## **TORAH PORTION**

**Deuteronomy 32:2** My doctrine shall drop <u>as the rain</u>, my speech shall distil <u>as the dew</u>, as <u>the small rain</u> upon the tender grass, and <u>as the showers upon the herb</u>.

**Hosea 6:3** And let us know, eagerly strive to know the LORD, His going forth is sure as the morning, and <u>He shall come unto us **as the rain**</u>, as the latter rain that watereth the earth.

Ezekiel 34:26 And I will make them and the places round about My hill a blessing, and I will cause the **shower to come down in its season**, there shall be **showers of blessing**.

**Zechariah 14:9** The **LORD will be King over all the earth**. In that day the LORD will be one, and his name one.

**Zechariah 14:16,17** And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations that came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and **to keep the feast of tabernacles**. And it shall be, that whoso of the families of the earth goeth not up unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, upon them **there shall be no rain**.

**Deuteronomy 33:1** And this is the blessing, with which Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel before his death.

Luke 24:50,51 And he led them out until they were over against Bethany: And he lifted up his hands, and blessed them. And it came to pass, while <u>he blessed them</u>, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven.

**Deuteronomy 33:2-4** He said, The LORD came from Sinai, And rose from Seir to them. He shone forth from Mount Paran. He came from the ten thousands of holy ones. At his <u>right hand was a fiery law</u> for them. Yes, he <u>loves</u> the people. <u>All his holy ones are in your hand</u>. <u>They sat down at your feet</u>, each receives your words. Moses commanded us a law, An inheritance for the assembly of Jacob.

NOTES

Matthew 15:29,30 And Yeshua went from there and came to the sea of Galilee, and he went up into the mountain, and took his seat there. And there came to him great numbers of people having with them those who were broken in body, or blind, or without voice, or wounded, or ill in any way, and a number of others, they <u>put them</u> down at his feet and he made them well.

John 8:1,2 Yeshua went unto the mount of Olives. And early in the morning he came again into the temple, and all the people came unto him, and he sat down, and taught them.

**Isaiah 30:20,21** And though the Lord will give you the bread of trouble and the water of grief, you will no longer put <u>your teacher</u> on one side, but <u>you will see your את</u>-Teacher: And at your back, when you are turning to the right hand or to the left, a voice will be sounding in your ears, saying, This is the way in which you are to go.

**Jeremiah 23:29** Is not my word like as a fire? said the LORD, and like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?

**Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment is a lamp, And the law a light.

**Deuteronomy 33:5** He was king in Jeshurun, When the heads of the people were gathered, All the tribes of Israel together.

Deuteronomy 33:13-16 And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD be his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath, And for the precious fruits brought forth by the sun, and for the precious things put forth by the moon. And for the chief things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the lasting hills, And for the precious things of the earth and fullness thereof, and for the good will of him that dwelled in the bush: Let the blessing come on the head of Joseph, and on the top of the head of him that was separated from his brothers.

**Deuteronomy 33:26-29** There is none like God, **Jeshurun**, who rides on the heavens for your help, In his excellency on the skies. The eternal God is your dwelling place. <u>Underneath are the everlasting arms</u>. He thrust out the enemy from before you, and said, Destroy! Israel dwells in safety, the fountain of Jacob alone, In a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens drop down dew. You are happy, Israel. Who is like you, a people saved by the LORD, the shield of your help, the sword of your excellency! Your enemies shall submit themselves to you. You shall tread on their high places.

**Deuteronomy 34:1a** Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is across from Jericho.

**Deuteronomy 34:4,5** Then the Lord said to him, This is the land of which I swore to give Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, I will give it to your descendants. I have caused you to see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there. So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord.

**Deuteronomy 34:6,7** And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: But no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day. And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated.

**Deuteronomy 34:8-12** And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days. So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses ended. Now Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him, so the children of Israel heeded him, and did as the Lord had commanded Moses. But since then there has not arisen in Israel a prophet like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face, in all the signs and wonders which the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, before Pharaoh, before all his servants, and in all his land, and by all that mighty power and all the great terror which Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.

Ezekiel 38:1-3 And the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Son of man, set your face against Gog, the <u>land of Magog</u>, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him, And say, Thus said

the Lord GOD; Behold I am against you, <u>O Gog</u>, the <u>chief prince of Meshech and Tubal.</u>

**Deuteronomy 22:8** When you build a new house, then you shall make a battlement for your **roof**,

Ezekiel 38:18-20 And it shall come to pass at the same time when Gog shall come against the land of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, that my fury shall come up in my face. For in my jealousy and in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel, So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that are upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.

**Psalm 27:5-7** For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: In the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me, he shall set me up upon a rock. And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: Therefore, will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy, I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD. Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice: Have mercy also upon me and answer me.

Ezekiel 38:22,23 And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood, and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone. Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself, and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

Ezekiel 39:17-21 And, you son of man, thus said the Lord GOD, Speak to every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come, gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel, that you may eat flesh, and drink blood. You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes

of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatted calves of Bashan. And you shall eat fat till you be full, and drink blood till you be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you. Thus you shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, said the Lord GOD. And I will set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid on them.

Revelation 19:17,18 And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the middle of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God, That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Revelation 20:7-9 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison and shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: The number of whom is as the sand of the sea. And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.

Jeremiah 34:8 This is the word that came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, after that the king Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people which were at Jerusalem, to proclaim liberty unto them.

Ezekiel 40:1 In the five and twentieth year of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth day of the month, in the fourteenth year after that the city was smitten, in the selfsame day the hand of the LORD was upon me and brought me thither.

**Joshua 1:1-3** After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving



to them the children of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses.

Joshua 1:6-9 Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, to observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded you. Don't turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. This scroll of the Torah shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written therein: For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall have good success. Haven't I commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Don't be afraid, neither be dismayed: For the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.

Joshua 1:16-18 So they answered Joshua, saying, All that you command us we will do, and wherever you send us we will go. Just as we heeded Moses in all things, so we will heed you. Only the Lord your God be with you, as He was with Moses. Whoever rebels against your command and does not heed your words, in all that you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and of good courage.

Genesis 1:1-3 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty. Darkness was on the surface of the deep. God's Spirit was hovering over the surface of the waters. God said, Let there be light, and there was light.

## 1 SAMUEL 15-17

**1 Samuel 13:14** But now thy kingdom shall not continue: The LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart, and the LORD hath commanded him to be captain over his people, because thou hast not kept that which the LORD commanded thee.

1 Samuel 15:1-3a Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I remember that which Amalek did to Israel, how he laid wait for him in the way,



when he came up from Egypt. Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not.

**Exodus 17:16** For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation.


Deuteronomy 17:14 When thou art come unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, and shalt possess it, and shalt dwell therein, and shalt say, I will set a king over me, like as all the nations that are about me.

Deuteronomy 25:17-19 Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt, How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, even all that were feeble behind thee, when thou wast faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore, it shall be, when the LORD thy God hath given thee rest from all thine enemies round about, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance to possess it, that thou shalt blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven; thou shalt not forget it.

- **1 Samuel 15:4,5** And Saul gathered the people together, and **numbered them** in Telaim, two hundred thousand footmen, and ten thousand men of Judah. And Saul came to a city of Amalek, and laid wait in the valley.
- 1 Samuel 15:7-9 And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah until thou comest to Shur, that is over against Egypt. And he took Agag the king of the Amalekites alive and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword. But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all that was good, and would not utterly destroy them: But everything that was vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.
- **1 Samuel 15:10,11** Then came the word of the LORD unto Samuel, saying, It repenteth me that I have set up Saul to be king: For he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my

commandments. And it grieved Samuel, and he cried unto the LORD all night.

- 1 Samuel 15:12 And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.
- 1 Samuel 15:13,14 And Samuel came to Saul: And Saul said unto him, Blessed be thou of the LORD: I have performed the commandment of the LORD. And Samuel said, What meaneth then this bleating of the sheep in mine ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?
- 1 Samuel 15:15,16 And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: For the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God, and the rest we have utterly destroyed. Then Samuel said unto Saul, Stay, and I will tell thee what the LORD hath said to me this night. And he said unto him, Say on.
- 1 Samuel 15:18,19 And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed. Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?
- 1 Samuel 15:20,21 And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal.
- 1 Samuel 15:22,23 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and



stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.


1 Samuel 15:24,25 And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: For I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: Because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD.

1 Samuel 15:26-28 And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: For thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel. And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt of his mantle, and it rent. And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the kingdom of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbor of thine, that is better than thou.

1 Samuel 15:30,31 Then he said, <u>I have sinned: Yet honor me</u> now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God. So Samuel turned again after Saul, and Saul worshipped the LORD.

1 Samuel 15:32,33 Then said Samuel, Bring ye hither to me Agag the king of the Amalekites. And Agag came unto him delicately. And Agag said, Surely the bitterness of death is past. And Samuel said, As thy sword hath made women childless, so shall thy mother be childless among women. And Samuel hewed Agag in pieces before the LORD in Gilgal.

1 Samuel 16:1,2 And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? Fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: For I have provided me a king among his sons. And Samuel said, How can I go? if Saul hear it, he will kill me. And the LORD said, Take an heifer with thee, and say, I am come to sacrifice to the LORD.



- 1 Samuel 16:4,5 And Samuel did that which the LORD spoke and came to Bethlehem. And the elders of the town trembled at his coming, and said, Comest thou peaceably? And he said, Peaceably: I am come to sacrifice unto the LORD: Sanctify yourselves and come with me to the sacrifice. And he sanctified Jesse and his sons and called them to the sacrifice.
- 1 Samuel 16:6,7 And it came to pass, when they were come, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD's anointed is before him. But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature, because I have refused him: For the LORD seeth not as man seeth, for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.
- **1 Samuel 16:8-10** Then Jesse called **Abinadab**, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this. Then Jesse made Shammah to pass by. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this. Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these.
- 1 Samuel 16:11,12a And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: For we will not sit down till he come hither. And he sent, and brought him in.
- 1 Samuel 16:13 Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: And the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up and went to Ramah.
- 1 Samuel 16:14,15 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubles thee.
- 1 Samuel 16:19-22 Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which is with the sheep. And

Jesse took an ass laden with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent them by David his son unto Saul. And David came to Saul and stood before him: And he loved him greatly, and he became his armourbearer. And **Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I** pray thee, stand before me, for he hath found favor in my sight. And whenever the evil spirit from God came on Saul, David took his instrument and made music: So new life came to Saul, and he got well, and the evil spirit went away from him.

1 Samuel 17:3-6 The Philistines were stationed on the mountain on one side and Israel on the mountain on the other side: And there was a valley between them. And a fighter came out from the tents of the Philistines, named Goliath of Gath, he was more than six cubits tall. And he had a head-dress of brass on his head, and he was dressed in a coat of metal, the weight of which was five thousand shekels of brass. His legs were covered with plates of brass and hanging on his back was a javelin of brass.


1 Samuel 17:10-13 And the Philistine said, I have put to shame the armies of Israel this day, give me a man so that we may have a fight together. And Saul and all Israel, hearing those words of the Philistine, were troubled and full of fear. Now David was the son of that Ephrathite of Beth-lehem-judah named Jesse, who had <u>eight sons</u>, and he was an old man in Saul's day, and far on in years. And the three oldest sons of Jesse had gone with Saul to the fight: The names of the three who went to the fight were Eliab, the oldest, and Abinadab the second, and Shammah the third.

**Numbers 1:3** From **twenty years old** and upward, all in Israel who are able to go to war, you and Aaron shall list them, company by company.

1 Samuel 17:14-16 And David was the youngest: And the three oldest were with Saul's army. Now David went to and from Saul, looking after his father's sheep at Beth-lehem. And the Philistine came near every morning and evening for forty days.



- 1 Chronicles 2:13-17 And Jesse begat his firstborn Eliab, and Abinadab the second, and Shimma the third, Nethaneel the fourth, Raddai the fifth, Ozem the sixth, **David the seventh**: Whose sisters were Zeruiah, and Abigail.
- 1 Samuel 17:23 And while he was talking to them, the fighter, the Philistine of Gath, Goliath by name, came out from the Philistines' lines and said the same words, in David's hearing. And all the men of Israel, when they saw him, went in flight, overcome with fear.
- 1 Samuel 17:33-36 And Saul said to David, You are not able to go out against this Philistine and have a fight with him: For you are only a boy, and he has been a man of war from his earliest days. And David said to Saul, Your servant has been keeper of his father's sheep, and if a lion or a bear came and took a lamb from the flock, I went out after him, and overcame him, and took it out of his mouth: And if, turning on me, he came at me, I took him by the hair and overcame him and put him to death. Your servant has overcome lion and bear: And the fate of this Philistine, who is without circumcision, will be like theirs, seeing that he has put shame on the armies of the living God.
- 1 Samuel 17:38,39 Then Saul gave David his clothing of war and put a head-dress of brass on his head and had him clothed with a coat of metal. And David took Saul's sword and put the band round him over the metal coat and was unable to go forward, for he was not used to them. Then David said to Saul, It is not possible for me to go out with these, for I am not used to them. So David took them off.
- **1 Samuel 17:44-46** And the Philistine said to David, Come here to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field. Then David said to the Philistine, You come to me with a sword and a spear and a javelin: But I come to you in the name of the Lord of armies, the God of the armies of Israel on which you have put shame. This day the Lord will give you up into my hands, and I will overcome you, and take your head off you, and I will give the bodies of the Philistine army to the birds of the air and the beasts of the earth today, so that all the earth may see that Israel has a God.



- 1 Samuel 17:51 So running up to the Philistine and putting his foot on him, David took his sword out of its cover, and put him to death, cutting off his head with it. And when the Philistines saw that their fighter was dead, they went in flight.
- 1 Samuel 17:54,55 And David took the head of the Philistine to Jerusalem, but the metal war-dress and the arms he put in his tent. And when Saul saw David going out against the Philistine, he said to Abner, the captain of the army, Abner, whose son is this young man? And Abner said, On your life, O king, I have no idea.
- 1 Samuel 18:1-4 Now after David's talk with Saul was ended, the soul of Jonathan was joined with the soul of David, and David became as dear to him as his very life. And that day Saul took David and would not let him go back to his father's house. Then Jonathan and David made an agreement together, because of Jonathan's love for David. And Jonathan took off the robe he had on and gave it to David, with all his military dress, even to his sword and his bow and the band round his body.
- 1 Samuel 18:5,6 And David went wherever Saul sent him and did wisely: And Saul put him at the head of his men of war, and this was pleasing to all the people as well as to Saul's servants. Now on their way, when David came back after the destruction of the Philistine, the women came out of all the towns of Israel, with songs and dances, meeting David with melody and joy and instruments of music.
- 1 Samuel 18:7-9 And the women, answering one another in their song, said, Saul has put to death his thousands and David his tens of thousands. And Saul was very angry and this saying was unpleasing to him, and he said, They have given David credit for tens of thousands, and to me for only thousands: What more is there for him but the kingdom? And from that day Saul was looking with envy on David.
