TORAH PORTION

Genesis 1:9 And God said, Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place,

Genesis 1:11 And God said, Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees bearing fruit in which is their seed, each according to its kind, on the earth.

Genesis 1:3 And God said, Let there be light,

Psalms 119:129-2131 Your testimonies are wonderful: Therefore my soul keeps them. The **entrance of Your words gives light**, it gives understanding unto the simple. I opened my mouth and panted: for I longed for Your commandments.

1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that **God is light**, and in him is no darkness at all.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart; and **you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD: Stand ye in the ways and see, and **ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.** But they said: We will not walk therein.

Leviticus 22:17,18 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, **Speak unto Aaron, and to his sons, and unto all the children of Israel, and say** unto them, Whatsoever he be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers in Israel, that will offer his oblation for all his vows, and for all his freewill offerings, which they will offer unto the LORD for a burnt offering.

Leviticus 6:24,25 And the Lord said to Moses, **Say to Aaron and his sons, This is the law for the sin-offering:** The sin-offering is to

be put to death before the Lord in the same place as the burned offering, it is most holy.

Leviticus 6:9 Command Aaron and his sons, saying, **This is the law of the burnt offering**: The burnt offering shall be on the hearth on the altar **all night** until the morning; and **the fire of the altar shall be kept burning** on it.

Genesis 46:2 And God said to Israel **in a night-vision**, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here am I. And he said, I am God, the God of your father: Go down to Egypt without fear, for I will make a great nation of you there.

Genesis 19:27 And Abraham got up early in the morning and went to the place where he had been talking with the Lord.

Genesis 25:21 Isaac made prayer to the Lord for his wife because she had no children, and the Lord gave ear to his prayer, and Rebekah became with child.

Leviticus 6:10 And the priest shall put on **his linen garment**, and **his linen breeches** shall he put upon his flesh, and he shall **take up the ashes** whereto the fire hath consumed the burnt-offering on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar.

Leviticus 6:12 **And the fire upon the altar shall be kept burning thereby, it shall not go out**; and the priest shall kindle wood on it every morning, and he shall lay the burnt-offering in order upon it, and shall make smoke thereon the fat of the peace-offerings.

Leviticus 6:13 Fire shall be kept burning upon the altar continually, it shall not go out.

Leviticus 6:25,26 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed shall the sin offering be killed before the LORD: **It is most holy**. The priest that offereth it for sin shall eat it: in the holy

place shall it be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Leviticus 7:1,2 This is the law of the **trespass offering**. It is most holy. In the place where they kill the burnt offering, he shall kill the trespass offering, and its blood he shall sprinkle around on the altar.

Leviticus 7:6,7 Every male among the priests may eat of it. It shall be eaten in a holy place. It is most holy. As is the sin offering, so is the trespass offering, there is one law for them. The priest who makes atonement with them shall have it.

Leviticus 7:11,12a This is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which one shall offer to the LORD. If he offers it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mixed with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mixed with oil.

Psalms 107:1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for He is good, for His mercy endureth for ever.

Psalms 107:2-6 So let the redeemed of the LORD say, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the adversary, And gathered them out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the sea. They wandered in the wilderness in a desert way, they found no city of habitation. Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses

Psalms 107:8-16 Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath satisfied the longing soul, and the hungry soul He hath filled with good. Such as **sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron**. Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the Most High. Therefore He humbled their heart with travail, they stumbled, and there was none to help. They cried unto the LORD

in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their bands in sunder. Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

Psalm 107:17-22 Crazy because of the way of their transgression, and afflicted because of their iniquities. Their soul abhorred all manner of food, and **they drew near unto the gates of death. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses, He sent His word, and healed them, and delivered them from their graves.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! And let them offer the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare His works with singing.

Psalm 107:23-32 **They that go down to the sea in ships**, that do business in great waters. These saw the works of the LORD, and His wonders in the deep, For He commanded, and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves thereof, They mounted up to the heaven, they went down to the deeps; their soul melted away because of trouble, They reeled to and fro, and staggered like a drunken man, and all their wisdom was swallowed up-. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and **He brought them out of their distresses. He made the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof were still. Then were they glad because they were quiet, and He led them unto their desired haven.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them exalt Him also in the assembly of the people, and praise Him in the seat of the elders.

Mark 4:35-41 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. And he was in the hinder part of the ship,

asleep on a pillow: And they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith? And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Psalm 50:23 Whoever offers the **sacrifice of thanksgiving** glorifies me and prepares his way so that I will show God's salvation to him.

Leviticus 8:3-7 And let all the people come together at the door of the Tent of meeting. And Moses did as the Lord said, and all the people came together at the door of the Tent of meeting. And Moses said to the people, This is what the Lord has given orders to be done. Then Moses took Aaron and his sons, and after **washing them with water**, He put the coat on him, making it tight with its band, and then the robe, and over it the ephod, with its band of needlework to keep it in place.

Leviticus 8:35,36 Therefore shall ye abide at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation day and night **seven days, and keep the charge of the LORD, that ye die not:** For so I am commanded. So Aaron and his sons did all things which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses.

Jeremiah 7:22-26 For I spoke not unto your fathers, nor commanded them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices: But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: And walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward. Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them: Yet they hearkened not unto me,

nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: They did worse than their fathers.

1 Corinthians 11:28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith, prove your own selves.

Joshua 10:13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed.

2 Kings 20 :9 And Isaiah said, This sign shalt thou have of the LORD, that the LORD will do the thing that he hath spoken: Shall the shadow go forward ten degrees, or go back ten degrees?

Matthew 18:20 And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests.

Acts 7:51 Ye stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: As your fathers did, so do ye.

Deuteronomy 30:15,16 See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil, In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: And the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Ephesians 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: Walk as children of light.

John 3:19-21 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their

deeds were evil. For everyone that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Matthew 7:16-18 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit, but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

Romans 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey, whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

2 Corinthians 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Matthew 7:24-27 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. And everyone that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house, and it fell: And great was the fall of it.

Ephesians 4:18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart.

2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: That by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Proverbs 23:7 For as he **thinks in his heart, so is he**: Eat and drink, he says to you, but **his heart** is not with you.

1 Samuel 16:7 But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature, because I have refused him: For the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Acts 8:18-21 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

1 Chronicles 28:9 And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: For the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee, but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off forever.

1 John 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: For sin is the transgression of the law.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the **pulling down of strong holds**) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into **captivity every thought** to the obedience of Christ.

Matthew 6:14,15 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

2 Corinthians 2:10,11 To whom ye forgive anything, I forgive also: For if I forgave anything, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave

I it in the person of Christ, Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: For we are not ignorant of his devices.

2 Corinthians 4:1,2 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not, But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not **walking in craftiness**, nor **handling the word of God deceitfully**, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

2 Corinthians 4:17,18 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

1 John 2:15-17 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: But he that doeth the will of God abideth forever.

Genesis 6:7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air, for it repenteth me that I have made them.

Genesis 11:6,7 And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language, and this they begin to do: And now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

Proverbs 21:1,2 The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: He turneth it whithersoever he will. Every way of a man is right in his own eyes: But the LORD pondereth the hearts.

Matthew 21:2,3 Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: Loose them, and bring them unto me. And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them, and straightway he will send them.

Exodus 9:12 And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh, and he hearkened not unto them, as the LORD had spoken unto Moses.

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Matthew 6:9,10 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. **Thy will be done in earth**, as it is in heaven.

1 Timothy 2:3,4 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour, **Who will have all men to be saved**, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

Romans 1:18,19 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness, Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.

Romans 10:14,15 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Hebrews 1:13,14 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

Acts 16:29-32 Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. And they spoke unto him the **Word of the Lord**, and to all that were in his house.

John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

2 Timothy 2:25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves, if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth, And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 3:7-9 Wherefore (as the Holy Spirit saith, Today if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness: When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years.
