TORAH PORTION

Exodus 21:1 Now these are the judgments which you shall set before them.

Genesis 26:5 Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, **my commandments**, my statutes, and my laws.

Deuteronomy 8:1 All the **commandments** which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.

Deuteronomy 8:1 All the **commandment** which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers.

Exodus 21:16 Whoever steals a man and sells him, and anyone found in possession of him, shall be put to death.

Exodus 21:18,19 If, in a fight, one man gives another a blow with a stone, or with the shut hand, not causing his death, but making him keep in bed, If he is able to get up again and go about with a stick, the other will be let off, only **he will have to give him payment for the loss of his time**, and see that he is cared for till he is well.

Exodus 21:33-36 And if a man shall open a pit, or if a man shall dig a pit, and not cover it, and an ox or an ass fall therein, **The owner of the pit shall make it good, and give money to the owner of them**, and the dead beast shall be his. And if one man's ox hurt another's, that he die, then they shall sell the live ox, and divide the money of it, and the dead ox also they shall divide. Or if it be known that the ox has used to push in time past, and his owner has not kept him in, he shall surely pay ox for ox, and the dead shall be his own.

Exodus 22:1 If a man shall steal an ox, or a sheep, and kill it, or sell it, he shall **restore five oxen for an ox, and four sheep for a sheep**.

Exodus 22:2-6 If a thief be found breaking up, and be smitten that he die, there shall no blood be shed for him. If the sun be risen on him, there shall be blood shed for him, for he should **make full restitution**, if he have nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft. If the theft be certainly found in his hand alive, whether it be ox, or ass, or sheep, **he shall restore double**. If a man shall cause a field or vineyard to be eaten, and shall put in his beast, and shall feed in another man's field, of the best of his own field, and of the best of his own vineyard, shall **he make restitution**. If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed therewith, he that kindled the fire **shall surely make restitution**.

Exodus 22:7 If a man delivers to his neighbor money or articles to keep, and it is stolen out of the man's house, if the thief is found, **he shall pay double**.

Ephesians 4:28 Let him that **stole steal no more**: But rather let him labor, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needs.

Luke 19:8 And Zacchaeus stood, and said to the Lord, Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor, and if I have taken anything from any man by false accusation, I restore him **fourfold**.

Exodus 22:14 If a man borrows anything of his neighbor, and it is injured or dies, the owner not being with it, **he shall make full restitution**.

Leviticus 5:4,5 Or if a person swears, speaking thoughtlessly with his lips to do evil or to do good, whatever it is that a man may pronounce by an oath, and he is unaware of it when he realizes it, then he shall be guilty in any of these matters. And it shall be, when he is guilty in any of these matters, that he shall confess that he has sinned in that thing, and he shall bring his trespass offering to the LORD for his sin which he has committed.

Exodus 22:22-24 You shall not afflict any widow, or fatherless child. **If you afflict them in any wise, and they cry at all to me, I will surely**

hear their cry, And my wrath shall wax hot, and I will kill you with the sword, and your wives shall be widows, and your children fatherless.

Exodus 22:26,27 If you at all take your neighbor's raiment to pledge, you shall deliver it to him by that the sun goes down: For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: Wherein shall he sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he cries to me, that I will hear, for **I am gracious**.

Exodus 23:1,2 You shall not spread a false report. Don't join your hand with the wicked to be a malicious witness. **You shall not follow a crowd to do evil**, neither shall you testify in court to side with a multitude to pervert justice.

Exodus 23:7 Keep you far from a false matter.

Exodus 23:8 You shall take no bribe, for a bribe blinds those who have sight and perverts the words of the righteous.

Exodus 23:10,11 And six years you shall sow your land, and shall gather in the fruits thereof: But the seventh year you shall let it rest and lie still, that the poor of your people may eat: And what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat. In like manner you shall deal with your vineyard, and with your olive grove.

Exodus 23:14-17 Three times in the year you shall keep a feast to me. You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread. As I commanded you, you shall eat unleavened bread for seven days at the appointed time in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt. **None shall appear before me empty-handed**. You shall keep the Feast of Harvest, of the first-fruits of your labor, of what you sow in the field. You shall keep the Feast of Ingathering at the end of the year, when you gather in from the field the fruit of your labor. **Three times in the year shall all your males appear before the Lord God**.

Exodus 23:19b You shall not seethe a kid in his mother's milk.

Exodus 23:20,21 Behold, I send an Angel *before you*, to *keep you in “the Way,”* and *to bring you into the place which I have prepared.* Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not, for **He** will not pardon your transgressions: For my name is in him.

Exodus 23:22 But if you carefully obey his voice and do all that I say, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.

Exodus 23:25,27 You shall serve the Lord your God, and **he will bless your** bread and **your** water, and I will take sickness away from among **you**. None shall miscarry or be barren in your land, I will fulfill the number of your days. I will send my terror before you and will throw into confusion all the people against whom you shall come, and I will make all your enemies turn their backs to you.

Exodus 23:31-33 And I will set your border from the Red Sea to **the Sea of the Philistines**, and from the wilderness to the Euphrates, for I will give the inhabitants of the land into your hand, and you shall drive them out before you. You shall make no covenant with them nor with their gods. They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against Me. For if you serve their gods, it will surely be a snare to you.

Exodus 24:1-3 And he said to Moses, Come up to the LORD, you, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship you afar off. And Moses alone shall come near the LORD: But they shall not come near, neither shall the people go up with him. And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: And all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD has said will we do.

Exodus 24:4-8 And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD, and rose up early in the morning, and built an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of Israel. And he sent young men of the children of Israel, which *offered burnt offerings*, and *sacrificed peace offerings* of oxen to the LORD. And Moses took half of the blood, and put it in basins, and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people:

And they said, All that the LORD has said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD has made with you concerning all these words.

Exodus 24:12-14 And the LORD said to Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: And I will give you tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written, that you may teach them. And Moses rose up, and his minister Joshua: And Moses went up into the mount of God. And he said to the elders, Tarry you here for us, until we come again to you: And, behold, Aaron and Hur are with you: If any man have any matters to do, let him come to them.

Exodus 24:16,17 The glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. The seventh day he called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud. The appearance of the glory of the LORD was like devouring fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.

2 KINGS 8

2 Kings 8:1 Then spoke Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: For the LORD hath called for a famine, and it shall also come upon the land seven years.

2 Kings 8:3 And it came to pass at the seven years end, that the woman returned out of the land of the Philistines: And she went forth to cry unto the king for her house and for her land.

2 Kings 8:4,5 And the king talked with Gehazi the servant of the man of God, saying, Tell me, I pray thee, all the great things that Elisha hath done. And it came to pass, as he was telling the king how he had restored a dead body to life, that, behold, the woman, whose son he had restored to life, cried to the king for her house and for her land. And Gehazi said, My lord, O king, this is the woman, and this is her son, whom Elisha restored to life.

2 Kings 8:6,7 And when the king asked the woman, she told him. So the king appointed unto her a certain officer, saying, Restore all that was hers, and all the fruits of the field since the day that she left the land, even until now. And Elisha came to Damascus, and Benhadad the king of Syria was sick, and it was told him, saying, The man of God is come hither.

2 Kings 8:8 And the king said unto Hazael, Take a present in thine hand, and go, meet the man of God, and enquire of the LORD by him, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

2 Kings 8:9,10 So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease? And Elisha said unto him, Go, say unto him, Thou mayest certainly recover howbeit the LORD hath shewed me that he shall surely die.

2 Kings 8:11-13 And he settled his countenance steadfastly, until he was ashamed: And the man of God wept. And Hazael said, Why weep my lord? And he answered, Because I know the evil that thou wilt do unto the children of Israel: Their strong holds wilt thou set on fire, and their young men wilt thou slay with the sword, and wilt dash their children, and rip up their women with child. And Hazael said, But what, is thy servant a dog, that he should do this great thing? And Elisha answered, The LORD hath shewed me that thou shalt be king over Syria.

2 Kings 8:14.15 So he departed from Elisha, and came to his master, who said to him, What said Elisha to thee? And he answered, He told me that thou shouldest surely recover. And it came to pass on the morrow, that he took a thick cloth, and dipped it in water, and spread it on his face, so that he died: and Hazael reigned in his stead.

2 Kings 8:16-18 And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat being then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign. Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem. And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, as did the house of Ahab:

For the daughter of Ahab was his wife: And he did evil in the sight of the LORD.

2 Kings 8:25-27 In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign. Two and twenty years old was Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel. And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as did the house of Ahab: **For he was the son in law of the house of Ahab.**

2 Kings 8:28,29 And he went with Joram the son of Ahab to the war against Hazael king of Syria in Ramothgilead, and the Syrians wounded Joram. And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

2 Kings 9:1-3 And Elisha the prophet called one of the children of the prophets, and said unto him, Gird up thy loins, and take this box of oil in thine hand, and go to Ramothgilead: And when you come here, look for Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi, and go in, and make him arise up from among his brethren, and carry him to an inner chamber, Then take the box of oil, and pour it on his head, and say, Thus saith the LORD, I have anointed thee king over Israel. Then open the door, and flee, and tarry not.

2 Kings 9:4-6 So the young man, even the young man the prophet, went to Ramothgilead. And when he came, behold, the captains of the host were sitting, and he said, I have an errand to thee, O captain. And Jehu said, Unto which of all us? And he said, To thee, O captain. And he arose and went into the house, and he poured the oil on his head, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I have anointed thee king over the people of the LORD, even over Israel.

2 Kings 9:7-10 And you shalt smite the house of Ahab thy master, that I may avenge the blood of my servants the prophets, and the

blood of all the servants of the LORD, at the hand of Jezebel. For the whole house of Ahab shall perish: And I will cut off from Ahab him that pisses against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel: And I will make the **house of Ahab** like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the **house of Baasha** the son of Ahijah: And **the dogs shall eat Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel**, and there shall be none to bury her. And he opened the door, and fled.

2 Kings 9:11 Then Jehu came forth to the servants of his lord: And one said unto him, Is all well? Wherefore came this mad fellow to thee? And he said unto them, Ye know the man, and his communication.

2 Kings 9:12,13 And he said, Thus and thus spoke he to me, saying, **Thus saith the LORD, I have anointed thee king over Israel.** Then they hasted, and took every man his garment, and put it under him on the top of the stairs, and blew with trumpets, saying, Jehu is king.

2 Kings 9:14,15 So Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi conspired against Joram. (Now Joram had kept Ramothgilead, he and all Israel, because of Hazael king of Syria. **But king Joram was returned to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him,** when he fought with Hazael king of Syria.) And Jehu said, If it be your minds, then let none go forth nor escape out of the city to go to tell it in Jezreel.

2 Kings 9:16,17 So Jehu rode in a chariot and went to Jezreel, for Joram lay there. And Ahaziah king of Judah came down to see Joram. And there stood a watchman on the tower in Jezreel, and he spied the company of Jehu as he came, and said, I see a company. And Joram said, Take a horseman, and send to meet them, and let him say, Is it peace?

2 Kings 9:18 So there went one on horseback to meet him, and said, Thus saith the king, Is it peace?

2 Kings 9:20,21 And the watchman told, saying, He came even unto them, and cometh not again: And the driving is like the driving of Jehu the son of Nimshi, for he drives furiously. And Joram said, Make ready. And his chariot was made ready. And **Joram king of Israel** and **Ahaziah**

king of Judah went out, each in his chariot, and they went out against Jehu, and met him in the portion of Naboth the Jezreelite.

1 Kings 21:1 And it came to pass after these things, that Naboth the Jezreelite had a vineyard, which was in Jezreel, hard by the palace of Ahab king of Samaria.

1 Kings 21:19 And thou shalt speak unto him, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Hast thou killed, and also taken possession? And thou shalt speak unto him, saying, Thus saith the LORD, **In the place where dogs licked the blood of Naboth shall dogs lick thy blood, even yours.**

2 Kings 9:22-24 And it came to pass, when Joram saw Jehu, that he said, Is it peace, Jehu? And he answered, What peace, so long as the whoredoms of thy mother Jezebel and her witchcrafts are so many? And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, There is treachery, O Ahaziah. And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and smote Jehoram between his arms, and the arrow went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.

2 Kings 9:25,26 Then said Jehu to Bidkar his captain, Take up, and cast him in the portion of the field of Naboth the Jezreelite: For remember how that, when I and you rode together after Ahab his father, the LORD laid this burden upon him, Surely I have seen yesterday the blood of Naboth, and the blood of his sons, saith the LORD, and I will requite thee in this plat, saith the LORD. Now therefore take and cast him into the plat of ground, according to the word of the LORD.

2 Kings 9:27-29 But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw this, he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. And they did so at the going up to Gur, which is by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo and died there. And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem and buried him in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David. **And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.**

2 Kings 9:30-32 And when Jehu came to Jezreel, Jezebel heard of it, and she painted her face, and tired her head, and looked out at a window. And

as Jehu entered in at the gate, she said, **Had Zimri peace, who slew his master?** And he lifted up his face to the window, and said, Who is on my side? Who? And there looked out to him two or three eunuchs.

2 Kings 9:33-35 And he said, Throw her down. So, they threw her down: And some of her blood was sprinkled on the wall, and on the horses: And he trode her under foot. And when he came in, he did eat and drink, and said, Go, see now this cursed woman, and bury her: For she is a king's daughter. And they went to bury her: But they found no more of her than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of her hands.

2 Kings 9:36 Wherefore they came again and told him. And he said, This is the word of the LORD, which he spoke by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall dogs eat the flesh of Jezebel.

2 Kings 10:1-3 And Ahab had seventy sons in Samaria. And Jehu wrote letters, and sent to Samaria, unto the rulers of Jezreel, to the elders, and to them that brought up Ahab's children, saying, Now as soon as this letter cometh to you, seeing your master's sons are with you, and there are with you chariots and horses, a fenced city also, and armor, Look even out the best and meetest of your master's sons, and set him on his father's throne, and fight for your master's house.

2 Kings 10:4,5 But they were exceedingly afraid, and said, Behold, two kings stood not before him: How then shall we stand? And he that was over the house, and he that was over the city, the elders also, and the bringers up of the children, sent to Jehu, saying, We are thy servants, and will do all that thou shalt bid us, we will not make any king: Do thou that which is good in thine eyes.

2 Kings 10:6,7 Then he wrote a letter the second time to them, saying, If ye be mine, and if ye will hearken unto my voice, take ye the heads of the men your master's sons, and come to me to Jezreel by tomorrow this time. Now the king's sons, being seventy persons, were with the great men of the city, which brought them up. And it came to pass, when the letter came to them, that they took the king's sons, and slew seventy persons, and put their heads in baskets, and sent him them to Jezreel.

2 Kings 10:12-14 And he arose and departed and came to Samaria. And as he was at the shearing house in the way, Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who are ye? And they answered, We are the brethren of Ahaziah, and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen. And he said, Take them alive. And they took them alive and slew them at the pit of the shearing house, even two and forty men, neither left he any of them.

2 Kings 10:15,16 And when he was departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab coming to meet him: And he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart is with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give me thine hand. And he gave him his hand, and he took him up to him into the chariot. And he said, Come with me, and see my zeal for the LORD. So they made him ride in his chariot.

2 Kings 10:18,19a And Jehu gathered all the people together, and said unto them, Ahab served Baal a little, but Jehu shall serve him much. Now therefore call unto me all the prophets of Baal, all his servants, and all his priests, let none be wanting: For I have a great sacrifice to do to Baal, whosoever shall be wanting, he shall not live.

2 Kings 10:23 And Jehu went, and Jehonadab the son of Rechab, into the house of Baal, and said unto the worshippers of Baal, Search, and look that there be here with you none of the servants of the LORD, but the worshippers of Baal only.

2 Kings 10:25-28 And it came to pass, as soon as he had made an end of offering the burnt offering, that Jehu said to the guard and to the captains, Go in, and slay them, let none come forth. And they smote them with the edge of the sword, and the guard and the captains cast them out and went to the city of the house of Baal. And they brought forth the images out of the house of Baal and burned them. And they broke down the image of Baal, and brake down the house of Baal, and made it a draught house unto this day. Thus, Jehu destroyed Baal out of Israel.

2 Kings 10:30,31 And the LORD said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing that which is right in mine eyes, and hast done unto the
