbering, for it was without number. And to Joseph <u>were born **two sons before the years of famine**</u> came, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bore unto him.

Genesis 41:51-53 And Joseph called the name of the firstborn <u>Manasseh</u>: For God, said he, has made me <u>forget</u> all my toil, and <u>all</u> <u>my father's house</u>. And the name of the second called he <u>Ephraim</u>: For God has caused me to be <u>fruitful</u> in **the land of my affliction**. And the seven years of plenty, that was in the land of Egypt, were ended.

Genesis 42:1-5 Now Jacob, hearing that there was grain in Egypt, said to his sons, **Why are you looking at one another**? And he said, **I have had news** that there is grain in Egypt: Go down there and get grain for us, so that life and not death may be ours. Joseph's ten brothers went down to buy grain from Egypt. But Jacob didn't send Benjamin, Joseph's brother, with his brothers, for he said, Lest perhaps harm happen to him. The sons of Israel came to buy among those who came, for the famine was in the land of Canaan.

Genesis 42:14-18 And Joseph said, It is as I said, you have come with some secret purpose, But in this way will you be put to the test: By the life of Pharaoh, you will not go away from this place till your youngest brother comes here. Send one of your number to get your brother, and the rest of you will be kept in prison, so that your

words may be tested to see if you are true, if not, by the life of Pharaoh, your purpose is certainly secret. So, he put them in prison for three days. And on the third day Joseph said to them, Do this, if you would keep your lives: For I am a god-fearing man.

Genesis 42:19-24 If you be true men, let one of your brothers be bound in the house of your prison: Go you, carry corn for the famine of your houses: But bring your youngest brother to me, so shall your words be verified, and you shall not die. And they did so. And they said one to another, We are truly guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he sought us, and we would not hear, therefore is this distress come on us. And Reuben answered them, saying, Spoke I not to you, saying, Do not sin against the child, and you would not hear? Therefore, behold, also his blood is required. And they knew not that Joseph understood them, for he spoke to them by an interpreter. And he turned himself about from them, and wept, and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

Romans 11:8 (According as it is written, <u>God</u> has given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and <u>ears that they should not hear</u>) to this day.

Genesis 42:27,28 And as one of them opened his sack to give his ass provender in the inn, he espied his money, for, behold, it was in his sack's mouth. And he said to his brothers, My money is restored, and see, it is even in my sack: And their heart failed them, and they were <u>afraid</u>, saying one to another, What is this that God has done to us?

Genesis 42:37,38 And Reuben spoke to his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to you: Deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to you again. And he said, My son shall not go down with you.

Genesis 43:8,9 And Judah said to Israel his father, Send the lad with me, and we will arise and go, that we may live, and not die, both we, and you, and also our little ones. <u>I will be surety for him</u>, of <u>my hand</u>



shall you require him: If I bring him not to you, and set him before you, then <u>let me bear the blame</u> for ever.



Genesis 1:14 And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.



Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: Only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) Then they laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: For thy heart is not **right** in the sight of God.
