TORAH PORTION

Numbers 8:1-5 Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and say to him, When you set up the lamps, the seven lamps shall give light in front of the lampstand. And Aaron did so: He set up its lamps in front of the lampstand, as the Lord commanded Moses. And this was the workmanship of the lampstand, hammered work of gold. From its base to its flowers, it was hammered work, according to the pattern that the Lord had shown Moses, so he made the lampstand.

Num 8:11 And Aaron shall offer the Levites before the LORD for an offering of the children of Israel, that they may execute the service of the LORD.

Revelation 4:5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunders and voices: And there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Zechariah 4:1,2 And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep, And said unto me, **What seest thou?** And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof.

Zechariah 3:8-10 Hear now, Joshua the high priest, you and your fellows who sit before you, for they are men who are a sign: For, behold, I will bring forth my servant, the Branch. For, behold, the stone that I have set before Joshua, on one stone are seven eyes: Behold, I will engrave its engraving, says the LORD of Hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day. In that day, says the LORD of Hosts, you will invite every man his neighbor under the vine and under the fig tree.

Zechariah 4:5,6 Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. Then he answered and spoke unto me, saying, This is the word of the

Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts.

Revelation 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood **a Lamb** as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

Revelation 1:4-8 Yochanan, to the seven assemblies that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace, from God, who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before his throne, and from Yeshua the Messiah, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us, and washed us from our sins by his blood, and he made us to be a Kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, including those who pierced him. All the tribes of the earth will mourn over him. Even so, Amen. I am the **Alef and the Tav**, says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.

Revelation 1:10,11a I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud **voice like a trumpet** saying, I am the '**Aleph**' and **the 'Tav'**, the First and the Last, and, Write in a book what you see

Revelation 1:12-14 And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks, And **in the midst of the seven candlesticks** one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle. His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were as a flame of fire.

John 1:1,2 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God.

Numbers 9:1-3 And the Lord spoke unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, **in the first month of the second year** after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying, Let the children of Israel also keep the

Passover at his appointed season. In the fourteenth day of this month, at even, ye shall keep it in his appointed season: According to all the rites of it, and according to all the ceremonies thereof, shall ye keep it.

Numbers 9:9-11 The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the people of Israel, saying, If any one of you or of your descendants is unclean through touching a dead body, or is on a long journey, he shall still keep the Passover to the Lord. In the second month on the fourteenth day at twilight they shall keep it. They shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. They shall leave none of it until the morning, nor break any of its bones, according to all the statute for the Passover they shall keep it.

Numbers 9:15,16 And on the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the testimony: And at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning. So it was alway: The cloud covered it by day, and the appearance of fire by night.

Numbers 10:11,12 And it came to pass **on the twentieth day of the second month**, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the testimony. And the children of Israel took their journeys out of the wilderness of Sinai, and the cloud rested in the wilderness of Paran.

Numbers 10:33,34 And they departed from the mount of the Lord three days journey: And the ark of the covenant of the Lord went before them in the three days' journey! To search out a resting place for them. And the cloud of the Lord was upon them by day, when they went out of the camp.

Numbers 10:35 And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said, Rise up, Lord, and let thine enemies be scattered, and let them that hate thee flee before thee.

Numbers 10:36 And when it rested, he said, Return, O Lord, unto the many thousands of Israel.

Matthew 1:1 A record of the genealogy of Yeshua the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations, from David to the exile to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the carrying away to Babylon to the Messiah, fourteen generations.

Numbers 11:1 And when the people complained, it displeased the Lord: And the Lord heard it, and his anger was kindled, and the fire of the Lord burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp.

Numbers 11:4-6 And the mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: And the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat? We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely, the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlick: But now our soul is dried away: there is nothing at all, **beside this manna**, before our eyes.

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended to heaven and come down? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has wrapped up the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name? Surely you know!

Exodus 16:31a and the house of Israel call its name Manna.

Numbers 11:10 Moses heard the people weeping throughout their clans, everyone at the door of his tent. And the anger of the Lord blazed hotly, and Moses was displeased.

Numbers 11:12-15 Did I conceive all this people? Did I give them birth, that you should say to me, Carry them in your bosom, as a nurse carries a nursing child, to the land that you swore to give their fathers? Where am I to get meat to give to all this people? For they weep before me and say, Give us meat, that we may eat. I am not able to carry all this people alone, the burden is too heavy for me. If you will treat me

like this, kill me at once, if I find favor in your sight, that I may not see my wretchedness.

Numbers 11:33 While the meat was yet between their teeth, before it was consumed, the anger of the Lord was kindled against the people, and the Lord struck down the people with a very great plague.

Numbers 12:1,2 And Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: For he had married an Ethiopian woman. And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? Hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it.

Numbers 12:9,10 And the anger of the Lord was kindled against them, and he departed. When the cloud removed from over the tent, behold, Miriam was leprous, like snow. And Aaron turned toward Miriam, and behold, she was leprous.

Why Jews won't believe in "Jesus"

Acts 3:21-23 Whom the heaven must receive until **the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.** For Moses truly said unto the fathers, **A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me,** him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that **every soul, which will not hear (and obey) that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.**

Deuteronomy 18:15 The LORD your God will raise up unto you a Prophet from your midst, from your brethren, **like me,** unto him you shall hearken.

Deuteronomy 18:18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, **like you,** and will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

Deuteronomy 13:1-3 If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or the wonder

does come to pass, whereof he spoke to you, saying, Let us go after other gods, which you have not known, and let us serve them, **You shall not hearken to the words of that prophet**, or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is proving you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Justin Martyr (c. AD 160) in speaking to a Jew said: The Scriptures are not yours, but ours.

Irenaeus, Bishop of Lyon (c. AD 177) declared: Jews are disinherited from the grace of God.

Tertullian (AD 160-230), in his treatise, Against the Jews, announced that God had rejected the Jews in favor of the Christians.

St. Jerome (AD 347-407) describes the Jews as ... serpents, wearing the image of Judas, their psalms and prayers are the braying of donkeys.

John Chrysostom Bishop of Antioch (AD 347-407) wrote a series of eight sermons against the Jews. To quote him: The synagogue is not only a brothel and a theater, it is also a den of robbers and a lodging for wild beasts. No Jew adores God... Jews are inveterate murderers, possessed by the devil, their debauchery and drunkenness gives them the manners of the pig.

Augustine confronted this problem in his Sermon Against the Jews. He maintained that even though the Jews deserved the most severe punishment for having killed our Jesus, but that they have been kept alive by Divine Providence to serve, together with their Scriptures, as witnesses to the truth of Christianity.

Martin Luther 1483-1546: The Jews and Their Lies (excerpts)

First: Set fire to their synagogues or schools... so that God might see that we are Christians.

Second: I advise that their houses also be razed and destroyed.

Third: Take away all their prayer books.

Fourth: Forbid their Rabbis to teach For they have justly forfeited the right to such an office by holding the poor Jews captive with the saying of Moses.

Fifth: I advise that safe-conduct on the highways be abolished completely.

Sixth: I advise that all cash and treasure of silver and gold be taken from them and put aside for safekeeping.

Seventh: Burn down their synagogues, forbid all that I enumerated earlier, force them to work, and deal harshly with them, as Moses did in the wilderness, slaying three thousand lest the whole people perish. They surely do not know what they are doing, moreover, as people possessed, they do not wish to know it, hear it, or learn it. There it would be wrong to be merciful and confirm them in their conduct. If this does not help we must drive them out like mad dogs, so that we do not become partakers of their abominable blasphemy and all their other vices and thus merit God's wrath and be damned with them. I have done my duty. Now let everyone see to his. I am exonerated.

Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, **Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.**

Isaiah 44:5 One shall say, I am the LORD's, and another shall call himself by the name of Jacob, and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the LORD and surname himself by the name of Israel.
