## TORAH PORTION

**Deuteronomy 14:22,23** You shall truly tithe all the increase of your grain that the field produces year by year. And you shall eat before the LORD your God, in the place where He chooses to make His name abide, the tithe of your grain and your new wine and your oil, of the firstborn of your herds and your flocks, that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always.

**Deuteronomy 14:24,25** But if the journey is too long for you, so that you are not able to carry the tithe, or if the place where the LORD your God chooses to put His name is too far from you, when the LORD your God has blessed you, then you shall exchange it for money, take the money in your hand, and go to the place which the LORD your God chooses.

**Deuteronomy 14:26,27** And you shall spend that money for whatever your heart desires: For oxen or sheep, for wine or similar drink, for whatever your heart desires, you shall eat there before the LORD your God, and you shall rejoice, you and your household. You shall not forsake the Levite who is within your gates, for he has no part nor inheritance with you.

**Deuteronomy 14:28,29** At the end of every third year you shall bring out the tithe of your produce of that year and store it up within your gates. And the Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are within your gates, may come and eat and be satisfied, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.

**Deuteronomy 15:1,2** At the end of every seven years you shall grant a release of debts. And this is the form of the release: Every creditor who has lent anything to his neighbor shall release it; he shall not require it of his neighbor or his brother, **because it is called the LORD's release.**

**Deuteronomy 15:4-6** Except when there may be no poor among you, for the LORD will greatly bless you in the land which the LORD your

God is giving you to possess as an inheritance only if you carefully obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe with care all these commandments which I command you today. For the LORD your God will bless you just as He promised you, you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow, you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you.

**Deuteronomy 15:7,8** If there is among you a poor man of your brethren, within any of the gates in your land which the LORD your God is giving you, you shall not harden your heart nor shut your hand from your poor brother, but you shall open your hand wide to him and willingly lend him sufficient for his need, whatever he needs.

**Deuteronomy 15:9,10** Beware lest there be a wicked thought in your heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand, and your eye be evil against your poor brother and you give him nothing, and he cry out to the LORD against you, and it become sin among you. You shall surely give to him, and your heart should not be grieved when you give to him, because for this thing the LORD your God will bless you in all your works and in all to which you put your hand.

**Deuteronomy 15:13-15** And when you send him away free from you, you shall not let him go away empty-handed, you shall supply him liberally from your flock, from your threshing floor, and from your winepress. From what the LORD your God has blessed you with, you shall give to him. You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God redeemed you, therefore, I command you this thing today.

**Deuteronomy 15:19-21** All the firstborn males that come from your herd and your flock you shall sanctify to the LORD your God, you shall do no work with the firstborn of your herd, nor shear the firstborn of your flock. You and your household shall eat it before the LORD your God year by year in the place which the LORD chooses. But if there is a defect in it, if it is lame or blind or has any serious defect, you shall not sacrifice it to the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 23:5** On the **fourteenth day of the first month** at twilight is the LORD's Passover.

**Deuteronomy 16:1-3** Observe the **month of Abib**, (Spring) and **keep the Passover** to the LORD your God, for in the month of Abib the LORD your God brought you out of Egypt by night. Therefore, you shall sacrifice the Passover to the LORD your God, from the flock and the herd, in the place where the LORD chooses to put His name. You shall eat no leavened bread with it; seven days you shall eat unleavened bread with it, that is, the bread of affliction (for you came out of the land of Egypt in haste), that you may remember the day in which you came out of the land of Egypt all the days of your life.

**Deuteronomy 16:8** Six days you shall eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day there shall be a sacred assembly to the LORD your God. You shall do no work on it.

**Deuteronomy 16:10,11** Then you shall keep the Feast of Weeks to the LORD your God with the tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give as the LORD your God blesses you. You shall rejoice before the LORD your God, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, the Levite who is within your gates, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are among you, at the place where the LORD your God chooses to make His name abide.

**Deuteronomy 16:13-15** You shall observe the Feast of Tabernacles seven days, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress. And you shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant and the Levite, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, who are within your gates. Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD chooses, because the LORD your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you surely rejoice.

**Deuteronomy 16:16,17** Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses: At the Feast

of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles, and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed. Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God which He has given you.

**Numbers 28:26** Also on the day of the first-fruits, when you bring a new grain offering to the LORD at your Feast of Weeks, you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work.

**Habakkuk 2:20** But the LORD is in His holy temple. Let all the earth keep silence before Him.

**Habakkuk 3:2** O LORD, I have heard Your speech and was afraid, O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy.

**Habakkuk 3:3b-5** His glory covered the heavens, And the earth was full of His praise. His brightness was like the light; He had rays flashing from His hand, And there His power was hidden. Before Him went pestilence, And fever followed at His feet.

**Habakkuk 3:6** He stood and measured the earth, He looked and startled the nations. And the everlasting mountains were scattered, The perpetual hills bowed. His ways are everlasting.

**Habakkuk 3:10-12** The mountains saw You and trembled, The overflowing of the water passed by. The deep uttered its voice And lifted its hands on high. The sun and moon stood still in their habitation, At the light of Your arrows they went, At the shining of Your glittering spear. You marched through the land in indignation; You trampled the nations in anger.

**Habakkuk 3:13** You went forth for the salvation of Your people, For salvation with Your **Anointed**. You struck the head from the house of the wicked, By laying bare from foundation to neck.

**Habakkuk 3:14,15** You thrust through with his own arrows The head of his villages. They came out like a whirlwind to scatter me, Their

rejoicing was like feasting on the poor in secret. You walked through the sea with Your horses, Through the heap of great waters.

**Habakkuk 3:16** When I heard, my body trembled, My lips quivered at the voice, Rottenness entered my bones; And I trembled in myself, That I might rest in the day of trouble. When he comes up to the people, He will invade them with his troops.

**Habakkuk 3:17-19** Though the fig tree may not blossom, Nor fruit be on the vines, Though the labor of the olive may fail, And the fields yield no food, Though the flock may be cut off from the fold, And there be no herd in the stalls **Yet I will rejoice in the LORD**, I will joy in the God of my salvation. The LORD God is my strength, **He will make my feet like deer's feet, And He will make me walk on my high hills.**

**Exodus 19:16-18** Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain, and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain. Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly.

**Exodus 19:19,20** And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice. Then the LORD came down upon Mount Sinai, on the top of the mountain. And the LORD called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.

**Acts 1:9-11** Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, who also said, Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.

**Acts 1:18,19** (Now **this man purchased a field** with the wages of iniquity, and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his entrails gushed out. And it became known to all those dwelling in Jerusalem, so that field is called in their own language, Akel Dama, that is, Field of Blood.)

**Jeremiah 18:1-6** The word which came to **Jeremiah** from the LORD, saying: Arise and go down to the **potter's** house, and there I will cause you to hear My words. Then I went down to the **potter's** house, and there he was, making something at the wheel. And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the **potter**, so he made it again into another vessel, as it seemed good to the **potter** to make. Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying: O house of Israel, can I not do with you as this **potter**? says the LORD. Look, as the clay is in the **potter's** hand.

**Matthew 27:5-8** Then he threw down the pieces of silver in the temple and departed, and went and hanged himself. But the chief priests took the silver pieces and said, It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because they are the price of blood. And they consulted together and **bought with them the potter's field**, to bury strangers in. Therefore that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day.

**Matthew 27:9,10** Then was fulfilled what was spoken by **Jeremiah** the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the value of Him who was priced, whom they of the children of Israel priced, and gave them for the **potter's field**, as the LORD directed me.

**Zechariah 11:12,13** Then I said to them, If it is agreeable to you, give me my wages, and if not, refrain. So they weighed out for my wages thirty pieces of silver. And the LORD said to me, Throw it to the **potter** that princely price they set on me. So I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them into the house of the LORD for the **potter**.

### **Zechariah : Potter: 2**

**Acts 2:1-3** When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from

heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.

## JEREMIAH 7,8,10,13

**Jeremiah 7:2-4** The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying, Stand in the gate of the LORD's house, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all you of Judah who enter in at these gates to worship the LORD! Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Amend your ways and your doings, and I will cause you to dwell in this place. Do not trust in these lying words, saying, The temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD are these.

**Jeremiah 7:5-7** For if you thoroughly amend your ways and your doings, if you thoroughly execute judgment between a man and his neighbor, if you do not oppress the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and do not shed innocent blood in this place, or walk after other gods to your hurt, then I will cause you to dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers forever and ever.

**Jeremiah 7:10,11** Behold, you trust in lying words that cannot profit. Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, burn incense to Baal, and walk after other gods whom you do not know, and then come and stand before Me in this house, which is called by My name, and say, We are delivered to do all these abominations? Has this house, which is called by My name, become a den of thieves in your eyes? Behold, I, even I, have seen it, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 7:12-14** But go now to My place which was in Shiloh, where I set My name at the first, and see what I did to it because of the wickedness of My people Israel. And now, because you have done all these works, says the LORD, and I spoke to you, rising up early and speaking, but you did not hear, and I called you, but you did not answer, therefore I will do to the house which is called by My name, in which

you trust, and to this place which I gave to you and your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh.

**Jeremiah 7:16** “Therefore **do not pray for this people**, nor lift up a cry or prayer for them, nor make intercession to Me; for I will not hear you.

**Jeremiah 7:23,24** But this is what I commanded them, saying, Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you. Yet they did not obey or incline their ear but followed the counsels and the dictates of their evil hearts and went backward and not forward.

**Jeremiah 7:30,31** For the children of Judah have done evil in My sight,” says the LORD. “They have set their abominations in the House which is called by My name, to pollute it. And they have built the high places of Tophet, which is in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire, which I did not command, nor did it come into My heart.

**Jeremiah 7:33,34** The corpses of this people will be food for the birds of the heaven and for the beasts of the earth. And no one will frighten them away. Then I will cause to cease from the cities of Judah and from the streets of Jerusalem the voice of mirth and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride. For the land shall be desolate.

**Jeremiah 8:5-7** Why has this people slidden back, Jerusalem, in a perpetual backsliding? They hold fast to deceit, They refuse to return. I listened and heard, But they do not speak aright. No man repented of his wickedness, Saying, What have I done?’ Everyone turned to his own course, As the horse rushes into the battle. Even the stork in the heavens Knows her appointed times, And the turtledove, the swift, and the swallow Observe the time of their coming. But My people do not know the judgment of the LORD.

**Jeremiah 8:8,9** How can you say, We are wise, And the law of the LORD is with us? Look, the false pen of the scribe certainly works

falsehood. The wise men are ashamed, They are dismayed and taken. Behold, they have rejected the word of the LORD, So what wisdom do they have?

**Jeremiah 9:23,24** Thus says the LORD: Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty man glory in his might, Nor let the rich man glory in his riches, But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I am the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 8:20-22** The harvest is past, The summer is ended, And we are not saved! For the hurt of the daughter of my people, I am hurt. I am mourning, Astonishment has taken hold of me. Is there no balm in Gilead, Is there no physician there? Why then is there no recovery For the health of the daughter of my people?

**Jeremiah 10:1-4** Hear the word which the LORD speaks to you, O house of Israel. Thus says the LORD: Do not learn the way of the Gentiles, Do not be dismayed at the signs of heaven, For the Gentiles are dismayed at them. For the customs of the peoples are futile, For one cuts a tree from the forest, The work of the hands of the workman, with the ax. They decorate it with silver and gold, They fasten it with nails and hammers So that it will not topple.

**Jeremiah 10:6,7** Inasmuch as there is none like You, O LORD (You are great, and Your name is great in might), Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your rightful due. For among all the wise men of the nations, And in all their kingdoms, There is none like You.

**Jeremiah 10:10,11** But the LORD is the true God; He is the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth will tremble, And the nations will not be able to endure His indignation. Thus, you shall say to them: The gods that have not made the heavens and the earth shall perish from the earth and from under these heavens.

**Jeremiah 10:12,13** He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His wisdom and has stretched out the heavens at His discretion. When He utters His voice, There is a multitude of waters in the heavens: And He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasures.

**Jeremiah 10:20,21** My tent is plundered, And all my cords are broken, My children have gone from me, And they are no more. There is no one to pitch my tent anymore Or set up my curtains. For the shepherds have become dull-hearted And have not sought the LORD, Therefore, they shall not prosper, And all their flocks shall be scattered.

**Jeremiah 10:23,24** O LORD, I know the way of man is not in himself, It is not in man who walks to direct his own steps. O LORD, correct me, but with justice, Not in Your anger, lest You bring me to nothing.

**Jeremiah 10:25** Pour out Your fury on the Gentiles, who do not know You, And on the families who do not call on Your name, For they have eaten up Jacob, Devoured him and consumed him, And made his dwelling place desolate.

**Jeremiah 13:1,2** Thus the LORD said to me: Go and get yourself a linen sash, and put it around your waist, but do not put it in water. So I got a sash according to the word of the LORD and put it around my waist.

**Jeremiah 13:3-5** And the word of the LORD came to me the second time, saying, Take the sash that you acquired, which is around your waist, and arise, go to the Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole in the rock. So, I went and hid it by the Euphrates, as the LORD commanded me.

**Jeremiah 13:6,7** Now it came to pass after many days that the LORD said to me, Arise, go to the Euphrates, and take from there the sash which I commanded you to hide there. Then I went to the Euphrates and dug, and I took the sash from the place where I had hidden it, and there was the sash, ruined. It was profitable for nothing.

**Jeremiah 13:8-10** Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thus says the LORD: In this manner I will ruin the pride of Judah and the great pride of Jerusalem. This evil people, who refuse to hear My words, who follow the dictates of their hearts, and walk after other gods to serve them and worship them, shall be just like this sash which is profitable for nothing.

**Jeremiah 13:11** For as the sash clings to the waist of a man, so I have caused the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah **to cling to Me**, says the LORD, ‘that they may become My people, for renown, for praise, and for glory; but they would not hear.

**Jeremiah 13:13,14** Then you shall say to them, Thus says the LORD: Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land even the kings who sit on David’s throne, the priests, the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with drunkenness! And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together, says the LORD. I will not pity nor spare nor have mercy but will destroy them.

**Jeremiah 13:15,16** Hear and give ear: Do not be proud, For the LORD has spoken. Give glory to the LORD your God Before He causes darkness, And before your feet stumble On the dark mountains, And while you are looking for light, He turns it into the shadow of death And makes it dense darkness.

**Jeremiah 13:17** But if you will not hear it, My soul will weep in secret for your pride, My eyes will weep bitterly And run down with tears, Because the LORD’s flock has been taken captive.

**Jeremiah 23:1,2** Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture! says the LORD. Therefore, thus says the LORD God of Israel against the shepherds who feed My people: You have scattered My flock, driven them away, and not attended to them. Behold, I will attend to you for the evil of your doings, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 23:3,4** But I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries where I have driven them and bring them back to their folds, and they shall be fruitful and increase. I will set up shepherds over them

who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 23:5,6** Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth. In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely, Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

**Jeremiah 23:7,8** Therefore, behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that they shall no longer say, As the LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt, but, As the LORD lives who brought up and led the descendants of the house of Israel from the north country and from all the countries where I had driven them. And they shall dwell in their own land.

**Jeremiah 23:9** My heart within me is broken Because of the prophets, All my bones shake. I am like a drunken man, And like a man whom wine has overcome, Because of the LORD, And because of His holy words.

**Jeremiah 23:11,12** For both prophet and priest are profane, Yes, in My house I have found their wickedness, says the LORD. Therefore, their way shall be to them Like slippery ways, In the darkness they shall be driven on And fall in them For I will bring disaster on them, The year of their punishment, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 23:14** Also I have seen a horrible thing in the prophets of Jerusalem: They commit adultery and walk in lies, They also strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that no one turns back from his wickedness. All of them are like Sodom to Me, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.

**Revelation 11:8** And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

**Jeremiah 23:15** Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets: Behold, I will feed them with wormwood And make them drink the water of gall, For from the prophets of Jerusalem Profaneness has gone out into all the land.

**Revelation 8:11** The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.
