TORAH PORTION

Exodus 40:1,2 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, On <u>the</u> <u>first day of the first month shall you set up the tabernacle</u> of the tent of the congregation.

Exodus 40:33-35 And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the screen of the gate of the court. So Moses finished the work. Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. And <u>Moses was not able to enter</u> into the tent of meeting, because the cloud abode thereon, and **the glory of the LORD** filled the tabernacle.

Leviticus 1:1a And the LORD called unto Moses, and spoke unto him out of the <u>tent of meeting</u>, saying.

Genesis 3:9 <u>And the LORD God called</u> unto the man, and said unto him: Where art thou?

1 Kings 19:12 And after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire: And after the fire a still **small** voice.

Micah 6:8 It hath been told thee, O man, what is good, and what the LORD doth require of thee: Only to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God.

Leviticus 2:9 And the priest shall take off from the meal-offering the memorial-part thereof, and shall make it smoke upon the altar an offering made by fire, of a **sweet savour unto the LORD**.

Isaiah 65:5 Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me, for **I am holier than thou**. These are **a smoke in my nose**, a fire that burneth all the day.

Numbers 23:16a The LORD met ויקר Balaam,

Leviticus 1:2-4 Speak to the children of Israel, and tell them, When anyone of you offers an <u>offering</u> to the LORD, you shall offer your offering of the livestock, from the herd and from the flock. If his offering is an offering from the herd, he shall offer a male without blemish. He shall offer it at the door of the Tent of Meeting, that he may be accepted before the LORD. He shall lay his hand on the head of the **burnt offering**, and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

Leviticus 1:14-17 If his offering to the LORD is a burnt offering of birds, then he shall offer his offering of turtledoves, or of young pigeons. The priest shall bring it to the altar, and wring off its head, and burn it on the altar, and its blood shall be drained out on the side of the altar, and he shall take away its crop with its filth, and cast it beside the altar on the east part, in the place of the ashes. He shall tear it by its wings, but shall not divide it apart. The priest shall burn it on the altar, on the wood that is on the fire. It is a burnt offering, an offering made by fire, of a pleasant aroma to the LORD.

Leviticus 2:1,2 And when anyone brings <u>a grain offering</u> to יהוה, his offering is to be of fine flour. And he shall pour oil on it, and put frankincense on it, and he shall bring it to the sons of Aharon, the priests, and he shall take from it his hand filled with fine flour and oil with all the frankincense.

Leviticus 2:4 And if you bring a sacrifice of a food (Minchah) offering baked in the oven, it shall be <u>unleavened</u> cakes of fine flour mixed with oil, or <u>unleavened wafers</u> anointed with oil.

1 Corinthians 11:24 And when <u>He</u> had given thanks, he <u>brake it</u>, and said, <u>Take, eat</u>: This is my body, <u>which is broken</u> for you: This do <u>in memorial</u> of me.

Leviticus 2:13 And every meal offering is to be salted with salt, your meal offering is not to be without the salt of the agreement of your God: With all your offerings give salt.

Leviticus 3:1,2 If his offering is a sacrifice of <u>peace offerings</u>, if he offers it from the herd, whether male or female, he shall offer it without blemish before the LORD. He shall lay his hand on the head of his offering and kill it at the door of the Tent of Meeting: And Aaron's sons, the priests shall sprinkle the blood around on the altar.

Leviticus 3:6-8 And if what he gives for a peace-offering to the Lord is of the flock, let him give a male or female, without any mark on it. If his offering is a lamb, then let it be placed before the Lord: And he is to put his hand on the head of his offering and put it to death before the Tent of meeting, and Aaron's sons are to put some of its blood on and round the altar.

Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, <u>we have peace</u> with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Leviticus 4:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, If anyone <u>sins</u> <u>unintentionally</u>, in any of the things which the LORD has commanded not to be done, and does any one of them: If the anointed priest sins so as to bring guilt on the people, then let him offer for his sin, which he has sinned, a young bull without blemish to the LORD for a <u>sin offering</u>.

Hebrews 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Leviticus 4:13-16 And if all the people of Israel do wrong, without anyone's knowledge, if they have done any of the things which by the Lord's order are not to be done, causing sin to come on them, When the sin which they have done comes to light, then let all the people give an ox for a sin-offering, and take it before the Tent of meeting. And let the chiefs of the people put their hands on its head before the Lord, and put the ox to death before the Lord. And the priest is to take some of its blood to the Tent of meeting.

Leviticus 4:22,23 When a ruler hath sinned, and done somewhat through ignorance against any of the commandments of the LORD his God concerning things which should not be done, and is guilty, Or if his sin, wherein he hath sinned, come to his knowledge, he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a male without blemish.

Leviticus 4:27,28 And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth somewhat against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which ought not to be done, and be guilty, Or if his sin, which he hath sinned, come to his knowledge: Then he shall bring his offering, a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he hath sinned.

Isaiah 40:15,16 Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: Behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing. And Lebanon is not sufficient to burn, nor the beasts thereof sufficient for a burnt offering.

Isaiah 1:11-17 To what purpose is the multitude of <u>your</u> sacrifices unto Me? Saith the LORD, I am full of the burnt-offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts, and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he-goats. When ye come to appear before Me, who hath required this at your hand, to trample My courts? Bring no more vain oblations, it is an offering of abomination unto Me, **new moon and sabbath, the holding of convocations** I cannot endure <u>iniquity along with the solemn assembly</u>. <u>Your</u> new moons and <u>your</u> appointed seasons My soul hateth, They are a burden unto Me, I am weary to bear them. And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide Mine eyes from you, yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear, your hands are full of blood. Wash you, make you clean, put away the evil of your doings from before Mine eyes, cease to do evil, Learn to do well, seek justice, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.

Jeremiah 17:26,27 And they shall come from the cities of Judah, and from the places round about Jerusalem, and from the land of Benjamin, and from the Lowland, and from the mountains, and from the South, bringing burnt-offerings, and sacrifices, and meal-offerings, and frankincense, and bringing sacrifices of thanksgiving, unto the house of the LORD. But if ye will not hearken unto Me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden and enter in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day, then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

Isaiah 56:7 Even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer, **their burnt-offerings and their sacrifices shall be acceptable** upon Mine altar, for My house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples.

Jeremiah 7:9,10 Will ye steal, murder, and commit adultery, and swear falsely, and offer unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom ye have not known, and come and stand before Me in this house, whereupon My name is called, and say: We are delivered, that ye may do all these abominations?

Jeremiah 9:23,24 Thus saith the LORD: Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches, But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth, and **knoweth Me**, that I am the LORD who **exercise mercy**, **justice**, **and righteousness**, in the earth, for in these things I delight, saith the LORD.

Leviticus 5:1-3 And if anyone does wrong by saying nothing when he is put under oath as a witness of something he has seen

or had knowledge of, then he will be responsible: If anyone becomes unclean through touching unconsciously some unclean thing, such as the dead body of an unclean beast or of unclean cattle or of any unclean animal which goes flat on the earth, he will be responsible: Or if he becomes unclean through touching unconsciously any unclean thing of man, whatever it may be, when it is made clear to him he will be responsible.

Leviticus 5:4,5 Or if anyone, without thought, takes an oath to do evil or to do good, whatever he says without thought, with an oath, having no knowledge of what he is doing, when it becomes clear to him, he will be responsible for any of these things. And whoever is responsible for any such sin, <u>let him make a statement openly</u> of his wrongdoing,

Leviticus 5:6-13 And take to the Lord the offering for the wrong which he has done, a female from the flock, a lamb or a goat, for a sin-offering, and the priest will take away his sin. And if he has not money enough for a lamb, then let him give, for his offering to the Lord, two doves or two young pigeons, one for a sinoffering and one for a burned offering. And let him take them to the priest, who will first give the sin-offering, twisting off its head from its neck, but not cutting it in two, And he is to put drops of the blood of the offering on the side of the altar, and the rest of the blood is to be drained out at the base of the altar, it is a sin-offering. And the second is for a burned offering, in agreement with the law, and the priest will take away his sin and he will have forgiveness. But if he has not enough money for two doves or two young pigeons, then let him give, for the sin he has done, the tenth part of an ephah of the best meal, for a sin-offering, let him put no oil on it, and no perfume, for it is a sin-offering. And let him come to the priest with it, and the priest will take some of it in his hand, to be burned on the altar as a sign, among the offerings of the Lord made by fire: It is a sin-offering. And the priest will take away his sin and he will have forgiveness: And the rest of the offering will be the priest's, in the same way as the meal offering.

Leviticus 5:14-16 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, If a soul commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the holy

things of the LORD, then he shall bring for his trespass to the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with your estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a **trespass offering**. And he shall make amends for the harm that he has done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it to the priest: And the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be forgiven him.

Leviticus 5:17,18 And if a soul sins, and he has done that which ought not to be done, any one from all the commands of the LORD, and <u>does not know</u>, yet he is guilty and bears his iniquity, then he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, for a <u>trespass offering</u>, to the priest. And the priest shall make an atonement for him <u>for his ignorance in which he erred without knowing it, and it shall be forgiven him.</u>

1 Samuel 15:2 The Lord of armies says, I will give punishment to Amalek for what he did to Israel, fighting against him on the way when Israel came out of Egypt.

1 Samuel 15:7-9 And Saul made an attack on the Amalekites from Havilah on the road to Shur, which is before Egypt. He took Agag, king of the Amalekites, prisoner, and put all the people to the sword without mercy. But Saul and the people did not put Agag to death, and they kept the best of the sheep and the oxen and the fat beasts and the lambs, and whatever was good, not desiring to put them to the curse: But everything which was bad and of no use they put to the curse.

1 Samuel 15:10,11 Then the Lord said to Samuel, It is no longer my pleasure for Saul to be king, for he is turned back from going in my ways and has not done my orders. And Samuel was very sad, crying to the Lord in prayer all night.

1 Samuel 15:13 And Samuel came to Saul, and Saul said to him, May the blessing of the Lord be with you: I have done what was ordered by the Lord.


1 Samuel 15:14 And Samuel said, What then is this sound of the crying of sheep and the noise of oxen which comes to my ears? And Saul said, They have taken them from the Amalekites: For the people have kept the best of the sheep and of the oxen as an offering to the Lord your God, all the rest we have given up to destruction.

1 Samuel 15:20,21 And Saul said, Truly, I have done the orders of the Lord and have gone the way the Lord sent me, I have taken Agag, the king of Amalek, and have given the Amalekites up to destruction. But the people took some of their goods, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which were put to the curse, to make an offering of them to the Lord your God in Gilgal.

1 Samuel 15:24,25 And Saul said to Samuel, Great is my sin: For I have gone against the orders of the Lord and against your words: Because, fearing the people, I did what they said. So now, let my sin have forgiveness, and go back with me to give worship to the Lord.

1 Samuel 15:26 And Samuel said to Saul, I will not go back with you: For you have put away from you the word of the Lord, and the Lord has put you from your place as king over Israel.

1 Samuel 15:30-33 Then he said, Great is my sin: But still, give me honour now before the heads of my people and before Israel, and come back with me so that I may give worship to the Lord your God. So Samuel went back after Saul, and Saul gave worship to the Lord. Then Samuel said, Make Agag, the king of the Amalekites, come here to me. And Agag came to him shaking with fear. And Agag said, Truly the pain of death is past. And Samuel said, As your sword has made women without children, so now your mother will be without children among women. And Agag was cut up by Samuel, bone from bone, before the Lord in Gilgal.
