TORAH PORTION

Genesis 44:18 Then Judah <u>came near</u> to him, and said, Oh my lord, let your servant, I pray you, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not your anger burn against your servant: For you are even as Pharaoh.

Genesis 44:19-23 My lord asked his servants, saying, Have you a father, or a brother? We said to my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one, and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father loves him. You said to your servants, Bring him down to me, that I may set my eyes on him. We said to my lord, 'The boy can't leave his father: for if he should leave his father, his father would die. You said to your servants, Unless your youngest brother comes down with you, you will see my face no more.

Genesis 46:21 And the sons of Benjamin were Belah, and Becher, and Ashbel, Gera, and Naaman, Ehi, and Rosh, Muppim, and Huppim, and Ard.

Genesis 44:30 Now therefore when I come to thy servant my father, and the lad be not with us, seeing that his life is bound up in the lad's life.

Genesis 44:32,33 For your servant became surety for the lad to my father, saying, If I bring him not to you, then I shall bear the blame to my father forever. Now therefore, I pray you, let your servant abide instead of *the lad* a slave to my lord, and let the lad go up with his brothers.

Genesis 37:23 And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stripped Joseph out of his coat, his coat of many colors that was on him.

1 Samuel 18:1,2 And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul. And Saul took him that day, and would let him go no more home to his father's house.

1 Samuel 18:3,4 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. And <u>Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that was upon him</u>, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle.

Romans 9:3,4 For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Messiah for my brothers sake, my relatives according to the flesh, who are Israelites, whose is the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service, and the promises.

Genesis 45:1,2 Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him, and he cried, <u>Cause every man to go out from me.</u> And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known to his brothers. And he wept aloud: And the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

Genesis 45:3 And Joseph said to his brothers, <u>I am Joseph</u>, does my father yet live? And his brothers could not answer him, <u>for they were troubled at his presence.</u>

Genesis 45:4,5 And Joseph said to his brothers, <u>Come near to me</u>, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, <u>I am Joseph</u> your brother, whom <u>you sold</u> into Egypt. Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that you sold me here: For God did send me before you to preserve life.

James 4:8-11 Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: Let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brothers. He that speaks evil of his brother, and judges his brother, speaks evil of the law, and judges the law: But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a judge.

Genesis 45:7 God sent me before you to preserve for you <u>a remnant</u> in the earth, and to save you alive by a great deliverance.

Isaiah 10:20-22 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **the remnant** of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay on him that smote them, but shall stay on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God. For though your people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: The consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness.

Jeremiah 50:20 In those days, and in that time, says the LORD, <u>the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none</u>, and the <u>sins of Judah</u>, and they shall not be found: For I will pardon them whom I leave as <u>a remnant</u>.

Genesis 45:9 <u>Hurry</u>, and go up to my father, and tell him, This is what your son Joseph says, <u>God has made me lord of all Egypt</u>. Come down to me. <u>Don't wait.</u>

Genesis 45:13 You shall tell my father of all my glory in Egypt, and of all that you have seen. You shall hurry and bring my father down here.

Genesis 45:22a To all of them he gave each man changes of raiment.

Revelation 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: For the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Genesis 46:2-4 And God said to Israel in a night-vision, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here am I. And he said, I am God, the God of your father: Go down to Egypt without fear, for I will make a great nation of you there: I will go down with you to Egypt, and I will see that you come back again, and at your death Joseph will put his hands on your eyes.

Genesis 46:8-15 And these are the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, <u>Jacob</u> and his sons: Reuben, Jacob's firstborn. And the sons of Reuben, Hanoch, and Phallu, and Hezron, and Carmi. And the sons of Simeon, Jemuel, and Jamin, and Ohad, and Jachin, and Zohar, and Shaul the son of a Canaanitish woman. And the sons of Levi, Gershon, Kohath, and Merari. And the sons of

Judah, Er, and Onan, and Shelah, and Pharez, and Zerah: But Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan. And the sons of Pharez were Hezron and Hamul. And the sons of Issachar, Tola, and Phuvah, and Job, and Shimron. And the sons of Zebulun, Sered, and Elon, and Jahleel. These be the sons of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob in Padanaram, with his daughter Dinah: All the souls of his sons and his daughters were thirty and three.

Genesis 46:27,28 And the sons of Joseph whom he had in Egypt were two. Seventy persons of the family of Jacob came into Egypt. Now he had sent Judah before him to Goshen, גשון to get word from Joseph, and so they came to the land of Goshen. גשנה

Genesis 46:29 And Joseph got his carriage ready and went to Goshen גשנה for the meeting with his father, and when he came before him, he put his arms round his neck, weeping.

Genesis 46:33,34 Now when Pharaoh sends for you and says, What is your business? You are to say, Your servants have been keepers of cattle from our early days up to now, like our fathers, in this way you will be able to have the land of Goshen for yourselves, because keepers of sheep are unclean in the eyes of the Egyptians.

Genesis 47:5 And Pharaoh said to Joseph, Let them have the land of Goshen, and if there are any able men among them, put them over my cattle.

Genesis 47:7-10 Then Joseph made his father Jacob come before Pharaoh, and Jacob gave him his blessing. And Pharaoh said to him, How old are you? And Jacob said, The years of my wanderings have been a hundred and thirty, small in number and full of sorrow have been the years of my life, and less than the years of the wanderings of my fathers. And Jacob gave Pharaoh his blessing, and went out from before him.

Genesis 47:11-21 And Joseph made a place for his father and his brothers, and gave them a heritage in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had given orders. And Joseph took care of his father and his brothers and all his father's people, giving them food for the needs of their families. Now there was no food to be had in all the land, so that all Egypt and Canaan were wasted from need of food. And all the money in Egypt and in the land of Canaan which had been given for grain, came into the hands of Joseph: And he put it in Pharaoh's house. And when all the money in Egypt and Canaan was gone, (1st year) the Egyptians came to Joseph, and said, Give us bread, would you have us come to destruction before your eyes? For we have no more money. And Joseph said, Give me your cattle, I will give you grain in exchange for your cattle if your money is all gone. So they took their cattle to Joseph and he gave them bread in exchange for their horses and flocks and herds and asses, so all that year he gave them food in exchange for their cattle. And when that year was ended, (2nd yr) they came to him in the second year, and said, We may not keep it from our lord's knowledge that all our money is gone, and all the herds of cattle are my lord's, there is nothing more to give my lord but our bodies and our land, Are we to come to destruction before your eyes, we and our land? Take us and our land and give us bread, and we and our land will be servants to Pharaoh, and give us seed so that we may have life and the land may not become waste. (3rd yr) So Joseph got all the land in Egypt for Pharaoh, for every Egyptian gave up his land in exchange for food, because of their great need, so all the land became Pharaoh's. And as for the people, he made servants of them, town by town, from one end of Egypt to the other.

Genesis 47:27 And <u>Israel</u> dwelled in the land of Egypt, in the country of <u>Goshen</u>, גשן and they had possessions therein, and grew, and <u>multiplied</u> exceedingly.

1 KINGS

1 Chronicles 22:14-16 Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD a hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver, and of brass and iron without



weight, for it is in abundance: Timber also and stone have I prepared, and thou mayest add thereto. Moreover, there are workmen with thee in abundance, hewers and workers of stone and timber, and all manner of cunning men for every manner of work. Of the gold, the silver, and the brass, and the iron, there is no number.

- 1 Chronicles 28:11,12 Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlors thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat, And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things.
- 1 Kings 5:13-16 And king Solomon raised a levy out of all Israel, and the levy was thirty thousand men. And he sent them to Lebanon, ten thousand a month by courses: A month they were in Lebanon, and two months at home: And Adoniram was over the levy. And Solomon had threescore and ten thousand that bare burdens, and fourscore thousand hewers in the mountains, Beside the chief of Solomon's officers which were over the work, three thousand and three hundred, which ruled over the people that wrought in the work.
- 1 Kings 6:11-14 And the word of the LORD came to Solomon, saying, Concerning this house which thou art in building, if you will walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them, then will I perform my word with thee, which I spoke unto David thy father: And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will not forsake my people Israel. So, Solomon built the house and finished it.
- 1 Kings 6:37-7:1 In the fourth year was the foundation of the house of the LORD laid, in the month Zif: And in the eleventh year, in the month Bul, which is the eighth month, was the house finished throughout all the parts thereof, and according to all the fashion of it. So was he seven years in building it. But Solomon was building his own house thirteen years, and he finished all his house.



- 1 Kings 7:8 And his house where he dwelt had another court within the porch, which was of the like work. Solomon made also a house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken to wife, like unto this porch.
- 1 Kings 7:13,14 And king Solomon sent and fetched <u>Hiram out of Tyre</u>. He was a widow's son of the tribe of Naphtali, and <u>his father</u> was a man of Tyre, a worker in brass: And he was <u>filled with wisdom</u>, and understanding, and cunning to work all <u>works in brass</u>.

Leviticus 26:19 And I will break the pride of your power, and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass.

Ezekiel 28:12,13 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD, You seal up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty. Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God, every precious stone was thy covering,

- 1 Kings 7:45 And the pots, and the shovels, and the basons: And all these vessels, which Hiram made to king Solomon for the house of the LORD, were of **bright brass**.
- 1 Kings 7:47 And Solomon left all the vessels unweighed, because they were exceeding many: Neither was the weight of the brass found out.
- 1 Kings 8:6-8 And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, into the oracle of the house, to the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims. For the cherubims spread forth their two wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubims covered the ark and the staves thereof above. And they drew out the staves, that the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy place before the oracle, and they were not seen without: And there they are unto this day. 487 years
- 1 Kings 8:9-11 There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt. And it came to pass, when the priests had come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, So that the priests

could not stand to minister because of the cloud: For the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.

- 1 Kings 8:20,21 And the LORD hath performed his word that he spoke, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and I have built a house for the name of the LORD God of Israel. And I have set there a place for the ark, wherein is the covenant of the LORD, which he made with our fathers, when he brought them out of the land of Egypt.
- 1 Kings 8:27 But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain you, how much less this house that I have built?
- 1 Kings 8:43 Hear you in heaven your dwelling place and do according to all that the stranger calleth to you for: That all people of the earth may know your name, to fear you, as do your people Israel, and that they may know that this house, which I have built, is called by your name.
- 1 Kings 8:44 If your people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever you shall send them, and shall pray unto the LORD toward the city which you have chosen, and toward the house that I have built for your name.
- **1Kings 8:48** And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which you gave to their fathers, the city which you have chosen, and the house which **I have built** for thy name.
- 1 Kings 8:63,64 And Solomon offered a sacrifice of peace offerings, which he offered unto the LORD, two and twenty thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep. So, the king and all the children of Israel dedicated the house of the LORD. The same day did the king hallow the middle of the court that was before the house of the LORD: For there he offered burnt offerings, and meat offerings, and the fat of the peace offerings: Because the brazen altar that was before



the LORD <u>was too little</u> to receive the burnt offerings, and meat offerings, and the fat of the peace offerings.

- 1 Kings 9:1,2 And it came to pass, when Solomon had finished the building of the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all Solomon's desire which he was pleased to do, That the LORD appeared to Solomon the second time, as he had appeared unto him at Gibeon.
- 1 Kings 9:4-9 And if you will walk before me, as David your father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded you, and will keep my statutes and my judgments: Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel forever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the throne of Israel. But if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your children, and will not keep my commandments and my statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them: Then will I cut off Israel out of the land which I have given them, and this house, which I have hallowed for my name, will I cast out of my sight, and Israel shall be a proverb and a byword among all people: And at this house, which is high, every one that passes by it shall be astonished, and shall hiss, and they shall say, Why hath the LORD done thus unto this land, and to this house? And they shall answer, Because they forsook the LORD their God, who brought forth their fathers out of the land of Egypt, and have taken hold upon other gods, and have worshipped them, and served them: Therefore hath the LORD brought upon them all this evil.
- 1 Kings 9:10,11 And it came to pass at the end of <u>twenty years</u>, when Solomon had built the two houses, the house of the LORD, and the king's house, (Now Hiram the king of Tyre had furnished Solomon with cedar trees and fir trees, and with gold, according to all his desire,) that then king Solomon gave Hiram twenty cities in the land of Galilee.
- 1 Kings 9:12-14 And Hiram came out from Tyre to see the cities which Solomon had given hi, and they pleased him not. And he said, What cities are these which thou hast given me, my brother? And he called them the land of Cabul unto this day. And Hiram sent to the king sixscore talents of gold.



Judges 1:29 Neither did Ephraim drive out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer, but the Canaanites dwelt in Gezer among them.

- 1 Kings 9:15 And this is the reason of the levy which king Solomon raised, for to build the house of the LORD, and his own house, and Millo, and the wall of Jerusalem, and Hazor, and Megiddo, and Gezer.
- 1 Kings 9:16,17a For Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it for a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife. And Solomon rebuilt Gezer,

Gezer was Canaanite territory

- 2 Chronicles 9:30 And Solomon reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel forty years. And Solomon slept with his fathers, and he was buried in the city of David his father: And Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.
- 1 Kings 14:21 And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam was forty and one years old when he began to reign, Rehoboam was born 1yr before Solomon was king and took on all the wives.
- 1 Kings 14:25-27 And it came to pass in the fifth year of king Rehoboam, that Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem: And he took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, he even took away all: And he took away all the shields of gold which Solomon had made. And king Rehoboam made in their stead brazen shields and committed them unto the hands of the chief of the guard, which kept the door of the king's house.
- 1 Kings 9:19 And all the cities of store that Solomon had, and cities for his chariots, and cities for his horsemen, and that which Solomon desired to build in Jerusalem, and in Lebanon, and in all the land of his dominion.

- 1 Kings 9:20,21 And all the people that were left of the Amorites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites, which were not of the children of Israel, Their children that were left after them in the land, whom the children of Israel also were not able utterly to destroy, upon those did Solomon levy a tribute of bond service unto this day.
- 1 Kings 9:22,23 But of the children of Israel did Solomon make no bondmen: But they were men of war, and his servants, and his princes, and his captains, and rulers of his chariots, and his horsemen. These were the chief of the officers that were over Solomon's work, five hundred and fifty, which bare rule over the people that wrought in the work.
- 1 Kings 9:24 But Pharaoh's daughter came up out of the city of David unto her house which Solomon had built for her: Then did he build Millo.
- 1 Samuel 8:11,12 And he said, This will be the manner of the king that shall reign over you: He will take your sons, and appoint them for himself, for his chariots, and to be his horsemen, and some shall run before his chariots. And he will appoint him captains over thousands, and captains over fifties, and will set them to ear his ground, and to reap his harvest, and to make his instruments of war, and instruments of his chariots.
- 1 Kings 4:31 For he was wiser than all men, than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: And his fame was in all nations round about.
- 1 Kings 10:1,2 Now the queen of Sheba, heard of the fame of Solomon, came to put his wisdom to the test with hard questions. And she came to Jerusalem with a very great train, with camels weighted down with spices, and stores of gold and jewels: And when she came to Solomon, she had talk with him of everything in her mind.
- 1 Kings 10:4,5 And when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's wisdom, and the house that he had built, And the food of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and



<u>their apparel</u>, and his cupbearers, and his ascent by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her.

1 Kings 10:13 And King Solomon gave the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatever she made request for, in addition to what he gave her freely from the impulse of his heart. So she went back to her country, she and her servants.

SOS 4:16-5:1 Awake, O north wind, and come, thou south, blow upon my garden, that the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden and eat his pleasant fruits. I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice, I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey, I have drunk my wine with my milk.

Ezekiel 16:11-21 And I made you fair with ornaments and put jewels on your hands and a chain on your neck. And I put a ring in your nose and earrings in your ears and a beautiful crown on your head. So, you were made beautiful with gold and silver, and your clothing was of the best linen and silk and needlework, your food was the best meal and honey and oil: And you were very beautiful. You were so beautiful that the story of you went out into all nations, you were completely beautiful because of my glory which I had put on you, says the Lord. But you put your faith in the fact that you were beautiful, acting like a loose woman because you were widely talked of, and offering your cheap love to everyone who went by, whoever it might be. And you took your robes and made high places for yourself ornamented with every color, acting like a loose woman on them, without shame or fear. And you took the fair jewels, my silver and gold which I had given to you, and made for yourself male images, acting like a loose woman with them, And you took your robes of needlework for their clothing, and put my oil and my perfume before them. And my bread which I gave you, the best meal and oil and honey which I gave you for your food, you put it before them for a sweet smell, says the Lord. And you took your sons and your daughters whom I had by you, offering even these to them to be their food. Was your loose behavior so small a thing, That you put my children to death and gave them up to go through the fire to them?



- 1 Kings 10:14 Now the weight of gold that came to Solomon in one year was six hundred threescore and six talents of gold.
- 1 Kings 10:24-26 And all the earth sought to Solomon, to hear his wisdom, which God had put in his heart. And they brought every man his present, vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and garments, and armor, and spices, horses, and mules, a rate year by year. And Solomon gathered together chariots and horsemen: And he had a thousand and four hundred chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen, whom he bestowed in the cities for chariots, and with the king at Jerusalem. And the king made silver to be in Jerusalem as stones, and cedars made he to be as the sycamore trees that are in the vale, for abundance.
- 1 Kings 10:28,29 And Solomon had horses brought out of Egypt, and linen yarn: The king's merchants received the linen yarn at a price. And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred shekels of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: And so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring them out by their means.

Deuteronomy 17:16 But he shall not multiply horses to himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt, to the end that he should multiply horses: Forasmuch as the LORD hath said unto you, Ye shall henceforth return no more that way.

1 Samuel 13:5 And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which is on the seashore in multitude
