TORAH PORTION

Exodus 27:20,21 And <u>you shall command</u> the children of Israel, that they bring you pure oil olive beaten for the light, to <u>cause the lamp to</u> <u>burn always</u>. <u>In the tabernacle of the congregation</u> without the veil, which is before the testimony, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: It shall be a statute forever to their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

Exodus 28:1,2 Bring <u>Aaron</u> your brother, and his sons with him, near to you from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office, even <u>Aaron</u>, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, <u>Aaron's</u> sons. You shall make holy garments for <u>Aaron</u> your brother, for glory and for beauty.

Deuteronomy 34:5-8 So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: But no man knows of his sepulcher to this day. And Moses was a hundred and twenty years old when he died: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab <u>thirty days:</u> So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:1,2 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead, now therefore arise, <u>go</u> <u>over this Jordan</u>, you, and all this people, to the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Joshua 1:11 Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals, for within <u>three days</u> you shall <u>pass over this</u> <u>Jordan</u>, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God gives you to possess it. Joshua 4:19 And the people <u>came up out of Jordan on the tenth day</u> <u>of the first month</u>, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, <u>I am a hundred and twenty years old</u> <u>this day</u>, I can no more go out and come in: Also the LORD has said to me, You shall not go over this Jordan.

Exodus 32:32 Yet now, if you will forgive their sin, and if not, blot me, I pray, <u>from your book</u> which you have written.

Exodus 28:9-12 And you shall take <u>two onyx stones</u>, and you shall engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel. Six of their names shall be on one stone, and six of the remaining names on the other stone, **according to their birth**. With the work of an engraver in stone, like the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall make them to be set in settings of gold. And you shall put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial to the sons of Israel. <u>And Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial.</u>

Exodus 32:21 And Moses said to Aaron, What did the people do to you that you let this great sin come on them? And Aaron said, Let not my lord be angry, you have seen how the purposes of this people are evil.

1 Samuel 15:24 And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: For I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: Because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

Exodus 28:15 You shall make a breastplate of judgment, the work of the skillful workman, like the work of the ephod you shall make it, of gold, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, you shall make it.

Exodus 28:21 The stones shall be according to <u>the names of the</u> <u>children of Israel</u>, twelve, according to their names, like the engravings of a signet, everyone according to his name, they shall be for the twelve tribes.

Exodus 28:28,29 They shall bind the **breastplate** by means of its rings to the rings of the ephod, using a blue cord, so that it is above the intricately woven band of the ephod, and so that the **breastplate** does not come loose from the ephod. So Aaron shall bear the names of the sons of Israel on the **breastplate** of judgment **over his heart**, when he goes into the holy place, as a memorial before the LORD **continually**.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the **breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation.**

Isaiah 59:17 For He put on righteousness as a breastplate, And a helmet of salvation on His head, He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, And was clad with zeal as a cloak.

Ephesians 6:13-17 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the **breastplate** of righteousness, and having shod your **feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace**, above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the **helmet of salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Exodus 29:19,20 You shall take the other ram, and Aaron and his sons shall lay their hands on the head of the ram, and you shall kill the ram and take part of its blood and put it on the tip of the right ear of Aaron and on the tips of the right ears of his sons, and on the thumbs of their right hands and on the great toes of their right feet, and throw the rest of the blood against the sides of the altar.

Exodus 29:38,39 Now this is that which you shall <u>offer on the altar</u>, two lambs of the first year <u>day by day continually</u>. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning, and the other lamb you shall offer at even.

Exodus 29:42-46 This shall be a <u>continual burnt offering</u> throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: <u>Where I will meet you, to speak there to you.</u> And <u>there I will meet</u> with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. And I will sanctify the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: I will sanctify also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, <u>that brought them forth out of the land of</u> Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

Exodus 30:7,8 And **Aaron** shall burn thereon <u>sweet incense every</u> <u>morning</u>: When he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. And when **Aaron** lights the lamps at even, he shall burn incense on it <u>a</u> <u>perpetual incense</u> before the LORD throughout your generations.

Leviticus 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the <u>feasts</u> (**Meeting times**) of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my <u>feasts</u>.(<u>Meeting</u> <u>times</u>)

Leviticus 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.(times)

Exodus 30:10 Aaron shall make atonement on its horns once a year. With the blood of the sin offering of atonement he shall make atonement for it once in the year throughout your generations. It is most holy to the Lord.

Exodus 30:11-16 The Lord said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the Lord when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **Half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the

shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as an offering to the Lord. Everyone who is numbered in the census, from twenty years old and upward, shall give the Lord's offering. The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less, than the half shekel, when you give the Lord's offering to make atonement for your lives. **You shall take the atonement money from the people of Israel and shall give it for the service of the tent of meeting**, that it may bring the people of Israel to remembrance before the Lord, so as to make atonement for your lives.

Matthew 17:24 When they had come to Capernaum, those who received the temple tax came to Peter and said, "Does your Teacher not pay the temple tax?"

THE KINGDOM PROBLEM

1 Peter 4:18 Now If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?

Ecclesiastes 8:11 Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.

Jeremiah 2:9 Why I will yet plead with you, said the LORD, and with your children's children will I plead.

Deuteronomy 11:26-28 Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse, A blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day: And a curse, if you will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known.

Romans 6:16-18 Don't you know that to whom you present yourselves as servants to obedience, his servants you are whom you obey, whether of sin to death, or of obedience to righteousness? But thanks be to God, that, whereas you were bondservants of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching whereunto

you were delivered. Being made free from sin, you became bondservants of righteousness.

1 Timothy 2:3,4 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and **come to full knowledge of the truth.**

John 8:32 You will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.

James 4:6,7 But he gives more grace. Therefore, it says, God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble. Be subject therefore to God. But resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Hebrew 9:27 Inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once, and after this, judgment,

Romans 8:1-7 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Messiah Yeshua, who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah Yeshua made me free from the law of sin and of death. For what the law couldn't do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God did, sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, that the ordinance of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For the mind of the flesh is death, but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace, because the mind of the flesh is hostile towards God, for it is not subject to God's law, neither indeed can it be.

Colossians 1:27,28 to whom God was pleased to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which **is Messiah in you,** the hope of glory, whom we proclaim, admonishing every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Messiah Yeshua.

Matthew 1:21 She shall bring forth a son. You shall call his name Yeshua, for it is he who shall save his people from their sins.

Matthew 23:37 Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets, and stones those who are sent to her! How often I would have gathered your children together, even as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you would not!

Revelation 21:27 There will in no way enter into it anything profane, or one who causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

John 3:19,20 This is the judgment, that the light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the light, for their works were evil. For everyone who does evil **hates the light**, and doesn't come to the light, lest his works would be exposed.

Romans 7:12 Therefore the law is holy, and the commandment <u>holy and just and good.</u>

Romans 7:14 For we know that **the law is spiritual**, but I am carnal, sold under sin.

Numbers 32:5 Therefore they said, If we have found favor in your sight, let this land be given to your servants as a possession. Do not take us over the Jordan.

Ezekiel 36:19-22 So I scattered them among the nations, and they were dispersed throughout the countries, I judged them according to their ways and their deeds. When they came to the nations, wherever they went, they profaned My holy name when they said of them, These are the people of the LORD, and yet they have gone out of His land. But I had concern for My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the nations wherever they went. Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name's sake, which you have profaned among the nations wherever you went.

Numbers 19:2,3 This is the ordinance of the law which the LORD has commanded, saying: Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring you a red heifer without blemish, in which there is no defect and on

which a yoke has never come. You shall give it to Eleazar the priest, that he may take it outside the camp, and it shall be slaughtered before him.

Ezekiel 36:23-25 And I will sanctify My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst, and the nations shall know that I am the LORD, says the Lord GOD, when I am hallowed in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the nations, gather you out of all countries, and bring you into your own land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.

Ezekiel 36:26-28 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you, I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, you shall be My people, and I will be your God.

Romans 11:15 For if their being cast away is the reconciling of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

Ezekiel 36:31,32 Then you will remember your evil ways and your deeds that were not good, and you will loathe yourselves in your own sight, for your iniquities and your abominations. Not for your sake do I do this, says the Lord GOD, let it be known to you. Be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel!

Ezekiel 36:36 Then the nations which are left all around you shall know that I, the LORD, have rebuilt the ruined places and planted what was desolate. I, the LORD, have spoken it, and I will do it.

Jeremiah 31:31,32 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the

land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, **though I was a husband to them**, says the LORD.


Hebrews 8:8 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, because they did not continue in My covenant, and **I** disregarded them, says the LORD.

Jeremiah 31:33,34 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD, for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD.
