TORAH PORTION

Exodus 30:11-13a The LORD said to Moses, **When you take** the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his life to the LORD **when you number them**, that there be no plague among them **when you number them**. Each one who is numbered in the census shall give this: **Half a shekel** according to the shekel of the sanctuary.

Exodus 30:15,16 The rich is not to give more or the poor less than the **half-shekel** when giving Adonai's offering **to atone for your lives**. You are to take the atonement money from the people of Israel and use it **for the service in the tent of meeting**, so that it will be a reminder of the people of Israel before Adonai **to atone for your lives**.

Proverbs 10:2 Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, but **righteousness** **מִתְּרַצָּן delivers from death**.

Acts 3:13-15 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his Servant Yeshua, whom you delivered up, and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had determined to release him. But you denied the **Holy and Righteous One**, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and **killed the Prince of life**, whom God raised from the dead, to which we are witnesses.

Ezekiel 33:12-16 Therefore you, O son of man, say to the children of your people: The righteousness of the righteous man shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression, as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall because of it in the day that he turns from his wickedness, nor shall the righteous be able to live because of his righteousness in the day that he sins. When I say to the righteous that he shall surely live, **but he trusts in his own righteousness** and commits iniquity, none of his righteous works shall be remembered, but because of the iniquity that he has committed, he shall die. Again, when I say to the wicked, You shall surely die, if he turns from his sin and does what is lawful and right, if the wicked restores the pledge, gives back what he has stolen, and walks in the statutes of life without

committing iniquity, he shall surely live, he shall not die. None of his sins which he has committed shall be remembered against him, he has done what is lawful and right, he shall surely live.

Exodus 31:1-5 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, See, I have called by name **Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah:** And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship, To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, And in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship.

Exodus 31:13,14a Tell the people of Israel, You are to observe My Shabbats, for this is a sign between me and you through all your generations, so that you will know that I am Adonai, who sets you apart for me. Therefore you are to keep My Shabbat, because it is set apart for you.

Exodus 31:16,17 The people of Israel are to keep the Shabbat, to observe Shabbat through all their generations as a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the people of Israel **forever**, for in six days Adonai made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day he stopped working and rested.

Exodus 31:18 When he had finished speaking with Moshe on Mount Sinai, Adonai gave him the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone **inscribed by the finger of God**.

Exodus 32:1-3 When the people saw that Moshe was taking a long time to come down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said to him, Get busy, and make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, **the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt** we don't know what has become of him. Aaron said to them, Have your wives, sons and daughters strip off their gold earrings, and bring them to me. The people stripped off their gold earrings and brought them to Aaron.

Exodus 32:4 He received what they gave him, **melted it down**, and **made it into the shape of a calf**. They said, Israel! Here is your god, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:7,8 Adonai said to Moshe, Go down! Hurry! **Your people, whom you brought up** from the land of Egypt, have become corrupt! So quickly they have turned aside from the way I ordered them to follow! They **have cast a metal statue** of a calf, **worshipped it, sacrificed to it** and said, Israel! Here is your god, who brought you up from the land of Egypt!

Exodus 32:9,10 Adonai continued speaking to Moshe: I have been watching these people, and you can see how stiff-necked they are. Now leave me alone, so that my anger can blaze against them, and I can put an end to them! **I will make a great nation out of you instead.**

Exodus 32:11 And Moses sought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why does your wrath wax hot against **your people,** which **you have brought forth** out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Exodus 32:12 Why should **the Egyptians speak,** and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against your people.

Exodus 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: The tables were written on both their sides, on the one side and on the other were they written.

Exodus 32:21-24 Moshe said to Aaron, What did these people do to you to make you lead them into such a terrible sin? Aaron replied, My lord shouldn't be so angry. You know what these people are like, that they are determined to do evil. So they said to me, Make us gods to go ahead of us, because this Moshe, the man that brought us up from the land of Egypt we don't know what has become of him. I answered them, Anyone with gold, strip it off! So they gave it to me. **I threw it in the fire, and out came this calf!**

Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the entrance of the camp, and said, Whoever is on the LORD's side come to me! And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together to him.

Exodus 32:28 And the sons of Levi did according to the word of Moses. And that day about **three thousand men** of the people fell.

Deuteronomy 9:19,20 For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure with which the LORD was angry with you, to destroy you. But the LORD listened to me at that time also. And the LORD was very angry with Aaron and would have destroyed him, so I prayed for Aaron also at the same time.

Exodus 32:30-32 And it came to pass on the morrow, that Moses said to the people, you have sinned a great sin: And now I will go up to the LORD, peradventure **I shall make an atonement** for your sin. And Moses returned to the LORD, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin, and have made them gods of gold. Yet now, if you will **forgive their sin**, and if not, **blot me, I pray you, out of your book which you have written.**

Exodus 33:2,3 I will send an angel before you, and I will drive out the Canaanite, the Amorite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite: To a land flowing with milk and honey: For I will not go up in the midst of you, for you are a stiff-necked people, lest I consume you in the way.

Exodus 33:12,13 Moshe said to Adonai, Look, you say to me, Make these people **move on!** But you haven't let me know whom you will be sending with me. Nevertheless you have said, I know you by name, and also, You have found favor in my sight. Now, please, if it is really the case that I have found favor in your sight, show me your ways, so that I will understand you and continue finding favor in your sight. Moreover, keep on seeing this nation **as your people**.

Exodus 33:14-16 He said, My presence will go with you, and I will give **you rest**. He said to him, If your presence doesn't go with me, don't carry us up from here. For how would people know that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people? Isn't it in that you go with us, so that we are separated, **I and your people**, from all the people who are on the surface of the earth?

Exodus 33:18-20 He said, Please **show me your glory**. He said, I will make all my **goodness** pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be **gracious** and will **show mercy on whom I will show mercy**. He said, You cannot see my face, for man may not see me and live.

Exodus 34:4,5 He chiseled two tablets of stone like the first, and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up to Mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand two stone tablets. The **LORD descended** in the cloud, and **stood with him** there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD.

Exodus 34:6-8 And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and Gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness and Truth, Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, **to the third and to the fourth generation**. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

14. And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for **appointed times**, and for **specific days**, and **particular years**;

Exodus 23:10 And six years thou shalt sow thy land, and shalt gather in the fruits thereof: But the seventh year thou shalt let it rest and lie still, that the poor of thy people may eat: And what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat.

Leviticus 25:4 But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land, a sabbath for the LORD: Thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

Leviticus 26:33-35 And I will scatter you among the heathen and will draw out a sword after you: And your land shall be desolate, and your cities waste. Then shall the land enjoy her sabbaths, as long as it lies desolate, and ye be in your enemies' land, even then shall the land rest and enjoy her sabbaths. As long as it lies desolate it shall rest, because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.

Deuteronomy 15:1,2 At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lends ought unto his neighbor shall release it, he shall not exact it of his neighbor, or of his brother, because it is called the LORD's release.

Deuteronomy 31:10,11 And Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

2 Chronicles 36:21 To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: For as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

Daniel 9:2 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

Jeremiah 34:13-16 Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, I made a covenant with your fathers in the day that I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondmen, saying, **At the end of seven years** let ye go every man his brother an Hebrew, which hath been sold to you, and when he has served you six years, you shall let him go free from you: But your fathers hearkened not unto me, neither inclined their ear. And you were now turned, and had done right in my sight, in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbor, and you had made a covenant before me in the house which is called by my name: But you turned and polluted my name, and caused every man his servant, and every man his handmaid, whom you had set at liberty at their

pleasure, to return, and brought them into subjection, to be unto you for servants and for handmaids.

Daniel 9:24a Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins.

Daniel 9:25a Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be **seven weeks**, and **threescore and two weeks**.

Daniel 9:27a And he shall **confirm the covenant with many for one week**: And in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate.

Revelation 11:2,3 But the court which is without the temple leave out and measure it not, for it is given unto the Gentiles: And the holy city shall they tread under foot **forty and two months**. And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth**.

Revelation 11:5,6 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceeds out of their mouth, and devours their enemies: And if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: And have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Revelation 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Revelation 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Revelation 11:11,12 And after three days and a half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet, and great fear fell upon them which saw them. And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them,

Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies beheld them.

Revelation 11:18,19 And the nations were angry, and your wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great, and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: And there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Revelation 12:1,2 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

Revelation 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there **a thousand two hundred and threescore days.**

Revelation 12:14 And to the woman were given **two wings of a great eagle**, that she **might fly into the wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for **a time, and times, and half a time**, from the face of the serpent.

Deuteronomy 32:10,11 He found him in a desert land and **in the waste howling wilderness**, he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye. **As an eagle stirs up her nest**, flutters over her young, spreads abroad her wings, taketh them, bears them on her wings.

Ezekiel 20:34-37 And I will bring you out from the people and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out. And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will **I plead with you face to face**. Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, saith the Lord GOD. And I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant.

Revelation 13:4,5 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: And they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? Who is able to make war with him? And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

Hosea 5:14,15 For I will be unto Ephraim as a lion, and as a young lion to the house of Judah: I, even I, will tear and go away, I will take away, and none shall rescue him. I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: In their affliction they will seek me early.

Hosea 6:1,2 Come and let us return unto the LORD: For he hath torn, and he will heal us, he hath smitten, and he will bind us up. After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

Matthew 20:19 And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify him: And the third day he shall rise again.

Psalms 102:16-18a When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory. He will regard the prayer of the destitute and not despise their prayer. This shall be written for the generation to come.

Psalms 90:10 The days of our years are threescore years and ten, and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years.

Daniel 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a **time and times and the dividing of time.**

Daniel 12:6,7 How long shall it be to the end of these wonders? And I heard the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, **when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and swore by him that liveth forever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half;**

Revelation 10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth **lifted up his hand to heaven, And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever,** who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth,

and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that **there should be time no longer:**

Daniel 12:10 Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but **the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.**

Exodus 12;1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, **This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.**

Daniel 12:11,12 And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, **there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days.** Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the **thousand three hundred and five and thirty days.**
