TORAH PORTION

Obadiah 1:10-12 For thy violence against thy brother Jacob shame shall cover thee, and thou shalt be cut off forever. In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even thou wast as one of them. But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger, neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction, neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

Obadiah 1:14,15 Neither shouldest thou have stood in the crossway, to cut off those of his that did escape, neither shouldest thou have delivered up those of his that did remain in the day of distress. For the day of the LORD is near upon all the heathen: As thou hast done, it shall be done unto thee: Thy reward shall return upon thine own head.

Genesis 32:3 And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom.

Genesis 32:6 And the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, We came to thy brother Esau, and also he cometh to meet thee, and four hundred men with him.

Genesis 32:7 Then Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed: And he divided the people that was with him, and the flocks, and herds, and the camels, into two bands.

Genesis 31:41 These twenty years have I been in thy house: I served thee fourteen years for thy two daughters, and six years for thy flock, and thou hast changed my wages ten times.

Genesis 32:22-25 And he rose up that night, and took his <u>two wives</u>, and his <u>two women servants</u>, and his <u>eleven sons</u>, and passed <u>over the ford Jabbok</u>. And he took them, and sent them over the brook, and sent



over that he had. And Jacob was left alone, and there <u>wrestled a man</u> with him **until the breaking of the day**. And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh, and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.

Deuteronomy 21:15,16 If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he maketh his sons to inherit that which he hath, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn.

Hosea 12:2-4 The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways, according to his doings will he recompense him. He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God. Yes, he wept and cried to Him, and he had power over the Angel and overcame.

Genesis 32:26-30 And He said, Let Me go, for the day breaks. And he said, I will not let You go except You bless me. And He said to him, What is your name? And he said, Jacob. And He said, Your name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel, for as a prince have you power with God and with men, and have prevailed. And Jacob asked him and said, Tell me, I pray You, Your name. And He said, Why is it that you do ask after My name? And He blessed him there. And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel, for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved.

Revelation 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: And I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: And I will write upon him my new name.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches, To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone **a new name** written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.



Genesis 33:4 And Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck, and kissed him: And they wept.

Genesis 33:18 And Jacob came in peace to the city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, when he came from Paddan-aram, and encamped before the city.

Genesis 33:19,20 And for a hundred bits of money he got from the children of Hamor, the builder of Shechem, the field in which he had put up his tents. And there he put up an altar, naming it El, the God of Israel.

Genesis 36:2 Esau took his wives of the daughters of Canaan, Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon *the Hivite*.

Genesis 34:1,2 Now Dinah, the daughter whom Leah had by Jacob, went out to see the women of that country. And when **Shechem**, the son of **Hamor the Hivite** who was the chief of that land, saw her, he **took** her by **force** and had connection with her.

Genesis 34:5 Now Jacob had word of what Shechem had done to <u>his</u> <u>daughter</u>, but his sons were in the fields with the cattle, and Jacob said nothing till they came.

Genesis 34:11-16 And Shechem said to her father and her brothers, If you will give ear to my request, whatever you say I will give to you. However great you make the bride-price and payment, I will give it; only let me have the girl for my wife. But the sons of Jacob gave a false answer to Shechem and Hamor his father, because of what had been done to Dinah their sister. And they said, It is not possible for us to give our sister to one who is without circumcision, for that would be a cause of shame to us: But on this condition only will we come to an agreement with you: If every male among you becomes like us and undergoes circumcision, (Then we will give our daughters to you and take your daughters to us and go on living with you as one people.)



Genesis 34:18-22 And their words were pleasing to Hamor and his son Shechem. And without loss of time the young man did as they said, because he had delight in Jacob's daughter, and <u>he was the noblest</u> of his father's house. Then Hamor and Shechem, his son, went to the meeting-place of their town, and said to the men of the town, It is the desire of these men to be at peace with us, let them then go on living in this country and doing trade here, for the country is wide open before them, let us take their daughters as wives and let us give them our daughters. Only herein will the men consent unto us for to dwell with us, to be one people, if every male among us be circumcised, as they are circumcised.

Genesis 34:23 Then will not their cattle and their goods and all their beasts be ours? So let us come to an agreement with them so that they may go on living with us.

Genesis 34:24,25 Then all the men of the town gave ear to the words of Hamor and Shechem his son, and every male in the town underwent circumcision. And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

Deuteronomy 21:10-13 When you go forth to war against thine enemies, and the LORD thy God hath delivered them into thine hands, and thou hast taken them captive, And sees among the captives a beautiful woman, and hast a desire unto her, that you would have her to thy wife, Then thou shalt bring her home to thine house, and she shall shave her head, and pare her nails, And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother a full month: And after that thou shalt go in unto her, and be her husband, and she shall be thy wife.

Genesis 34:29 And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they captive, and spoiled even all that was in the house.




Genesis 34:30,31 And Jacob said to Simeon and Levi: Ye have troubled me, to make me odious unto the inhabitants of the land, even unto the Canaanites and the Perizzites, and I being few in number, they will gather themselves together against me and smite me, and I shall be destroyed, I and my house.' And they said: Should one deal with <u>our sister</u> as with a harlot?'

Genesis 35:1 And God said to Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: And make there an altar to God, that appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother.

Genesis 35:2-5 Then Jacob said to his household, and to all that were with him, Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments. And let us arise and go up to Bethel, and I will make there an altar to God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went. And they gave to Jacob all the strange gods which were in their hand, and all their earrings which were in their ears. And Jacob hid them under the oak which was by Shechem. And they journeyed. And the terror of God was on the cities that were round about them, and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob.

Genesis 35:10-12 And God said to him, Your name is Jacob: Your name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel shall be your name: And He called his name Israel. And God said to him, I am God Almighty: Be fruitful and multiply, a nation and a company of nations shall be of you, and kings shall come out of your loins, And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to you I will give it, and to your seed after you will I give the land.

Genesis 35:16-18 And they journeyed from Bethel, and there was but <u>a</u> little way to come to Ephrath: And Rachel travailed, and she had hard labor. And it came to pass, when she was in hard labor, that the midwife said unto her, Fear not, thou shalt have this son also. And it came to pass, as her soul was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name **Benoni:** But his father called him **Benjamin**.



Genesis 35:19-21 And Rachel died and was buried in the way to Ephrath, which is Bethlehem. And Jacob set a pillar on her grave: That is the pillar of Rachel's grave to this day. And Israel journeyed and spread his tent beyond the tower of Edar.

Genesis 35:22 And it came to pass, while Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his <u>father's concubine</u>, and Israel heard of it. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve.

Genesis 35:29 And Isaac gave up the ghost, and died, and was gathered unto his people, being old and full of days: And his sons Esau and Jacob buried him.

Genesis 37:2 These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was feeding the flock with his brethren, being still a lad even with the sons of Bilhah, and with the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives.


Exodus 1:7 And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty, and the land was filled with them.

Exodus 38:26 A bekah for every man, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that went to be numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

2 Samuel 20-24

2 Samuel 20:10,11 But Amasa did not see danger from the sword which was now in Joab's left hand, and Joab put it through his stomach so that his inside came out on to the earth, and he did not give him another blow. So, **Joab and his brother Abishai** went on after Sheba, the son of Bichri. And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He said: He that is for Joab, and he that is for David, let him follow Joab.

2 Samuel 20:12,13 And Amasa wallowed in blood in the midst of the highway. And when the man saw that all the people stood still, he



removed Amasa out of the highway into the field, and cast a cloth upon him, when he saw that every one that came by him stood still. When he was removed out of the highway, all the people went on after Joab, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

- **2 Samuel 20:15** And they came and besieged him in Abel of Bethmaachah, and they cast up a bank against the city, and it stood in the trench: And all the people that were with Joab battered the wall, to throw it down.
- **2 Samuel 20:16,17** Then cried a wise woman out of the city, Hear, hear, say, I pray you, unto Joab, Come near hither, that I may speak with thee. And when he was come near unto her, the woman said, Art thou Joab? And he answered, I am he. Then she said unto him, Hear the words of thine handmaid.
- **2 Samuel 20:21,22** The matter is not so: But a man of mount Ephraim, Sheba the son of Bichri by name, hath lifted up his hand against the king, even against David: Deliver him only, and I will depart from the city. And the woman said unto Joab, Behold, his head shall be thrown to thee over the wall. Then the woman went unto all the people in her wisdom. And they cut off the head of Sheba the son of Bichri and cast it out to Joab.
- **2 Samuel 20:23** Now Joab was over all the host of Israel: And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and over the Pelethites.
- **2 Samuel 21:1** Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year, and David enquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, It is for Saul, and for his bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.
- **Joshua 9:3-5** And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai, They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up, And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry and moldy.



Joshua 9:7 And the men of Israel said unto the Hivites, Peradventure ye dwell among us, and how shall we make a league with you?

Joshua 9:15,16 And Joshua made peace with them, and made a league with them, to let them live and the princes of the congregation swore unto them. And it came to pass at the end of three days after they had made a league with them, that they heard that they were their neighbors, and that they dwelt among them.

Joshua 9:19 But all the princes said unto all the congregation, We have sworn unto them by the LORD God of Israel: Now therefore we may not touch them.

Joshua 9:22,23 And Joshua called for them, and he spoke unto them, saying, Wherefore have ye beguiled us, saying, We are very far from you, when ye dwell among us? Now therefore ye are cursed, and there shall none of you be freed from being bondmen, and hewers of wood and drawers of water for the house of my God.

Joshua 9:24 And they answered Joshua, and said, Because it was certainly told thy servants, how that the LORD thy God commanded his servant Moses to give you all the land, and to destroy all the inhabitants of the land from before you, therefore we were sore afraid of our lives because of you and have done this thing.

2 Samuel 21:2 And the king called the Gibeonites and said unto them, (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites, and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: And Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.)

2 Samuel 21:3 Wherefore David said unto the Gibeonites, What shall I do for you? And wherewith shall I make the atonement, that ye may bless the inheritance of the LORD?

2 Samuel 21:5,6 And they answered the king, The man that consumed us, and that devised against us that we should be destroyed from remaining in any of the coasts of Israel, Let seven men of his sons be



delivered unto us, and we will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, whom the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give them.


- **2 Samuel 3:7** And Saul had a concubine, whose name was **Rizpah**, the daughter of Aiah: And Ishbosheth said to Abner, Wherefore hast thou gone in unto my father's concubine?
- 2 Samuel 21:7-9 But the king spared Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, because of the LORD's oath that was between them, between David and Jonathan the son of Saul. But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth, and the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul, whom she brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite: And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: And they fell all seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first days, in the beginning of barley harvest.
- 1 Samuel 18:19 But it came to pass at the time when Merab Saul's daughter should have been given to David, that she was given unto Adriel the Meholathite to wife.
- **1 Samuel 25:44** But Saul had given Michal his daughter, David's wife, to Phalti the son of Laish, which was of Gallim.
- **2 Samuel 3:13** And he said, Well, I will make a league with thee: But one thing I require of thee, that is, Thou shalt not see my face, except thou first bring Michal Saul's daughter, when you come to see my face.
- **2 Samuel 21:15,16** Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel, and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: And David waxed faint. And Ishbibenob, which was of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear weighed three hundred shekels of brass in weight, he being girded with a new sword, thought to have slain David.



- **2 Samuel 21:17** But Abishai the son of Zeruiah helped him, and smote the Philistine, and killed him. Then the men of David swore unto him, saying, Thou shalt go no more out with us to battle, that thou quench not the light of Israel.
- **2 Samuel 21:18,19** And it came to pass after this, that there was again a battle with the Philistines at Gob: Then Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Saph, which was of the sons of the giant. And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew the brother of Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear was like a weaver's beam.
- **2 Samuel 21:20-22** And there was yet a battle in Gath, where was a man of great stature, that had on every hand six fingers, and on every foot six toes, four and twenty in number, and he also was born to the giant. And when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea the brother of David slew him. These four were born to the giant in Gath, and fell by the hand of David, and by the hand of his servants.
- **2 Samuel 22:1-4** And David spoke unto the LORD the words of this song in the day that the LORD had delivered him out of the hand of all his enemies, and out of the hand of Saul: And he said, The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; The God of my rock, in him will I trust: He is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior, you save me from violence. I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: So, shall I be saved from my enemies.
- **2 Samuel 22:7-9** In my distress I called upon the LORD and cried to my God: And he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry did enter into his ears. Then the earth shook and trembled, the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth. There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: Coals were kindled by it.
- **2 Samuel 22:26,27** With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful, and with the upright man thou wilt shew thyself upright. With the pure thou wilt shew thyself pure.



- **2 Samuel 22:33-37** God is my strength and power: And he maketh my way perfect. He maketh my feet like hinds' feet: And sets me upon my high places. He teaches my hands to war, so that a bow of steel is broken by my arms. Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: And thy gentleness hath made me great. Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, so that my feet did not slip.
- **2 Samuel 23:3** The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spoke to me, He that rules over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God.
- **2 Samuel 23:18,19** And Abishai, the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief among three. And he lifted up his spear against three hundred, and slew them, and had the name among three. Was he not most honorable of three? Therefore he was their captain.
- **2 Samuel 23:20-23** And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man, of Kabzeel, who had done many acts, he slew two lionlike men of Moab: He went down also and slew a lion in the midst of a pit in time of snow: And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: And the Egyptian had a spear in his hand, but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear. These things did Benaiah the son of Jehoiada and had the name among three mighty men. He was more honorable than the thirty,
- 2 Samuel 23:24 Asahel the brother of Joab was one of the thirty.
- 2 Samuel 23:34 Eliam the son of Ahithophel the Gilonite.
- 2 Samuel 23:39 Uriah the Hittite: Thirty and seven in all.
- **2 Samuel 24:1** And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.
- **2 Samuel 24:3** For the king said to Joab the captain of the host, which was with him, Go now through all the tribes of Israel, from Dan even to Beersheba, and number ye the people, that I may know the number of the people. And Joab said unto the king, Now the LORD thy God add unto the people, how many soever they be, an hundredfold, and that the eyes of my lord the king may see it: But why doth my lord the king delight in this thing?



- **2 Samuel 24:4** Notwithstanding the king's word prevailed against Joab, and against the captains of the host. And Joab and the captains of the host went out from the presence of the king, to number the people of Israel.
- **2 Samuel 24:8,9** So when they had gone through all the land, they came to Jerusalem at the end of nine months and twenty days. And Joab gave up the sum of the number of the people unto the king: And there were in Israel eight hundred thousand valiant men that drew the sword, and the men of Judah were five hundred thousand men.
- **2 Samuel 24:11,12** For when David was up in the morning, the word of the LORD came unto the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying, Go and say unto David, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three things, choose thee one of them, that I may do it unto thee.
- **2 Samuel 24:13** So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, Shall seven years of famine come unto thee in thy land? Or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? Or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land? Now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.
- **2 Samuel 24:14** And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: Let us fall now into the hand of the LORD, for his mercies are great: And let me not fall into the hand of man.
- **2 Samuel 24:15,16** So the LORD sent a pestilence upon Israel from the morning even to the time appointed: And there died of the people from Dan even to Beersheba seventy thousand men. And when the angel stretched out his hand upon Jerusalem to destroy it, the LORD repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed the people, It is enough: Stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD was by the threshing place of Araunah the Jebusite.
- **2 Samuel 24:17** And David spoke unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the people, and said, Lo, I have sinned, and I have done wickedly: But these sheep, what have they done? Let thine hand, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's house.



- **2 Samuel 24:18,19** And Gad came that day to David, and said unto him, Go up, rear an altar unto the LORD in the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite. And David, according to the saying of Gad, went up as the LORD commanded.
- **2 Samuel 24:21-23** And David said, To buy the threshing floor of thee, to build an altar unto the LORD, that the plague may be stayed from the people. And Araunah said unto David, Let my lord the king take and offer up whatever seems good unto him: Behold, here be oxen for burnt sacrifice, and threshing instruments and other instruments of the oxen for wood. All these things did Araunah, as a king, give unto the king.
- **2 Samuel 24:24,25** And the king said unto Araunah, Nay, but I will surely buy it of thee at a price: Neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing. So, David bought the threshing floor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver. And David built there an altar unto the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So, the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.
