

TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 23:6,7 And on <u>the fifteenth day</u> of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: Seven days ye must eat unleavened bread. In the <u>first day</u> ye shall have a holy convocation: Ye shall do no servile work therein. But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: In <u>the seventh day</u> is a holy convocation: Ye shall do no servile work therein.

Exodus 12:17 And ye shall observe the feast of unleavened bread, for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: Therefore, shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance forever.

Exodus 12:40,41 Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, who dwelt in Egypt, **was four hundred and thirty years.** And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, **even the selfsame day it came to pass, that all the hosts of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt.**

Exodus 13:17-19 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh (<u>sent the</u> <u>people away</u>,) that God led them not through the way of <u>the land of</u> the Philistines, although that was near, for God said, Lest peradventure (<u>the people</u>) repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt: But *God led* (<u>the people</u>) about, through the way of the wilderness of the Red sea: And <u>the children of Israel</u> went up <u>harnessed out of the land of Egypt</u>. And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him: For he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, <u>God will surely visit you</u>, and ye shall <u>carry up my bones</u> away hence with you.

Exodus 14:10-13 And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them, and they were sore afraid: And the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD. They said to Moses, Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us in bringing us out of Egypt? Is not this what we


said to you in Egypt: Leave us alone that we may serve the Egyptians? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness. And Moses said to the people, Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again.

Exodus 14:15,16 And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore cries thou unto me? Speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: But lift thou up thy rod, and <u>stretch out your hand</u> over the sea, and divide it: And the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.

Exodus 14:19-22 The angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them, and the pillar of cloud moved from before them, and stood behind them. It came between the camp of Egypt and the camp of Israel, and there was <u>the cloud and the darkness</u>, yet gave it <u>light by night</u>: And the one didn't come near the other all the night. Moses *stretched out his hand* over the sea, and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a **strong east wind** all night, and made the sea **dry land, and the waters were divided**. The children of Israel went into the midst of the sea <u>on the dry ground</u>, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand, and on their left.

Exodus 14:23 And the Egyptians pursued and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

Exodus 14:26-29 The LORD said to Moses, <u>Stretch out your hand</u> over the sea, that the waters may come again on the Egyptians, on their chariots, and on their horsemen. And Moses <u>stretched forth his</u> <u>hand</u> over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared, and the Egyptians fled against it, and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the middle of the sea. And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them, there remained not so much as one of them. But the children of Israel <u>walked on dry</u>



ground in the middle of the sea, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand, and on their left.

Exodus 3:20 And I will stretch out my hand and smite Egypt with all my wonders.

Exodus 7:5 And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I **stretch forth mine hand** upon Egypt.

Exodus 7:19 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, **and stretch out your hand** upon the waters of Egypt.

Exodus 9:15 For now I will stretch out my hand, that I may smite thee and thy people.

Exodus 10:12 And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out your hand over the land of Egypt for the locusts.

Exodus 10:21 And the LORD said unto Moses, **Stretch out your hand** toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt.

Exodus 12:34 The people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneading troughs being **bound up in their clothes on their shoulders**.

The 15th a Sabbath

Exodus 15:1-3 Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spoke, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: The horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. **The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation:** He is my God, and I will prepare him a habitation, my father's God, and I will exalt him. The LORD is a man of war: The LORD is his name.

Matthew 2:27,28 And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath: Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Matthew 12:8-14 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day. And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: And behold, there was a man whose right hand was withered. And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether **he would heal on the sabbath day**, that they might find an accusation against him. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out? Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? To save life, or to kill? But they held their peace. And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, which had the withered hand, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth, and it was restored whole, like as the other. Then the Pharisees went out, filled with madness, and held a council against him, with those Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

Psalm 118:14-16 <u>The LORD is my strength and song, and is</u> <u>become my salvation</u>. The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: *The right hand* of the LORD doeth valiantly. *The right hand* of the LORD is exalted: *the right hand* of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Isaiah 12:2-6 Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust, and will not be afraid, <u>for the LORD GOD is my strength and my song, and he</u> <u>has become my salvation</u>. With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation. And you will say in that day: Give thanks to the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the peoples, proclaim that his name is exalted. Sing praises to the LORD, for he has done gloriously, let this be made known in all the earth. Shout, and sing for joy, O inhabitant of Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.

Exodus 15:22-24 Then Moses made Israel set out from the Red Sea, and they went into the wilderness of Shur. They went **three days in the wilderness and found no water**. When they came to Marah, they could not drink the water of Marah because it was bitter; therefore it

was named Marah. And the people grumbled against Moses, saying, What shall we drink?

Exodus 16:2,3 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel <u>murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness</u>: And the children of Israel said to them, **Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD** in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat bread to the full, for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger.

Exodus 16:4 Then said the LORD unto Moses: Behold, I will cause to rain bread from heaven for you, and the people shall go out and gather <u>a day's portion</u> every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in My law, or not.

Matthew 6:19-21 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Psalm 62:9,10 Those of low estate are but a breath; those of high estate are a delusion, in the balances they go up; they are together lighter than a breath. Put no trust in extortion. set no vain hopes on robbery, **if riches increase, set not your heart on them.**

Exodus 16:25-29 Moses said, Eat that **today**, for **today** is a Sabbath to the LORD. **Today** <u>**you shall not find it in the field**</u>. Six days you shall gather it, but on the seventh day is the Sabbath. In it there shall be none. It happened on the seventh day, that some of the people went out to gather, and they found none. The LORD said to Moses, How long do you refuse to keep my commandments and my laws? Behold, because the LORD has given you the Sabbath, therefore he gives you on the sixth day the bread of two days. Everyone stay in his place. Let no one go out of his place on the seventh day.

Exodus 17:1b-3 And there was no water for the people to drink. Why the people did chide with Moses, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said to them, Why chide you with me? <u>why do ye tempt the LORD</u>? And the people thirsted there for water; and the people <u>murmured</u> against Moses, and said, Why is this that you have brought us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our cattle with thirst?

Exodus 17:4-8 And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, What shall I do to this people? They be almost ready to stone me. And the LORD said unto Moses, Go on before the people, and take with you of the elders of Israel, <u>and thy rod</u>, with <u>which you smote the river</u>, take in your hand, and go. Behold, I will stand before you there on the <u>rock in Horeb</u>, and you shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel. And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, Is the LORD among us, or not? <u>Then came Amalek</u>, and fought with Israel in <u>Rephidim</u>.

Exodus 17:15,16 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it <u>Jehovahnissi</u>: For he said, Because the LORD has sworn that the LORD will have <u>war with Amalek</u> from generation to generation.

Laying the Foundation

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a <u>new</u> <u>creature</u>: Old things are passed away, behold, <u>all things are become</u> <u>new</u>.

Romans 6:5-7 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also **in the likeness of his resurrection**: Knowing this, that **our old man is crucified** with him, that **the body of sin might be destroyed**, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin.



Acts 8:14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John.

Acts 8:18-21 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: For thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

Ephesians 2:1-3 And you hath **he quickened**, who <u>were dead in</u> <u>trespasses and sins</u>, Wherein **in time past** ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the **prince of the power of the air**, **the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:** Among whom also we **all had our conversation in times past** in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Galatians 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth anything, nor uncircumcision, <u>but a new creature</u>.

Ephesians 4:24 And that ye <u>**put on the new man**</u>, which after God <u>is created in righteousness and true holiness.</u>

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin, that we might be <u>made the righteousness</u> of God in him.

Romans 5:19 For as by one man's disobedience many were <u>made</u> <u>sinners</u>, so by the obedience of one shall many be <u>made righteous</u>.

Colossians 2:10 And ye are complete in him.

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Hebrews 4:10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath **ceased** from his own works, as God did from his.



Psalm 87:5,6 And of Zion it will be said, This one and that one were born in her, And the Most High Himself shall establish her. The	
LORD will record, When He registers the peoples: This one was born there. Selah	
Jeremiah 31:33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.	
James 1:22-25 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face <u>in a mirror</u> ; for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. But he who looks into the <u>perfect law of liberty</u> and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.	
Psalm 119:44 So shall I <u>keep thy law continually forever and ever</u> . <u>And I will walk at liberty</u> : For I seek thy precepts.	
Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the <u>Word</u> .	
Exodus 38:8 And he made the laver of brass, and the foot of it of brass, of the looking glasses of the women assembling.	
Numbers 5:6,7 Speak to the children of Israel: When a man or woman commits any sin that men commit, so as to trespass against the LORD, and that soul is guilty, then <u>he shall confess his sin</u> which he has done, and he shall <u>make restitution</u> for his guilt in full, and add to it the fifth part of it, and give it to him in respect of whom he has been guilty.	
Psalm 19:7-11 The law of the LORD is perfect , converting the soul: The testimony of the LORD is sure , making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right , rejoicing the heart: The	

commandment of the LORD **is pure**, enlightening the eyes. **The fear** of the LORD **is clean**, enduring forever: The **judgments** of the LORD are **true and righteous** altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover, by them is thy servant warned: And **in keeping of them there is great reward.**

2 Timothy 3:16,17 Every Scripture is God-breathed and profitable for <u>teaching</u>, for <u>reproof</u>, for <u>correction</u>, and for <u>instruction</u> in righteousness, that the man of God may be <u>complete</u>, thoroughly <u>equipped</u> for every <u>good work</u>.

Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed, it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Genesis 9:12,13 And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.

Genesis 12:2,3 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great, and thou shalt be a blessing: And I will bless them that bless thee and curse him that curseth thee: And in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

Deuteronomy 18:17-19 And the LORD said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken. I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.

Deuteronomy 29:1 These are the words of the covenant, which the LORD commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel in the land of Moab, beside the covenant which he made with them in Horeb.

Psalm 89:3,4 I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant, Thy seed will I establish forever, and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah.

Micah 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel, whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign, Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: And **the government shall be upon his shoulder**: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 11:9-11 They shall **not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain**: For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people, to it shall the Gentiles seek: And **his rest shall be glorious**. And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people.

Isaiah 53:10,11 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him, he hath put him to grief: When thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: By his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many, for he shall bear their iniquities.

Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek, he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound, To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.

Daniel 9:25,26 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: And the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary, and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.

Zechariah 6:12,13 And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH, and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD: Even he shall build the temple of the LORD, and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne, and he shall be a **priest upon his throne**: And the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Zechariah 14:3,4 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley, and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

1 Corinthians 2:7,8 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: For had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.




Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.
