## **TORAH PORTION**

**Exodus 25:8,9** And **let them make** me a sanctuary, that <u>I may dwell</u> <u>among them</u>. According to <u>all that I show you</u>, <u>after the pattern</u> of <u>the tabernacle</u>, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall you make it.

Leviticus 23:33 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, and say, On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of booths for seven days to the LORD.

Leviticus 23:39,40 Also in the <u>fifteenth day of the seventh month</u>, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD <u>seven days</u>: On <u>the first day</u> shall be a sabbath, and on <u>the eighth day</u> shall be a sabbath. And ye shall take you on the first day the <u>boughs of goodly trees</u>, <u>branches of palm trees</u>, and the <u>boughs of thick trees</u>, and <u>willows of the brook</u>, and <u>ye shall rejoice</u> before the LORD your God <u>seven days</u>.

Leviticus 23:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall <u>proclaim</u> to be holy <u>convocations</u>, even these are MY feasts.

Leviticus 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

JPS Leviticus 23:4 These are the <u>appointed</u> seasons of the LORD, even <u>holy convocations</u>, which <u>ye shall proclaim</u> in their <u>appointed</u> <u>season</u>.

Genesis 33:17 And Jacob journeyed to <u>Succoth</u>, and built him a house, and made <u>booths</u> <u>for his cattle</u>: Therefore the name of the place is called <u>Succoth</u>.

Leviticus 23:41-44 You shall keep it a feast to the LORD <u>seven days</u> in the year: It is a statute forever throughout your generations, you shall keep it in the seventh month. You shall **dwell in booths** seven



days. All who are native-born in Israel shall <u>dwell in booths</u>, that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to <u>dwell in booths</u>, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt. I am the LORD your God. Moses declared to the children of Israel the appointed feasts of the LORD.

- **2 Peter 1:13,14** Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this **tabernacle**, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance; Knowing that shortly I must put off this my **tabernacle**, even as our Lord Jesus Christ hath showed me.
- **2 Corinthians 5:1** For we know that if our earthly house of this **tabernacle** were dissolved, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, **eternal** in the heavens.

Ezekiel 38:20 And all the men that are upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.

Isaiah 51:6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: For the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner.

Zechariah 14:3,4 Then the LORD will go out and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. His feet will stand in that day on the Mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the Mount of Olives will be split in two, from east to west, making a very great valley. Half of the mountain will move toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

**Zechariah 14:16-19** And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to **keep the feast of tabernacles.** And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain. And if the family of



Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain, there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to **keep the feast of tabernacles.** This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to **keep the feast of tabernacles**.

**Exodus 34:29** And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.

Revelation 21:1-4 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: For the first heaven and the first earth were passed away, and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

**Zephaniah 1:7** Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord GOD: For the day of the LORD is at hand: For the LORD hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath **bid his guests**.

Matthew 22:1-3 And Jesus answered and spoke unto them again by parables, and said, The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: And they would not come.

Matthew 22:11-14 And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness, there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few are chosen.



**Zephaniah 1:8** And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD's sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with **strange apparel**.

Revelation 19:9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

Luke 12:35-37 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning, And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding, that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately. Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching, verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

Deuteronomy 16:13-17 You shall observe the feast of tabernacles seven days, after that you have gathered in your corn and your wine: And you shall rejoice in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within your gates. Seven days shall you keep a solemn feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD shall choose: Because the LORD your God shall bless you in all your increase, and in all the works of your hands, therefore you shall surely rejoice. Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles: And they shall not appear before the LORD empty: Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee.

Numbers 29:12,13a On the fifteenth day of the seventh month you shall have a holy convocation. You shall not do any ordinary work, and you shall keep a feast to the Lord seven days. And you shall offer a burnt offering, a food offering, with a pleasing aroma to the Lord, thirteen bulls from the herd.



**2 Peter 1:16** For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Yeshua HaMashiach, but were **eyewitnesses** of his majesty.

Mark 8:22a And he cometh to Bethsaida.

Mark 8:27 And Jesus went forth, and his disciples, to the villages of Caesarea Philippi.

Mark 9:1,2,5 And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the kingdom of God come with power. And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into a high mountain apart by themselves: And he was transfigured before them. And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: And let us make three tabernacles, one for you, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah.

**John 8:12** Again, therefore, Yeshua spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world. He who follows me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life.

John 7:2,14,15 Now the Jewish festival, the Feast of Sukkot, was at hand. But when it was now the midst of the feast, Yeshua went up into the temple and taught. The Judeans therefore marveled, saying, How does this man know letters, having never been educated?

**Exodus 15:2** The LORD is my strength and song. **He has become my salvation** [yeshu'ah]. This is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Psalm 118:14 The LORD is my strength and song. He has become my salvation [yeshu'ah].

Isaiah 12:2-4 Behold, God is my salvation. I will trust, and will not be afraid, for the LORD, the LORD, is my strength and song, and he has become my salvation [yeshu`ah]. Therefore with joy you will draw water out of the wells of salvation [yeshu`ah].

John 7:37,38 Now on the last and greatest day of the feast, Yeshua stood and <u>cried out</u>, If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink! He who believes in me, <u>as the Scripture has said, from within him will flow rivers of living water.</u>

Isaiah 12:6 Cry aloud and shout, you inhabitant of Zion, for the Holy One of Israel is great in the midst of you!

Luke 3:23 And Yeshua at this time was about thirty years old.

**Deuteronomy31:10,11** And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Luke 2:6-8 And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in <a href="mailto:swaddling clothes">swaddling clothes</a>, and laid him in a manger, because <a href="mailto:there was no room for them in the inn. And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night.

**John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and **dwelt (Tabernacled) among us**, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only **begotten** of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

**Psalm 118:15** The voice of rejoicing and <u>salvation</u> is in the tabernacles of the righteous: The right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Luke 1:5 There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia.

1 Chronicles 24:10 The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah.



Luke 1:8,9 And it came to pass, that while he executed the priest's office before God in the order of his course, According to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord.

Luke 2:20,21 And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them. And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called Yeshua, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

Luke 2:22-24 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord, (As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called holy to the Lord) And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

Leviticus 12:3,4 And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised. And she shall then continue in the blood of her purifying three and thirty days, she shall touch no hallowed thing, nor come into the sanctuary, until the days of her purifying be fulfilled.

Leviticus 12:6 And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall <u>bring a lamb</u> of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest.

Leviticus 12:8 And <u>if she be not able to bring a lamb</u>, <u>then she shall</u> <u>bring two turtledoves</u>, <u>or two young pigeons</u>, the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: And the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.
