

TORAH PORTION

Exodus 10:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, <u>Go</u> into Pharaoh: For I have hardened his heart, and the heart of his servants, that **I might show these** <u>my signs</u> before him.

Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said, **Who is the LORD**, that I **should obey his voice** to **let Israel go?**

Exodus 10:2 <u>And (*in order*)</u> that you may recount in the ears of your son, and of your son's son, <u>what things I have worked in Egypt</u> by <u>My signs</u> which I have done among them, that <u>you may know how</u> that I am the LORD.

Exodus 10;3,4 And <u>Moses and Aaron came into Pharaoh</u>, and said to him, Thus said the LORD God **of the Hebrews**, How long will you refuse to humble yourself before me? <u>Let my people go</u>, that they may serve me. Else, if you refuse to <u>let my people go</u>, behold, tomorrow will <u>I bring the locusts into your coast</u>.

Exodus 10:6 And they shall fill your houses, and the houses of all your servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians, which neither your fathers, nor your fathers' fathers have seen, since the day that they were on the earth to this day. <u>And he turned himself, and went out from Pharaoh.</u>

Exodus 10;7 And Pharaoh's **servants said to him**, How long shall this man be a snare to us? <u>Let the men go</u>, that they may serve the LORD their God: Don't you know that Egypt is destroyed?

Exodus 10:8,9 And Moses and Aaron were brought again to Pharaoh: And he said to them, Go, serve the LORD your God: But who are they that shall go? **And Moses said**, We will go with our young and with our old, with our sons and with our daughters, with our flocks and with our herds will we go, for we must hold a feast to the LORD. Genesis 50:8 and all the house of Joseph, and his brethren, and his father's house, only their little ones, and their flocks, and their herds, they left in the land of Goshen.

Exodus 10:10,11 But he said to them, The Lord be with you, if ever I let you and your little ones go! Look, you have some evil purpose in mind. No! Go, the men among you, and serve the Lord, **for that is what you are asking**. And they were driven out from Pharaoh's presence.

Exodus 10:20-23 But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go. And the LORD said to Moses, **Stretch out your hand** toward heaven, that there may **be darkness** over the land of Egypt, **even darkness** which may be felt. And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven, and there was a **thick darkness** in all the land of Egypt **three days:** They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: But all the **children of Israel had light in their dwellings**.

Exodus 12:1-3 And the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying, This month shall be to you the beginning of months: <u>It shall be the first month of the year</u> to you. Speak you to all the congregation of Israel, saying, **In the tenth day of this month** they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house.

Exodus 12:7-8 And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper doorpost of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. And they shall <u>eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire,</u> and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

Exodus 12:12 For I will go through the land of Egypt in that night, and will smite all the first-born in the land of Egypt, both man and beast, and <u>against all the gods of Egypt</u> I will execute judgments: I am the LORD.

Exodus 12:13 And the blood shall be <u>a sign</u> for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I shall pass over you, and

let the plague not come on you to destroy you when I smite the land of Egypt.

Exodus 12:14 And this day shall be unto you for <u>a memorial</u>, and you shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations, you shall keep it a feast by an ordinance <u>forever</u>.

Exodus 12:43-46 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron, This is the ordinance of the Passover. No foreigner shall eat of it, but every man's servant who is bought for money, when you have circumcised him, then shall he eat of it. A foreigner and a hired servant shall not eat of it. In one house shall it be eaten, you shall not carry out anything of the flesh abroad out of the house, <u>neither shall you break a bone of it.</u>

John 19:36 For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken.

Exodus 11:1,2 And the LORD said unto Moses, Yet will I bring one plague more upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt, afterwards he will let you go hence: When he shall let you go, he shall surely thrust you out hence altogether. Speak now in the ears of the people, and let every man <u>borrow</u> of his neighbour, and every woman of her neighbour, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold.

Exodus 11:3 And the LORD <u>gave the people favor</u> in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses <u>was very great</u> in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Exodus 11:4-7 So Moses said, Thus says the Lord: About **midnight** I will go out in the midst of Egypt, and <u>every firstborn</u> in the land of Egypt shall die, from <u>the firstborn</u> of Pharaoh who sits on his throne, even to <u>the firstborn</u> of the slave girl who is behind the handmill, and all <u>the firstborn</u> of the cattle. There shall be **a great cry** throughout all the land of Egypt, such as there has never been, nor ever will be again. But <u>not a dog shall growl against any of the people of Israel</u>,

either man or beast, that you may know that the Lord makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel.

Job 34:20 In a moment they die, even **at midnight**; the people are shaken and pass away, and the mighty are taken away without hand.

Psalm 119:61-63 The bands of the wicked have enclosed me, but I have not forgotten Thy law. **At midnight** I will rise to give thanks unto Thee because of Thy righteous ordinances. I am a companion of all them that fear Thee, and of them that observe Thy precepts.

Judges 16:3 And Samson lay till **midnight**, and arose at midnight, and laid hold of the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and plucked them up, bar and all, and put them upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of the mountain that is before Hebron.

Ruth 3:8 And it came to pass at midnight, that the man was startled, and turned himself, and, behold, a woman lay at his feet.

Matthew 25:6-8 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh, go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.

Exodus 11:8 And all these <u>your servants</u> shall come down to me, and **bow down themselves to me**, saying, Get you out, and all the people that follow you and after that I will go out. <u>And he went out from Pharaoh in a great anger.</u>

Exodus 12:29,30 And it came to pass, that **at midnight** the Lord <u>smote all the firstborn</u> in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon, and all the firstborn of cattle. And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians, and there was a **great cry** in Egypt, for there was not a house where there was not one dead.

Exodus 13:3-5a Then Moses said to the people, <u>**Remember this day**</u> in which you came out from Egypt, out of the house of slavery, for

by a strong hand the Lord brought you out from this place. <u>No</u> <u>leavened bread shall be eaten</u>. Today, in the month of Abib, you are going out. <u>And when the Lord brings you into the land of the</u> <u>Canaanites</u>,

Luke 22:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave to them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: <u>This</u> <u>do in remembrance</u> of me.

Leviticus 23:4-6 These are the fixed feasts of the Lord, the holy days of worship which you will keep at their regular times. In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at nightfall, is the Lord's Passover, And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread, for seven days let your food be unleavened bread.

LAYING THE FOUNDATIONS

Amos 7:7,8 Thus he shewed me: And, behold, **the Lord stood upon a wall made by a plumbline**, with a plumbline in his hand. And the LORD said unto me, Amos, what do you see? And I said, a plumbline. Then said the Lord, Behold, I will set a plumbline in the midst of my people Israel.

Psalm 11:3 If the **foundations** be destroyed, what can the righteous do?

Luke 6:49 But he that hears, and doesn't do, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth, against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great.

Luke 14:28-30 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sits not down first, and counts the cost, whether he has sufficient to finish it? Lest haply, after he has **laid the foundation**, and is not able to finish it, all that behold it begin to mock him, Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish.

1 Corinthians 3:10-15 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another builds thereon. But let every man take heed how he builds thereon. For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Yeshua HaMashiach. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble, Every man's work shall be made manifest: For the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire, and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: But he himself shall be saved, yet so as by fire.

1 Timothy 6:17-19 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not high-minded, **nor trust in uncertain riches**, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy, That they do good, that they be <u>rich in good works</u>, ready to distribute, willing to communicate, Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

2 Timothy 2:19-21 Nevertheless the foundation of God stands sure, having this seal, The Lord knows those that are his. And, Let everyone that names the name of Messiah depart from iniquity. But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth, and some to honor, and some to dishonor. If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

Ephesians 2:19-22 Now therefore you (Gentiles) are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the (Jewish) saints, and of the household of God; And are built upon the foundation of the (Jewish) apostles and the (Jewish) prophets, Yeshua HaMashiach himself being the, (Jewish) chief corner stone In whom all the building fitly framed together grows unto a holy temple in the Lord.

Romans 9:3,4 For I could wish that myself were accursed from Mashiach for my brethren, <u>my kinsmen according to the flesh</u>: Who

<u>are Israelies</u>, to whom pertains: The <u>Adoption</u>, and <u>the glory</u>, and <u>the CovenantS</u>, and <u>the giving of the law</u>, and <u>the service of God</u>, and <u>the Promises</u>.

Galatians 3:24,25 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all **as an unclean thing**, and **all our righteousness is as filthy rags;** and we all do fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Ezekiel 36:25-27 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and you shall be clean: From all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. A <u>new heart</u> also will I give you, and a <u>new spirit</u> will I put within you: And I will <u>take away the stony heart</u> out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

Matthew 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good, or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: For the tree is known by his fruit.

2 Corinthians 13:13 All the saints salute you.

Ephesians 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the <u>saints</u> which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Ephesians 4:7,8 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

1 John 2:2 And he is the atonement for our sins: And not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.


Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us.
