TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 6:24-26 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the **sin offering**: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the **sin offering** shall be killed before the LORD. **It is most holy**. The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. It shall be eaten in a holy place, in the court of the Tent of Meeting.

Leviticus 9:1 It came to pass on the **eighth day** that Moses called Aaron and his sons and the elders of Israel.

Exodus 40:17-20 And it came to pass in the **first month** in the second year, on the **first day of the month**, that the tabernacle was reared up. And Moses reared up the tabernacle, and laid its sockets, and set up the boards thereof, and put in the bars thereof, and reared up its pillars. And he spread the tent over the tabernacle and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the LORD commanded Moses.

Leviticus 9:3,4 And to the children of Israel you shall speak, saying, Take you a **kid of the goats for a sin offering**, and a *calf and a lamb, both of the first year, without blemish, for a **burnt offering***. Also a *bullock and a ram for **peace offerings***, to sacrifice before the LORD, and a **meal offering** mingled with oil: **For today the LORD will appear to you.**

Exodus 40:29 And he put the altar of burnt offering before the door of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting and offered upon it the burnt offering and the grain offering, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Leviticus 9:6 And Moses said, This is the thing which the LORD commanded that you should do: And the glory of the LORD shall appear to you.

Exodus 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and **the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.**

Leviticus 9:22-24 And Aaron lifted up his hand toward the people, and *blessed them*, and came down from offering of the **sin offering**, and the **burnt offering**, and **peace offerings**. And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and *blessed the people*: And the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people. And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed on the altar the burnt offering and the fat: Which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.

Leviticus 10:1,2 And **Nadab and Abihu**, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not. And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Leviticus 10:3 Then Moses said to Aaron, This is it that the LORD spoke, saying, I will be sanctified in them that **come near me**, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace.

Amos 3:1,2 Hear this word that the LORD has spoken against you, children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up out of the land of Egypt, saying: You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth. Therefore, I will punish you for all of your sins.

Leviticus 10:8-11 And the LORD spoke to Aaron, saying, **Do not drink wine nor strong drink**, you, nor your sons with you, when you go into the tabernacle of the congregation, **lest you die**: It shall be a statute forever throughout your generations: And that you **may put difference between holy and common**, and between **unclean and clean**, And that you may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD has spoken to them by the hand of Moses.

Leviticus 10:12,13 And Moses spoke to Aaron, and to Eleazar and to Ithamar, his sons that were left, Take the **meal offering** that remains of the offerings of the LORD **made by fire, and eat it** *without leaven* beside the altar: For it **is most holy**: And **you shall eat it in the holy place**, because it is your due, and your sons' due, of the sacrifices of the LORD **made by fire: for so I am commanded**.

Leviticus 10:16-18 And Moses diligently sought the goat of the sin offering, and, behold, it was burnt: And he was angry with Eleazar and Ithamar, the sons of Aaron which were left alive, saying, **Why have you not eaten the sin offering** in the holy place, seeing it is most holy, and God has given it you to bear the iniquity of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD? Behold, the blood of it was not brought in within the holy place: You should indeed have eaten it in the holy place, as I commanded.

Leviticus 10:16a And Moses diligently sought. Sought sought

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, **rightly dividing** the word of truth.

Leviticus 11:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and to Aaron, saying to them, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, **These are the beasts which you shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth.**

1 Thessalonians 4:7-12 **Because it is God's purpose** that our way of life may be not unclean but holy. Whoever, then, goes against this word, goes against not man but God, who gives his Holy Spirit to you.

Genesis 1:28,29 God blessed them. God said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth, and subdue it. **Have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the sky, and **over every living thing that moves on the earth.** God said, Behold, I have given you **every herb yielding seed**, which is on the surface of all the earth, **and every tree, which bears fruit yielding seed. It will be your food.**

Genesis 2:16,17 The LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, **you shall not eat of it**, for in the day that you eat of it you will surely die.

Genesis 7:2 You shall take seven pairs of every clean animal with you, the male and his female. Of the animals that are not clean, take two, the male and his female.

For sacrifices not food

Deuteronomy 14:21a You shall **not eat of anything that dies of itself**: You shall **give it to the stranger** that is in your gates, **that he may eat it**, or you **may sell it to an alien**: For you are a **holy** people to the LORD your God.

Leviticus 11:39,40 If any animal, **of which you may eat, dies**, he who **touches its carcass shall be unclean** until the evening. He who **eats of its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening**. He also who carries its carcass shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the evening.

Leviticus 11:44,45 For I am the LORD your God: You shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and **you shall be holy, for I am holy**: Neither shall you **defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creeps on the earth**. For I am the LORD that brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: **You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy**.

1 Peter 1:15 but as He who called you **is holy**, you also **be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, Be holy, for I am holy**.

Leviticus 11:46,47 This is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature **that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth: To make a difference between the unclean and the clean, and between the beast that may be eaten and the beast that may not be eaten**.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Leviticus 13:45 The leper in whom the plague is shall wear torn clothes, and the hair of his head shall hang loose. He shall cover his upper lip, and shall cry, **Unclean! Unclean!**

Leviticus 19:5-7 And if you offer a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD, you shall offer it at your own will. It shall be eaten the same day you offer it, and on the morrow: And if any remains until the third day, it shall be burnt in the fire. And if it is eaten at all on the third day, **it is an abomination. It shall not be accepted.**

Acts 10:7 And when the angel which spoke unto Cornelius was departed, **he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier** of them that waited on him continually.

Acts 10:9-13 On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the **sixth hour**: And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: But while they made ready, he fell into a trance, And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of four footed beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat.

Acts 10:15,16 And the voice spoke unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common. **This was done thrice**: And the vessel was received up again into heaven.

Acts 10:19 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, **three men seek thee**.

Acts 10:14 But Peter said, Not so, Lord, for I have never **eaten anything that is common or unclean**.

Acts 10:28 And he said unto them, Ye know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation, but **God hath shewed me** that I should **not call any Man common or unclean**.

Romans 14:14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself, but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.

Acts 10:28 Then he said to them, You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But God has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean.

JEREMIAH

Jeremiah 36:1 And it came to pass in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that this word came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, saying.

Jeremiah 32:1 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which was the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar.

Jeremiah 45:1 The word that Jeremiah the prophet spoke unto Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had written these words in a book at the mouth of Jeremiah, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, saying.

Jeremiah 1:1 The words of Jeremiah the son of Hilkiah, of the priests that were in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin: To whom the word of the LORD came in the days of **Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reign.**

Jeremiah 38:4,5 Therefore **the princes said unto the king,** We beseech thee, let this man be put to death: For thus he weakeneth the hands of the men of war that remain in this city, and the hands of all the people, in speaking such words unto them: For this man seeketh not the welfare of this people, but the hurt. Then Zedekiah the king said, Behold, he is in your hand: For the king is not he that can do anything against you.

Jeremiah 26:8 Now it happened, when Jeremiah had made an end of speaking all that the LORD had commanded him to speak to all the people, that the **priests and the prophets and all the people seized him,** saying, You will surely die!

Jeremiah 11:21 Therefore thus says the LORD concerning the men of Anathoth who seek your life, **saying, Do not prophesy in the name of the LORD, lest you die by our hand.**

Jeremiah 20:10 For I have heard the defaming of many, terror on every side. Denounce, and we will denounce him, say all my familiar friends, they that watch for my fall, peradventure he will be persuaded, and we shall prevail against him, and we shall take our revenge on him.

Jeremiah 12:6 For even thy brethren, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee, even they have cried aloud after thee: believe them not, though they speak fair words unto thee.

Jeremiah 15:10 Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth!

Jeremiah 16:1,2 The word of the LORD was to me, saying, You shall not take a wife for yourself, nor shall you have sons or daughters in this place.

Jeremiah 20:14,15 Cursed be the day wherein I was born let not the day wherein my mother bare me be blessed. Cursed be the man who brought tidings to my father, saying, A man child is born unto thee, making him very glad. And let that man be as the cities which the LORD overthrew and repented not: And let him hear the cry in the morning, and the shouting at noontide, Because he slew me not from the womb, or that my mother might have been my grave, and her womb to be always great with me. Wherefore came I forth out of the womb to see labor and sorrow, that my days should be consumed with shame.

Jeremiah 1:4-6 Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee, and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, I cannot speak: For I am a child.

Jeremiah 1:7-9 But the LORD said unto me, Say not, I am a child: For thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak. Be not afraid of their faces: For I am with thee to deliver thee, saith the LORD. Then the LORD put forth his hand and touched my mouth. And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth.

Jeremiah 1:10 See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-3 To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose time to pluck up that which is planted, A time to kill, and a time to heal, a time to break down, and a time to build up.

Jeremiah 1:11,12 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Jeremiah, what seest thou? And I said, I see a rod of an **almond tree**. Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for **I will hasten my word to perform it**.

Jeremiah 1:13-15 And the word of the LORD came unto me the second time, saying, What seest thou? And I said, I see a seething pot, and the face thereof is toward the north. Then the LORD said unto me, Out of the north an evil shall break forth upon all the inhabitants of the land. For, lo, I will call all the families of the kingdoms of the north, saith the LORD, and they shall come, and they shall set everyone his throne at the entering of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all the walls thereof round about, and against all the cities of Judah.

Jeremiah 1:16 And I will utter my judgments against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshipped the works of their own hands.

Jeremiah 1:19 They will be fighting against you, but they will not overcome you: For I am with you, says the Lord, to give you salvation.

Jeremiah 2:1-3 Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Go and cry in the hearing of Jerusalem, saying, Thus says the LORD:

I remember you, The kindness of your youth, The love of your betrothal, When you went after Me in the wilderness, In a land not sown. Israel was holiness to the LORD, The first fruits of His increase. All that devour him will offend, Disaster will come upon them, says the LORD.

Jeremiah 2:4,5 Hear the word of the LORD, O house of Jacob and all the families of the house of Israel. Thus says the LORD: What injustice have your fathers found in Me, That they have gone far from Me, Have followed idols, And have become idolaters?

Jeremiah 2:6 Neither did they say, Where is the LORD, Who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, Who led us through the wilderness, Through a land of deserts and pits, Through a land of drought and the shadow of death, Through a land that no one crossed And where no one dwelt?

Jeremiah 2:7,8 I brought you into a bountiful country, To eat its fruit and its goodness. But when you entered, you defiled My land And made My heritage an abomination. The priests did not say, Where is the LORD? And those who handle the law did not know Me, The rulers also transgressed against Me. The prophets prophesied by Baal and walked **after things that do not profit.**

Jeremiah 2:11,12 Has a nation changed its gods, Which are not gods? **But My people have changed their glory for what does not profit.** Be astonished, O heavens, at this, And be horribly afraid, Be very desolate, says the LORD.

Romans 1:21-23 Professing to be wise, they became fools, and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

Jeremiah 2:13 For My people have committed two evils: **They have forsaken Me, the fountain of living waters, And hewn themselves cisterns broken cisterns that can hold no water.**

Psalm 1:1-3 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful, But **his delight is in the law of the LORD,** And **in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water,** That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither, And whatever he does shall prosper.

Jeremiah 2:17 **Have you not brought this on yourself,** In that you have **forsaken the LORD your God** When He led you in the way?

Jeremiah 2:19 Your own wickedness will correct you, And your backslidings will rebuke you. Know therefore and see that it is an evil and bitter thing That you have **forsaken the LORD your God,** And the fear of Me is not in you, Says the Lord GOD of hosts.

Jeremiah 2:20 For of old I have broken your yoke and burst your bonds, And you said, I will not transgress, When on every high hill and under every green tree You lay down, playing the harlot.

Jeremiah 2:21,22 Yet I had planted you a noble vine, a seed of highest quality. How then have you turned before Me Into the degenerate plant of an alien vine? For though you wash yourself with lye, and use much soap, Yet your iniquity is marked before Me, says the Lord GOD.

Jeremiah 2:27b-28 For they have turned their back to Me, and not their face. But in the time of their trouble They will say, Arise and save us. But where are your gods that you have made for yourselves? Let them arise, If they can save you in the time of your trouble, For according to the number of your cities Are your gods, O Judah.

Jeremiah 2:32 Can a virgin forget her ornaments, Or a bride her attire? Yet My people have forgotten Me days without number.

Jeremiah 2:35 Yet you say, Because I am innocent, Surely His anger shall turn from me. Behold, I will plead My case against you, Because you say, I have not sinned.

Jeremiah 3:1a They say, If a man divorces his wife, And she goes from him And becomes another man's, **May he return to her again?**

Jeremiah 3:1b Would not that land be greatly polluted? But you have played the harlot with many lovers, Yet return to Me, says the LORD.

Jeremiah 3:2 Lift up your eyes to the desolate heights and see: Where have you not lain with men? By the road you have sat for them like an Arabian in the wilderness, And you have polluted the land with your harlotries and your wickedness.

Jeremiah 3:3 Therefore the showers have been withheld, And there has been no latter rain. You have had a harlot's forehead, You refuse to be ashamed.

Jeremiah 3:4,5 Will you not from this time cry to Me, **My Father**, You are the guide of my youth? Will He remain angry forever? Will He keep it to the end? Behold, you have spoken and done evil things, as you were able.

Jeremiah 3:6,7a The LORD said also to me in the days of Josiah the king: Have you seen what backsliding Israel has done? She has gone up on every high mountain and under every green tree, and there played the harlot. And I said, after she had done all these things, **Return to Me**. But she did not return.

Jeremiah 3:7b,8 And her **treacherous sister Judah** saw it. Then I saw that for all the causes for which backsliding Israel had committed adultery, I had put her away and given **her a certificate of divorce**, yet her treacherous sister Judah did not fear, but went and played the harlot also.
