TORAH PORTION

Numbers 14:35 I the LORD have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Deuteronomy 8:15 Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water.

1 Samuel 24:1,2 And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David is in the wilderness of Engedi. Then Saul took three thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and went to seek David and his men upon the rocks of the wild goats.

Revelation 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

Numbers 9:18 At the commandment of the LORD the children of Israel journeyed, and at the commandment of the LORD they pitched: As long as the cloud stayed on the tabernacle they rested in their tents.

Exodus 25:8 And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of him that crieth **in the wilderness**, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

John 1:17 For the Torah was given through Moses. Grace and truth were realized through Yeshua the Messiah.

Isaiah 40:5 And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it/Him together: For the mouth of the LORD has spoken it.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelled among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father), full of grace and truth.

Isaiah 40:6 The voice said cry. And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh is grass, and all the goodliness thereof is as the flower of the field: The grass wither, the flower fades: Because the spirit of the LORD blows on it: Surely the people is grass. The grass wither, the flower fades: But the Word of our God shall stand forever.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Isaiah 40:9,10 O Zion, that bring good tidings, get you up into the high mountain, O Jerusalem, that bring good tidings, lift up your voice with strength, lift it up, be not afraid, **say to the cities of Judah, Behold your God!** Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: Behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

John 1:29 The next day, he saw Yeshua coming to him, and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

Isaiah 30:20,21 Though יהוה gave you bread of adversity and water of affliction, your Teacher shall no longer be hidden. But your eyes shall see your Teacher, and your ears hear a word behind you, saying, This is the Way, walk in it, whenever you turn to the right, or whenever you turn to the left.

John 3:2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said to him, Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God.

Hosea 2:14 Therefore, behold, I will allure her, and bring her **into the wilderness**, and speak comfortably unto her.

Hosea 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king, and shall come trembling unto the LORD and to His goodness **in the end of days**.

Mark 6:31 And he said to them, Come you yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: For there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat.

Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness, he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye.

Zechariah 2:8 For thus saith the LORD of hosts, After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: For he that touches you touches the apple of his eye.

Proverbs 7:2 Keep my commandments, and live, and my law as the apple of thine eye.

Exodus 40:1 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, **On the first day of the first month** shall you set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

Exodus 40:17 And it came to pass in the **first month in the second year, on the first day of the month**, that the tabernacle was reared up.

Numbers 7:1 And it came to pass on the day that Moses had fully set up the tabernacle, and had anointed it, and sanctified it, and all the instruments thereof, both the altar and all the vessels thereof, and had anointed them, and sanctified them, That the princes of Israel, heads of the house of their fathers, who were the princes of the tribes, and were over them that were numbered, offered.

Numbers 1:1 the LORD spoke to Moses **in the wilderness** of Sinai, in the Tent of Meeting, **on the first day of the second month, in the second year** after they had come out of the land of Egypt.

Numbers 1:2-4 Take you the sum of all the congregation of the children of Israel, after their families, by the house of their fathers, with the number of their names, every male by their polls. From twenty years old and upward, all that are able to go forth to war in

Israel: You and Aaron shall number them **by their armies**. And with you there shall be a man of every tribe, every one head of the house of his fathers.

Numbers 1:16-18a These were the renowned of the congregation, princes of the tribes of their fathers, heads of thousands in Israel. And Moses and Aaron took these men which are expressed by their names: And they assembled all the congregation together on the first day of the second month,

Numbers 1:51-53 And when the tabernacle sets forward, the Levites shall take it down: And when the tabernacle is to be pitched, the Levites shall set it up: And the stranger that cometh near shall be put to death. And the children of Israel shall pitch their tents, every man by his own camp, and every man by his own standard, throughout their hosts. But the Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of testimony, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: And the Levites shall keep שמר the charge of the tabernacle of testimony.

SHAVUOT/PENTECOST

Deuteronomy 16:16 Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, in the feast of (matzah) unleavened bread, and in the feast of (Shavuot) weeks, and in the feast of (Sukkot) tabernacles.

Leviticus 23:17 Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour, they shall be baked with leaven, they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

Leviticus 23:20,21 And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two lambs: They shall be holy to the LORD for the priest. And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be a holy convocation unto you.

Acts 2:1,5 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Acts 2:2,3 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

Acts 2:16-18 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel, And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the **LORD** shall be saved.

Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: And the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

Acts 4:4 Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed, and the number of the men was about five thousand.

Acts 6:7 And the word of God increased, and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly, **and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.**

Acts 2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having

favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Acts 3:1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of **THE** prayer, being the **ninth hour**. And a certain **man lame from his mother's womb** was carried, whom they **laid daily at the gate of the temple** which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple.

Acts 4:22 For the man was **above forty years old**, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed.

AMIDAH – STANDING PRAYER

Acts 3:7,8 And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: And immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. And he leaping up **STOOD**, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God.

Acts 3:12 And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? Or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though **by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?**

AMIDAH

SANCTIFICATION OF GOD:

We will sanctify Your Name in the world even as they sanctify it in the heavens, as it is written by the hand of Your prophet: And they called one unto the other and said, **Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Hosts**, the whole earth is full of His glory. Blessed be the glory of the Lord from His place. And in Your holy Words it is written, saying, The Lord reigns forever, your God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise you the Lord. Unto all generations we will proclaim **Your greatness**, and to all eternity **we will tell of Your Holiness**. Your praise, O our God, shall not cease from our mouth forever, for **You are a great and Holy God and King**. Blessed are You, **O Lord, the Holy God. You are Holy, and Your Name is**

Holy, and the holy ones praise You every day. Blessed are You, **O Lord, the Holy God.**

Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Yeshua, whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

AMIDAH

GOD OF HISTORY: Blessed are You OH LORD our God and **God of our Fathers, The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**, the great, mighty and revered God, the Most High God who bestows loving kindnesses, the Creator of all things, who remembers the good deeds of the patriarchs and in love came as a Redeemer to their children's children for Your names sake. Oh King, Helper, Savior and Shield. Blessed are You, Oh LORD, the shield of Abraham.

Acts 3:19-23 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord, And he shall send Yeshua HaMashiach, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive **until the times of restitution of all things**, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me, him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

Acts 3:26-4:2 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Yeshua, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. And as they spoke unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them, Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Yeshua **the resurrection from the dead.**

AMIDAH

THE GOD OF NATURE: You, Oh LORD are mighty forever, **You revive the dead**, you have the power to save. You cause the wind to blow and the rain to fall. You sustain the living with lovingkindness, **You revive the dead** with great mercy, and You support the falling, heal the sick, set free the bound and keep faith with those **who sleep in the dust**. Who is like you, Oh Doer of mighty acts? Who resembles You, a King, who **puts to death and restores to life**, and causes *salvation to flourish*. And You are **certain to revive the dead**. Blessed are You, OH LORD, **who revives the dead!**

Exodus 23:14-16 Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year. Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib, for in it thou came out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:) And the feast of harvest, the first fruits of thy labors, which thou hast sown in the field: And the feast of ingathering, which is in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labors out of the field.

Acts 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou sees, brother, how many (tens of) thousands of Jews there are which believe, and they are all zealous of the law.

Exodus 19:16,18 And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud, so that all the people that was in the camp trembled. And mount Sinai was altogether on smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire.

Ezekiel 1:4 And I looked, and, behold, a whirlwind came out of the north, a great cloud, and a fire infolding itself, and a brightness was about it, and out of the midst thereof as the color of amber, out of the midst of the fire.

Ezekiel 3:12,13 Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the glory of the

LORD from his place. I heard also the noise of the wings of the living creatures that touched one another, and the noise of the wheels over against them, and a noise of a great rushing.

Ezekiel 36:26,27 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: And I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

Isaiah 24:5,6 The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof, because they have transgressed the (torah), changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore, hath the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate: Therefore, the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and few men left.

Psalms 119:53 Horror hath taken hold upon me because of the wicked that forsake thy law.

Psalms 119:126 It is time for thee, LORD, to work: For they have made void thy law.

Ruth 2:23 So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest, and dwelt with her mother in law.

Revelation 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire, and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe.
