## TORAH PORTION

Numbers 12:15 And Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days: And the people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in again. And afterward the people removed from Hazeroth and pitched in the wilderness of Paran.

Numbers 13:1-3 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <u>Send</u> <u>you men</u>, that they may <u>search</u> (spy) the land of Canaan, which I give to the children of Israel: Of every tribe of their fathers shall <u>you send</u> a man, <u>every one a ruler</u> among them. And <u>Moses by the commandment of the LORD sent them</u> from the wilderness of Paran: All those men were heads of the children of Israel.

**Deuteronomy 1:20-23** And I said to you, You are come to the mountain of the Amorites, which the LORD our God does give to us. Behold, the LORD your God has set the land before you: Go up and possess it, as the LORD God of your fathers has said to you, fear not, neither be discouraged. **And you came near to me every one of you,** and said, **We will send men before us,** and they shall **search** us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

**Deuteronomy 1:24** And they turned and went up into the mountain, and came unto the valley of Eshcol, and <u>searched</u> <ragal> it out.

Numbers 13:17-20 And Moses sent them to spy out the land of Canaan, and said to them, Get you up this way southward, and go up into the mountain: And see the land, what it is, and the people that dwells therein, whether they be strong or weak, few or many, And what the land is that they dwell in, whether it be good or bad, and what cities they be that they dwell in, whether in tents, or in strong holds, And what the land is, whether it be fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not. And be you of good courage,



and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time was the time of the first ripe grapes.

Ezekiel 20:1 And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month, that certain of the elders of Israel came to inquire of the LORD, and sat before me.

Ezekiel 20:5-8 And say to them, Thus said the Lord GOD; In the day when I chose Israel, and <u>lifted up my hand</u> to the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known to them in the land of Egypt, when I <u>lifted up my hand</u> to them, saying, I am the LORD your God, In the day that <u>I lifted up my hand</u> to them, to bring them forth of the land of Egypt into a land that <u>I had espied explored for them</u>, flowing with milk and honey, which is the glory of all lands: Then said I to them, <u>Cast you away every man the abominations of his eyes</u>, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I am the LORD your God. But <u>they rebelled against me</u>, and would not <u>listen to me</u>: They did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt.

Numbers 13:22-24 And they ascended by the south, and came <u>to</u> <u>Hebron</u>, where <u>Ahiman</u>, <u>Sheshai</u>, and <u>Talmai</u>, the children of <u>Anak</u>, were. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.) And they came to the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from there a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bore it between two on a staff, and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs. The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes which the children of Israel cut down from there.

Numbers 13:28,29 Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: And moreover we saw the children of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: And the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: And the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.



**Numbers 13:32** And they spread an evil report of the land which they had spied out unto the children of Israel, saying: The land, through which we have passed to spy it out, is a land that **eateth up the inhabitants** thereof, and all the people that we saw in it are men of great stature.

Ezekiel 36:8-15 But you, mountains of Israel, you shall shoot forth your branches, and yield your fruit to my people Israel, for they are at hand to come. For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn into you, and you shall be tilled and sown, and I will multiply men on you, all the house of Israel, even all of it, and the cities shall be inhabited, and the waste places shall be built, and I will multiply on you man and animal, and they shall increase and be fruitful, and I will cause you to be inhabited after your former estate, and will do better [to you] than at your beginnings: And you shall know that I am the LORD. Yes, I will cause men to walk on you, even my people Israel, and they shall possess you, and you shall be their inheritance, and you shall no more henceforth bereave them of children. Thus says the Lord GOD: Because they say to you, You are a devourer of men, and have been a bereaver of your nation, therefore you shall devour men no more, neither bereave your nation any more, says the Lord GOD; neither will I let you hear any more the shame of the nations, neither shall you bear the reproach of the peoples any more, neither shall you cause your nation to stumble any more, says the Lord GOD.

**Genesis 48:19** And his father refused, and said, I know it, my son, I know it: He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great: But truly his younger brother shall **be greater than he.** 

Numbers 13:30 And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it, for we are well able to overcome it.

**Numbers 13:31** But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger **than we.** 



Numbers 13:33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: And we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

Numbers 14:22-24 Because all these men, having seen my glory and the signs which I have done in Egypt and in the waste land, still have put me to the test ten times, and have not given ear to my voice, They will not see the land about which I made an oath to their fathers, not one of these by whom I have not been honored will see it. But my servant Caleb, because he had a different spirit in him, and has been true to me with all his heart, him I will take into that land into which he went, and his seed will have it for their heritage.

Joshua 2:9-11 And she said to the men, I know that the LORD has given you the land, and that your terror is fallen on us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom you utterly destroyed. And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: For the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

**Joshua 2:23,24** So the two men returned, and descended from the mountain, and passed over, and came to Joshua the son of Nun, and told him all things that befell them: And they said to Joshua, Truly the LORD has delivered into our hands all the land; for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.

Numbers 14:1-4 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried, and the people wept that night. And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: And the whole congregation said to them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would God we had died in this wilderness! And why has the LORD brought us to this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? Were it not better for us



to return into Egypt? And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

**Deuteronomy 11:7-9** But your eyes have seen all the great acts of the LORD which he did. Therefore shall you keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land, where you go to possess it, And that you may prolong your days in the land, which the LORD swore to your fathers to give to them and to their seed, a land that flows with milk and honey.

Numbers 14:6-9 And Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes: And they spoke to all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. If the LORD delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us, a land which flows with milk and honey. Only rebel not you against the LORD, neither fear you the people of the land, for they are bread for us: Their defense is departed from them, and the LORD is with us: fear them not.

**Numbers 14:11,12** And the LORD said to Moses, How long will this people provoke me? And how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them? I will smite them with the pestilence, and disinherit them, and will make of you a greater nation and mightier than they.

Numbers 14:15-19 Now if you shall kill all this people as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of you will speak, saying, Because the LORD was not able to bring this people into the land which he swore to them, therefore he has slain them in the wilderness. And now, I beseech you, let the **power of my LORD** be <u>Great</u>, according as you have spoken, saying, The LORD is <u>long-suffering</u>, and <u>of great mercy</u>, <u>forgiving iniquity and transgression</u>, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech you, the iniquity of this people



according to the greatness of your mercy, and as you have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

**Numbers 14:26-29** And the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, How long shall I bear with this evil congregation, which murmur against me? I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel, which they murmur against me. Say to them, As truly as I live, said the LORD, as you have spoken in my ears, so will I do to you: Your carcasses shall fall in this wilderness, and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward which have murmured against me.

**Numbers 14:30** Not one will come into the land which I gave my word you would have for your resting-place, but **only Caleb**, the son of Jephunneh, **and Joshua**, the son of Nun.

Romans 10:14,15 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

### **CURRENT WAR**

Genesis 10:22 The sons of Shem were Elam, Asshur, Arphaxad, Lud, and Aram.

Ezekiel 32:24,25 There is Elam and all her multitude, All around her grave, All of them slain, fallen by the sword, Who have gone down uncircumcised to the lower parts of the earth, Who caused their terror in the land of the living, Now they bear their shame with those who go down to the Pit. They have set her bed in the midst of the slain, With all her multitude, With her graves all around it, All of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword, Though their terror was caused In the land of the living, Yet they bear their shame With those who go down to the Pit, It was put in the midst of the slain.

Jeremiah 49:34–39 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against Elam, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, I will break the bow of Elam, The foremost of their might. Against Elam I will bring the four winds From the four quarters of heaven And scatter them toward all those winds, There shall be no nations where the outcasts of Elam will not go. For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies And before those who seek their life. I will bring disaster upon them, My fierce anger, says the LORD, And I will send the sword after them Until I have consumed them. I will set My throne in Elam And will destroy from there the king and the princes, says the LORD. But it shall come to pass in the latter days: I will bring back the captives of Elam, says the LORD.

**Daniel 8:2** I saw in the vision, and it so happened while I was looking, that I was **in Shushan**, the citadel, which **is in the province of Elam**, and I saw in the vision that I was by the River Ulai.

Nehemiah 1:1,2 The words of Nehemiah the son of Hachaliah. It came to pass in the month of Kislev, in the twentieth year, as I was in Shushan the citadel, that Hanani one of my brethren came with men from Judah, and I asked them concerning the Jews who had escaped, who had survived the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

Esther 1:2,3a In those days when King Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which was in Shushan the citadel, that in the third year of his reign he made a feast for all his officials and servants the powers of Persia.

Esther <u>6:13</u> When Haman told his wife Zeresh and all his friends everything that had happened to him, his wise men and his wife Zeresh said to him, If Mordecai, before whom you have begun to fall, is of Jewish descent, you will not prevail against him but will surely fall before him.



Esther 8:9 So the king's scribes were called at that time, in the third month, which is the month of Sivan, on the twenty-third day, and it was written, according to all that Mordecai commanded.

Esther 8:11,12 By these letters the king permitted the Jews who were in every city to gather together and protect their lives to destroy, kill, and annihilate all the forces of any people or province that would assault them, both little children and women, and to plunder their possessions, on one day in all the provinces of King Ahasuerus, on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, which is the month of Adar.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: <u>Fear God</u>, and keep his commandments: For this is the whole duty of man.

**Joshua 2:11** And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: For the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

Deuteronomy 25:17-19 Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt, How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, even all that were feeble behind thee, when thou wast faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore it shall be, when the LORD thy God hath given thee rest from all thine enemies round about, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance to possess it, that thou shalt blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven, thou shalt not forget it.

**Exodus 17:16** For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.

Judges 3:12,13 Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD. And he gathered unto him the children of Ammon and Amalek, and went and smote Israel, and possessed the city of palm trees.

**Judges 6:3,4** And so it was, when Israel had sown, that the Midianites came up, **and the Amalekites**, and the children of the east, even they came up against them, And they encamped against them, and destroyed the increase of the earth, till thou come unto Gaza, and left no sustenance for Israel, neither sheep, nor ox, nor ass.

**Psalm 83:1-7** Keep not silent, O God: Hold not your peace, and be not still, O God. For, lo, your enemies make a tumult: And they that hate you have lifted up the head. They have taken crafty counsel against your people, and consulted against your hidden ones. They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. For they have consulted together **with one consent:** They are confederate against you: The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites, of Moab, and the Hagarenes, Gebal, and Ammon, **and Amalek**, the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre.

Obadiah 1:10-12 For your violence against your brother Jacob shame shall cover you, and you shall be cut off forever. In the day that you stood on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even you were as one of them. But you should not have looked on the day of your brother in the day that he became a stranger, neither should you have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest you have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

2 Corinthians 11:13,14 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light. Therefore, it is no great thing if his ministers also transform themselves into ministers of righteousness, whose end will be according to their works.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?

Matthew 24:11,12 Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.

**Matthew 24:24,25** For <u>false messiahs and false prophets</u> will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. See, I have told you beforehand.

**2 Peter 2:1** But there were also <u>false prophets</u> among the people, even as <u>there will be false teachers among you</u>, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction.

**Ephesians 4:11** And He Himself gave some to be <u>apostles</u>, some <u>prophets</u>, some evangelists, and some pastors and <u>teachers</u>, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry.

Matthew 7:21-23 Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name? And then I will declare to them, I never knew you, depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!

**Jeremiah 12:10 Many pastors** have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.

**Ezekiel 34:7-10** Therefore, ye shepherds, hear the word of the LORD, As I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely because my flock became a prey, and my flock became meat to every beast of the field, because there was no shepherd, neither did my shepherds search for my flock, but the shepherds fed themselves, and fed not

my flock, Therefore, O ye shepherds, hear the word of the LORD, Thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I am against the shepherds; and I will require my flock at their hand, and cause them to cease from feeding the flock, neither shall the shepherds feed themselves anymore; for I will deliver my flock from their mouth, that they may not be meat for them.

2 Corinthians 11:3,4 But I fear, lest somehow, <u>as the serpent</u> <u>deceived Eve by his craftiness</u>, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Messiah. For if he who comes preaches <u>another YESHUA whom</u> we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted you may well put up with it!

Acts 22:3 I am verily a man which am a Jew, born in Tarsus, a city in Cilicia, yet brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, and taught according to the perfect manner of the law of the fathers, and was zealous toward God, as ye all are this day.

Acts 3:19-21 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord, And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

Luke 2:22-24 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord, (As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord) And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

Acts 22:12 And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt there.

James 2:8-11 If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well: But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

**Romans 5:13** For until the law sin was in the world: But sin is not imputed when there is no law.

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 3:17-22 And this I say, that the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect. For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: But God gave it to Abraham by promise. Wherefore then serves the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made, and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator. Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but God is one. Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: For if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law. But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: For there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.



**Isaiah 25:9** And it shall be said in that day, See, this is our **God**, we have waited for Him, and <u>He will save us</u>: this is the **LORD**, we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

Psalm 55:16 As for me, I will call on God. <u>The LORD will save</u> me.

Isaiah 45:21,22 Declare and present it. Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has shown this from ancient time? Who has declared it of old? Haven't I, the LORD? There is no other God besides me, a just God and a Savior, There is no one besides me. Look to me, and be saved, all the ends of the earth, for I am God, and there is no other.

Philippians 2:9-11 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Yeshua HaMashiach is LORD, (YHWH) to the glory of God the Father.

Romans 14:10-13 But you, why do you judge your brother? (the Jew) Or you again, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of Messiah. For it is written, As I live,' says the Lord, (YHWH) to me every knee will bow. Every tongue will confess to God. So then each one of us will give account of himself to God. Therefore let's not judge one another any more, but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block in his brother's way, or an occasion for falling.

Isaiah 45:23-25 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That <u>unto me</u> every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear. Surely, <u>shall</u> one say, in the LORD have I righteousness and strength: Even to him shall men come and <u>all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed</u>. <u>In the LORD (YHWH) shall all the seed of Israel be justified</u>, and shall glory.
