TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 6:24-26 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, <u>This is the law of the sin offering</u>: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD. <u>It is most holy</u>. The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. <u>It shall be eaten in a holy place</u>, in the court of the Tent of Meeting.

Leviticus 9:1 It came to pass on the <u>eighth day</u> that Moses called Aaron and his sons and the elders of Israel.

Exodus 40:17-20 And it came to pass in the **first month** in the second year, on the **first day of the month**, that the tabernacle was reared up. And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and laid its sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up its pillars. And he spread the tent over the tabernacle and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the LORD commanded Moses.

Leviticus 9:3,4 And to the children of Israel you shall speak, saying, Take you a kid of the goats for a sin offering, and a calf and a lamb, both of the first year, without blemish, for a burnt offering, Also a bullock and a ram for peace offerings, to sacrifice before the LORD, and a meal offering mingled with oil: For today the LORD will appear to you.

Exodus 40:29 And he put the altar of burnt offering before the door of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting and offered upon it the burnt offering and the grain offering, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Leviticus 9:6 And Moses said, This is the thing which the LORD commanded that you should do: <u>And the glory of the LORD shall appear to you.</u>

Exodus 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and **the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.**

Leviticus 9:22-24 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and *blessed them*, and came down from offering of <u>the **sin offering**</u>, and the **burnt offering**, and **peace offerings**. And <u>Moses and Aaron went into</u>

<u>the tabernacle</u> of the congregation, and came out, and *blessed the people*: And <u>the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people</u>. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed on the altar the burnt offering and the fat: Which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Leviticus 10:1,2 And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and <u>put fire therein</u>, and put incense thereon, and <u>offered strange fire</u> before the LORD, which he commanded them not. And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Leviticus 10:3 <u>Then Moses said to Aaron</u>, This is it that the LORD spoke, saying, <u>I will be sanctified in them that come near me</u>, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace.

Amos 3:1,2 Hear this word that the LORD has spoken against you, children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up out of the land of Egypt, saying: <u>You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth.</u> Therefore, I will punish you for all of your sins.

Leviticus 10:8-11 <u>And the LORD spoke to Aaron</u>, saying, <u>Do not</u> <u>drink wine nor strong drink</u>, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of the congregation, <u>lest you die</u>: It shall be a statute forever throughout your generations: <u>And that you may put</u> <u>difference between holy and common</u>, and between <u>unclean and</u> <u>clean</u>, And that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.

Leviticus 10:12,13 <u>And Moses spoke to Aaron</u>, and to Eleazar and to Ithamar, his sons that were left, Take the <u>meal offering</u> that remains of the offerings of the LORD <u>made by fire, and eat it</u> without leaven beside the altar: For it <u>is most holy</u>: And <u>you shall eat it in the holy</u> <u>place</u>, because it is your due, and your sons' due, of the sacrifices of the LORD <u>made by fire: For so I am commanded</u>.

Leviticus 10:16-18 And Moses <u>diligently sought</u> the goat of <u>the sin</u> <u>offering</u>, and, behold, it was burnt: And he was angry with Eleazar and Ithamar, the sons of Aaron which were left alive, saying, Why have you not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing <u>it is most holy</u>, and God has given it you to bear the iniquity of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD? Behold, <u>the blood of it was not</u> brought in within the holy place: You should indeed have eaten it in the holy place, as I commanded.

Leviticus 10:16a And Moses diligently sought. Sought sought

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, **rightly dividing** the word of truth.

John 5:39 You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life, and it is they that bear witness about me.

Leviticus 11:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and to Aaron, saying to them, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, <u>These are the</u> beasts which you shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.

1 Thessalonians 4:7-12 Because it is God's purpose that our **way of life may be not unclean but holy.** Whoever, then, goes against this word, goes against not man but God, who gives his Holy Spirit to you

Genesis 1:28,29 God blessed them. God said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth, and subdue it. <u>Have dominion over the fish of</u> the sea, over the birds of the sky, and over every living thing that <u>moves on the earth</u>. God said, Behold, I have given you <u>every herb</u> <u>yielding seed</u>, which is on the surface of all the earth, <u>and every tree,</u> <u>which bears fruit yielding seed. It will be your food.</u>

Genesis 2:16,17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat, but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, <u>you shall not eat of it</u>, for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die.

Genesis 7:2 You shall take seven pairs of every clean animal with you, the male and his female. Of the animals that are not clean, take two, the male and his female.

Deuteronomy 14:21a You shall **not eat of anything that dies of itself**: You shall **give it to the stranger** that is in your gates, **that he may eat it**, or you **may sell it to an alien**: For you are a **holy** people to the LORD your God.

Leviticus 11:39,40 If any animal, <u>of which you may eat</u>, dies, he who <u>touches its carcass shall be unclean</u> until the evening. He <u>who eats</u> of its carcass shall wash his clothes, and <u>be unclean until the evening</u>. He also who carries its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening.

Leviticus 11:44,45 For I am the LORD your God: You shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and you shall be holy, for I am holy: Neither shall you <u>defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creeps on the earth.</u> For I am the LORD that brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.

1 <u>Peter</u> 1:15 But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, Be holy, for I am holy.

Leviticus 11:46,47 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth: <u>To make a difference between the unclean and the clean</u>, and <u>between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten.</u>

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Leviticus 13:45 The leper in whom the plague is shall wear torn clothes, and the hair of his head shall hang loose. He shall cover his upper lip, and shall cry, Unclean! Unclean!

Leviticus 19:5-7 And if you offer a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD, you shall offer it at your own will. It shall be eaten the same day you offer it, and on the morrow: And if any remains until the third day, it shall be burnt in the fire. And if it is eaten at all on the third day, it is an abomination. It shall not be accepted.

Acts 10:7 And when the angel which spoke unto Cornelius was departed, he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier of them that waited on him continually.

Acts 10:9-13 On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: But while they made ready, he fell into a trance, And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of four footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat.

Acts 10:15,16 And the voice spoke unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common. <u>This was done</u> <u>thrice</u>: And the vessel was received up again into heaven.

Acts 10:19 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.

Acts 10:14 But Peter said, Not so, Lord, for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean.

Acts 10:28 And he said unto them, Ye know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation, but <u>God hath shewed me</u> that I should <u>not call any</u> <u>Man common or unclean.</u>

Romans 14:14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself, but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.

Acts 10:28 Then he said to them, You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But God has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean.
