TORAH PORTION

Exodus 30:11-13a The LORD said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the LORD when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **Half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary.

Exodus 30:15,16 The rich is not to give more or the poor less than the <u>half-shekel</u> when giving Adonai's offering <u>to atone for your lives</u>. You are to take the atonement money from the people of Israel and use it <u>for the service in the tent of meeting</u>, so that it will be a reminder of the people of Israel before Adonai <u>to atone</u> for your lives.

Proverbs 10:2 Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, but righteousness צדקה delivers from death.

Acts 3:13-15 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his Servant Yeshua, whom you delivered up, and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had determined to release him. But you denied the Holy and Righteous One, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, to which we are witnesses.

Exodus 30:30-33 And you shall anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister to me in the priest's office. And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil to me throughout your generations. On man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall you make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy to you. Whoever compounds any like it, or whoever puts any of it on a stranger, shall even be cut off from his people.

Exodus 31:1-5 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, See, I have called **by name <u>Bezaleel</u>** the son of <u>Uri</u>, the son of <u>Hur</u>, of the tribe of Judah: And I have filled him with the spirit of God,

in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship.

Exodus 31:13,14a Tell the people of Israel, You are to <u>observe</u> My Shabbats, for <u>this is a sign</u> between me and you through all your generations, so that you will know that I am Adonai, <u>who sets you apart for me</u>. Therefore you are to keep My Shabbat, because it is set apart <u>for you</u>.

Exodus 31:16,17 The people of Israel are to keep the Shabbat, to observe Shabbat through all their generations as a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the people of Israel **forever**, for in six days Adonai made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day he stopped working and rested.

Exodus 31:18 When he had finished speaking with Moshe on Mount Sinai, Adonai gave him the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone **inscribed by the finger of God.**

Exodus 32:1-3 When the people saw that Moshe was taking a long time to come down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said to him, Get busy, and make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt we don't know what has become of him. Aaron said to them, Have your wives, sons and daughters strip off their gold earrings, and bring them to me. The people stripped off their gold earrings and brought them to Aaron.

Exodus 32:4 He received what they gave him, <u>melted it down</u>, and <u>made it into the shape of a calf.</u> They said, Israel! Here is your god, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:7,8 Adonai said to Moshe, Go down! <u>Hurry</u>! <u>Your</u> <u>people, whom you brought up</u> from the land of Egypt, have become <u>corrupt</u>! So quickly they have turned aside <u>from the way</u>

I ordered them to follow! They **have cast a metal statue** of a calf, **worshipped it**, **sacrificed to it** and said, Israel! Here is <u>your god</u>, <u>who brought you up</u> from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:9,10 Adonai continued speaking to Moshe: I have been watching these people, and you can see how stiff necked they are. Now leave me alone, so that my anger can blaze against them, and I can put an end to them! I will make a great nation out of you instead.

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people**, which **you have brought forth** out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 32:12 Why should **the Egyptians speak**, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against your people.

Exodus 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: The tables were written on both their sides, on the one side and on the other were they written.

Exodus 32:21-24 Moshe said to Aaron, What did these people do to you to make you lead them into such a terrible sin? Aaron replied, My lord shouldn't be so angry. You know what these people are like, that they are determined to do evil. So they said to me, Make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt we don't know what has become of him. I answered them, Anyone with gold, strip it off! So they gave it to me. I threw it in the fire, and out came this calf!

Exodus 32:28 And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And that day about **three thousand men** of the people fell.

Exodus 32:30-32 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said to the people, you have sinned a great sin: And now I will go up to the LORD, peradventure **I shall make an atonement** for your sin. And Moses returned to the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. Yet now, if you will forgive their sin **written.**

Exodus 33:2,3 <u>I will send an angel before you</u>; And <u>I will drive out</u> the Canaanite, the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite: To a land flowing with milk and honey: For <u>I will not go up in the midst of you</u>, for you are a stiffnecked people, lest I consume you in the way.

Exodus 33:12,13 Moshe said to Adonai, Look, you say to me, Make these people **move on**! But you haven't let me know whom you will be sending with me. Nevertheless you have said, I know you by name, and also, You have found favor in my sight. Now, please, if it is really the case that I have found favor in your sight, show me your ways, so that I will understand you and continue finding favor in your sight. Moreover, keep on seeing this nation **as your people**.

Exodus 33:14-16 He said, My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest. He said to him, If your presence doesn't go with me, don't carry us up from here. For how would people know that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people? Isn't it in that you go with us, so that we are separated, I and your people, from all the people who are on the surface of the earth?

Exodus 33:18-20 He said, Please <u>show me your glory</u>. He said, I will make all my **goodness** pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be **gracious**, and will **show mercy on whom I will show mercy**. He said, You cannot see my face, for man may not see me and live.

Exodus 34:4,5 He chiseled two tablets of stone like the first, and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up to Mount Sinai,

as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand two stone tablets. The **LORD descended** in the cloud, and **stood with him** there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD.

Exodus 34:6-8 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and **Gracious**, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness **and Truth**, Keeping mercy for **thousands**, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, **to the third and to the fourth generation**. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

THE NAMES OF GOD

Exodus 33:18 He said, Please *show* me your glory.

Exodus 34:5 And the LORD descended in the cloud, and **stood** with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD.

John 1:12-15 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: Who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of Grace and Truth.

Exodus 34:6-8 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, to the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

The 1st and 2nd attribute is the NAME!

Ezekiel 18:23 Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord GOD: And not that he should return from his ways, and live?

The 3rd attribute/name: El or God.

Numbers 14:15-19 Now if thou shalt kill all this people as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of thee will speak, saying, Because the LORD was not able (God was not strong enough) to bring this people into the land which he swore unto them, therefore he hath slain them in the wilderness. And now, I beseech thee, let the power of my Lord be great, according as thou hast spoken, saying, The LORD is long suffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

Romans 9:15 For He says to Moses, I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion.

The 4th attribute: Racham- Merciful Compassionate

The 5th attribute is Chanan

Isaiah 30:19 For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: Thou shalt weep no more: He will be very <u>gracious</u> unto thee at the voice of thy cry, when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.

The 6th attribute/name: Erekh Apayim – Longsuffering (delaying anger)

Psalm 7:11 God judgeth the righteous, and <u>God is angry with the</u> wicked every day.

7th Rav Chesed – Abundant in Goodness

Micah 7:18-20 Who is a God like unto thee, that <u>pardoneth</u> noseh iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? He retaineth not his anger forever, because he delighteth in mercy. He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us, he will <u>subdue</u> kabash our iniquities, and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

The 8th attribute: Rav Emet – Abundant in Truth

Daniel 8:12 And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground.

Psalm 85:10,11 Mercy and truth are met together, righteousness and peace have kissed each other. <u>Truth shall spring out of the</u> earth.

The 9th attribute: Notzer – Chesed LaAlafim –Keeping (Preserves) Mercy for thousands [extending to future generations]

The 10th, 11th and 12th – Noseh: Avon, VaFesha, VeHata'a –

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.

The 13th attribute: VeNakeh Lo Yenakeh VeNakeh —and cleanses but not entirely.
