## TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 16:29-34 It shall be a statute to you forever: In the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall afflict your souls, and shall do no kind of work, the native-born, or the stranger who lives as a foreigner among you: For on this day shall atonement be made for you, to cleanse you, from all your sins you shall be clean before the LORD. It is a Sabbath of solemn rest to you, and you shall afflict your souls, it is a statute forever. The priest, who is anointed and who is consecrated to be priest in his father's place, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen garments, even the holy garments. Then he shall make atonement for the Holy Sanctuary, and he shall make atonement for the Tent of Meeting and for the altar, and he shall make atonement for the priests and for all the people of the assembly. This shall be an everlasting statute for you, to make atonement for the children of Israel once in the year because of all their sins. It was done as the LORD commanded Moses.

Leviticus 25:8-11 And let seven Sabbaths of years be numbered to you, seven times seven years, even the days of seven Sabbaths of years, that is forty-nine years, Then let the loud horn be sounded far and wide on the tenth day of the seventh month, on the day of taking away sin let the horn be sounded through all your land. And let this fiftieth year be kept holy, and proclaim publicly that everyone in the land is set at liberty and freed from debt: It is the Jubilee, and every man may go back to his heritage and to his family. Let this fiftieth year be the Jubilee!

Exodus 24:18 And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and gat him up into the mount: And Moses was in the mount forty days and forty nights.

**Exodus 32:19** And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: And Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

**Deuteronomy 9:17,18** And I took the two tables, and cast them out of my two hands, and brake them before your eyes. And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, **forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water,** because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

NOTES

Exodus 34:28 And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights, he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

Leviticus 16:2 And the LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark, that he die not: For I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat.

**Revelation 11:19** And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple **the ark of his testament**: And there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

**Revelation 12:10** And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: For <u>the accuser</u> of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Leviticus 16:4 He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches on his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen turban shall he be attired: These are holy garments, therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and so put them on.

Leviticus 16:17 And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goes in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

Revelation 15:6-8 And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth forever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power, and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

Genesis 45:1 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him, and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

Ezekiel 20:35 And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face.

Leviticus 16:11-14 And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself: And he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it within the vail: And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward, and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

Revelation 8:3-6 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: And there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

Leviticus 16:18,19 And he shall go out unto the altar that is before the Lord, and make an atonement for it, and shall take of the blood of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about. And he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel.

**Isaiah 1:18** O though your sins be as scarlet they shall be as white as snow.

Revelation 19:7,8 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to him: For the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, <u>clean and</u> white: For the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Revelation 19:11-16 And <u>I saw heaven opened</u>, and behold a white horse, and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his <u>head were many crowns</u>, and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. <u>And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood:</u> And his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, <u>clothed in fine linen, white and clean.</u> And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, <u>King of Kings, and Lord of Lords.</u>

**Isaiah 63:1-4** Who is this who comes from Edom, in crimsoned garments from Bozrah, he who is splendid in his apparel, marching in the greatness of his strength? It is I, speaking in righteousness, mighty to save. Why is your apparel red, and your garments like his who treads in the winepress? I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples **no one was with me**, I trod them in my anger and trampled them in my wrath, **their lifeblood spattered on my garments**, and stained all my apparel. **For the day of vengeance was in my heart, and my year of redemption had come.** 

**Zechariah 3:8,9** Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before thee: For they are men wondered at: For, behold, I will bring forth my servant the BRANCH. For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua, upon one stone shall be seven eyes: Behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts, and <u>I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day</u>.

- **1 Kings 17:1** And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.
- 1 Kings 17:8-12 And the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which belonged to Zidon, and dwell there: Behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee. So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman was there gathering of sticks: And he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink. And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand. And she said, As the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: And, behold, I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.
- 1 Kings 17:17-22 And it came to pass after these things, that the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick, and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him. And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? Art thou come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son? And he said unto her, Give me thy son. And he took him out of her bosom, and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, and laid him upon his own bed. And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also **brought evil** upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son? And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again. And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah, and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived.
- **1 Kings 17:24** And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in thy mouth **is truth.**
- Jonah 1:1-3 Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and call out against it, for <u>their evil</u> has come up before me. But Jonah rose to flee to Tarshish <u>from the presence of the Lord</u>. He went down to Joppa and found a ship going to

Tarshish. So he paid the fare **and went down** into it, to go with them to Tarshish, away <u>from the presence of the Lord.</u>

**Jonah 1:4,5** But the LORD hurled a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken. And the mariners were afraid, and cried every man unto his god, and they cast forth the wares that were in the ship into the sea, to lighten it unto them. But Jonah **was gone down** into the innermost parts of the ship, and he lay, and was fast asleep.

Jonah 2:6 I went down to the bottoms of the mountains.

**Jonah 3:1-3** And the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the second time, saying, Arise, go unto Nineveh, that great city, and preach unto it the preaching that I bid thee. So Jonah arose, and **went unto Nineveh**, according to the word of the Lord.

Jonah 3:7-10 And he caused it to be proclaimed and published through Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying: Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste any thing, let them not feed, nor drink water, but let them be covered with sackcloth, both man and beast, and let them cry mightily unto God, yea, let them turn every one from <a href="https://linear.com/his evil">his evil</a> way, and from the violence that is in their hands. Who knoweth whether God will not turn and repent, and turn away from His fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from <a href="their evil">their evil</a> way. And God repented of <a href="the evil">the evil</a>, which He said He would do unto them, and He did it not.

Jonah 1:6-8 So the captain came and said to him, What do you mean, <u>you</u> <u>sleeper? Arise</u>, call out to your god! Perhaps the god will give a thought to us, that we may not perish. And they said to one another, Come, let us cast lots, <u>that we may know on whose account this evil has come upon us.</u> So they cast lots, and the lot fell on Jonah. Then they said to him, Tell us on whose account **this evil** has come upon us.

**Ephesians 5:13,14** But when anything is exposed by the light, it becomes visible, for anything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it says, Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Messiah will shine on you. Look

carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

Jonah 1:12 He said to them, Pick me up and hurl me into the sea, then the sea will quiet down for you, for I know it is because of me that this great tempest has come upon you.

Jonah 4:1-3 But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was angry. And he prayed unto the LORD, and said: I pray Thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in mine own country? Therefore I fled beforehand unto Tarshish, for I knew that Thou art a gracious God, and compassionate, long-suffering, and abundant in mercy, and repentest Thee of the evil. Therefore now, O LORD, take, I beseech Thee, my life from me, for it is better for me to die than to live.

Exodus 34:6 And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed, The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in mercy and truth. Here we are in our cycle again bringing us back even at the same time this was declared!!

**Jonah 4:5** So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a **booth, and sat under it in the shadow**, till he might see what would become of the city.

Jonah 4:6-8 And the Lord God prepared a gourd, and made it to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shadow over his head, to deliver him from his grief. So Jonah was exceeding glad of the gourd. But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered. And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind, and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, It is better for me to die than to live.

Jonah 4:6 And the <u>LORD God prepared a gourd</u>, and made it to come up over Jonah, that <u>it might be a shadow</u> over his head, <u>to deliver him from his evil.</u>

**Daniel 9:3-6** I set my face to the Lord God, to seek by prayer and petitions, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. I prayed to the LORD my God, and made confession, and said, Oh, Lord, the great and dreadful God, who keeps covenant and loving kindness with those who love him and keep his commandments, **we have sinned**, and have dealt perversely, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even turning aside from your precepts and from your ordinances, neither have we listened to your servants the prophets, who spoke in your name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.

**Revelation 1:17** And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not, I am the first and the last.

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

**Revelation 5:6** And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood <u>a Lamb as it had been slain.</u>

Revelation 6:1,2 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see. And I saw, and behold a white horse: And he that sat on him had a bow, and a crown was given unto him: And he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

**Revelation 20:12** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God, and the books were opened: And another book was opened, which is **the book of life.** 

Luke 1:49 For he that is mighty hath done to me great things, and Holy is his name.
