TORAH PORTION

Exodus 35:1 And Moses **assembled** all the congregation of the children of Israel, and said to them, These are the words which **the LORD has commanded**, that you should do them.

Hebrews 10:24,25 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, **not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together**, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Exodus 35:2a Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be a holy day for you, a **Sabbath of solemn rest** to the LORD.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah is the goal of the Torah unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

Exodus 35:4,5 Moses said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, This is the thing that **the Lord has commanded**. Take from among you a contribution to the Lord. **Whoever is of a generous heart**, let him bring the Lord's contribution: Gold, silver, and bronze.

Exodus 35:10 And every **wise hearted** among you shall come, and make all that **the LORD hath commanded**.

Exodus 35:20-22 And all the congregation of the children of Israel **departed from the presence of Moses**. And they came, everyone whose heart stirred him up, and everyone whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD's offering **to the work** of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. And they came, both men and women, as many as were **willing hearted**, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: And every man that offered, offered an offering of gold to the LORD.

Exodus 35:25,26 And all the women that were wise hearted did spin with their hands, And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' hair.

Exodus 35:29 All the men and women, the people of Israel, whose **heart** moved them to bring anything **for the work that the Lord had commanded** by Moses to be done brought it as a freewill offering to the Lord.

Exodus 35:30,31 And Moses said to the children of Israel, See, the LORD has called by name Bezaleel the **son of Uri**, the **son of Hur**, of the tribe of **Judah**, And he has filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of **workmanship**.

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our **image**, after our **likeness**.

Genesis 1:27 God created man in his own image. In God's image צלם he created him, male and female he created them.

Psalms 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

Colossians 2:16,17 Let no one therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a **feast day** or a **new moon** or a **Sabbath day**, which are a **shadow** of the things to come, **but** the body is Messiah's.

John 1:9 That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

(KJV) **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth.

(TS1998) **Romans 10:4** For Messiah is the goal of the 'Torah unto righteousness' to everyone who believes.

Exodus 35:34,35a And he has put in his heart that he may teach, both he, and **Aholiab**, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. Them has he filled with **wisdom of heart**, to work all manner of work,

Exodus 36:1,2 Then worked Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. And Moses called **Bezaleel and Aholiab**, and every wise hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put wisdom, even everyone whose heart stirred him up to come to the work to do it.

Exodus 36:5-8 And they spoke to Moses, saying, The people bring much more than enough for the service of the work, which the LORD commanded to make. And Moses gave commandment, and they caused it to be proclaimed throughout the camp, saying, Let neither man nor woman make any more work for the offering of the sanctuary. So, **the people were restrained from bringing**. For the stuff they had was sufficient for all the work to make it, and too much. And every wise hearted man among them that worked the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen,

Exodus 37:3-5 And he cast for it four rings of gold, to be set by the four corners of it, even two rings **upon the one side of it, and two rings upon the other side** of it. And he made staves of shittim wood, and overlaid them with gold. And he put the **staves into the rings by the sides of the ark**, to bear the ark.

1 Kings 8:6,7 Then the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim. For the cherubim spread their two wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubim overshadowed the ark and its poles.

1 Kings 8:8 And they drew out the staves, that **the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy place** before the oracle, and they were not seen without: and there they are unto this day.

Exodus 38:8 And he made the laver of brass, and the foot of it of brass, of the looking glasses of the women assembling, which assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

Exodus 38:25,26 The silver of those who were numbered of the congregation was one hundred talents, and one thousand seven hundred seventy-five shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary: **A beka** בקע **a head** גלגל, that is, half a shekel, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for every one that passed over to them that were numbered, from twenty years old and upward, for six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty men.

Mark 15:22 And they bring him to the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.

Genesis 24:22 And it came to pass, as the camels had done drinking, that the man took a golden earring of half a shekel בקע weight, and two bracelets for her hands of ten shekels weight of gold.

2 KINGS 15

2 Chronicles 25:27 Now after the time that **Amaziah** did turn away from following the LORD they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem, and he fled to Lachish: But they sent to Lachish after him and **slew him** there. And they brought him upon horses and buried him with his fathers in the city of Judah.

2 Kings 15:1,2 In the **twenty and seventh year of Jeroboam** king of Israel began Azariah (**Uzziah**) son of Amaziah king of Judah to reign. **Sixteen years** old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned **two and fifty years** in Jerusalem.

2 Kings 15:3-5a And he did that which was right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah had done, Save that the high places were not removed: The people sacrificed and burnt incense still on the high places. And **the LORD smote the king, so that he was a leper unto the day of his death** and dwelt in a several house.

2 Chronicles 26:8,9 And the Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: And his name spread abroad even to the entering in of Egypt, for he **strengthened himself exceedingly**. Moreover, Uzziah built towers in Jerusalem at the corner gate, and at the valley gate, and at the turning of the wall, and **fortified them**.

2 Chronicles 26:11a Moreover, Uzziah had a **host of fighting men**, that went out to war by bands,

2 Chronicles 26:14 And Uzziah prepared for them throughout all the host shields, and spears, and helmets, and habergeons, and bows, and **slings to cast stones**.

2 Chronicles 26:15 And he made in Jerusalem **engines, invented by cunning men**, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, **to shoot arrows and great stones withal**. And his **name spread far abroad, for he was marvelously helped, till he was strong**.

2 Chronicles 26:16,17 But when he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: For he transgressed against the LORD his God and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incense. And Azariah the priest went in after him, and with him fourscore priests of the LORD, that were valiant men.

2 Chronicles 26:18-20 And they withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, It appertains not to you, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: Go out of the sanctuary, for thou hast trespassed, neither shall it be for thine honor from the LORD God. Then Uzziah was furious and had a censer in his hand to **burn incense**: and while he was furious with the priests, the **leprosy even rose up in his forehead** before the priests in the house of the LORD, from beside the incense altar.

2 Kings 15:8,9 In the **thirty and eighth year of Azariah** king of Judah did **Zachariah the son of Jeroboam reign over Israel in Samaria six months**. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, as his fathers had done: He **departed not from the sins of Jeroboam** the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

2 Kings 15:10 And **Shallum** the son of Jabesh conspired against him, and smote him before the people, **and slew him**, and reigned in his stead.

2 Kings 15:13 Shallum the son of Jabesh began to reign in the **nine and thirtieth year of Uzziah king of Judah; and he reigned a full month** in Samaria.

2 Kings 15:14 For **Menahem** the son of Gadi went up from Tirzah, and came to Samaria, and **smote Shallum** the son of Jabesh in Samaria, **and slew him**, and reigned in his stead.

2 Kings 15:16-18 Then Menahem smote Tiphseh, and all that were therein, and the coasts thereof from Tirzah: Because they opened not to him, therefore he smote it, and **all the women therein that were with child he ripped up**. In the **nine and thirtieth year of Azariah king of Judah began Menahem the son of Gadi to reign over Israel, and reigned ten years** in Samaria. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, **he departed not all his days from the sins of Jeroboam** the son of Nebat,

2 Kings 15:19,20 And Pul the king of Assyria came against the land: And Menahem gave Pul a thousand talents of silver, that his hand might be with him to confirm the kingdom in his hand. And Menahem exacted the money of Israel, even of all the mighty men of wealth, of each man fifty shekels of silver, to give to the king of Assyria. So the king of Assyria turned back and stayed not there in the land.

2 Chronicles 26:21 And Uzziah the king was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house, being a leper, for he was cut off from the house of the LORD: And **Jotham his son** was over the king's house, judging the people of the land.

2 Kings 15:22-24 And Menahem slept with his fathers, and Pekahiah his son reigned in his stead. In the fiftieth year of Azariah king of Judah Pekahiah the son of Menahem began to reign over Israel in Samaria and reigned two years. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

2 Kings 15:5b-7 And **Jotham** the king's son was over the house, judging the people of the land. And the rest of the acts of Azariah, and all that he did, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? So Azariah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: And Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

2 Kings 15:25 But **Pekah** the son of Remaliah, a captain of his, conspired against him, and **smote him** in Samaria, in the palace of the king's house, with Argob and Arieah, and with him fifty men of the Gileadites: And he killed him, and reigned in his room.

2 Kings 15:27,28 In the **two and fiftieth year of Azariah** king of Judah Pekah the son of Remaliah began to reign over Israel in Samaria and **reigned twenty years**. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD: **He departed not from the sins of Jeroboam** the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

2 Kings 15:29 In the days of **Pekah king of Israel** came **Tiglathpileser king of Assyria**, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, **and carried them captive to Assyria**.

2 Kings 15:30 And **Hoshea the son of Elah** made a conspiracy against **Pekah the son of Remaliah, and smote him, and slew him**, and reigned in his stead, in the **twentieth year of Jotham the son of Uzziah**.

2 Kings 15:32,33a In the second year of Pekah the son of Remaliah king of Israel began **Jotham the son of Uzziah** king of Judah to reign. Five and twenty years old was he when he began to reign, and he **reigned sixteen years** in Jerusalem.

2 Kings 15:38 And Jotham slept with his fathers and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: And **Ahaz his son reigned in his stead**.

2 Kings 16:1,2 In the **seventeenth year of Pekah** the son of Remaliah **Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign**. **Twenty years old was Ahaz** when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in

Jerusalem, and **did not that which was right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.**

2 Kings 16:3,4 But he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, yea, and **made his son to pass through the fire**, according to the abominations of the heathen, whom the LORD cast out from before the children of Israel. And he sacrificed and burnt incense in the high places, and on the hills, and under every green tree.

2 Kings 16:5 Then **Rezin king of Aram and Pekah** son of Remaliah king of Israel **came up to Jerusalem to war**, and they besieged Ahaz but could not overcome him.

2 Kings 16:7,8 So Ahaz sent messengers to **Tiglath-pileser king of Assyria**, saying: I am thy servant and thy son; come up, and **save me out of the hand of the king of Aram, and out of the hand of the king of Israel**, who rise up against me. And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent it for a present to the king of Assyria.

2 Chronicles 28:5,6 Wherefore the LORD his God delivered him into the hand of the king of Aram, and they smote him, and carried away of his a great multitude of captives, and brought them to Damascus. And he was also delivered into the hand of the king of Israel, who smote him with a great slaughter. For Pekah the son of Remaliah slew in Judah a hundred and twenty thousand in one day, all of them valiant men, because they had forsaken the LORD, the God of their fathers.

2 Chronicles 28:16 At that time did king Ahaz send unto the kings of Assyria to help him.

2 Kings 16:10-12 And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglath-pileser king of Assyria and saw the altar that was at Damascus, and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof. **And Urijah the priest built an altar, according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus**, so did Urijah the priest make it against the coming of king Ahaz from

Damascus. And when the king came from Damascus, the king saw the altar, and the king drew near unto the altar and offered thereon.

2 Chronicles 28:20-22 And Tiglath-pileser, king of Assyria came unto him, **and distressed him, but strengthened him not.** For Ahaz stripped the house of the LORD, and the house of the king and the princes, and gave thereof unto the king of Assyria, **but it helped him not.** And in the **time of his distress did he act even more treacherously against the LORD, this same king Ahaz.** For he sacrificed unto the gods of Damascus, which smote him, and he said: Because the gods of the kings of Aram helped them, therefore will I sacrifice to them, that they may help me.' But they were the ruin of him, and of all Israel.

2 Kings 16:20 And Ahaz slept with his fathers and was buried with his fathers in the city of David, and **Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.**

2 Kings 17:1-6 In the **twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel and reigned nine years.** And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, yet not as the kings of Israel that were before him. Against him came up **Shalmaneser king of Assyria**, and Hoshea became his servant and brought him presents. And the king of Assyria found conspiracy in Hoshea, for he had sent messengers to So king of Egypt, and offered no present to the king of Assyria, as he had done year by year, therefore, the king of Assyria shut him up, and bound him in prison. Then the king of Assyria came up throughout all the land, and went up to Samaria, and besieged it three years. **In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria took Samaria, and carried Israel away unto Assyria,**

2 Kings 17:13-18 Yet the LORD forewarned Israel, and Judah, by the hand of every prophet, and of every seer, saying: **Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep My commandments and My statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by the hand of My servants the prophets, notwithstanding they would not hear, but hardened their neck, like to the neck of their fathers, who believed not in the LORD their God; and they rejected His statutes, and His covenant that He made with their fathers, and His testimonies wherewith He testified against them; and they went after**

things of nought, and became nought, and after the nations that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them that they should not do like them, and they forsook all the commandments of the LORD their God, and made them molten images, even two calves, and made an Asherah, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal, **and they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire**, and used divination and enchantments, and gave themselves over to do that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him, **that the LORD was very angry with Israel, and removed them out of His sight, there was none left but the tribe of Judah only.**

2 Kings 17:24-28 And the king of Assyria brought men from Babylon, and from Cuthah, and from Avva, and from Hamath and Sepharvaim, and placed them in the cities of Samaria instead of the children of Israel, and they possessed Samaria and dwelt in the cities thereof. And so it was, at the beginning of their dwelling there, that they **feared not the LORD, therefore, the LORD sent lions among them, which killed some of them. Wherefore they spoke to the king of Assyria, saying: The nations which thou hast carried away, and placed in the cities of Samaria, know not the manner of the God of the land, therefore, He hath sent lions among them, and behold, they slay them, because they know not the manner of the God of the land. Then the king of Assyria commanded, saying: Carry thither one of the priests whom ye brought from thence, and let them go and dwell there, and let him teach them the manner of the God of the land. So one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Beth-el and taught them how they should fear the LORD.**

2 Kings 17:32-34 So they feared the LORD and made unto them from among themselves priests of the high places, who sacrificed for them in the houses of the high places. They feared the LORD, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations from among whom they had been carried away. Unto this day they do after the former manners: **They fear not the LORD**, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law or after the commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom He named Israel.
