## TORAH PORTION

**Exodus 33:12** And Moses said unto the LORD, See, thou sayest unto me, Bring up this people: And thou hast not let me know whom thou wilt send with me. Yet thou hast said, I know thee by name, and thou hast also found grace in my sight. Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found grace in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find grace in thy sight: and consider that this nation is thy people.

**Exodus 12:21** Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take you a lamb according to your families, and **kill the Passover**.

**Numbers 28:16-18** And in the **fourteenth day of the first month** is the Passover of the Lord. And in the fifteenth day of this month is the feast: Seven days shall **unleavened bread** be eaten. In the first day shall be an holy convocation, ye shall do no manner of servile work therein.

**Exodus 12:22** And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason, and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.

**Exodus 5:2** And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

**Exodus 7:5** And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

**Exodus 12:29** And it came to pass, that **at midnight** the Lord smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon, and all the firstborn of cattle.

**Leviticus 23:4,5** These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy **convocations**, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the **LORD's Passover**.

**Revelation 13:8** And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb **slain from the foundation of the world**.

**Matthew 26:30,31** And when they had **sung an hymn**, they went out into the mount of Olives. Then Yeshua said to them, You shall all be offended because of me this night: For it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.

**John 19:41,42** Now in the **place where he was crucified there was a garden**, and **in the garden a new tomb** wherein was never man yet laid. There then because of the Jews' Preparation (**for the tomb was nigh at hand**) they laid Yeshua.

**Matthew 27:57-60** And in the evening, there came **a man of wealth** from **Arimathaea**, Joseph by name, who was a disciple of Yeshua: This man went in to Pilate, and made a request for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate gave orders for it to be given to him. And Joseph took the body, folding it in clean linen, And put it in the resting-place which had been cut out of the rock for himself, and after rolling a great stone to the door of it he went away.

**Zechariah 14:4** And His feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleft in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, so that there shall be a very great valley, and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

**Luke 23:2** They began to accuse him, saying, We found this man perverting the nation, forbidding paying taxes to Caesar, and saying that he himself is Messiah, **a king**.

**Matthew 27:37** They set up over his head the accusation against him written, This is Yeshua, the **King of the Jews**.

**John 19:19,20** And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was,  
YESHUA OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS. This title then read many of the Jews: For the place where **Yeshua was crucified was nigh to the city**: And it was written in Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin.

**John 18:1** When Yeshua had spoken these words, he went out with his disciples over the brook Kidron, where there **was a garden**, into which he and his disciples entered.

**John 18:12,13** So the detachment, the commanding officer, and the officers of the Judeans, seized Yeshua and bound him, and led him to Annas first, for he was father-in-law to Caiaphas, who was high priest that year.

**John 18:26** One of the servants of the high priest, being a relative of him whose ear Peter had cut off, said, Didn't I see you **in the garden** with him?

**Mark 11:1-4** And when they came nigh to **Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives**, he sendeth forth two of his disciples, And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: And as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring him. And if any man say unto you, Why do ye this? Say ye that the Lord hath need of him, and straightway he will send him hither. And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door **without in a place where two ways met**, and they loose him.

**Matthew 27:54** Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Yeshua, saw the earthquake, and **those things that were done**, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

**Luke 23:44,45** And it was now about the sixth hour, and a darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour, the sun's light failing: And **the veil of the temple was rent in the midst**.

**Luke 23:47-49** And when **the centurion** saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man. And all the multitudes that came together to this sight, **when they beheld the things that were done**, returned smiting their breasts. And **all his acquaintances, and the women** that followed with him from Galilee, stood afar off, **seeing these things**.

**Numbers 19:2-5** This is the statute of the law that the LORD has commanded: Tell the people of Israel to bring you a red heifer without defect, in which there is no blemish, and on which a yoke has never come. And you shall give it to Eleazar the priest, and it shall be **taken outside the camp** and slaughtered **before Him**. And Eleazar the priest shall take some of its blood with his finger, and sprinkle some of its blood toward the front of the tent of meeting seven times. And the heifer shall be burned in His sight. Its skin, its flesh, and its blood, with its dung, shall be burned.

**Ezekiel 43:21** Thou shalt take the bullock also of the sin offering and he shall burn it in the **appointed place** of the house, without the sanctuary.

**Hebrews 13:10-13** We have an altar from which those who serve the tent have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy places by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned **outside the camp**. So Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood. Therefore let us go to him **outside the camp** and bear the reproach he endured. Messiah fulfilled the cleansing of those contaminated by death at the designated place.

## 2 Kings 22-24

**2 Kings 22:3** And it came to pass in the **eighteenth year of king Josiah**, that the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD,

**2 Kings 22:8** And Hilkiyah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiyah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it.

**2 Kings 22:12,13** And the king commanded Hilkiyah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying, Go ye, enquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: For great is the wrath of the LORD that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us.

**Jeremiah 26:1-3** In the beginning of the reign of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah came this word from the LORD, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Stand in the court of the LORD's house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to worship in the LORD's house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them, diminish not a word: If so be they will hearken, and turn every man from his evil way, that I may repent me of the evil, which I purpose to do unto them because of the evil of their doings.

**Jeremiah 26:20** And there was also a man that prophesied in the name of the LORD, Urijah the son of Shemaiah of Kirjathjearim, who prophesied against this city and against this land according to all the words of Jeremiah.

**Jeremiah 26:23** And they fetched forth Urijah out of Egypt and brought him unto Jehoiakim the king, **who slew him with the sword and cast his dead body into the graves of the common people.**

**Jeremiah 22:18,19** Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, They shall not lament for him, saying, Ah my brother! Or, Ah sister! They shall not lament for him, saying, Ah lord! Or, Ah his glory! He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

**Daniel 1:1,2** In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came **Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem and besieged it**. And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: Which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god, and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god.

**Jeremiah 25:1-3** The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that was the first year of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, The which Jeremiah the prophet spoke unto all the people of Judah, and to all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying, From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, even unto this day, that is the **three and twentieth year**, the word of the LORD hath come unto me, and I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking, but ye have not hearkened.

**Jeremiah 45:1** The word that Jeremiah the prophet spoke unto Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had written these words in a book at the mouth of Jeremiah, **in the fourth year of Jehoiakim** the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying,

**Jeremiah 36:1** And it came to pass in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that this word came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, saying, Take thee a roll of a book, and write therein all the words that I have spoken unto thee against Israel, and against Judah, and against all the nations, from the day I spoke unto thee, from the days of Josiah, even unto this day.

**Jeremiah 36:9,10** And it came to pass in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, in the ninth month, that they proclaimed a fast before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people that came from the cities of Judah unto Jerusalem. Then read Baruch in the book the words of Jeremiah in the house of the LORD, in the chamber of Gemariah the son of Shaphan the scribe, in the higher court, at the entry of the new gate of the LORD's house, in the ears of all the people.

**Jeremiah 36:22-24** Now the king sat in the winter-house in the **ninth month**: And there was a fire on the hearth burning before him. And it came to pass, that when Jehudi had read **three or four leaves**, he cut it with the penknife and **cast it into the fire** that was on the hearth, until all the roll was consumed in the fire that was on the hearth. Yet they were not afraid, nor rent their garments, neither the king, nor any of his servants that heard all these words.

**Daniel 2:1,2** And in the second year of the reign of **Nebuchadnezzar**, Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him. Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.

**Daniel 3:23-25** And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the **burning fiery furnace**. Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spoke, and said unto his counsellors, **Did not we cast three men** bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king. He answered and said, Lo, **I see four men loose**, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

**2 Kings 24:1-4** In his days Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up, and **Jehoiakim** became **his servant three years**: Then he turned and rebelled against him. And the LORD sent against him bands of the Chaldees, and bands of the Syrians, and bands of the Moabites, and bands of the children of Ammon, and sent them against Judah to destroy it, according to the word of the LORD, which he spoke by his servants the prophets. Surely at the commandment of the LORD came this upon Judah, to remove them out of his sight, for **the sins of Manasseh**, according to all that he did; And also, for the innocent blood that he shed: for he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, **which the LORD would not pardon**.

**2 Kings 24:6-9** So Jehoiakim slept with his fathers: and Jehoiachin his son reigned in his stead. And the king of Egypt came not again any

more out of his land: For the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt. Jehoiachin was **eighteen years old when he began to reign**, and he reigned in Jerusalem **three months**. And his mother's name was Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem. And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father had done.

**2 Kings 24:11,12** And Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against the city, and his servants did besiege it. And Jehoiachin the king of Judah went out to the king of Babylon, he, and his mother, and his servants, and his princes, and his officers: and the king of Babylon took him in the **eighth year of his reign**.

**2 Kings 24:14,15** And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valor, even ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save the poorest sort of the people of the land. And he carried away Jehoiachin to Babylon, and the king's mother, and the king's wives, and his officers, and the mighty of the land, those carried he into captivity from Jerusalem to Babylon.

**2 Kings 24:17,18** And the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead and changed his name to Zedekiah. **Zedekiah was twenty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years** in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

**Jeremiah 28:1** And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, **in the fourth year, and in the fifth month**, that **Hananiah** the son of Azur the prophet, which was of Gibeon, spoke unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying.

**Jeremiah 28:2-4** Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon. Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD's house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this

place, and carried them to Babylon: And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

**Jeremiah 28:5,6** Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD, Even the prophet Jeremiah said, Amen: the LORD do so: The LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again the vessels of the LORD's house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place.

**Jeremiah 28:10,11** Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck and brake it. And Hananiah spoke in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of two full years. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way.

**Jeremiah 28:12-14** Then the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the prophet, after that Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying, Go and tell Hananiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Thou hast broken the yokes of wood, but thou shalt make for them yokes of iron. For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and they shall serve him: And I have given him the beasts of the field also.

**Jeremiah 28:15-17** Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah, The LORD hath not sent thee, but thou makest this people to trust in a lie. Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: This year thou shalt die, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. So Hananiah **the prophet died the same year in the seventh month.**

**2 Kings 25:1-3** And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he, and all his host, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it; and they built forts against it round about. And the city was besieged unto the eleventh year of king Zedekiah. And on the ninth day of the fourth month the famine prevailed in the city, and there was no bread for the people of the land.

**Ezekiel 24:1,2** Again in the ninth year, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, write thee the name of the day, even of this same day: The king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

**Jeremiah 52:4,5** And it came to pass in the ninth year of his reign, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came, he and all his army, against Jerusalem, and pitched against it, and built forts against it round about. So the city was besieged unto the eleventh year of king Zedekiah.

**Jeremiah 52:6,7** And in the fourth month, in the ninth day of the month, the famine was sore in the city, so that there was no bread for the people of the land. Then the city was broken up, and all the men of war fled, and went forth out of the city by night by the way of the gate between the two walls, which was by the king's garden; (now the Chaldeans were by the city round about:) and they went by the way of the plain.

**2 Kings 25:5-7** And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: And all his army were scattered from him. So, they took the king and brought him up to the king of Babylon to Riblah, and they gave judgment upon him. **And they slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, and put out the eyes of Zedekiah**, and bound him with fetters of brass, and carried him to Babylon.

**2 Kings 25:8-10** And in the fifth month, on the seventh day of the month, which is the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the

king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem: And he burnt the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every great man's house burnt he with fire. And all the army of the Chaldees, that were with the captain of the guard, brake down the walls of Jerusalem round about.

**2 Kings 25:22** And as for the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

**2 Kings 25:25,26** But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and **smote Gedaliah, that he died**, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah. And all the people, both small and great, and the captains of the armies, arose, and came to Egypt: for they were afraid of the Chaldees.

**2 Kings 25:27,28** And it came to pass in the **seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah**, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, that Evil Merodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison, And he spoke kindly to him, and set his throne above the throne of the kings that were with him in Babylon.
