TORAH PORTION

Numbers 14:35 I the LORD have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Deuteronomy 8:15 Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water.

The Wilderness of Refuge and Provision

1 Samuel 24:1,2 And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David is in the wilderness of Engedi. Then Saul took three thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and went to seek David and his men upon the rocks of the wild goats.

Revelation 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

The Wilderness of Revelation Mt Sinai - Yochanan

Numbers 9:18 At the commandment of the LORD the children of Israel journeyed, and at the commandment of the LORD they pitched: As long as the cloud stayed on the tabernacle they rested in their tents.

Exodus 25:8 And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of him that crieth **in the wilderness**, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

John 1:17 For the Torah was given through Moses. Grace and truth were realized through Yeshua the Messiah.

Isaiah 40:5 And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it/Him together: For the mouth of the LORD has spoken it.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and **dwelled among us**, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father), full of grace and truth.

Isaiah 40:6 The voice said cry. And he said, What shall I cry? All flesh is grass, and all the goodness thereof is as the flower of the field: The grass wither, the flower fades: Because the spirit of the LORD blows on it: Surely the people is grass. The grass wither, the flower fades: But the Word of our God shall stand forever.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Isaiah 40:9,10 O Zion, that bring good tidings, get you up into the high mountain, O Jerusalem, that bring good tidings, lift up your voice with strength, lift it up, be not afraid, **say to the cities of Judah, Behold your God!** Behold, the Lord GOD will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: Behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

John 1:29 The next day, he saw Yeshua coming to him, and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

Isaiah 30:20,21 Though יהוה gave you bread of adversity and water of affliction, your Teacher shall no longer be hidden. But your eyes shall see your Teacher, and your ears hear a word behind you, saying, This is the Way, walk in it, whenever you turn to the right, or whenever you turn to the left.

John 3:2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said to him, Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God.

Hosea 2:14 Therefore, behold, I will allure her, and bring her **into the wilderness**, and speak comfortably unto her.

Hosea 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall come trembling unto the LORD and to His goodness **in the end of days**.

Mark 6:31 And he said to them, Come you yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: For there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat.

Deuteronomy 32:10 He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness, he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye.

Zechariah 2:8 For thus saith the LORD of hosts, After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: For he that touches you touchs the apple of his eye.

Proverbs 7:2 Keep my commandments, and live, and my law as the apple of thine eye.

Exodus 40:1 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, **On the first day of the first month** shall you set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.

Exodus 40:17 And it came to pass in the **first month in the second year, on the first day of the month**, that the tabernacle was reared up.

Numbers 7:1 And it came to pass on the day that Moses had fully set up the tabernacle, and had anointed it, and sanctified it, and all the instruments thereof, both the altar and all the vessels thereof, and had anointed them, and sanctified them; That the princes of Israel, heads of the house of their fathers, who were the princes of the tribes, and were over them that were numbered, offered.

Numbers 1:1 the LORD spoke to Moses **in the wilderness** of Sinai, in the Tent of Meeting, **on the first day of the second month, in the second year** after they had come out of the land of Egypt.

Numbers 1:2-4 Take you the sum of all the congregation of the children of Israel, after their families, by the house of their fathers, with the number of their names, every male by their polls. From twenty years old and upward, all that are able to go forth to war in Israel: You and Aaron shall number them **by their armies**. And with you there shall be a man of every tribe, every one head of the house of his fathers.

Numbers 1:51-53 And when the tabernacle sets forward, the Levites shall take it down: And when the tabernacle is to be pitched, the Levites shall set it up: And the stranger that cometh near shall be put to death. And the children of Israel shall pitch their tents, every man by his own camp, and every man by his own standard, throughout their hosts. But the Levites shall pitch round about **the tabernacle of testimony**, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: And the Levites shall keep שמר the charge of the **tabernacle of testimony**.

Numbers 2:3 On the east side, toward the rising of the sun, those of the standard of the forces with Judah shall camp according to their armies, and Nahshon the son of Amminadab shall be the leader of the children of Judah. And his army was numbered at seventy-four thousand six hundred.

Numbers 2:32,33 All who were numbered according to their armies of the forces were six hundred and three thousand five hundred and fifty. But the Levites were not numbered among the children of Israel, just as the LORD commanded Moses.

Numbers 3:1-3 Now these are the records of Aaron and Moses when the LORD spoke with Moses on Mount Sinai. And these are the names of the sons of Aaron: Nadab, the firstborn, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar. These are the names of the sons of Aaron, the anointed priests, whom he consecrated to minister as priests.

Numbers 3:14-17 Then the LORD spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, saying: Number the children of Levi by their fathers houses, by their families, you shall number every male from a month old and above. So Moses numbered them according to the word of the LORD,

as he was commanded. These were the sons of Levi by their names: Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.

Numbers 3:25,26 The duties of the **children of Gershon** in the tabernacle of meeting included the tabernacle, the tent with its covering, the screen for the door of the tabernacle of meeting, the screen for the door of the court, the hangings of the court which are around the tabernacle and the altar, and their cords, according to all the work relating to them.

Numbers 3:30,31 And the leader of the fathers' house of the families of **the Kohathites** was Elizaphan the son of Uzziel. Their duty included the ark, the table, the lampstand, the altars, the utensils of the sanctuary with which they ministered, the screen, and all the work relating to them.

Numbers 3:36,37 And the appointed duty of the **children of Merari** included the boards of the tabernacle, its bars, its pillars, its sockets, its utensils, all the work relating to them, and the pillars of the court all around, with their sockets, their pegs, and their cords.

Numbers 3:39 All who were numbered of the Levites, whom Moses and Aaron numbered at the commandment of the LORD, by their families, all the males from a month old and above, were twenty-two thousand.

Numbers 3:40 Then the LORD said to Moses: Number all the firstborn males of the children of Israel from a month old and above and take the number of their names.

Numbers 3:43 And all the firstborn males, according to the number of names from a month old and above, of those who were numbered of them, were twenty-two thousand two hundred and seventy-three.

Numbers 4:1-3 Then the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: Take a census of the sons of Kohath from among the children of Levi, by their families, by their fathers house, from thirty years old and above,

even to fifty years old, all who enter the service to do the work in the tabernacle of meeting.

JEREMIAH 36,4,5,6

Daniel 1:1,2 In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah, *Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon* came to Jerusalem and besieged it. And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with some of the articles of the house of God, which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god, and he brought the articles into the treasure house of his god.

2 Kings 24:1 In his (Jehoiakim's) days Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up, and Jehoiakim became his vassal for three years. Then he turned and rebelled against him.

Jeremiah 25:1 The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah (which was the first year of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon),

Jeremiah 36:1,2 Now it came to pass in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah, that this word came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying: Take a scroll of a book and write on it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel, against Judah, and against all the nations, from the day I spoke to you, **from the days of Josiah** even to this day.

Jeremiah 36:3,4 It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the adversities which I purpose to bring upon them, that everyone may turn from his evil way, that I may forgive their iniquity and their sin. Then Jeremiah called **Baruch the son of Neriah, and Baruch wrote on a scroll of a book, at the instruction of Jeremiah, all the words** of the LORD which He had spoken to him.

Jeremiah 36:5-7 And Jeremiah commanded Baruch, saying, I am confined, I cannot go into the house of the LORD. You go, therefore,

and read from the scroll which you have written at my instruction, the words of the LORD, in the hearing of the **people in the LORD's house on the day of fasting**. And you shall also read them in the hearing of all Judah who come from their cities. It may be that they will present their supplication before the LORD, and everyone will turn from his evil way. For great is the anger and the fury that the LORD has pronounced against this people.

Jeremiah 45:1-5 The word that Jeremiah the prophet spoke to Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had **written these words in a book** at the instruction of Jeremiah, **in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah**, king of Judah, saying, Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, to you, O Baruch: You said, Woe is me now! For the LORD has added grief to my sorrow. I fainted in my sighing, and I find no rest. Thus you shall say to him, **Thus says the LORD**: Behold, what I have built I will break down, and what I have planted I will pluck up, that is, this whole land. And do you seek great things for yourself? Do not seek them, for behold, I will bring adversity on all flesh, says the LORD. But I will give your life to you as a prize in all places, wherever you go.

Jeremiah 36:9 Now it came to pass in the **fifth year of Jehoiakim** the son of Josiah, king of Judah, **in the ninth month, that they proclaimed a fast** before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people who came from the cities of Judah to Jerusalem.

Jeremiah 36:10 Then Baruch read from the book the words of **Jeremiah in the house of the LORD**, in the chamber of Gemariah the son of Shaphan the scribe, in the upper court at the entry of the New Gate of the LORD's house, in the hearing of all the people.

Jeremiah 36:13,14 Then Michaiah declared to them (The Princes) all the words that he had heard when Baruch read the book in the hearing of the people. Therefore, all the princes sent Jehudi the son of Nethaniah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Cush, to Baruch, saying, Take in your hand the scroll from which you have read in the hearing of the people, and come. So, Baruch the son of Neriah took the scroll in his hand and came to them.

Jeremiah 36:15-19 And they said to him, Sit down now, and read it in our hearing. So Baruch read it in their hearing. Now it happened, when they had heard all the words, that they looked in fear from one to another, and said to Baruch, We will surely tell the king of all these words. And they asked Baruch, saying, Tell us now, how did you write all these words at his (Jeremiah's) instruction? So, Baruch answered them, He proclaimed with his mouth all these words to me, and I wrote them with ink in the book. Then the princes said to Baruch, Go and hide, you and Jeremiah; and let no one know where you are.

Jeremiah 36:20,21 And they went to the king, into the court, but they stored the scroll in the chamber of Elishama the scribe and **told all the words in the hearing of the king**. So, the king sent Jehudi **to bring the scroll**, and he took it from Elishama the scribe's chamber. And **Jehudi read it** in the hearing of the king and in the hearing of all the princes who stood beside the king.

Jeremiah 36:22,23 Now the king was sitting in the winter house **in the ninth month**, with a fire burning on the hearth before him. And it happened, when Jehudi had read **three or four columns**, that the king cut it with the scribe's knife and cast it into the fire that was on the hearth, until all the scroll was consumed in the fire that was on the hearth.

Jeremiah 36:24-26 Yet they were not afraid, nor did they tear their garments, the king nor any of his servants who heard all these words. Nevertheless **Elnathan, Delaiah, and Gemariah implored the king not to burn the scroll, but he would not listen to them**. And the king commanded Jerahmeel the king's son, Seraiah the son of Azriel, and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel, to seize Baruch the scribe and Jeremiah the prophet, but the LORD hid them.

Daniel 2:1 Now in the second year of Nebuchadnezzar's reign, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams, and his spirit was so troubled that his sleep left him.

Daniel 3:23-25 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace. Then

King Nebuchadnezzar was astonished, and he rose in haste and spoke, saying to his counselors, Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said to the king, True, O king. Look! he answered, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

Jeremiah 36:27-29 Now after the king had burned the scroll with the words which Baruch had written at the instruction of Jeremiah, the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, saying: **Take yet another scroll, and write on it all the former words that were in the first scroll which Jehoiakim the king of Judah has burned.** And you shall say to Jehoiakim king of Judah, Thus says the LORD: You have burned this scroll, saying, Why have you written in it that the king of Babylon will certainly come and destroy this land, and cause man and beast to cease from here?

Jeremiah 36:30,31 Therefore thus says the LORD concerning Jehoiakim king of Judah: He shall have no one to sit on the throne of David, and his dead body shall be cast out to the heat of the day and the frost of the night. I will punish him, his family, and his servants for their iniquity, and I will bring on them, on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and on the men of Judah all the doom that I have pronounced against them, but they did not heed.

Jeremiah 36:32 Then Jeremiah took another scroll and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah, who wrote on it at the instruction of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire. And besides, there were added to them many similar words.

Jeremiah 4:1,2 If you will return, O Israel, says the LORD, Return to Me And if you will put away your abominations out of My sight, Then you shall not be moved. And you shall swear, The LORD lives, In truth, in judgment, and in righteousness, The nations shall bless themselves in Him, And in Him they shall glory.

Jeremiah 4:3,4 For thus says the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem: **Break up your fallow ground,** And do not sow among

thorns. Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, And take away the foreskins of your hearts, You men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, Lest My fury come forth like fire, And burn so that no one can quench it, Because of the evil of your doings.

Hosea 10:12 Sow for yourselves righteousness, Reap in mercy, Break up your fallow ground, For it is time to seek the LORD, Till He comes and rains righteousness on you.

Matthew 13:5-7 Some fell on **stony places**, where they did not have much earth, and they immediately sprang up because they had no depth of earth. But when the sun was up they were scorched, and because they had no root they withered away. And some fell among **thorns**, and the thorns sprang up and choked them.

Jeremiah 4:5,6 Declare in Judah and proclaim in Jerusalem and say: Blow the trumpet in the land, Cry, Gather together, And say, Assemble yourselves, And let us go into the fortified cities. Set up the standard toward Zion. Take refuge! Do not delay! For I will bring disaster from the north, And great destruction.

Jeremiah 4:10 Then I said, Ah, Lord GOD! Surely You have greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, Saying, You shall have peace, Whereas the sword reaches to the heart.

Jeremiah 4:22,23 For My people are foolish, They have not known Me. They are silly children, And they have no understanding. They are wise to do evil, But to do good they have no knowledge. I beheld the earth, and indeed it was without form, and void, And the heavens, they had no light.

Jeremiah 4:27,28 For thus says the LORD: The whole land shall be desolate, Yet I will not make a full end. For this shall the earth mourn, And the heavens above be black, Because I have spoken. I have purposed and will not relent, Nor will I turn back from it.

Jeremiah 4:31 For I have heard a voice as of a woman in labor, The anguish as of her who brings forth her first child, The voice of the

daughter of Zion bewailing herself, She spreads her hands, saying, Woe is me now, for my soul is weary Because of murderers!

Jeremiah 5:1,2 Run to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, See now and know, And seek in her open places **If you can find a man, If there is anyone who executes judgment, Who seeks the truth, And I will pardon her.** Though they say, As the LORD lives, Surely they swear falsely.

Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, are not Your eyes on the truth? You have stricken them, But they have not grieved, You have consumed them, But they have refused to receive correction. They have made their faces harder than rock, They have refused to return.

Jeremiah 5:11-14 For the house of Israel and the house of Judah Have dealt very treacherously with Me, says the LORD. They have lied about the LORD, And said, It is not He. Neither will evil come upon us, Nor shall we see sword or famine. And the prophets become wind, For the word is not in them. Thus, shall it be done to them. Therefore, thus says the LORD God of hosts: Because you speak this word, Behold, I will make My words in your mouth fire, And this people wood, And it shall devour them.

Jeremiah 5:18-22 Nevertheless in those days, says the LORD, I will not make a complete end of you. And it will be when you say, Why does the LORD our God do all these things to us? Then you shall answer them, Just as you have forsaken Me and served foreign gods in your land, so you shall serve aliens in a land that is not yours. Declare this in the house of Jacob And proclaim it in Judah, saying, Hear this now, O foolish people, Without understanding, Who have eyes and see not, And who have ears and hear not: Do you not fear Me? says the LORD. Will you not tremble at My presence, Who have placed the sand as the bound of the sea, By a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass beyond it?

Jeremiah 5:23-27 But this people have a defiant and rebellious heart, They have revolted and departed. They do not say in their heart, Let us now fear the LORD our God, Who gives rain, both the former and the latter, in its season. He reserves for us the appointed weeks of the

harvest. Your iniquities have turned these things away, And your sins have withheld good from you. For among My people are found wicked men, They lie in wait as one who sets snares, They set a trap, They catch men. As a cage is full of birds, So their houses are full of deceit. Therefore, they have become great and grown rich.

Jeremiah 5:30,31 An astonishing and horrible thing Has been committed in the land: The prophets prophesy falsely, And the priest's rule by their own power, And My people love to have it so. But what will you do in the end?

Jeremiah 6:10,11 To whom shall I speak and give warning, That they may hear? Indeed, their ear is uncircumcised, And they cannot give heed. Behold, the word of the LORD is a reproach to them, They have no delight in it. Therefore, I am full of the fury of the LORD. I am weary of holding it in.

Jeremiah 6:13,14 Because from the least of them even to the greatest of them, Everyone is given to **covetousness**, And from the prophet even to the priest, Everyone deals falsely. They have also healed the hurt of My people slightly, Saying, Peace, peace! When there is no peace.

Jeremiah 6:16,17 Thus says the LORD: Stand in the ways and see, And **ask for the old paths, where the good way is**, And walk in it, **Then you will find rest for your souls**. But they said, We will not walk in it. Also, I set watchmen over you, saying, Listen to the sound of the trumpet! But they said, We will not listen.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls**. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

Jeremiah 6:18,19 Therefore hear, you nations, And know, O congregation, what is among them. Hear, O earth! Behold, I will certainly bring calamity on this people The fruit of their thoughts, Because they have not heeded My words Nor **My law**, but rejected it.

Jeremiah 6:20 For what purpose to Me Comes frankincense from Sheba, And sweet cane from a far country? Your burnt offerings are not acceptable, Nor your sacrifices sweet to Me.
