TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 12:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, saying, If a **woman conceives**, and bears a male child, then **she shall be unclean** seven days, as in the days of her **monthly period she shall be unclean.** In the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.

Numbers 19:13-18 **Whoever touches the body of anyone who has died, and does not purify himself, defiles the tabernacle of the LORD. That person shall be cut off from Israel. He shall be unclean,** because the water of purification was not sprinkled on him, **his uncleanness** is still on him. **This is the law** when a man dies in a tent: All who come into the tent and all who are in the tent **shall be unclean seven days,** and **every open vessel,** which has no cover fastened on it, **is unclean.** Whoever in the open field touches one who is slain by a sword or **who has died, or a bone of a man, or a grave, shall be unclean seven days.** And for an **unclean person** they shall take some of the ashes of the heifer burnt for purification from sin, and running water shall be put on them in a vessel. A clean person shall take hyssop and dip it in the water, sprinkle it on the tent, on all the vessels, on the persons who were there, or on the one who touched a bone, the slain, the dead, or a grave.

Numbers 9:6,7 And there were certain men, who were **defiled by the dead body of a man, that they could not keep the Passover on that day:** And they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day: And those men said unto him, We are **defiled by the dead body of a man:** Wherefore are we kept back, that we may not offer an offering of the LORD in **his appointed season** among the children of Israel?

Matthew 3:14,15 And John tried to prevent Him, saying, I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me? But Yeshua answered and said to him, Permit it to be so now, for thus **it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.** Then he allowed Him.

Leviticus 12:6 And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a **lamb** of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young **pigeon, or a turtledove**, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest.

Luke 2:22 And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present him to the Lord.

Leviticus 12:8 And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons, the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: And the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

Leviticus 13:1-3 The LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, When a man shall have a rising in his body's skin, or a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes in the skin of his body the **plague נגע** of **leprosy**, **צרעת** then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest, or to one of his sons, the priests: And **the priest shall examine** the plague in the skin of the body: And if the hair in the plague has turned white, and the appearance of the plague is deeper than the body's skin, it is the **plague of leprosy**, and **the priest shall examine him**, and **pronounce him unclean**.

05061. נגע neh'-gah ; a blow, plague, sore, stricken, stripe, stroke, wound.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he has borne our sickness and carried our suffering, yet we considered him plagued, **struck נגע** by God, and **afflicted**.

Babylonian Talmud:

"The Messiah --what is his name?...The Rabbis say, **The Leper Scholar**, as it is said, *'surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him a leper, **smitten** of God and afflicted...'*" (Sanhedrin 98b)

John 19:1 So Pilate then took Yeshua, and **flogged him**.

John 19:3 And said, Hail, King of the Jews! and they **smote him with their hands**.

Luke 22:63,64 The men who held Yeshua mocked him and beat him. Having blindfolded him, they **struck him on the face** and asked him, Prophecy! Who is the one who struck you?

Matthew 27:30 And they spit upon him, and **took the reed, and smote him** on the head.

Leviticus 13:5a **The priest shall examine him** on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:6a **The priest shall examine him again** on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:8 **The priest shall examine him;** and behold, if the scab has spread on the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean. It is leprosy.

Leviticus 13:9,10a When the plague of leprosy is in a man, then he shall be brought to the priest, and **the priest shall examine him.**

Leviticus 13:12,13 If the leprosy breaks out all over the skin, and the leprosy covers all the skin of the infected person from his head even to his feet, as far as it appears to the priest; then **the priest shall examine him**, and, behold, if the leprosy has covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce him clean of the plague. It has all turned white: He is clean.

Leviticus 13:15 **The priest shall examine** The raw flesh, and pronounce him unclean: the raw flesh is unclean. It is leprosy.

Leviticus 13:17a **and the priest shall examine him.**

Leviticus 13:20 **and the priest shall examine it.**

Leviticus 13:21a **But if the priest examines it.**

Leviticus 13:26a **But if the priest examines it.**

Leviticus 13:27a **The priest shall examine him** on the seventh day.

Leviticus 13:30a then **the priest shall examine the plague.**

Vs 31,32,34,36,39,43, 50,53,55

Matthew 8:2-4 Behold, a leper came to him and worshiped him, saying, Lord, if you want to, you can make me clean. Yeshua stretched out his

hand, and touched him, saying, I want to. Be made clean. Immediately his leprosy was cleansed. Yeshua said to him, See that you tell nobody, but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.

Numbers 12:10 The cloud departed from over the Tent, and behold, Miriam was leprous, as white as snow. Aaron looked at Miriam, and behold, she was leprous.

Psalm 64:3 Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words.

M'TZORA Leper

Leviticus 14:1-7 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his **cleansing**. He shall be brought to the priest, and **the priest shall go forth out of the camp.** The priest shall examine him, and behold, if the plague of leprosy **is healed** in the leper, then the priest shall command them to take for him who is **to be cleansed two living clean birds, and cedar wood, and scarlet, and hyssop.** The priest shall command them to kill one of the birds in an **earthen vessel over running water.** As for the living bird, he shall take it, and the cedar wood, and the scarlet, and the hyssop, and shall dip them and the living bird in the blood of the bird that was killed over the running water. He shall sprinkle on him who is to be cleansed from the leprosy seven times, and shall pronounce him clean, and shall let the living bird go into the open field. And he that is to be cleansed shall wash his clothes, and shave off all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be clean: and after that he shall come into the camp, and shall tarry abroad out of his tent seven days.

The priest goes out to the Leper. Realize these rituals are not the cure or treatment But cleansing from the state of uncleanness after the healing takes place.

Mark 1:40-45 A leper came to him, begging him, kneeling down to him, and saying to him, If you want to, you can make me **clean**. Being moved with compassion, he stretched out his hand, and **touched him**, and said to him, I want to. Be made clean. When he had said this, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was made clean. He

strictly warned him, and immediately sent him out, and said to him, See you say nothing to anybody, but **go show yourself to the priest**, and offer **for your cleansing the things which Moses commanded, for a testimony to them.** But he went out, and began to proclaim it much, and to spread about the matter, so that Yeshua could no more openly enter into a city, but was outside in desert places: And they came to him from everywhere.

2 Kings 5:1 Now Naaman, captain of the army of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honorable, because by him the LORD had given victory to Syria: He was also a mighty man of valor, **but he was a leper.**

Luke 4:27-29 There were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet, yet not one of them was cleansed, **except Naaman**, the Syrian. They were all filled with wrath in the synagogue, as they heard these things. They rose up, threw him out of the city, and led him to the brow of the hill that their city was built on, that they might throw him off the cliff.

Matthew 11:4,5 Yeshua answered them, Go and tell Yochanan the things which you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have good news preached to them.

Leviticus 14:14-16 And the priest shall take some of **the blood** of the trespass offering, and the priest shall put it upon the **tip of the right ear** of him that is **to be cleansed**, and upon the **thumb of his right hand**, and upon the **great toe of his right foot**: And the priest shall take some of the log of oil, and pour it into the palm of his own left hand: And the priest shall dip his right finger in the oil that is in his left hand, and shall sprinkle of the oil with his finger seven times before the LORD.

Leviticus 14:33-40 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, When ye be come into the land of Canaan, which I give to you for a possession, and I put the plague <nega`> of leprosy in a house of the land of your possession, And he that owneth the house shall come and tell the priest, saying, It seemeth to me there is as it were a plague

<k'nega`> in the house: Then the priest shall command that they empty the house, before the priest go into it to see the plague, that all that is in the house be not made unclean (spiritually defiled): And afterward the priest shall go in to see the house: And he shall look on the plague, and, behold, if the plague be in the walls of the house with hollow strakes, greenish or reddish, which in sight are lower than the wall, Then the priest shall go out of the house to the door of the house, and shut up the house seven days: And the priest shall come again the seventh day, and shall look: And, behold, if the plague be spread in the walls of the house, Then the priest shall command that they take away the stones in which the plague is, and they shall cast them into an unclean place without the city.

JEREMIAH 3,7,9,11

Jeremiah 3:10 And yet for all this her treacherous sister Judah hath **not turned unto me with her whole heart**, but **feignedly**, saith the LORD. And the LORD said unto me, The backsliding Israel hath justified herself more than treacherous Judah.

Jeremiah 3:12 Go and proclaim these words toward **the north**, and say, **Return, thou backsliding Israel**, saith the LORD, and I will not cause mine anger to fall upon you: For I am merciful, saith the LORD, and I will not keep anger forever.

Jeremiah 3:13-15 **Only acknowledge thine iniquity**, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD. Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD, for I am married unto you: And I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion: And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Jeremiah 3:16,17 And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the LORD, they shall say no more, The ark of the covenant of the LORD: **Neither shall it come to mind: Neither shall they remember it**, neither shall they visit it,

neither shall that be done any more. At that time, they shall call Jerusalem the throne of the LORD, and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem: Neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart.

Jeremiah 3:18 In those days the family of Judah will go with the family of Israel, and they will come together out of the land of the north into **the land which I gave for a heritage to your fathers.**

Jeremiah 3:21,22 A voice is sounding on the open hilltops, the weeping and the prayers of the children of Israel, **because their way is twisted, they have not kept the Lord their God in mind.** Come back, you children who have been turned away, and **I will take away your desire for wandering.** See, we have come to you, for you are the Lord our God.

Jeremiah 3:25 Let us be stretched on the earth in our downfall, covering ourselves with our shame: For we have been sinners against the Lord our God, we and our fathers, from our earliest years even till this day: And we have not given ear to the voice of the Lord our God.

Jeremiah 7:1,2 The word which came to Jeremiah from the Lord, saying, Take your place in the doorway of the Lord's house, and give out this word there, and say, Give ear to the word of the Lord, **all you of Judah who come inside these doors to give worship to the Lord.**

Jeremiah 7:3,4 Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Amend your ways and your doings, and I will cause you to dwell in this place. Do not trust in these lying words, saying, **The temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD,** the temple of the LORD are these.

Jeremiah 7:5-7 For if you thoroughly **amend your ways** and your doings, if you thoroughly **execute judgment** between a man and his neighbor, if you **do not oppress the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and do not shed innocent blood** in this place, or **walk after other gods to your hurt**, then I will cause you to dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers forever and ever.

Jeremiah 7:8-10 Behold, you trust in lying words that cannot profit. **Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, burn incense to Baal, and walk after other gods whom you do not know, and then come and stand before Me in this House which is called by My name, and say, We are delivered to do all these abominations?**

Jeremiah 7:11 Has this house, which is called by My name, become a den of thieves in your eyes? Behold, I, even I, have seen it, says the LORD.

Matthew 21:13 And He said to them, It is written, My house shall be called a house of prayer, but you have made it a den of thieves.

Jeremiah 7:12-14 But go now to My place which was in Shiloh, where I set My name at the first, and see what I did to it because of the wickedness of My people Israel. And now, because you have done all these works, says the LORD, and I spoke to you, rising up early and speaking, but you did not hear, and I called you, but you did not answer, therefore I will do to the house which is called by My name, in which you trust, and to this place which I gave to you and your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh.

Jeremiah 7:15-17 And I will cast you out of My sight, as I have cast out all your brethren the whole posterity of Ephraim. Therefore, **do not pray for this people**, nor lift up a cry or prayer for them, nor make intercession to Me; for I will not hear you. Do you not see what they do in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Jeremiah 7:22,23 For I did not speak to your fathers, or command them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices. But this is what I commanded them, saying, Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.

Jeremiah 7:24-26 Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but followed the counsels and the dictates of their evil hearts, and went backward and not forward. Since the day that your fathers came out of

the land of Egypt until this day, I have even sent to you all My servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them. Yet they did not obey Me or incline their ear but stiffened their neck. They did worse than their fathers.

Jeremiah 7:27,28 Therefore you shall speak all these words to them, but they will not obey you. You shall also call to them, but they will not answer you. So, you shall say to them, **This is a nation** that does not obey the voice of the LORD their God nor receive correction. **Truth has perished** and has been cut off from their mouth.

Jeremiah 7:30,31 For the children of Judah have done evil in My sight, says the LORD. They have set their abominations in the House which is called by My name, to pollute it. And they have built the high places of Tophet, which is in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire, which I did not command, nor did it come into My heart.

Jeremiah 9:1,2 Oh, that my head were waters, And my eyes a fountain of tears, That I might weep day and night For the slain of the daughter of my people! Oh, **that I had in the wilderness. A lodging place** for travelers, That I might leave my people and go from them! For they are all adulterers, An assembly of treacherous men.

Jeremiah 9:3-5 And like their bow they have bent their tongues for lies. **They are not valiant for the truth on the earth.** For they proceed from evil to evil, And they do not know Me, says the LORD. Everyone take heed to his neighbor, **And do not trust any brother,** For every brother will utterly supplant, And every neighbor will walk with slanderers. Everyone will deceive his neighbor, **And will not speak the truth,** **They have taught their tongue to speak lies,** They weary themselves to commit iniquity.

Matthew 10:35,36 For I have come to set a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law', and a man's enemies will be those of his own household.

Jeremiah 9:7,8 Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, I will refine them and try them; For how shall I deal with the daughter of My people? **Their tongue is an arrow shot out, It speaks deceit, One speaks peaceably to his neighbor with his mouth, But in his heart he lies in wait.**

Jeremiah 9:11,12 I will make Jerusalem a heap of ruins, a den of jackals. I will make the cities of Judah desolate, without an inhabitant. **Who is the wise man** who may understand this? And who is he to whom the mouth of the LORD has spoken, that he may declare it? Why does the land perish and burn up like a wilderness, so that no one can pass through?

Jeremiah 9:13-15 And the LORD said, **Because they have forsaken My law** which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, nor walked according to it, but they have walked according to the dictates of their own hearts and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them, therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Behold, I will feed them, this people, **with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink.**

Revelation 8:10,11 Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

Jeremiah 9:23,24 Thus says the LORD: “Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty man glory in his might, Nor let the rich man glory in his riches, **But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I am the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight, says the LORD.**

Jeremiah 9:25,26 Behold, the days are coming,” says the LORD, that I will punish all who are circumcised with the uncircumcised Egypt, Judah, Edom, the people of Ammon, Moab, and all who are in the farthest corners, who dwell in the wilderness. **For all these nations are**

uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel are uncircumcised in the heart.

Jeremiah 11:1-5 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying, Hear the words of this covenant, and speak to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and say to them, Thus says the LORD God of Israel: **Cursed is the man who does not obey the words of this covenant which I commanded your fathers in the day I brought them out of the land of Egypt**, from the iron furnace, saying, Obey My voice, and do according to all that I command you, so shall you be My people, and I will be your God, that I may establish the oath which I have sworn to your fathers, to give them a land flowing with milk and honey, as it is this day. And I answered and said, So be it, LORD.

Deuteronomy 27:26 Cursed is the one who does not confirm all the words of this law by observing them. And all the people shall say, Amen!

Galatians 3:10,11 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse, for it is written, Cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them. But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for the just shall live by faith.

Jeremiah 11:6-8 Then the LORD said to me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying: Hear the words of this covenant and do them. For I earnestly exhorted your fathers in the day I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, until this day, rising early and exhorting, saying, Obey My voice. Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but everyone followed the dictates of his evil heart, therefore, I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do, but which they have not done.

Jeremiah 11:11 Therefore thus says the LORD: Behold, I will surely bring calamity on them which they will not be able to escape, and though they cry out to Me, I will not listen to them.

Jeremiah 11:13,14 For according to the number of your cities were your gods, O Judah, and according to the number of the streets of Jerusalem, you have set up altars to that shameful thing, altars to burn incense to Baal. **So do not pray for this people** or lift up a cry or prayer for them, for I will not hear them in the time that they cry out to Me because of their trouble.

Jeremiah 11:15,16 What has My beloved to do in My house, Having done lewd deeds with many? And the holy flesh has passed from you. When you do evil, then you rejoice. The LORD called your name, Green Olive Tree, Lovely and of Good Fruit. With the noise of a great tumult He has kindled fire on it, **And its branches are broken.**

Romans 11:16-21 For if the first fruit is holy, the lump is also holy, and if the root is holy, so are the branches. And if some of **the branches were broken off**, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you. You will say then, Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in. Well said. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear. For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either.

Jeremiah 11:18,19 Now the LORD gave me knowledge of it, and I know it, for You showed me their doings. But I was like a docile lamb brought to the slaughter, and I did not know that they had devised schemes against me, saying, Let us destroy the tree with its fruit, and let us cut him off from the land of the living, that his name may be remembered no more.

Jeremiah 11:21-23 Therefore thus says the LORD concerning the men of Anathoth who seek your life, saying, Do not prophesy in the name of the LORD, lest you die by our hand' therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, I will punish them. The young men shall die by the sword, their sons and their daughters shall die by famine; and there shall be no remnant of them, for I will bring catastrophe on the men of Anathoth, even the year of their punishment.
