TORAH PORTION

Exodus 27:20,21 And you shall command the children of Israel, that they bring you pure oil olive beaten for the light, to cause the lamp to burn always. In the tabernacle of the congregation without the veil, which is before **the testimony**, **Aaron** and his sons shall order it from **evening to morning** before the LORD: It shall be a statute forever to their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

Exodus 28:1,2 Bring **Aaron** your brother, and his sons with him, near to you from among the children of Israel, that he may minister to me in the priest's office, even **Aaron**, Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar, **Aaron's** sons. You shall make holy garments for **Aaron** your brother, for glory and for beauty.

Deuteronomy 34:5-8 So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: But no man knows of his sepulcher to this day. And Moses was an hundred and twenty years old when he died: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days**: So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:1,2 Now after the death of Moses the servant of the LORD it came to pass, that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you, and all this people, to the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Joshua 1:11 Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals, for within three days you shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God gives you to possess it.

Joshua 4:19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, **I am an hundred and twenty years old this day**, I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD has said to me, You shall not go over this Jordan.

Exodus 32:32 Yet now, if you will forgive their sin, and if not, blot me, I pray, **from your book** which you have written.

Exodus 28:9-12 And you shall take **two onyx stones**, and you shall engrave on them the names of the sons of Israel. Six of their names shall be on one stone, and six of the remaining names on the other stone, **according to their birth**. With the work of an engraver in stone, like the engravings of a signet, you shall engrave the two stones with the names of the sons of Israel. You shall make them to be set in settings of gold. And you shall put the two stones upon the shoulders of the ephod for stones of memorial to the sons of Israel. **And Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD upon his two shoulders for a memorial.**

Exodus 32:21 And Moses said to Aaron, What did the people do to you that you let this great sin come on them? And Aaron said, Let not my lord be angry, you have seen how the purposes of this people are evil.

1 Samuel 15:24 And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: For I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: Because **I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.**

Exodus 28:15 You shall make a breastplate of judgment, the work of the skillful workman, like the work of the ephod you shall make it, of gold, of blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen, you shall make it.

Exodus 28:21 The stones shall be according to **the names of the children of Israel**, twelve, according to their names, like the engravings of a signet, everyone according to his name, they shall be for the twelve tribes.

Exodus 28:28,29 They shall bind the **breastplate** by means of its rings to the rings of the ephod, using a blue cord, so that it is above the

intricately woven band of the ephod, and so that the **breastplate** does not come loose from the ephod. So Aaron shall bear the names of the sons of Israel on the **breastplate of judgment over his heart**, when he goes into the holy place, as a memorial before the LORD **continually**.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the **breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation**.

Isaiah 59:17 For He put on **righteousness as a breastplate, And a helmet of salvation on His head**, He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, And was clad with zeal as a cloak.

Ephesians 6:13-17 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the **breastplate** of righteousness, and having shod your **feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace**, above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the **helmet of salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Exodus 29:19,20 You shall take the other ram, and Aaron and his sons shall lay their hands on the head of the ram, and you shall kill the ram and take part of its blood and put it on the tip of the right ear of Aaron and on the tips of the right ears of his sons, and on the thumbs of their right hands and on the great toes of their right feet, and throw the rest of the blood against the sides of the altar.

Exodus 29:38,39 Now this is that which you shall **offer on the altar**, two lambs of the first year **day by day continually**. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning; and the other lamb you shall offer at even.

Exodus 29:42-46 This shall be a **continual burnt offering** throughout your generations at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD: **Where I will meet you, to speak there to you**. And **there I will meet** with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be

sanctified by my glory. And **I will sanctify** the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar: **I will sanctify** also both Aaron and his sons, to minister to me in the priest's office. And **I will dwell** among the children of Israel, and will be their God. And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.

Exodus 30:7,8 And **Aaron** shall burn thereon **sweet incense every morning**: When he dresses the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. And when **Aaron** lights the lamps at even, he shall burn incense on it **a perpetual incense** before the LORD throughout your generations.

Leviticus 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts (**Meeting times**) of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.
(**Meeting times**)

Leviticus 23:4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. (**times**)

Exodus 30:10 Aaron shall make atonement on its horns once a year. With the blood of the sin offering of atonement he shall make atonement for it once in the year throughout your generations. It is most holy to the Lord.

Exodus 30:11-16 The Lord said to Moses, When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the Lord when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **Half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as an offering to the Lord. Everyone who is numbered in the census, from twenty years old and upward, shall give the Lord's offering. The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less, than the half shekel, when you give the Lord's offering to make atonement for your lives. **You shall take the atonement money from the people of Israel and shall give it for the service of the tent of meeting**, that it may bring the people of Israel to remembrance before the Lord, so as to make atonement for your lives.

Matthew 17:24 When they had come to Capernaum, those who received the temple tax came to Peter and said, Does your Teacher not pay the temple tax?

2 KINGS 11-14

2 Kings 11:1 And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

2 Kings 11:2 But Jehosheba, the **daughter of king Joram**, sister of Ahaziah, took **Joash the son of Ahaziah**, and stole him from among the king's sons which were slain, and they hid him, even him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

2 Kings 11:3 And he was with her hid in the house of the LORD six years. And Athaliah did reign over the land.

2 Kings 11:4 And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD and shewed them the king's son.

2 Kings 11:5 And he commanded them, saying, This is the thing that ye shall do, A third part of you that enter in on the sabbath shall even be keepers of the watch of the king's house.

2 Kings 11:7,8 And two parts of all you that go forth on the sabbath, even they shall keep the watch of the house of the LORD about the king. And ye shall compass the king round about, every man with his weapons in his hand: And he that cometh within the ranges, let him be slain and be ye with the king as he goeth out and as he cometh in.

2 Kings 11:10-12 And to the captains over hundreds did the priest give king David's spears and shields, that were in the temple of the LORD. And the guard stood, every man with his weapons in his hand, round about the king, from the right corner of the temple to the left corner of the temple, along by the altar and the temple. And he brought forth the

king's son, and put the crown upon him, and gave him the testimony, and they made him king and anointed him; and they clapped their hands, and said, God save the king.

2 Kings 11:13,14 And when Athaliah heard the noise of the guard and of the people, she came to the people into the temple of the LORD. And when she looked, behold, the king stood by a pillar, as the manner was, and the princes and the trumpeters by the king, and all the people of the land rejoiced, and blew with trumpets: And Athaliah rent her clothes, and cried, Treason, Treason.

2 Kings 11:15,16 But Jehoiada the priest commanded the captains of the hundreds, the officers of the host, and said unto them, Have her forth without the ranges: And him that follows her kill with the sword. For the priest had said, Let her not be slain in the house of the LORD. And they laid hands on her, and she went by the way by the which the horses came into the king's house: And there was she slain.

2 Kings 11:17,18 And Jehoiada made a covenant between the LORD and the king and the people, that they should be the LORD's people, between the king also and the people. And all the people of the land went into the house of Baal and broke it down, his altars and his images brake they in pieces thoroughly and slew Mattan the priest of Baal before the altars. And the priest appointed officers over the house of the LORD.

2 Kings 11:20,21 And all the people of the land rejoiced, and the city was in quiet: And **they slew Athaliah** with the sword beside the king's house. **Seven years old** was Jehoash when he began to reign.

2 Kings 12:1 In the seventh year of Jehu, **Jehoash** began to reign, and **forty years reigned he in Jerusalem**. And his mother's name was **Zibiah of Beersheba**. And Jehoash did that which was right in the sight of the LORD all his days wherein **Jehoiada the priest** instructed him. But the high places were not taken away: the people still sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places.

2 Kings 12:5,6 Let the priests take it to them, every man of his acquaintance: And let them **repair the breaches** of the house,

wheresoever any breach shall be found. But it was so, that in the **three and twentieth year of king Jehoshaphat the priests had not repaired the breaches of the house.**

2 Kings 12:7,8 Then king Jehoshaphat called for Jehoiada the priest, and the other priests, and said unto them, Why repair ye not the breaches of the house? Now therefore receive no more money of your acquaintance but deliver it for the breaches of the house. **And the priests consented to receive no more money of the people, neither to repair the breaches of the house.**

2 Kings 12:9-12 But Jehoiada the priest took a chest, and bored a hole in the lid of it, and set it beside the altar, on the right side as one cometh into the house of the LORD: And the priests that kept the door put therein all the money that was brought into the house of the LORD. And it was so, when they saw that there was much money in the chest, that the king's scribe and the high priest came up, and they put up in bags, and told the money that was found in the house of the LORD. And they gave the money, being told, into the hands of them that did the work, that had the oversight of the house of the LORD: And they laid it out to the carpenters and builders, that wrought upon the house of the LORD, And to masons, and hewers of stone, and to buy timber and hewed stone to repair the breaches of the house of the LORD, and for all that was laid out for the house to repair it.

2 Kings 12:17,18 Then Hazael king of Syria went up, and fought against Gath, and took it: And Hazael set his face to go up to Jerusalem. And **Jehoshaphat king of Judah** took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold that was found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent it to Hazael king of Syria: And he went away from Jerusalem.

2 Kings 12:20,21 And his servants arose, and made a conspiracy, **and slew Joash** in the house of Millo, which goeth down to Silla. For Jozabab the son of Shimeath, and Jehozabab the son of Shomer, his servants, smote him, and he died, and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: And **Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.**

2 Kings 13:1,2 In the **three and twentieth year of Joash** the son of Ahaziah king of Judah **Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel** in Samaria and reigned seventeen years. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD and followed the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which made Israel to sin; he departed not therefrom.

2 Kings 13:3 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all their days.

2 Kings 13:9,10 And **Jehoahaz** slept with his fathers, and they **buried him in Samaria**: And **Joash** his son reigned in his stead. In the **thirty and seventh year of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz** to reign over Israel in Samaria and reigned **sixteen years**.

2 Kings 13:12,13 And the rest of the acts of Joash, and all that he did, and his might wherewith he fought against Amaziah king of Judah, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel? And Joash slept with his fathers, and Jeroboam sat upon his throne: And Joash was **buried in Samaria** with the kings of Israel.

2 Kings 13:14 Now Elisha was fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.

2 Kings 13:15-17 And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows. And he said to the king of Israel, Put thine hand upon the bow. And he put his hand upon it: And Elisha put his hands upon the king's hands. And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened it. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD's deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: For thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed them.

2 Kings 13:18,19 And he said, Take the arrows. And he took them. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice and stayed. And the man of God was wroth with him, and said,

Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times, then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed it: Whereas now thou shalt smite Syria but thrice.

2 Kings 13:20,21 And Elisha died, and they buried him. And the bands of the Moabites invaded the land at the coming in of the year. And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men, and they cast the man into the sepulcher of Elisha: And when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

2 Kings 13:24,25 So Hazael king of Syria died, and Benhadad his son reigned in his stead. And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash beat him and recovered the cities of Israel.

2 Kings 14:1,2 In the **second year of Joash, son of Jehoahaz king of Israel** reigned **Amaziah the son of Joash** king of Judah. He was twenty and five years old when he began to reign and **reigned twenty and nine years** in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

2 Kings 14:5,6 And it came to pass, as soon as the kingdom was confirmed in his hand, that he slew his servants which had slain the king his father. But the children of the murderers he slew not: according unto that which is written in the book of the law of Moses, wherein the LORD commanded, saying, The fathers shall not be put to death for the children, nor the children be put to death for the fathers; but every man shall be put to death for his own sin.

2 Kings 14:8 Then Amaziah sent messengers to Jehoash, the son of Jehoahaz son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us look one another in the face.

2 Kings 14:12-14 And Judah was put to the worse before Israel, and they fled every man to their tents. And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Beth Shemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem

from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits. And he took all the gold and silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and hostages, and returned to Samaria.

2 Kings 14:15-17 Now the rest of the acts of Jehoash which he did, and his might, and how he fought with Amaziah king of Judah, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel? And Jehoash slept with his fathers and was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel, and **Jeroboam his son** reigned in his stead. And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

2 Kings 14:19-21 Now they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem: And he fled to Lachish, but they sent after him to Lachish and slew him there. And they brought him on horses: And he was buried at Jerusalem with his fathers in the city of David. And all the people of Judah took Azariah, which was sixteen years old, and made him king instead of his father Amaziah.

2 Kings 14:23,24 In the **fifteenth year of Amaziah** the son of Joash king of Judah **Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel** began to reign in Samaria and reigned forty and one years. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD: He departed not from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

2 Kings 14:25 He restored the coast of Israel from the entering of Hamath unto the sea of the plain, according to the word of the LORD God of Israel, which he spoke by the hand of his servant **Jonah, the son of Amittai, the prophet**, which was of Gath Hopher.

2 Kings 14:27 And the LORD said not that he would blot out the name of Israel from under heaven: But he saved them by the hand of Jeroboam the son of Joash.

2 Kings 14:29 And Jeroboam slept with his fathers, even with the **kings of Israel, and Zachariah his son reigned in his stead.**
