TORAH PORTION

Numbers 16:1-3 Now **Korach**, קָרַח the son of *Izhar*, the son of *Kohath*, the son of *Levi*, and **Dathan and Abiram**, the sons of Eliab, and **On**, the son of Peleth, ***sons of Reuben***, took men: And they rose up before Moses, with certain of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty princes of the assembly, famous in the congregation, men of renown: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them, Ye take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation are holy every one of them, and the LORD is among them: Wherefore then lift ye up yourselves above the congregation of the LORD?

Numbers 14:35 I the LORD have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Numbers 14:39-42 And when Moses put these words before the children of Israel, the people were full of grief. And early in the morning they got up and went to the top of the mountain, saying, We are here and we will go up to the place which the Lord said he would give us: For we have done wrong. And Moses said, Why are you now acting against the Lord's order, seeing that no good will come of it? Go not up, for the Lord is not with you, and you will be overcome by those who are fighting against you.

Deuteronomy 14:1,2 You are the children of the LORD your God: **You shall not cut yourselves**, nor make any **baldness** קִרְחָה between your eyes **for the dead**. For you are a **holy people** to the LORD your God, and the LORD has **chosen you to be a people for his own possession, above all peoples** who are on the face of the earth.

Numbers 16:4-7 When Moses heard it, he fell on his face: And he spoke to Korah and to all his company, saying, In the morning the LORD will show who are his, and who is holy, and will cause him to come near to him: Even him whom he shall choose he will cause to come near to him. Do this: Take censers, Korah, and all his company, and put fire in them, and put incense on them before the LORD tomorrow: And it shall be that

the man whom the LORD chooses, he shall be holy. You have gone too far, you sons of Levi!

Numbers 16:10-12 And He has brought you near to him, and all your brothers the sons of Levi with you. And you seek the priesthood also? For which cause both **you and all your company are gathered against the LORD**. And what is Aaron, that you murmur against him? And Moses sent to call **Dathan and Abiram**, the sons of **Eliab** which said, **We will not come up.**

Numbers 16:13 Is it a small thing that you have brought us up **out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us** in the wilderness, **but you must also make yourself a prince over us?**

Exodus 2:13,14 He went out the second day, and behold, **two men of the Hebrews were fighting with each other**. He said to him who did the wrong, Why do you strike your fellow? He said, **Who made you a prince and a judge over us?** Do you plan to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? Moses was afraid, and said, Surely this thing is known.

Numbers 16:21-27 Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment. And they **fell on their faces**, and said, O God, the God of the spirits of all flesh, shall one man sin, and will you be wroth with all the congregation? And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the congregation, saying, **Get you up from about the tabernacle** of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram. And **Moses rose up** and went unto Dathan and Abiram, and the elders of Israel followed him. And he spoke to the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins. So they got up from the tabernacle of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram, on every side: and Dathan and Abiram came out, and stood in the door of their tents, and **their wives, and their sons, and their little children.**

Numbers 16:30,31 But if the LORD **make a new thing**, and **the earth open her mouth** and swallow them up with all that appertain unto them, and they go down alive into the pit, then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD. And it came to pass, as he had made an

end of speaking all these words, the ground clave asunder that was under them.

Numbers 16:33-35 They, and all that [appertained] to them, went down alive into the pit, and the earth closed upon them: And they perished from among the congregation. And all Israel that [were] round about them fled at the cry of them: For they said, Lest the earth swallow us up [also]. And there came out a fire from the Lord, and consumed the two hundred and fifty men that offered incense.

Revelations 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Psalms 106:13-18,24,25 They hurried and forgot His works, they did not wait for His counsel, but they lusted greedily in the wilderness, and tested God in the desert. And He gave them what they asked, but sent leanness into their soul. And they were jealous of Moses in the camp, and Aaron the saint of the LORD. The earth opened and swallowed up Dathan, and covered the company of Abiram. And a fire was kindled in their company, the flame burned up the wicked. And they despised the pleasant land, they did not believe His word, but murmured in their tents, and did not listen to the voice of the LORD.

Numbers 16:41 But on the next day all the congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron saying, *You have killed the LORD'S people!*

Numbers 16:44-48 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **Get away from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment!** They fell on their faces. Moses said to Aaron, Take your censer, and put fire from off the altar in it, and lay incense on it, and carry it quickly to the congregation, and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone out from the LORD! The plague has begun. Aaron did as Moses said, and ran into the midst of the assembly, and behold, the plague has begun among

the people: And he put on the incense, and made atonement for the people. He stood between the dead and the living, and the plague was stayed.

Numbers 16:49 Now they that **died in the plague** were fourteen thousand and seven hundred, beside them that died about the matter of Korah.

Numbers 17:12,13 And the children of Israel spoke to Moses, saying, Behold, we die, we perish, we all perish. Whoever comes any thing near to the tabernacle of the LORD shall die: Shall we be consumed with dying?

Numbers 17:8-10 And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness, and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds. And Moses brought out all the rods from before the LORD to all the children of Israel: And they looked, and took every man his rod. And the LORD said to Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token **against the rebels**, and you shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

Numbers 17:11 And Moses did so: As the LORD commanded him, so did he.

1 Corinthians 10:10,11 Neither **murmur** ye, as some of them also **murmured**, and **were destroyed** of the destroyer. Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples.

Numbers 26:11 Notwithstanding the children of Korah died not.

HEBREW AND THE GOSPELS

Exodus 20:3-5 Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: For I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers

upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me.

Exodus 20:13,14 Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not commit adultery. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Numbers 14:42 Do not go up, for the LORD is not among you, that ye be not smitten before your enemies.

Mark 10:19 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness.

Matthew 5:21 Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill, and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment.

Mark 10:33,34 Saying, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles: And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again.

Luke 20:14,15 But when the husbandmen saw him, they reasoned among themselves, saying, This is the heir: Come, let us kill him, that the inheritance may be ours. So, they cast him out of the vineyard and killed him.

John 7:19 Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me? The people answered and said.

Matthew 5:17,18 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Matthew 5:40 And if any man will sue thee at the law, and take away thy coat, let him have thy cloke also.

Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

Luke 2:39 And when they had performed all things according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city Nazareth.

John 1:45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my **church**, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Matthew 18:15-17 Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: If he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the **church**: But if he neglect to hear the **church**, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

Israel and the Nations

Psalms 2:1-3 Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

Psalms 83:1-5 Keep not silent, O God: Hold not your peace, and be not still, O God. For, lo, your enemies make a tumult: And they that hate you have lifted up the head. They have taken crafty counsel against your people and consulted against your hidden ones. They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. For they have consulted together with one consent: They are confederate against you.

Psalm 83:12-18 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession. O my God, make them like a wheel, as the stubble before the wind. As the fire burns wood, and as the flame sets the mountains on fire, So, persecute them with your tempest and make them afraid with your storm. Fill their faces with shame, that they may seek your name, O LORD. Let them be confounded and troubled forever, yea, let them be put to shame, and perish: That men may know that You, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, **are the most-high over all the earth.**

Zechariah 14:16,17 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

Psalm 2:4,5 **He that sits in the heavens shall laugh:** The Lord shall have them in derision. Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath and vex them in his sore displeasure.

Psalm 2:6-9 Yet have **I set my king** upon my holy hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: The LORD has said unto me, You are my Son, this day have I begotten you. Ask of me, and I shall give you the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for your possession. You shall break them **with a rod of iron, you shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.**

Revelation 2:27,28 And he shall rule them **with a rod of iron, as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers:** Even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star.

Revelation 12:5 And she brought forth a man child, who **was to rule all nations with a rod of iron:** And her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

Revelation 19:15,16 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall **rule them with a rod of iron:** And he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty

God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

Psalms 2:10-12 Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: Be instructed, ye judges of the earth. Serve the LORD with fear and rejoice with trembling. **Kiss the Son**, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

Jeremiah 16:13-15 Therefore I will cast you out of this land into a land that you know not, neither you nor your fathers, and there you shall serve other gods day and night, where I will not show you favor. Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be said, The LORD lives, that brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt, But, The LORD lives, that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north, and **from all the lands where he had driven them: And I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers.**

Jeremiah 16:16 Behold, I will send for **many fishers**, saith the LORD, and they shall fish them, and after **I will send for many hunters**, and they shall hunt them from every mountain, and from every hill, **and out of the holes of the rocks.**

Ezekiel 38:18-20 And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face. For in my jealousy and in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel, So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that are upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.

Ezekiel 38:22,23 And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood, and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone. Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself, and I

will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

Ezekiel 39:17-20 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD, Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come, gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood. Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan. And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you. Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord GOD.

Revelation 19:11-18 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse, and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns, and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: And his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, **saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God, That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.**
