TORAH PORTION

Exodus 1:1 And these are the names of the sons of Israel who are coming into Egypt with Jacob; a man and his household have they come.

Exodus 1:8,9 Now there arose up a new king over Egypt, which knew not Joseph. And he said unto his people, Behold, the people of the children of Israel are more and mightier than we.

Exodus 1:10,11 Come on, let us deal wisely with them, lest they multiply, and it come to pass, that, when there falls out any war, they join also to our enemies, and fight against us, and so get them up out of the land. Therefore, they did set over them *taskmasters* to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for **Pharaoh** treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

Exodus 1:15,16 And the king of Egypt spoke to the **Hebrew** midwives, of which the name of the one was Shiprah, and the name of the other Puah: And he said, When you do the office of a midwife to the **Hebrew women**, and see them on the stools, if it be a son, then you shall kill him: But if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them but saved the men children alive.

Exodus 1:22 And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, Every son that is born you shall cast into the river, and every daughter you shall save alive.

Exodus 2:1,2 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi. And the woman conceived and bore a son: And when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

Exodus 2:5-10 And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river, and her maidens walked along by the river's side, and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. And when she had opened it, she saw the child: And, behold, the babe

wept. And she had compassion on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. Then said his sister to **Pharaoh's daughter**, Shall I go and call to thee a nurse of the Hebrew women, that she may nurse the child for thee? And **Pharaoh's daughter** said to her, Go. And the maid went and called the child's mother. And **Pharaoh's daughter** said unto her, Take this child away, and nurse it for me, and I will give thee thy wages. And the woman took the child, and nursed it. And the child grew, and she brought him unto **Pharaoh's daughter**, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: And she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

1 Chronicles 4:15a And the sons of Caleb the son of Jephunneh.

1 Chronicles 4:18b And these are the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Exodus 2:11-15 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brothers, and looked on their burdens: And he spied an Egyptian smiting a Hebrew, one of his brothers. And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand. And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: And he said to him that did the wrong, Why smite you your fellow? And he said, Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Intend you to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelled in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

Numbers 16:12,13 And Moses sent to call Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, and they said: We will not come up, is it a small thing that thou hast brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, but thou must needs **make thyself also a prince over us?**

Exodus 2:16-19 Now the priest of Midian had **seven daughters**: And they came and drew water and filled the troughs to water their father's

flock. And the shepherds came and drove them away: But Moses stood up and helped them and watered their flock. And when they came to

Reuel their father, he said, How is it that you are come so soon today? And they said, **An Egyptian** delivered us out of the hand of **the shepherds**, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock.

Exodus 2:23 And it came to pass in process of time, that the **king of Egypt died**: And the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.

Exodus 3:1,2 Now Moses kept the flock of **Jethro** his father in law, the priest of Midian: And he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the middle of a bush: And he looked, and, behold, **the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.**

Deuteronomy 4:24 For the LORD your God is a consuming fire.

Exodus 3:3-6 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. And he said, Draw not nigh hither: Put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon you stand is holy ground. Moreover, he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 3:7 And the **LORD** said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows.

Exodus 3:8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land to a good land and a large, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the

Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

Exodus 3:10 Come now therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh, that you may bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Exodus 32:7 And the LORD said to Moses, Go, get you down, for your people, which you brought out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves.

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against your people, which you have brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 3:11,12 And Moses said to God, אֱלֹהִים Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt? And he said, Certainly I will be אֵלֶיךָ with you; and this shall be a token to you, that I have sent you: When you have brought forth the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.

Exodus 3:13 And Moses said to God, Behold, when I come to the children of Israel, and shall say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they shall say to me, What is his name? What shall I say to them?

Exodus 3:14 And God said to Moses אָהִיה אֲשֶׁר אָהִיה אֱלֹהִים I AM THAT I AM: And he said, Thus shall you say to the children of Israel, I AM אָהִיה has sent me to you.

Isaiah 48:12 Hearken unto Me, O Jacob, and Israel My called: I am He, I am the first, I also am the last. Yea, **My hand** hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **My right hand** hath spread out the heavens, when I call out to them, they stand up together.

John 18:4-6 Yeshua therefore, knowing all the things that were happening to him, went forth, and said to them, Who are you looking for? They answered him, Yeshua of Nazareth. Yeshua said to them, I

am he. Judah also, who betrayed him, was standing with them. When therefore he said to them, **I am He**, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Exodus 3:18 And they will give ear to your voice: And you, with the chiefs of Israel, will go to Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, and say to him, The Lord, the God of the Hebrews, has come to us: (Please) let us then go three days' journey into the waste land to make an offering to the Lord our God.

Exodus 4:2 And the LORD said unto him, What is that in thine hand? And he said, A rod. And he said, Cast it on the ground. **And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent, and Moses fled from before it.**

Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said to Moses, When you go to return into Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in your hand: But I will harden **רָזֶה** his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Exodus 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened **רָזֶה** his heart, and listened not to them, as the LORD had said.

Exodus 4:22,23 And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel is my son, even my firstborn: And I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me: And if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn.

Exodus 5:1 And after that, Moses and Aaron came to Pharaoh, and said, **The Lord, the God of Israel, says, Let my people go so that they may keep a feast to me in the waste land.**

Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said: **Who is the LORD, why should I obey His voice to let Israel go?** I know not the LORD, and moreover I will not let Israel go.

Exodus 5:3 And they said, The God of the Hebrews hath met with us: Let us go, we pray thee, three days journey into the desert, and sacrifice unto the LORD our God, lest he fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword.

1 KINGS 14

1 Kings 14:1,2 At that time Abijah the son of Jeroboam fell sick. And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam, and get thee to Shiloh: Behold, there is **Ahijah the prophet, which told me that I should be king over this people**.

1 Kings 14:4 And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see, for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

1 Kings 14:6 Then Ahijah, hearing the sound of her footsteps coming in at the door, said, Come in, O wife of Jeroboam, why do you make yourself seem like another? for I am sent to you with bitter news.

1 Kings 14:9 But you have done evil more than any before you, and have made for yourself other gods, and images of metal, moving me to wrath, and turning your back on me.

1 Kings 14:11,12 Those of the family of Jeroboam who come to death in the town, will **become food for the dogs, and those on whom death comes in the open country, will be food for the birds of the air**, for the Lord has said it. Up, then! Go back to your house, and in the hour when your feet go into the town, the death of the child will take place.

1 Kings 14:20 And Jeroboam was king for **twenty-two years**, and was put to rest with his fathers, and **Nadab his son** became king in his place.

1 Kings 14:30,31 And there was **war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all their days**. And **Rehoboam slept with his fathers** and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And his **mother's name was Naamah an Ammonitess**. And **Abijam his son** reigned in his stead.

1 Kings 15:1-3 Now in the eighteenth year of **king Jeroboam** the son of Nebat reigned **Abijam** over Judah. Three years reigned he in Jerusalem. **And his mother's name was Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.**

Abishalom. And he walked in all the sins of his father, which he had done before him: And his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as the heart of David his father.

1 Kings 15:7 Now the rest of the acts of **Abijam**, and all that he did, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? **And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.**

1 Kings 15:8-10 And Abijam slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: And **Asa his son reigned** in his stead. And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel **reigned Asa** over Judah. And **forty and one years reigned** he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

1 Kings 15:11-14 And Asa did that which was right in the eyes of the LORD, as did David his father. And he took away the sodomites out of the land and removed all the idols that his fathers had made. And also, Maachah his mother/(grandmother), even her he removed from being queen, because she had made an idol in a grove, and Asa destroyed her idol and burnt it by the brook Kidron. But the high places were not removed: Nevertheless, Asa's heart was perfect with the LORD all his days.

1 Kings 15:25 And **Nadab the son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah and reigned over Israel two years.**

1 Kings 15:27,28 And **Baasha the son of Ahijah**, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him, and **Baasha smote him (Nadab)** at Gibbethon, which belonged to the Philistines, for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon. Even **in the third year of Asa king of Judah did Baasha slay him and reigned in his stead.**

1 Kings 15:29 Even in the third year of Asa king of Judah did Baasha slay him, and reigned in his stead. And it came to pass, when he reigned, that he smote all the house of Jeroboam, he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spoke by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite.

1 Kings 15:16,17 And there was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days. And Baasha king of Israel went up against Judah, and built Ramah, that he might not suffer any to go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

1 Kings 15:18 Then Asa took all the silver and the gold that were left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: And king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus.

1 Kings 15:19,20 saying, There is a league between me and thee, and between my father and thy father: Behold, I have sent unto thee a present of silver and gold, come and break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me. So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel.

1 Kings 15:21,22 And it came to pass, when Baasha heard thereof, that he left off building of Ramah, and dwelt in Tirzah. Then king Asa made a proclamation throughout all Judah, none was exempted: And they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha had built.

1 Kings 16:1-4 Then the word of the LORD came to Jehu the son of Hanani against Baasha, saying, Forasmuch as I exalted thee out of the dust, and made you prince over my people Israel, and thou hast walked in the way of Jeroboam, and hast made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to anger with their sins, Behold, I will take away the posterity of Baasha, and the posterity of his house, and will make thy house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat. Him that dies

of Baasha in the city **shall the dogs eat, and him that dies of his in the fields shall the fowls of the air eat.**

1 Kings 16:8-10 In the twenty and sixth year of Asa king of Judah began Elah the son of Baasha to reign over Israel in Tirzah, two years. And his servant Zimri, captain of half his chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of his house in Tirzah. And Zimri went in and smote him, and killed him, in the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah and reigned in his stead.

1 Kings 16:11,12 And it came to pass, when he began to reign, as soon as he sat on his throne, that **he slew all the house of Baasha**: he left him not one that pisses against a wall, neither of his kinsfolks, nor of his friends. Thus did Zimri destroy all the house of Baasha, **according to the word of the LORD, which he spoke against Baasha by Jehu the prophet,**

1 Kings 16:15-17 In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people were encamped against Gibbethon, which belonged to the Philistines. And the people that were encamped heard say, Zimri hath conspired, and hath also slain the king: Wherefore **all Israel made Omri**, the captain of the host, king over Israel that day in the camp. And Omri went up from Gibbethon, and all Israel with him, and they besieged Tirzah.

1 Kings 16:18 And it came to pass, when Zimri saw that the city was taken, that he went into the palace of the king's house, and **burnt the king's house over him with fire, and died.**

1 Kings 16:21,22 Then were the people of Israel divided into two parts: Half of the people **followed Tibni the son of Ginath, to make him king, and half followed Omri.** But the people that followed Omri prevailed against the people that followed Tibni the son of Ginath: **So Tibni died, and Omri reigned.**

1 Kings 16:23 In the **thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah** began Omri to reign over Israel, **twelve years: Six years reigned he in Tirzah.**

1 Kings 16:25 But **Omri wrought evil** in the eyes of the LORD and did worse than all that were before him.

1 Kings 16:28 So Omri slept with his fathers and was buried in Samaria: And **Ahab** his son reigned in his stead.

1 Kings 16:29,30 And in the **thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah** began **Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel:** And Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria **twenty and two years.** And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD above all that were before him.

1 Kings 16:31-33 And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took **to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians**, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him. And he reared up an altar for Baal in the house of Baal, which he had built in Samaria. And Ahab made a grove, and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him.

1 Kings 11:5 For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians,

1 Kings 16:34 In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: He laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn and set up the gates thereof in his youngest son Segub, according to the word of the LORD, **which he spoke by Joshua the son of Nun.**

Joshua 6:26 And Joshua adjured them at that time, saying, Cursed be the man before the LORD, that rises up and builds this city Jericho: He shall lay the foundation thereof in his firstborn, and in his youngest son shall he set up the gates of it.

1 Kings 17:1 And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

1 Kings 17:8-10 And the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which belongs to Zidon, and dwell there: Behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee. So, he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow woman was there gathering of sticks: And he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, a little water in a vessel, that I may drink.

1 Kings 17:11,12 And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand. And she said, As the LORD your God lives, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: And, behold, I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.

1 Kings 17:14,15 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the LORD sends rain upon the earth. And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: And she, and he, and her house, did eat many days.

1 Kings 17:17,18 And it came to pass after these things, that the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick, and his sickness was so sore, that there was no breath left in him. And she said unto Elijah, What have I to do with you, O you man of God? Art you come unto me to call my sin to remembrance, and to slay my son?

1 Kings 17:22-24 And the LORD heard the voice of Elijah, and the soul of the child came into him again, and he revived. And Elijah took the child and brought him down out of the chamber into the house and delivered him unto his mother: and Elijah said, See, your son lives. And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that you are a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in your mouth is truth.
