TORAH PORTION

Exodus 40:34,35 Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

Leviticus 1:1a **And the LORD called** unto Moses, and spoke unto him out of the tent of meeting, saying.

Genesis 3:9 **And the LORD God called** unto the man, and said unto him: 'Where art thou?'

Leviticus 9:22-24 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and blessed them, and came down from offering of the sin offering, and the burnt offering, and peace offerings. And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: And the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the people. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed upon the altar the burnt offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Micah 6:8 It hath been told thee, O man, what is good, and what the LORD doth require of thee: Only to do justly, and to love mercy, and to **walk humbly with thy God.**

Leviticus 2:9 And the priest shall take off from the meal-offering the memorial-part thereof, and shall make it smoke upon the altar an offering made by fire, of a **sweet savor unto the LORD.**

Isaiah 65:5 Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me, for **I am holier than thou.** These are **a smoke in my nose**, a fire that burneth all the day.

Leviticus 3:1,2 If his offering is a sacrifice of peace offerings, if he offers it from the herd, whether male or female, he shall offer it without blemish before the LORD. He shall lay his hand on the head of his offering and kill it at the door of the Tent of Meeting: And Aaron’s sons, the priests shall sprinkle the blood around on the altar.

Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Leviticus 4:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, If anyone sins unintentionally, in any of the things which the LORD has commanded not to be done, and does any one of them: If the anointed priest sins so as to bring guilt on the people, then let him offer for his sin, which he has sinned, a young bull without blemish to the LORD for a sin offering.

Hebrews 10:4 For **it is not possible** that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who labor and are heavily burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**

2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers.

Deuteronomy 22:10 Thou shalt not plow with an ox and an ass together.

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD: Stand ye in the ways and see, and **ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.** But they said: We will not walk therein.

Leviticus 7:11,12a This is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which one shall offer to the LORD. If he offers it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mixed with oil, and unleavened wafers anointed with oil, and cakes mixed with oil.

Psalm 107:1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for He is good, for His mercy endureth forever.

Psalm 107:2-6 So let the redeemed of the LORD say, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the adversary, And gathered them out of the lands, from the east and from the west, from the north and from the sea. They wandered in the wilderness in a desert way, they found no city of habitation. Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He delivered them out of their distresses.

Psalm 107:8-16 Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath satisfied the longing soul, and the hungry soul He hath filled with good. Such as **sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, being bound in affliction and iron.** Because they rebelled against the words of God and contemned the counsel of the Most High. Therefore, He humbled their heart with travail, they stumbled, and there was none to help. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He brought them out of darkness and the

shadow of death and broke their bands in sunder. Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

Psalm 107:17-22 Crazy because of the way of their transgression and afflicted because of their iniquities. Their soul abhorred all manner of food, and **they drew near unto the gates of death. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses, He sent His word, and healed them, and delivered them from their graves.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! And let them offer the **sacrifices of thanksgiving** and declare His works with singing.

Psalm 107:23-32 They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters. These saw the works of the LORD, and His wonders in the deep, For He commanded, and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves thereof, They mounted up to the heaven, they went down to the deeps, their soul melted away because of trouble, They reeled to and fro, and staggered like a drunken man, and all their wisdom was swallowed up. They cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and **He brought them out of their distresses. He made the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof were still. Then were they glad because they were quiet, and He led them unto their desired haven.** Let them give thanks unto the LORD for His mercy, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them exalt Him also in the assembly of the people and praise Him in the seat of the elders.

Mark 4:35-41 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was **in the ship**. And there were also with him **other little ships**. And there arose a great **storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship**, so that it was now full. And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: And they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea,

Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith? And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Psalm 50:23 Whoever offers the **sacrifice of thanksgiving** glorifies me and prepares his way so that I will show God's salvation to him.

2 KINGS 22

1 Kings 13:1,2 And, behold, there came a man of God out of Judah by the word of the LORD unto Bethel: And Jeroboam stood by the altar to burn incense. And he cried against the altar in the word of the LORD, and said, O altar, altar, thus saith the LORD, Behold, a child shall be born unto the house of David, **Josiah by name**, and upon thee shall he offer the priests of the high places that burn incense upon thee, and men's bones shall be burnt upon thee.

Jeremiah 1:1-3 The words of Jeremiah the son of Hilkiah, of the priests that were in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin: To whom the word of the LORD came in the days of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, **in the thirteenth year of his reign**. It came also in the days **of Jehoiakim** the son of Josiah king of Judah, unto the end of the eleventh year of Zedekiah the son of Josiah king of Judah, unto the carrying away of Jerusalem captive in the fifth month.

2 Kings 22:3-5 And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king **Josiah**, that the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying, Go up to Hilkiah the high priest, that he may sum the silver which is brought into the house of the LORD, which the keepers of the door have gathered of the people: And let them deliver it into the hand of the doers of the work, that have the oversight of the house of the LORD: And let them give it to the doers of the work which is in the house of the LORD, to repair the breaches of the house,

2 Kings 22:12,13 And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying, Go ye, enquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: For great is the wrath of the LORD that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us.

2 Kings 22:15-17 And she said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Tell the man that sent you to me, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, even all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read: Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands, therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.

2 Kings 22:18-20 But to the king of Judah which sent you to enquire of the LORD, this shall you say to him, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, As touching the words which you have heard, Because your heart was tender, and you have humbled yourself before the LORD, when you heard what I spoke against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and have rent your clothes, and wept before me, **I also have heard you**, saith the LORD. Behold therefore, I will gather you unto your fathers, and you shall be gathered into your grave in peace, and your eyes shall not see all the evil which I will bring upon this place. And they brought the king word again.

2 Kings 23:1,2 And the king sent, and they gathered unto him all the elders of Judah and of Jerusalem. And the king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: And he read in their ears all the words of the book of the covenant which was found in the house of the LORD.

2 Kings 23:3 And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

2 Kings 23:4 And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest, and the priests of the second order, and the keepers of the door, to bring forth out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, and for the grove, and for all the host of heaven: And he burned them without Jerusalem in the fields of Kidron, and carried the ashes of them unto Bethel.

2 Kings 23:5 And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem, them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven.

2 Kings 23:7 And he broke down the houses of the sodomites, that were by the house of the LORD, where the women wove hangings for the grove.

2 Kings 23:10-12 And he defiled Topheth, which is in the valley of the children of Hinnom, that no man might make his son or his daughter to pass through the fire to Molech. And he took away the horses that the kings of Judah had given to the sun, at the entering in of the house of the LORD, by the chamber of Nathanmelech the chamberlain, which was in the suburbs, and burned the chariots of the sun with fire. And the altars that were on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake them down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron.

2 Kings 23:13 And the high places that were before Jerusalem, which were on the right hand of **the mount of corruption**, which Solomon the king of Israel had built for Ashtoreth the abomination of the

Zidonians, and for Chemosh the abomination of the Moabites, and for Milcom the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile.

2 Kings 23:15 Moreover the altar that was at Bethel, and the high place which Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, had made, both that altar and the high place he broke down, and burned the high place, and stamped it small to powder, and burned the grove.

2 Kings 23:16,17 And as Josiah turned himself, he spied the sepulchers that were there in the mount, and sent, and took the bones out of the sepulchers, and burned them upon the altar, and polluted it, according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words. Then he said, What title is that that I see? And the men of the city told him, It is the sepulcher of the man of God, which came from Judah, and proclaimed these things that thou hast done against the altar of Bethel.

2 Kings 23:21-23 And the king commanded all the people, saying, **Keep the Passover** unto the LORD your God, as it is written in the book of this covenant. Surely there was not holden such a **Passover from the days of the judges that judged Israel, nor in all the days of the kings of Israel, nor of the kings of Judah,** But in the **eighteenth year of king Josiah, wherein this Passover was holden** to the LORD in Jerusalem.

2 Kings 23:25,26 And like unto him was there no king before him, that turned to the LORD with all his heart, and with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the law of Moses, neither after him arose there any like him. **Notwithstanding the LORD turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath,** wherewith his anger was kindled against Judah, because of all the provocations that Manasseh had provoked him withal.

2 Kings 23:27 And the LORD said, I will remove Judah also out of my sight, as I have removed Israel, and will cast off this city Jerusalem which I have chosen, and the house of which I said, My name shall be there.

Matthew 18:23-26 Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants. And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents. But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made. The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

Matthew 18:27-30 Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt. But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellow-servants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest. And his fellow servant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all. And he would not: But went and **cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.**

Matthew 25:36-40 Naked, and you clothed me: I was sick, and you visited me: **I was in prison, and you came unto me.** Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when did we see you hungry, and fed you? Or thirsty, and gave you drink? When did we see as a stranger, and took you in? Or naked, and clothed you? Or when did we see you sick, **or in prison,** and came to you? And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, you have done it unto me.

Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek, he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, **to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound.**

2 Chronicles 35:20-23 After all this, **when Josiah had prepared the temple,** Necho king of Egypt came up to fight against Carchemish by Euphrates: And Josiah went out against him. But he sent ambassadors to him, saying, What have I to do with you, you king of Judah? I come not against you this day, but against the house wherewith I have war:

For God commanded me to make haste: Forbear from meddling with God, who is with me, that he destroys you not. Nevertheless, Josiah would not turn his face from him, but disguised himself, that he might fight with him, and hearkened not unto the words of Necho from the mouth of God and came to fight in the valley of Megiddo. And the archers shot at king Josiah, and the king said to his servants, Have me away, for I am sore wounded.

2 Chronicles 35:25 And Jeremiah lamented for Josiah.

2 Chronicles 36:1-4 Then the people of the land took **Jehoahaz** the son of Josiah and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem. Jehoahaz was **twenty and three years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months in Jerusalem.** And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold. And the **king of Egypt made Eliakim** his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother and carried him to Egypt.

2 Kings 23:31,32 Jehoahaz was twenty and three years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months in Jerusalem. And **his mother's name was Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.** **And he did that which was evil** in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.

2 Kings 23:31,34 And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem, and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold. And **Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim,** and took Jehoahaz away: And he came to Egypt and died there.

2 Kings 23:36,37 Jehoiakim was **twenty and five years old** when he began to reign, and he reigned **eleven years** in Jerusalem. And **his mother's name was Zebudah, the daughter of Pedaiah of Rumah.** **And he did that which was evil** in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.

2 Chronicles 36:6,7 Then the people of the land took **Jehoahaz** the son of Josiah and Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him in fetters, to carry him to Babylon. Nebuchadnezzar also carried of the vessels of the house of the LORD to Babylon, and put them in his temple at Babylon
