

TORAH PORTION

Isaiah 46:10 <u>Declaring the end from the beginning</u>, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Genesis 1:3 And God said, Be light: And there was light.

Genesis 1:6 And God said, Be there a firmament amid the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

Genesis 1:9 And God said, Waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place and let the dry land appear: And it was so.

Genesis 1:11 And God said, Earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

Genesis 1:14 And God said, Be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years.

Genesis 1:21 And God created great whales, and every living creature that moves, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:25 And God made the beasts of the earth after their kind, and cattle after their kind, and everything that creeps upon the earth after its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:26,27 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth. So, God

created man in his own image, in the image of God **created** he him, male and female He **created** them.

Genesis 2:7 And the LORD God <u>formed man</u> of the dust of the ground and <u>breathed into his nostrils the breath of life</u>, and man became a living soul.

Genesis 2:18,19 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone, I will make him a help to challenge him. And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them: And whatever Adam called every living creature, that was its name.

Genesis 2:8 And the LORD God planted a garden eastward, in Eden, and there He put the man whom He had formed.


Gen 2:18,19 And the LORD God said, *It is* not good that man should be alone, I will make him a helper comparable to him., Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought *them* to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that *was* its name.

Exodus 32:4 And he received them at their hand, and **fashioned** it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: And **they said**, These be thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Genesis 2:22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, built he a woman, and brought her to the man.

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground made the LORD God every tree to grow that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and bad.

Genesis 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you^[a] shall surely die.



Genesis 3:2,3 And the woman said to the serpent: We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden. but of the fruit of the tree, which is in the midst of the garden, God has said: You shall not eat of it, nor shall you touch it, lest ye die.

Genesis 3:5 For God knows that in the day ye eat of it, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as <u>God</u>, knowing good and **bad**!

Genesis 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was **good for food**, and that it was a **delight to the eyes**, and that the tree was to be desired **to make one wise**, she took of the fruit thereof and did eat, and she gave also unto her husband with her, and he did eat.

Genesis 3:22 And the LORD <u>God said</u>, Behold, the man is <u>become</u> as one of us, to know <u>good and evil</u>: And now, what if he puts forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eats, <u>and lives</u> forever.


Genesis 24:50 Then Laban and Bethuel answered and said, The matter proceeds from the LORD: We cannot speak to you bad or good.

Genesis 40:7 And he asked Pharaoh's officers that were with him in the ward of his lord's house, saying, Wherefore look ye so <u>sadly</u> today?

Nehemiah 2:2 And the king said to me, Why is your face <u>sad</u>, seeing you are not sick? This is nothing but sadness of the heart. Then I was very much afraid.

2 Kings 2:19 Now the men of the city said to Elisha, Behold, the situation of this city is pleasant, as my lord sees, but the water is **bad**, and the land is unfruitful.

Deuteronomy 6:22 And the LORD showed signs and wonders, great and **grievous**, against Egypt and against Pharaoh and all his household, before our eyes.



2 Samuel 13:16 But she said to him, No, my brother, for this **wrong** in sending me away is greater than the other that you did to me. But he would not listen to her.

Deuteronomy 22:9 You **shall not sow your vineyard** with **two kinds of seed**; lest the fulness of the seed which you have sown be forfeited together with the increase of the vineyard.

Leviticus 19:19 You shall not sow your field with mixed seed.

James 3:11,12 Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter? Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? Either a vine, figs? So can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh.

Matthew 7:18 <u>It is NOT POSSIBLE</u> for a good tree to give bad fruit, and a bad tree will not give good fruit.


Matthew 12:33 <u>Make the tree good</u>, and its fruit good, or <u>make the tree bad</u>, and its fruit bad, for <u>by its fruit you will get KNOWLEDGE</u> of the tree.

Daniel 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.


Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

1 SAMUEL

1 Samuel 18:10,11 And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: And David played with his hand, as at other times: And there was a javelin in Saul's hand. And Saul cast the javelin, for he said, I will smite David even to the wall with it. And David avoided out of his presence twice.



- 1 Samuel 18:17-19 And Saul said to David, Behold my elder daughter Merab, her will I give thee to wife: Only be thou valiant for me, and fight the LORD's battles. For Saul said, Let not mine hand be upon him, but let the hand of the Philistines be upon him. And David said unto Saul, Who am I? And what is my life, or my father's family in Israel, that I should be son in law to the king? But it came to pass at the time when Merab Saul's daughter should have been given to David, that she was given unto Adriel the Meholathite to wife.
- 1 Samuel 18:20,21a And Saul's daughter Michal was in love with David: And Saul had word of it and was pleased. And Saul said, I will give her to him, so that she may be a cause of danger to him, and so that the hands of the Philistines may be against him.
- 1 Samuel 18:25 And Saul said, Then say to David, The king has no desire for any bride-price, but only for the private parts of a hundred Philistines so that the king may get the better of his haters. But it was in Saul's mind that David might come to his end by the hands of the Philistines.
- 1 Samuel 19:1,2 And Saul gave orders to his son Jonathan and to all his servants to put David to death. But Saul's son Jonathan had great delight in David. And Jonathan said to David, Saul, my father, is purposing your death: So now, take care in the morning, and keep yourself safe in a secret place.
- 1 Samuel 19:6-8 And Saul gave ear to the voice of Jonathan, and said with an oath, By the living Lord, he is not to be put to death. Then Jonathan sent for David and gave him word of all these things. And Jonathan took David to Saul, who kept him by his side as in the past. And there was war again: And David went out fighting the Philistines, causing great destruction among them, and they went in flight before him.
- 1 Samuel 19:9,10 And an evil spirit from the Lord came on Saul, when he was seated in his house with his spear in his hand, and David made music for him. And Saul would have sent his spear through him, pinning him to the wall, but he got away and the spear went into the wall: And that night David went in flight and got away.



- 1 Samuel 19:11,12 Then in that night Saul sent men to David's house to keep watch on him so as to put him to death in the morning: And David's wife Michal said to him, If you do not go away to a safe place tonight you will be put to death in the morning. So, Michal let David down through the window, and he went in flight and got away.
- **1 Samuel 19:18** So David went in flight and got away and came to Ramah, to Samuel, and gave him an account of all Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and were living in Naioth.
- **1 Samuel 20:1** And David fled from Naioth in Ramah, and came and said before Jonathan, What have I done? What is my iniquity? And what is my sin before your father, that he seeks my life?
- 1 Samuel 20:5-7 And David said unto Jonathan, Behold, tomorrow is the new moon, and I should not fail to sit with the king at meat: But let me go, that I may hide myself in the field unto the third day at even. If thy father at all misses me, then say, David earnestly asked leave of me that he might run to Bethlehem his city: For there is a yearly sacrifice there for all the family.
- 1 Samuel 20:18,19 Then Jonathan said to David, Tomorrow is the new moon: And you shall be missed, because thy seat will be empty.
- 1 Samuel 20:24-26 So David hid himself in the field: And when the new moon was come, the king sat him down to eat meat. And the king sat upon his seat, as at other times, even upon a seat by the wall: And Jonathan arose, and Abner sat by Saul's side, and David's place was empty. Nevertheless, Saul spoke not anything that day: For he thought, Something hath befallen him, he is not clean, surely he is not clean.
- 1 Samuel 20:27 And it came to pass on the morrow, which was the second day of the month, that David's place was empty: And Saul said unto Jonathan his son, Wherefore cometh not the son of Jesse to meat, neither yesterday, nor today?
- 1 Samuel 20:30-33 Then Saul's anger was kindled against Jonathan, and he said unto him, Thou son of the perverse rebellious woman, do


not I know that thou hast chosen the son of Jesse to thine own confusion, and unto the confusion of thy mother's nakedness? For as long as the son of Jesse lives upon the ground, you shalt not be established, nor thy kingdom. Wherefore now send and fetch him unto me, for he shall surely die. And Jonathan answered Saul his father, and said unto him, Wherefore shall he be slain? What hath he done? And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: Whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

1 Samuel 21:1-4a Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why art thou alone, and no man with thee? And David said unto Ahimelech the priest, The king hath commanded me a business, and hath said unto me, Let no man know anything of the business whereabout I send thee, and what I have commanded thee: And I have appointed my servants to such and such a place. Now therefore what is under thine hand? Give me five loaves of bread in mine hand, or what there is present. And the priest answered David, and said, There is no common bread under my hand, but there is hallowed bread.

1 Samuel 21:6,7 So the priest gave him hallowed bread: For there was no bread there but the shewbread, that was taken from before the LORD, to put hot bread in the day when it was taken away. Now a certain man of the servants of Saul was there that day, detained before the LORD, and his name was Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that belonged to Saul.


1 Samuel 21:8-10 And David said unto Ahimelech and is there not here under thine hand spear or sword? For I have neither brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste. And the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom you slew in the valley of Elah, behold, it is here wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: If thou wilt take that, take it: For there is no other save that here. And David said, There is none like that, give it me. And David arose, and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.

1 Samuel 21:11,12 And the servants of Achish said unto him, Is not this David the king of the land? Did they not sing one to another of



him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands? And David laid up these words in his heart and was sore afraid of Achish the king of Gath.

- 1 Samuel 21:13-15 And he changed his behavior before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard. Then said Achish unto his servants, Lo, ye see the man is mad: Wherefore then have ye brought him to me? Have I need of mad men, that ye have brought this fellow to play the mad man in my presence? Shall this fellow come into my house?
- 1 Samuel 22:1,2 David therefore departed thence, and escaped to the cave Adullam: And when his brethren and all his father's house heard it, they went down thither to him. And every one that was in distress, and every one that was in debt, and every one that was discontented, gathered themselves unto him, and he became a captain over them: And there were with him about four hundred men.
- 1 Samuel 22:7 Then Saul said unto his servants that stood about him, Hear now, ye Benjamites, will the son of Jesse give every one of you fields and vineyards, and make you all captains of thousands, and captains of hundreds.
- **1 Samuel 8:14** And he will take your fields, and your vineyards, and your oliveyards, even the best of them, and give them to his servants.
- 1 Samuel 8:12 And he will appoint him captains over thousands, and captains over fifties, and will set them to ear his ground, and to reap his harvest, and to make his instruments of war, and instruments of his chariots.
- 1 Samuel 22:8-10 That all of you have conspired against me, and there is none that show me that my son hath made a league with the son of Jesse, and there is none of you that is sorry for me, or shows u me that my son hath stirred up my servant against me, to lie in wait, as at this day? Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub. And he enquired of the LORD for him,



and gave him victuals, and gave him the sword of Goliath the Philistine.

- 1 Samuel 22:11-13 Then the king sent to call Ahimelech the priest, the son of Ahitub, and all his father's house, the priests that were in Nob: And they came all of them to the king. And Saul said, Hear now, thou son of Ahitub. And he answered, Here I am, my lord. And Saul said unto him, Why have ye conspired against me, thou and the son of Jesse, in that thou hast given him bread, and a sword, and hast enquired of God for him, that he should rise against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?
- 1 Samuel 22:16-19 And the king said, Thou shalt surely die, Ahimelech, thou, and all thy father's house. And the king said unto the footmen that stood about him, Turn, and slay the priests of the LORD, because their hand also is with David, and because they knew when he fled, and did not shew it to me. But the servants of the king would not put forth their hand to fall upon the priests of the LORD. And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod. And Nob, the city of the priests, smote he with the edge of the sword, both men and women, children and sucklings, and oxen, and asses, and sheep, with the edge of the sword.
- 1 Samuel 22:20-23 And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David. And Abiathar shewed David that Saul had slain the LORD's priests. And David said unto Abiathar, I knew it that day, when Doeg the Edomite was there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned the death of all the persons of thy father's house. Abide thou with me, fear not: For he that seeks my life seeks thy life: but with me thou shalt be in safeguard.
- 1 Samuel 23:1-5 Then they told David, saying, Behold, the Philistines fight against Keilah, and they rob the threshing floors. Therefore, David enquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go and smite these Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, Go, and smite the Philistines, and save Keilah. And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be afraid here in Judah: How much more then if we come to Keilah



against the armies of the Philistines? Then David enquired of the LORD yet again. And the LORD answered him and said, Arise, go down to Keilah, for I will deliver the Philistines into thine hand. So David and his men went to Keilah, and fought with the Philistines, and brought away their cattle, and smote them with a great slaughter. So David saved the inhabitants of Keilah.

- 1 Samuel 23:6-8 And it came to pass, when Abiathar the son of Ahimelech fled to David to Keilah, that he came down with an ephod in his hand. And it was told Saul that David was come to Keilah. And Saul said, God hath delivered him into mine hand, for he is shut in, by entering into a town that hath gates and bars. And Saul called all the people together to war, to go down to Keilah, to besiege David and his men.
- 1 Samuel 23:11,12 Will the men of Keilah deliver me up into his hand? Will Saul come down, as thy servant hath heard? O LORD God of Israel, I beseech thee, tell thy servant. And the LORD said, He will come down. Then said David, Will the men of Keilah deliver me and my men into the hand of Saul? And the LORD said, They will deliver thee up.
- **1 Samuel 23:14** And David abode in the wilderness in strong holds, and remained in a mountain in the wilderness of Ziph. And Saul sought him every day, but God delivered him not into his hand.
- 1 Samuel 23:19,20 Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which is on the south of Jeshimon? Now therefore, O king, come down according to all the desire of thy soul to come down, and our part shall be to deliver him into the king's hand.
- 1 Samuel 23:29 And David went up from thence and dwelt in strong holds at Engedi.
