### **TORAH PORTION**

**Exodus 1:1** And these are <u>the names</u> of the sons of Israel who are coming into Egypt with Jacob, a man and his household have they come.

**Exodus 1:8,9** Now there arose up a new king over <u>Egypt</u>, **which knew not Joseph**. And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we.

**Exodus 1:10,11** Come on, let us deal wisely with them, <u>lest they multiply</u>, and it come to pass, that, when there falls out any war, they join also to our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land. Therefore, they did set over them *taskmasters* to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for **Pharaoh** treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

**Exodus 1:15,16** And the king of Egypt spoke to the **Hebrew** midwives, of which the name of the one was <u>Shiphrah</u>, and the name of the other <u>Puah</u>: And he said, When you do the office of a midwife to the **Hebrew women**, and see them on the stools; if it be a son, then you shall kill him: but if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

**Exodus 1:17** But the midwives feared God and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them but saved the men children alive.

**Exodus 1:22** And Pharaoh <u>charged all his people</u>, saying, Every son <u>that is born you</u> shall <u>cast</u> into the river, and every daughter you shall save alive.

Exodus 2:1,2 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi. And the woman conceived and bore a son: And when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

**Exodus 2:5-10** And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river, and her maidens walked along by the river's side, and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. And when she had opened it, she saw the child: And, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. Then said his sister to **Pharaoh's daughter**, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee? And **Pharaoh's daughter** said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother. And **Pharaoh's daughter** said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it. And the child grew, and she brought him unto **Pharaoh's daughter**, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: And she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

1 Chronicles 4:15a <u>And the sons</u> of <u>Caleb</u> the son of Jephunneh.

1 Chronicles 4:18b And these are the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Exodus 2:11-15 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brothers, and <u>looked on their burdens</u>: And he spied an Egyptian smiting a Hebrew, one of his brothers. And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: And he said to him that did the wrong, Why smite you your fellow? And he said, <u>Who made you a prince and a judge over us</u>? Intend you to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelled in the land of Midian: And he sat down by a well.

**Numbers 16:12,13** And Moses sent to call Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and they said: We will not come up, is it a small thing that thou hast brought us up out of a land flowing with milk

and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, but thou must needs make thyself also a prince over us?

**Exodus 2:16-19** Now the priest of Midian had **seven daughters**: And they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. And the shepherds came and drove them away: But Moses stood up and helped them, and watered their flock. And when they came to **Reuel** their father, he said, How is it that you are come so soon to day? And they said, **An Egyptian** delivered us out of the hand of <u>the shepherds</u>, and also <u>drew water enough for us</u>, and watered the flock.

**Exodus 2:23** And it came to pass in process of time, that the **king of Egypt died**: And the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.

**Exodus 3:1,2** Now Moses **kept the flock** of **Jethro** his father in law, the priest of Midian: And he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the middle of a bush: And he looked, and, behold, **the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.** 

**Deuteronomy 4:24** For the LORD your God is a consuming fire.

**Exodus 3:3-6** And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. And he said, Draw not nigh hither: Put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.

Psalm 68:4 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name: Yah איז

**Exodus 3:7** And the **LORD** said, <u>I have surely seen</u> the affliction of <u>my people</u> which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters, for <u>I know their sorrows</u>.

**Exodus 3:8** And <u>I am come down to deliver them</u> out of the hand of the Egyptians, and <u>to bring them up out</u> of that land to a good land and a large, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

**Exodus 3:10** Come now therefore, and <u>I will send you</u> to Pharaoh, that <u>you may bring</u> forth <u>my people</u> the children of Israel <u>out of Egypt</u>.

**Exodus 32:7** And the LORD said to Moses, Go, get you down; for **your people**, **which you brought out** of **the land of Egypt**, have corrupted themselves.

**Exodus 32:11** And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people**, **which you have brought forth** out of the **land of Egypt** with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 3:11,12 And Moses said to God, אלהים Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt? And he said, Certainly I will be with you, and this shall be a token to you, that I have sent you: When you have brought forth the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.

**Exodus 3:13** And Moses said to God, Behold, when I come to the children of Israel, and shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they shall say to me, **What is his name?** What shall I say to them?

**Exodus 3:14** And God אלהים said to Moses אהיה אשר אהיה <u>I AM</u> THAT I AM: And he said, Thus shall you say to the children of Israel, <u>I AM</u> has sent me to you.

**Isaiah 48:12** Hearken unto **Me**, O Jacob, and Israel My called: **I am He**; *I am the first, I also am the last*. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens, when I call out to them, they stand up together.

**John 18:4-6** Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were happening to him, went forth, and said to them, Who are you looking for? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said to them, I am he. Judah also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, I am He, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Exodus 3:18 And they will give ear to your voice: And you, with the chiefs of Israel, will go to Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, and say to him, The Lord, the God of the Hebrews, has come to us: (Please) let us then go three days' journey into the waste land to make an offering to the Lord our God.

Exodus 5:1 And after that, <u>Moses and Aaron</u> came to Pharaoh, and said, The Lord, the God of Israel, says, Let my people go so that they may keep a feast to me in the waste land.

**Exodus 5:2** And Pharaoh said: **Who is the LORD**, why should **I obey His voice** to **let Israel go**? I know not the LORD, and moreover I will not let Israel go.

And Rachel said, God hath judged me, and hath also heard my voice, and hath given me a son: Therefore called she his name Dan. we pray thee, three days' journey into the wasteland, to make an offering to the LORD our God, *lest He fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword*.

**Exodus 4:2** And the LORD said unto him, What is that in thine hand? And he said, A rod. And he said, Cast it on the ground.

NOTES

And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent, and Moses fled from before it.

**Exodus 4:21** And the LORD said to Moses, When you go to return into Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in your hand: but <u>I will **harden**</u> his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Exodus 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened 735 his heart, and listened not to them, as the LORD had said.

# 10<sup>th</sup> Month TEVET – Dan – Judge or rule

Genesis 30:6 And Rachel said, God hath judged me, and hath also heard my voice, and hath given me a son: Therefore called she his name Dan.

Psalm 110:6 He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill the places with the dead bodies, he shall wound the heads over many countries.

**Deuteronomy 32:36** For the **Lord will be judge of his people,** he will have pity for his servants, when he sees that their power is gone, there is no one, shut up or free.

**Deuteronomy 32:40-43** For lifting up my hand to heaven I say, By my unending life, If I make sharp my shining sword, and my hand is outstretched for judging, I will give punishment to those who are against me, and their right reward to my haters. I will make my arrows red with blood, my sword will be feasting on flesh, with the blood of the dead and the prisoners, of the longhaired heads of my haters. Be glad, O you his people, over the nations, for he will take payment for the blood of his servants, and will give punishment to his haters, and take away the sin of his land, for his people.

**Revelation 19:1,2** After this I heard what seemed to be the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, crying out, Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God, for his judgments are true and just, for he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality, and has avenged on her the blood of his servants.

Genesis 49:16-18 <u>Dan shall judge</u> his people, as one of the tribes of Israel. Dan shall be a serpent by the way, an adder in the path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward. I have waited for thy salvation, O Lord.

**Deuteronomy 33:22** And of Dan he said, **Dan is a young lion**: He shall leap from Bashan.

**Judges 13:2** Now there was a certain man of Zorah of the family **of the Danites,** and his name was Manoah; and his wife had never given birth to a child.

**Judges 13:24,25** And the woman bare a son, and called his name **Samson:** And the child grew, and the LORD blessed him. And the Spirit of the LORD began to move him at times **in the camp of Dan** between Zorah and Eshtaol.

Judges 14:3-6 Then his father and mother said to him, Is there no woman among the daughters of your relations or among all my people, that you have to go for your wife to the Philistines, who are without circumcision? But Samson said to his father, Get her for me, for she is pleasing to me. Now his father and mother had no knowledge that this was the purpose of the Lord, who had the destruction of the Philistines in mind. Now the Philistines at that time were ruling over Israel. Then Samson went down to Timnah (and his father and his mother,) and came to the vine-gardens of Timnah, and a young lion came rushing out at him. And the spirit of the Lord came on him with power, and, unarmed as he was, pulling the lion in two as one might do to a young goat, he put him to death, (but he said nothing to his father and mother of what he had done.)

Exodus 35:30-35 And Moses said unto the children of Israel, See, the LORD hath called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah; And he hath filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, And to devise curious works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, And in the cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of wood, to make any manner of cunning work. And he hath put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. Them hath he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, even of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

**Exodus 38:22,23** And **Bezaleel** the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the **tribe of Judah**, made all that the Lord commanded Moses. And with him was **Aholiab**, son of Ahisamach, **of the tribe of Dan**, an engraver, and a cunning workman, and an embroiderer in blue, and in purple, and in scarlet, and fine linen.

Numbers 2:25 The standard of the camp of Dan shall be on the north side by their armies: And the captain of the children of Dan shall be Ahiezer the son of

Numbers 10:25 And the flag of the children of Dan, whose tents were moved last of all, went forward with their armies: And at the head of his army was Ahiezer, the son of Ammishaddai.

Judges 18:29-31 And they called the name of the city Dan, after the name of Dan their father, who was born unto Israel: Howbeit the name of the city was Laish at the first. And the children of Dan set up the graven image: And Jonathan, the son of Gershom, the son of Manasseh, he and his sons were priests to the tribe of Dan until the day of the captivity of the land. And they set them up Micah's graven image, which he made, all the time that the house of God was in Shiloh.

### **Tragedy in the month of Tevet**

Ezekiel 24:1 Again in the ninth year, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of man, write thee the name of the day, even of this same day: The king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

1 Kings 12:28-30 Whereupon the king took counsel and made two calves of gold, and he said unto them: Ye have gone up long enough to Jerusalem, behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt. And he set the one in Beth-el, and the other put he in Dan. And this thing became a sin, for the people went to worship before the one, even unto Dan.

**Ezekiel 33:21** And it came to pass in the twelfth year of our captivity, **in the tenth month**, in the **fifth day** of the month, that one that had escaped out of Jerusalem came unto me, saying, The city is smitten.

Ezekiel 29:1,2 In the tenth year, in the tenth month, in the twelfth day of the month, the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Son of man, set thy face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt.
