TORAH PORTION

Deuteronomy 31:25,26 That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying, Take this book of the law, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.

Deuteronomy 31:29,30 Or I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you, and evil will befall you in the latter days, because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands. And Moses spoke in the ears of all the congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.

Deuteronomy 32:1 Give ear, O you heavens, and I will speak, and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

Revelations 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Revelation 15:3,4 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are your works, Lord God Almighty, just and true are your ways, you King of saints. Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name? for you only are holy: For all nations shall come and worship before you, for your judgments are made manifest.

Deuteronomy 32:3,4 Because I will publish the name of the LORD: Ascribe you greatness to our God. He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: A God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

Psalms 19:1-4 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world.

Psalm 148:3-5 Praise ye Him, **sun and moon**, praise Him, **all ye stars** of light. Praise Him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that are above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for He commanded, and they were created.

Revelation 5:11-13 And I beheld, and I heard the **voice of many angels** round about the throne and **the beasts** and the elders: And the number of them was **ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands**, Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing.** And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are **in the sea**, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto him that sits **upon the throne**, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.

Daniel 7:10 A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: Thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.

Deuteronomy 32:5 They have dealt corruptly with him. **They are not his children, because of their defect. They are a perverse and crooked generation.**

Matthew 17:17 Then Yeshua answered and said, **O faithless and perverse generation.**

Deuteronomy 32:6 Do you do this to יְהוָה, O foolish and unwise people? **Is He not your Father**, who bought you, **Who created** you and established you?

Genesis 2:4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth **when they were created**, *in the day* that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

Psalm 89:26-29 He shall cry to me, **You are my Father**, my God, and **the Rock** of my salvation. Also, I will make him my **firstborn**,

higher than the kings of the earth. My mercy will I keep for him for ever more, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. **His seed also will I make to endure forever, and his throne as the days of heaven.**

Psalm 89:30-36 If his children **forsake my law** and **walk not in my judgments**, If **they break my statutes and keep not my commandments**, Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my loving kindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by **my holiness** that I will not lie unto David. **His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before me.**

Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness, he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him **as the apple of his eye.**

Deuteronomy 32:15-18 But **Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked:** You are waxen fat, you are grown thick, you are covered with fatness, then he forsook God which made him, and lightly esteemed **the Rock of his salvation.** They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger. They sacrificed to devils, not to God, to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up, whom your fathers feared not. Of the Rock that begat you, you are unmindful, and have forgotten God that formed you.

Isaiah 1:2,3 Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: For the LORD has spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me. The ox knows his owner, and the ass his master's crib: but Israel does not know, my people do not consider.

Zechariah 7:11-13 But they refused to listen, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear. Yes, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts **has sent in his spirit** by the former prophets: Therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts. Therefore it is come to pass, that as **he cried, and they would**

not hear, so they cried, and I would not hear, said the LORD of hosts.

Jeremiah 6:16-19 Thus says the LORD, Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, Where is the good way? And walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk in it. I set watchmen over you, saying, **Listen to the sound of the shofar'** But they said, We will not listen! Therefore hear, **you nations**, and know, congregation, what is among them. **Hear, earth!** Behold, I will bring evil on this people, even the fruit of their thoughts, **because they have not listened to my words; And as for my law, they have rejected it.**

Deuteronomy 32:20,21 And he said, **I will hide my face from them,** I will see what their end shall be: For they are a **very perverse generation**, Children in whom **is no faithfulness.** They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God, They have provoked me to anger with their vanities: **And I will move them to jealousy with those that are not a people, I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.**

Romans 10:19,20 But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses said, I will **provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a foolish nation I will anger you.** But Isaiah is very bold, and said, I was found of them that sought me not, I was made manifest to them that asked not after me.

Romans 11:11,12 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: But rather through their fall **salvation is come to the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.** Now if the fall of them be the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles, how much more their fullness?

Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come to you from the ends of the earth, and shall say, **Surely our fathers have inherited lies,** vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.

Deuteronomy 32:26,27 I said, I would scatter them into corners, I would make the remembrance of them to cease from among men: Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, and lest **they should say, Our hand is high, and the LORD has not done all this.**

Deuteronomy 32:29 O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end.

Deuteronomy 32:30,31 How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except their Rock had sold them, and the Lord had shut them up? For their rock is not as our Rock, even our enemies themselves being judges.

Deuteronomy 32:41,42 If I whet my glittering sword, and my hand take hold on judgment, I will render vengeance to my enemies, and will reward them that hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall devour flesh, and that with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revenges on the enemy.

Revelation 19:15 And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the wine press of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Deuteronomy 32:43 Rejoice, O you nations, with his people: For **he will avenge the blood of his servants**, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful to his land, and to his people.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: For he has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and has avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

Romans 15:8-12 Now I say that Messiah has been made a servant of the circumcision for the truth of God, that he might confirm the promises given to the fathers, and that **the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy.** As it is written, Therefore will I give praise to

you among the Gentiles, and **sing to your name**. Again he says, **Rejoice, you Gentiles, with his people.** Again, Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles! Let all the peoples praise him. Again, **Isaiah says,** **“There will be the root of Jesse, he who arises to rule over the Gentiles; in him the Gentiles will hope.**

Deuteronomy 32:44,45 And Moses came and spoke all the words of this song in the ears of the people, he, and Hoshea the son of Nun. And Moses made an end of speaking all these words to all Israel.

1 SAMUEL

1 Samuel 11:1,2 Then Nachash the Ammonite came up and encamped against Jabesh Gilead, and all the men of Jabesh said to Nahash, Make a covenant with us, and we will serve you. And Nachash the Ammonite answered them, On this condition I will make a covenant with you, that I may put out all your right eyes, and bring reproach on all Israel.

1 Samuel 11:7 So he took a yoke of oxen and cut them in pieces and sent them throughout all the territory of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whoever does not go out with Saul and Samuel to battle, so it shall be done to his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent.

1 Samuel 11:8 When **he numbered them** in Bezek, the children of Israel were three hundred thousand, and the men of Judah thirty thousand.

1 Samuel 11:12,13 Then the people said to Samuel, Who is he who said, Shall Saul reign over us? Bring the men, that we may put them to death. But Saul said, Not a man shall be put to death this day, for today the LORD has accomplished salvation in Israel.

1 Samuel 11:14 Then Samuel said to the people, Come, let us go to Gilgal and renew the kingdom there. So, all the people went to Gilgal, and there they made Saul king before the LORD in Gilgal.

There they made sacrifices of peace offerings before the LORD, and there Saul and all the men of Israel rejoiced greatly.

1 Samuel 12:1 Now Samuel said to all Israel: Indeed I have heeded your voice in all that you said to me and have made a king over you.

1 Samuel 12:8 When Jacob had gone into Egypt, and your fathers **cried out to the LORD**, then the LORD sent Moses and Aaron, who brought your fathers out of Egypt and made them dwell in this place.

1 Samuel 12:9 And when they forgot the LORD their God, He sold them into the hand of Sisera, commander of the army of Hazor, into the hand of the Philistines, and into the hand of the king of Moab, and they fought against them.

1 Samuel 12:10,11 Then **they cried out to the LORD**, and said, We have sinned, because we have forsaken the LORD and served the Baals and Ashtoreths, but now deliver us from the hand of our enemies, and we will serve You. And the LORD sent Jerubbaal, Bedan, Jephthah, and Samuel, and delivered you out of the hand of your enemies on every side, and you dwelt in safety.

1 Samuel 12:12 And when you saw that **Nachash** king of the Ammonites came against you, you said to me, No, but a king shall reign over us, when the LORD your God was your king.

1 Samuel 12:16-18 Now therefore, stand and see this great thing which the LORD will do before your eyes: Is today not the **wheat harvest**? I will call to the LORD, and He will send thunder and rain, that you may perceive and see that **your wickedness is great, which you have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking a king for yourselves**. So, Samuel called to the LORD, and the LORD sent thunder and rain that day, and all the people greatly feared the LORD and Samuel.

1 Samuel 12:20-22 Then Samuel said to the people, Do not fear. You have done all this wickedness, yet do not turn aside from following the LORD but serve the LORD with all your heart. And do not turn

aside, for then you would go after empty things which cannot profit or deliver, for they are nothing. **For the LORD will not forsake His people, for His great name's sake, because it has pleased the LORD to make you His people.**

1 Samuel 12:23-25 Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to pray for you, but I will teach you the good and the right way. Only fear the LORD and serve Him in truth with all your heart, for consider what great things He has done for you. But if you still do wickedly, you shall be swept away, both you and your king.

1 Samuel 13:1,2 Saul reigned one year, and when he had reigned two years over Israel, Saul **chose for himself three thousand men** of Israel. Two thousand were with Saul in Michmash and in the mountains of Bethel, and a thousand were with Jonathan in Gibeah of Benjamin.

1 Samuel 13:3-5 Then Saul **blew (Tekiah) the shofar** throughout all the land, saying, Let the Hebrews hear! Now all Israel heard it said that Saul had attacked a garrison of the Philistines, and that Israel had also become an abomination to the Philistines. And the people were **called together** to Saul **at Gilgal**. Then the Philistines gathered together to fight with Israel, **thirty thousand chariots and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which is on the seashore in multitude.** And they came up and encamped in Michmash, to the east of Beth Aven.

1 Samuel 13:6,7 When the men of Israel saw that they were in danger (for the people were distressed), then the people hid in caves, in thickets, in rocks, in holes, and in pits. And some of the Hebrews crossed over the Jordan to the land of Gad and Gilead. As for Saul, **he was still in Gilgal, and all the people followed him trembling.**

1 Samuel 13:8-10 Then he waited seven days, according **to the time set by Samuel**. But Samuel did not come to Gilgal, and **the people were scattered** from him. So, Saul said, *Bring a burnt offering and peace offerings here to me.* And he offered the burnt offering. Now

it happened, as soon as he had finished presenting the burnt offering, that Samuel came, and Saul went out to meet him, that he might greet him.

1 Samuel 13:11,12 And Samuel said, What have you done? Saul said, When I saw that **the people were scattered from me**, and that **you did not come within the days appointed**, and that the Philistines gathered together at Michmash, then I said, ‘The **Philistines will now come down on me** at Gilgal, and **I have not made supplication to the LORD**. Therefore, I felt compelled, and offered a burnt offering.

1 Samuel 13:14,15 But now your kingdom shall not continue. The LORD has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you. Then Samuel arose and went up from Gilgal to Gibeah of Benjamin. And Saul **numbered the people** present with him, about **six hundred men**.

1 Samuel 13:19-21 Now there was **no blacksmith to be found throughout all the land of Israel**, for the Philistines said, Lest the Hebrews make themselves swords or spears. But every one of the Israelites **went down to the Philistines to sharpen** his plowshare, his mattock, his axe, or his sickle, and the charge was two-thirds of a shekel for the plowshares and for the mattocks, and a third of a shekel for sharpening the axes and for setting the goads.

1 Samuel 13:22 So it came about, on the day of battle, that **there was neither sword nor spear found in the hand of any of the people who were with Saul and Jonathan**. But they were found with Saul and Jonathan his son.

1 Samuel 14:1 Now it happened one day that Jonathan the son of Saul said to the young man who bore his armor, Come, let us go over to the Philistines' garrison that is on the other side. But he did not tell his father.

1 Samuel 14:3 Ahijah the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD's priest in Shiloh, was wearing an ephod. But the people did not know that Jonathan had gone.

1 Samuel 14:11-14 So both of them showed themselves to the garrison of the Philistines. And the Philistines said, Look, the Hebrews are coming out of the holes where they have hidden. Then the men of the garrison called to Jonathan and his armorbearer, and said, Come up to us, and we will show you something. Jonathan said to his armorbearer, Come up after me, for the LORD has delivered them into the hand of Israel. And Jonathan climbed up on his hands and knees with his armorbearer after him, and they fell before Jonathan. And as he came after him, his armorbearer killed them. That first slaughter which Jonathan and his armorbearer made was about twenty men within about half an acre of land.

1 Samuel 14:24 And the men of Israel were distressed that day, for Saul had placed the people under oath, saying, Cursed is the man who eats any food until evening, before I have taken vengeance on my enemies. So none of the people tasted food.

1 Samuel 14:27,28 But Jonathan had not heard his father charge the people with the oath, therefore he stretched out the end of the rod that was in his hand and dipped it in a honeycomb, and put his hand to his mouth, and his countenance brightened. Then one of the people said, Your father strictly charged the people with an oath, saying, Cursed is the man who eats food this day. And the people were faint.

1 Samuel 14:31-33 Now they had driven back the Philistines that day from Michmash to Aijalon. So the people were very faint. And the people rushed on the spoil, and took sheep, oxen, and calves, and slaughtered them on the ground, and the people ate them with the blood. Then they told Saul, saying, Look, the people are sinning against the LORD by eating with the blood!

1 Samuel 14:35,36 Then Saul built an altar to the LORD. This was **the first altar that he built to the LORD**. Now Saul said, Let us go down after the Philistines by night, and plunder them until the

morning light, and let us not leave a man of them. And they said, Do whatever seems good to you. Then the priest said, Let us draw near to God here.

1 Samuel 14:43-45 Then Saul said to Jonathan, Tell me what you have done. And Jonathan told him, and said, I only tasted a little honey with the end of the rod that was in my hand. So now I must die! **Saul answered, God do so and more also, for you shall surely die, Jonathan.** But the people said to Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who has accomplished this great deliverance in Israel? Certainly not! As the LORD lives, not one hair of his head shall fall to the ground, for he has worked with God this day. So, the people rescued Jonathan, and he did not die.

1 Samuel 14:52 Now there was **fierce war with the Philistines all the days of Saul.** And when Saul saw any strong man or any valiant man, **he took him for himself.**
