## TORAH PORTION

**Exodus 35:1** And Moses assembled all the congregation of the children of Israel, and said to them, These are the words which **the LORD has commanded**, that you should do them.

**Hebrews 10:24,25** And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, **not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together**, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

**Exodus 35:2a** Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be a holy day for you, **a Sabbath of solemn rest** to the LORD.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah is the goal of the Torah unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

**Exodus 35:4,5** Moses said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, This is the thing that **the Lord has commanded**. Take from among you a contribution to the Lord. **Whoever is of a generous heart**, let him bring the Lord's contribution: Gold, silver, and bronze.

**Exodus 35:10** And every **wise hearted** among you shall come, and make all that **the LORD hath commanded**.

**Exodus 35:20-22** And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him up, and everyone whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD's offering **to the work** of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were **willing hearted**, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: And every man that offered, offered an offering of gold to the LORD.

**Exodus 35:25,26** And all the **women that were wise hearted** did spin with their hands, And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' hair.

**Exodus 35:29** All the men and women, the people of Israel, whose **heart** moved them to bring anything **for the work** that **the Lord had commanded** by Moses to be done brought it as a freewill offering to the Lord.

**Exodus 35:30,31** And Moses said to the children of Israel, See, the LORD has called **by name Bezaleel** the **son of Uri**, the **son of Hur**, of the tribe of **Judah**, And he has **filled him with the spirit of God**, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner **of workmanship**.

**Genesis 1:26** And God said, Let us make man in our **image**, after our **likeness**.

**Genesis 1:27** God created man in his own image. In God's image **צלם** he created him, male and female he created them.

**Psalms 91:1** He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will rest in the **shadow of the Almighty**.

**Colossians 2:16,17** Let no one therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a **feast day** or a **new moon** or a **Sabbath day**, which are a **shadow** of the things to come, **but the body** is Messiah's.

**John 1:9** That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah is the goal of the 'Torah unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

**Exodus 35:34,35a** And he has put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and **Aholiab**, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. Then has he filled with **wisdom of heart**, to work all manner of work,

**Exodus 36:1,2** Then worked Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. And Moses called **Bezaleel and Aholiab**, and every wise hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put wisdom, even everyone whose heart stirred him up to come to the work to do it.

**Exodus 36:5-8** And they spoke to Moses, saying, The people bring much more than enough for the service of the work, which the LORD commanded to make. And Moses gave commandment, and they caused it to be proclaimed throughout the camp, saying, Let neither man nor woman make any more work for the offering of the sanctuary. So **the people were restrained from bringing**. For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much. And every wise hearted man among them that worked the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen,

**Exodus 37:3-5** And he cast for it four rings of gold, to be set by the four corners of it, even two rings upon the one side of it, and two rings upon the other side of it. And he made staves of shittim wood, and overlaid them with gold. And he put the **staves into the rings by the sides of the ark**, to bear the ark.

**1 Kings 8:6,7** Then the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim. For the cherubim spread their two wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubim overshadowed the ark and its poles.

**1 Kings 8:8** And they drew out the staves, that **the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy place** before the oracle, and they were not seen without: And there they are unto this day.

**Exodus 38:8** And he made the laver of brass, and the foot of it of brass, of the looking glasses of the women assembling, which assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

**Exodus 38:25,26** The silver of those who were numbered of the congregation was one hundred talents, and one thousand seven hundred seventy-five shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: **a beka** בקע **a head** גלגלת, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

**Mark 15:22** And they bring him to the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.

**Genesis 24:22** And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of half a shekel בקע weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold.

## PASSOVER

**Luke 22:15** And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this **Passover** with you before I suffer:

**Luke 22:19** And he took **matzah**, and gave thanks, and broke it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me.

*Passover*

**1 Corinthians 11:24,25** And when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, Take, eat: This is my body, which is broken for you: This do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: This do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

**Acts 12:1-3** About that time Herod (Agrippa) the king laid violent hands on some who belonged to the church. He **killed James the brother of John** with the sword, and when he saw that **it** pleased the Jews, he proceeded to arrest Peter also. This was during **the days of Unleavened Bread.**

**Acts 12:4** And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after **Easter** to bring him forth to the people.

**Leviticus 23:5,6** In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's Passover. And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: Seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

**2 Timothy 4:22b** The second [epistle unto Timotheus, ordained **the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians,** was written from Rome, **when Paul was brought before Nero** the second time.]

**Acts 18:19-21** And they came to **Ephesus**, and he left them there, but he himself **went into the synagogue** and reasoned with the Jews. When they asked him to stay for a longer period, he declined. But on taking leave of them he said, I will return to you if God wills, and he set sail from Ephesus.

**Acts 18:24-26** Now a **Jew** named Apollos, a native of Alexandria, **came to Ephesus**. He was an eloquent man, **competent in the Scriptures**. He had been instructed in the way of the Lord. And being fervent in spirit, he spoke and **taught accurately the things concerning Yeshua**, though he knew only the baptism of John. He began to speak boldly in the synagogue, but when Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.

**Acts 19:24,25** For a man named Demetrius, a silversmith, who made silver shrines of Artemis, brought no little business to the craftsmen. These he gathered together, with the workmen in similar trades, and said, Men, you know that from this business we have our wealth.

**Acts 19:33,34** And they drew **Alexander** out of the multitude, the Jews putting him forward. And Alexander beckoned with the hand, and would have made his defense unto the people. But when they recognized that **he was a Jew**, for about two hours they all cried out with one voice, Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!

**Mark 15:21** And they compel one Simon a Cyrenian, who passed by, coming out of the country, **the father of Alexander and Rufus, to bear his cross**.

**1 Corinthians 16:8,9** But I will stay in **Ephesus until Pentecost**, for a wide door for effective work has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

**1 Timothy 1:3-11** As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge **certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies**, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith. **The aim of our charge is love** that issues from a **pure heart** and a good conscience and a sincere faith. **Certain persons, by swerving from these, have wandered away into vain discussion, desiring to be teachers of the law, without understanding either what they are saying or the things about which they make confident assertions.** Now we know that the law is good, if one uses it lawfully, understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane, for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers, the sexually immoral, men who practice homosexuality, enslavers, liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound doctrine, in accordance with the gospel of the glory of the blessed God with which I have been entrusted.

**Revelation 2:1,2** To the angel of **the assembly in Ephesus** write: The words of him **who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands. I know your works**, your toil and your patient endurance, and how you cannot bear with **those who are evil**, but have tested those **who call themselves apostles** and are not, and found them to be false.

**Revelation 2:3,4** I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary. But I have this against you, that **you have abandoned the love** you had at first.

**Revelation 2:5** Remember therefore from where you have fallen, repent, **and do the works** you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.

**Revelation 2:6** Yet this you have: You **hate the works of the Nicolaitans**, which I also hate.

**Revelation 2:7** He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the assemblies. To the one who conquers I will grant **to eat of the tree of life**, which is **in the paradise of God**.

**Acts 6:3-6** Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business, but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word. And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and **Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch**, whom they set before the apostles, and when they had prayed, they laid hands on them.

**Revelation 2:8** And unto the angel of **the assembly in Smyrna** write, These things saith **the first and the last**, which was dead, and is alive.

**Revelation 2:9** I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which **say they are Jews, and are not, but are the assembly of Satan**
