TORAH PORTION

Leviticus 16:1 And the LORD spoke unto Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they drew near before the LORD, and died.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Hebrews 4:14-16 Having then a great high priest, who has passed through the heavens, Yeshua, the Son of God, let us hold tightly to our confession. For we don't have a high priest who can't be touched with the feeling of our infirmities, but one who has been in all points tempted like we are, yet without sin. **Let us therefore draw near with boldness to the throne of grace**, that we may receive **mercy, and may find grace** for help in time of need.

Leviticus 16:2 And the LORD said to Moses, Speak to Aaron your brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the veil before the **mercy seat**, which is on the ark; that **he die not**: For I will appear in the cloud on the **mercy seat**.

Leviticus 16:4 He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches on his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen turban shall he be attired: These are holy garments, therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and so put them on.

Leviticus 16:8-10 And Aaron shall cast lots upon the two goats, one lot for the LORD, and the other lot for the scapegoat. And Aaron shall bring the goat upon which the LORD's lot fell and offer him for a sin offering. But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

Leviticus 16:11-14 And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself: And **he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire**

from off the altar before the LORD, and his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it within the veil: And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

Revelation 8:2-5 And I saw the **seven angels** which stood before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. And another angel came and stood at the altar, **having a golden censer, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.** And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: And there were **voices, and thunderings and lightnings, and an earthquake.**

Revelation 11:18,19 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great, and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was **seen in his temple the ark of his testament:** And there were **lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.**

Leviticus 16:17 And there shall be **no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement** in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for **all the congregation of Israel.**

Revelation 15:6-8 And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory

of God, and from his power, **and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.**

Leviticus 16:30 For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord. It shall be a sabbath of rest to you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute forever.

Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, do you not **judge and avenge our blood** on them that dwell on the earth?

Deuteronomy 32:40-44 For I lift up my hand to heaven, and say, I live forever. If I **whet my glittering sword**, and my hand take hold on judgment, I will **render vengeance** to mine enemies, and will reward them that hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall **devour flesh**, and that with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revenges on the enemy. Rejoice, O ye nations, with his people: For **he will avenge the blood of his servants**, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful to his land, and to his people. And Moses came and spoke all the words of this song in the ears of the people, he, and Hoshea the son of Nun.

Revelation 19:15-18 And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron: And he treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he has on his clothing and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. And I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the middle of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God, That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Hebrews 4:12a For **the word of God** is living, and active, and sharper than any two-edged sword.

Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: For he has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and **has avenged the blood of his servants** at her hand.

Leviticus 18:26-28 Ye shall therefore keep my statutes and my judgments, and shall not commit any of these abominations, neither any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you: (For all these abominations have the men of the land done, which were before you, and the land is defiled) **That the land spue not you out also, when ye defile it, as it spued out the nations that were before you.**

KEDOSHIM

Leviticus 27:14 And when a man shall sanctify his house to be holy unto the Lord.

Leviticus 27:28 Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the Lord of all that he hath, both of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed: every devoted thing is most holy unto the Lord.

Leviticus 27:21 But the field, when it goeth out in the jubilee, shall be holy unto the Lord, as a field devoted; the possession thereof shall be the priest's.

Acts 5:1,2 But a certain man named Hananiah, with Shappirah, his wife, sold a possession, and kept back part of the price, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the emissaries' feet.

Acts 5:4,5 While you kept it, didn't it remain your own? After it was sold, wasn't it in your power? How is it that you have conceived this thing in your heart? You haven't lied to men, but to God. Hananiah, hearing these words, fell down and died. Great fear came on all who heard these things.

Leviticus 19:1,2 And the Lord spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: קדש for I the Lord your God am holy. קדוש

1 Peter 1:15,16 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy, for I am holy.

Ephesians 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.

Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious assembly, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing, but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord.

Revelations 22:11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: And he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: And he that is holy, let him be holy still.

Isaiah 65:1-5 I am inquired of by those who didn't ask, I am found by those who didn't seek me: I said, See me, see me, to a nation that was not called by my name. I have spread out my hands all the day to a rebellious people, who walk in a way that is not good, after their own thoughts, a people who provoke me to my face continually, sacrificing in gardens, and burning incense on bricks, who sit among the graves, and lodge in the secret places, who eat pig's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels, who say, Stand by yourself, don't come near to me, for I am holier than you. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burns all the day.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus says the high and lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also who is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

Psalm 99:3 Let them praise thy great and terrible name, for it is holy.

Isaiah 40:25 To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? Saith the Holy One.

Luke 4:33,34 And in the synagogue, there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice, Saying, Let us alone, what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? Art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God

Leviticus 19:3 Each one of you shall respect his mother and his father. You shall keep my Sabbaths. I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 19:9,10 When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field, neither shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest. You shall not glean your vineyard, neither shall you gather the fallen grapes of your vineyard; you shall leave them for the poor and for the foreigner. I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 19:11,12 You shall not steal. You shall not lie. You shall not deceive one another. You shall not swear by my name falsely and profane the name of your God. I am the LORD.

Leviticus 19:13 You shall not oppress your neighbor, nor rob him. The wages of a hired servant shall not remain with you all night until the morning.

Leviticus 19:15 You shall do no injustice in judgment: You shall not be partial to the poor, nor show favoritism to the great, but you shall judge your neighbor in righteousness.

Leviticus 19:16-18 You shall not go up and down as a slanderer among your people. I am the LORD. You shall not hate your brother in your heart. You shall surely rebuke your neighbor, and not bear sin because of him. You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD.

Jeremiah 12

Jeremiah 12:1 Righteous art thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: Yet let me talk with thee of thy judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? Wherefore are all they happy that deal very treacherously? Thou hast planted them, yea, they have taken root: They grow, yea, they bring forth fruit: Thou art near in their mouth, and far from their reins.

Jeremiah 12:3,4a But thou, O LORD, knowest me: thou hast seen me, and tried mine heart toward thee: Pull them out like sheep for the slaughter and prepare them for the day of slaughter. How long shall the land mourn, and the herbs of every field wither, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein?

Jeremiah 12:5a If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses?

Jeremiah 12:6 For even thy brethren, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee, yea, they have called a multitude after thee: Believe them not, though they speak fair words unto thee.

Jeremiah 12:7,8 I have forsaken mine house, I have left **My heritage**, I have given the dearly beloved of my soul into the hand of her enemies. **My heritage** is unto me as a lion in the forest, it cries out against me: Therefore, have I hated it.

Jeremiah 12:10,11 Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness. They have made it desolate and being desolate it mourns unto me; the whole land is made desolate, because no man lays it to heart.

Jeremiah 12:14 Thus saith the LORD against all mine evil neighbors, that touch the inheritance which I have caused my people Israel to inherit, Behold, I will pluck them out of their land and pluck out the house of Judah from among them.

Jeremiah 12:15 And it shall come to pass, after that I have plucked them out I will return, and have compassion on them, and will bring them again, every man to his heritage, and every man to his land.

Jeremiah 12:16.17 And it shall come to pass, if they (The nations) will diligently learn the ways of my people, to swear by my name, The LORD lives, as they (The nations) taught my people to swear by Baal, then shall they (The nations) be built in the midst of my people. But if they (The nations) will not obey, I will utterly pluck up and destroy that nation, saith the LORD.
