## TORAH PORTION

**Numbers 12:15** And **Miriam** was shut out from the camp seven days: And the people **journeyed not** till Miriam was brought in again. And afterward the people removed from Hazeroth, and pitched in the wilderness of Paran.

**Numbers 13:1-3** And the **LORD** spoke to Moses, saying, **Send you men**, that they may **search** (spy) the land of Canaan, which I give to the children of Israel: Of every tribe of their fathers shall **you send** a man, **everyone a ruler** among them. And **Moses by the commandment of the LORD sent them** from the wilderness of Paran: All those men were heads of the children of Israel.

**Deuteronomy 1:20-23** And I said to you, You are come to the mountain of the Amorites, which the LORD our God does give to us. Behold, the LORD your God has set the land before you: Go up and possess it, as the LORD God of your fathers has said to you, fear not, neither be discouraged. **And you came near to me every one of you**, and said, **We will send men before us**, and they shall **search** us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

**Deuteronomy 1:24** And they turned and went up into the mountain, and came unto the valley of Eshcol, and **searched** <ragal> it out.

**Numbers 13:16-20** These are the names of the men which Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses called **Oshea** the son of Nun **Jehoshua**. And **Moses sent them to spy** out the land of Canaan, and said to them, Get you up this way **southward**, and go up into the mountain: And see the land, what it is, and the people that dwells therein, whether they be strong or weak, few or many, And what the land is that they dwell in, whether it be good or bad, and what cities they be that they dwell in, whether in tents, or in strong holds, **And what the land is, whether it be fat or lean, whether there be wood**

therein, or not. And be you of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time was the time of the first ripe grapes.

**Ezekiel 20:1** And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month, that certain of the elders of Israel came to inquire of the LORD, and sat before me.

**Ezekiel 20:5-8** And say to them, Thus said the Lord GOD, In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up my hand to the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known to them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up my hand to them, saying, I am the LORD your God, In the day that I lifted up my hand to them, to bring them forth of the land of Egypt into a land that I had espied for them, flowing with milk and honey, which is the glory of all lands: Then said I to them, Cast you away every man the abominations of his eyes, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I am the LORD your God. But they rebelled against me, and would not listen to me: They did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, **neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt.**

**Numbers 13:22-24** And they ascended by the south, and came to Hebron, where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmi, the children of Anak, were. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.) And they came to the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from there a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bore it between two on a staff, and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs. The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes which the children of Israel cut down from there.

**Joshua 15:13** Even the city of Arba the father of Anak, which city is Hebron. And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmi, the children of Anak.

**Psalms 78:42-45** How he had wrought his signs in Egypt, and his wonders **in the field of Zoan**: And had turned their rivers into blood, and their floods, that they could not drink. He sent divers sorts of flies among them, which devoured them; and frogs, which destroyed them.

**Psalm 78:12-14** Marvellous things did he in the sight of their fathers, in the land of Egypt, in the **field of Zoan**. He divided the sea, and caused them to pass through, and he made the waters to stand as an heap. In the daytime also he led them with a cloud, and all the night with a light of fire.

**Numbers 13:28,29** Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and **the cities are walled**, and very great: and moreover **we saw** the children of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: And the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: And the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

**Numbers 13:32** And they spread an **evil report** of the land which they had spied out unto the children of Israel, saying: The land, through which we have passed to spy it out, is a land that **eateth up the inhabitants** thereof, and all the people that we saw in it are men of great stature.

**Ezekiel 36:8-15** But you, mountains of Israel, you shall shoot forth your branches and yield your fruit to my people Israel, for they are at hand to come. For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn into you, and you shall be tilled and sown, and I will multiply men on you, all the house of Israel, even all of it, and the cities shall be inhabited, and the waste places shall be built, and I will multiply on you man and animal, and they shall increase and be fruitful, and I will cause you to be inhabited after your former estate, and will do better [to you] than at your beginnings: And you shall know that I am the LORD. Yes, I will cause men to walk on you, even my people Israel, and they shall possess you, and you shall be their inheritance, and you shall no more henceforth bereave them of children. Thus says the Lord GOD: Because they say to you, **You are a devourer of men**, and have been a bereaver of your nation, therefore you shall devour men no more, neither bereave your nation any more, says the Lord GOD, neither will I let you hear any more the shame of the nations, neither shall you bear the reproach of the peoples any more, neither shall you cause your nation to stumble any more, says the Lord GOD.

**Numbers 13:30** And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it, for we are well able to overcome it.

**Numbers 13:33** And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: And we were **in our own sight** as grasshoppers, and so we were in **their sight**.

**Numbers 14:22-24** Because all these men, having **seen my glory** and the signs which I have done in Egypt and in the waste land, still have put me to the test ten times, and have not given ear to my voice, They **will not see the land** about which **I made an oath to their fathers**, not one of these by whom I have not been honored will see it. **But my servant Caleb**, because he had a different spirit in him, and has been true to me with all his heart, him I will take into that land into which he went, and his seed will have it for their heritage.

**Joshua 2:9-11** And she said to the men, I know that the LORD has given you the land, and that your terror is fallen on us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you. For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites, that were on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom you utterly destroyed. And as soon as we had heard these things, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: For the LORD your God, he is God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

**Joshua 2:23,24** So the two men returned, and descended from the mountain, and passed over, and came to Joshua the son of Nun, and told him all things that befell them: And they said to Joshua, Truly the LORD has delivered into our hands all the land, for even all the inhabitants of the country do faint because of us.

**Numbers 14:1-4** And all the congregation lifted up their voice and cried, and the people wept that night. And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: And the whole congregation said to them, Would God that we had died in the land

of Egypt! Or would God we had died in this wilderness! And why has the LORD brought us to this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? Were it not better for us to return into Egypt? And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

**Deuteronomy 11:7-9** But your eyes have seen all the great acts of the LORD which he did. Therefore shall you keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land, where you go to possess it, And that you may prolong your days in the land, which the LORD swore to your fathers to give to them and to their seed, a land that flows with milk and honey.

**Numbers 14:6-9** And **Joshua the son of Nun**, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes: And **they spoke** to all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land. If the LORD delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us, a land which flows with milk and honey. Only rebel not you against the LORD, neither fear you the people of the land, for they are bread for us: their defense is departed from them, and the LORD is with us: Fear them not.

**Numbers 14:11,12** And the LORD said to Moses, How long will this people ~~provoke~~ **defame** me? And how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them? I will smite them with the pestilence, and **disinherit kill them, and will make of you a greater nation and mightier than they.**

**Numbers 14:15-19** Now if **you shall kill all this people** as one man, then the nations which have heard the fame of you will speak, saying, Because **the LORD was not able** to bring this people into the land which he swore to them, therefore he has slain them in the wilderness. And now, I beseech you, let the **power of my LORD be Great**, according as you have spoken, saying, The LORD is **long-suffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the**

iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation. **Pardon**, Forgive I beseech you, the iniquity of this people according to **the greatness of your mercy**, and as you have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

**Numbers 14:26-29** And the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying, How long shall I bear with this evil congregation, which murmur against me? I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel, which they murmur against me. Say to them, As truly as I live, said the LORD, as you have spoken in my ears, so will I do to you: Your carcasses shall fall in this wilderness, and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward which have murmured against me.

**Numbers 14:30** Not one will come into the land which I gave my word you would have for your resting-place, but **only Caleb**, the son of Jephunneh, **and Joshua**, the son of Nun.

*12 were sent – 2 received the promise.*

**Romans 10:14,15** How then shall they **call on him** in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

*Shelach – To send The Father sent Yeshua, who sent the Holy Spirit who has now sent you realize God is stronger than all the giants in your life! The world, the flesh and the evil one!*

## **JEREMIAH 24, 29, 46-48**

**Jeremiah 24:1,2** The LORD showed me, and there were two baskets of figs set before the temple of the LORD, **after Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim, king of Judah**, and the princes of Judah with the craftsmen and smiths, from Jerusalem, and had brought them to Babylon. One basket had very good figs, like the figs that are first

ripe, and the other basket had very bad figs which could not be eaten, they were so bad.

**Jeremiah 24:3-7** Then the LORD said to me, What do you see, Jeremiah? And I said, **Figs, the good figs, very good, and the bad, very bad, which cannot be eaten**, they are so bad. Again, the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: Like these good figs, so will I acknowledge those who are carried away captive from Judah, whom I have sent out of this place for their own good, into the land of the Chaldeans. For I will set My eyes on them for good, and I will bring them back to this land, I will build them and not pull them down, and I will plant them and not pluck them up. Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the LORD, and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.

**Jeremiah 24:8-10** And as the bad figs which cannot be eaten, they are so bad surely thus says the LORD so will I give up Zedekiah the king of Judah, his princes, the residue of Jerusalem who remain in this land, and those who dwell in the land of Egypt. I will deliver them to trouble into all the kingdoms of the earth, for their harm, to be a reproach and a byword, a taunt and a curse, in all places where I shall drive them. And I will send the sword, the famine, and the pestilence among them, till they are consumed from the land that I gave to them and their fathers.

**Jeremiah 29:1,2** Now these are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent **from Jerusalem to the remainder of the elders who were carried away captive** to the priests, the prophets, and all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon. (This happened after Jeconiah the king, the queen mother, the eunuchs, the princes of Judah and Jerusalem, the craftsmen, and the smiths had departed from Jerusalem.)

**Jeremiah 29:3,4** The letter was sent by the hand of Elasah the son of Shaphan, and Gemariah the son of Hilkiah, whom Zedekiah king of Judah sent to Babylon, to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, to all who

were carried away captive, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem to Babylon:

**Jeremiah 29:5-7** Build houses and dwell in them, plant gardens and eat their fruit. Take wives and beget sons and daughters, and take wives for your sons and give your daughters to husbands, so that they may bear sons and daughters that you may be increased there and not diminished. And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the LORD for it, for in its peace you will have peace.

**Jeremiah 29:8,9** For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are in your midst deceive you, nor listen to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed. For they prophesy falsely to you in My name; I have not sent them, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 29:10-13** For thus says the LORD: After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you and cause you to return to this place. For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. **Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.**

**Jeremiah 29:14** I will be found by you, says the LORD, and I will bring you back from your captivity, I will gather you from all the nations and from all the places where I have driven you, says the LORD, and I will bring you to the place from which I cause you to be carried away captive.

**Jeremiah 29:15-19** Because you have said, The LORD has raised up prophets for us in Babylon therefore thus says the LORD concerning the king who sits on the throne of David, concerning all the people who dwell in this city, and concerning your brethren who have not gone out with you into captivity thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, I will send on them the sword, the famine, and the

pestilence, and will make them like rotten figs that cannot be eaten, they are so bad. And I will pursue them with the sword, with famine, and with pestilence, and I will deliver them to trouble among all the kingdoms of the earth to be a curse, an astonishment, a hissing, and a reproach among all the nations where I have driven them, because they have not heeded My words, says the LORD, which I sent to them by My servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, neither would you heed, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 29:20,21** Therefore hear the word of the LORD, all you of the captivity, whom I have sent from Jerusalem to Babylon. Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning Ahab the son of Kolaiah, and Zedekiah the son of Maaseiah, who prophesy a lie to you in My name: Behold, I will deliver them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and he shall slay them before your eyes.

**Jeremiah 29:22,23** And because of them a curse shall be taken up by all the captivity of Judah who are in Babylon, saying, The LORD make you like Zedekiah and Ahab, whom the king of Babylon roasted in the fire, because they have done disgraceful things in Israel, have committed adultery with their neighbors' wives, and have spoken lying words in My name, which I have not commanded them. Indeed, I know and am a witness, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 29:30-32** Then the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, saying: Send to all those in captivity, saying, Thus says the LORD concerning Shemaiah the Nehelamite: Because Shemaiah has prophesied to you, and I have not sent him, and he has caused you to trust in a lie therefore thus says the LORD: Behold, I will punish Shemaiah the Nehelamite and his family: He shall not have anyone to dwell among this people, nor shall he see the good that I will do for My people, says the LORD, because he has taught rebellion against the LORD.

**Jeremiah 46:1,2** The word of the LORD which came to Jeremiah the prophet against the nations. Against Egypt. Concerning the army of Pharaoh Necho, king of Egypt, which was by **the River**

**Euphrates in Carchemish**, and which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon defeated in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah.

**Jeremiah 46:10** For this is the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, A day of vengeance, That He may avenge Himself on His adversaries. The sword shall devour, It shall be satiated and made drunk with their blood, For the Lord GOD of hosts has a sacrifice In the north country by the River Euphrates.

**Jeremiah 46:13-15** The word that the LORD spoke to Jeremiah the prophet, how Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon would come and strike the land of Egypt. Declare in Egypt and proclaim in Migdol, Proclaim in Noph and in Tahpanhes; Say, Stand fast and prepare yourselves, For the sword devours all around you. Why are your valiant men swept away? They did not stand Because the LORD drove them away.

**Jeremiah 46:16,17** He made many fall, Yes, one fell upon another. And they said, Arise! Let us go back to our own people And to the land of our nativity From the oppressing sword. They cried there, Pharaoh, king of Egypt, is but a noise. He has passed by the appointed time!

**Jeremiah 46:18-21** As I live, says the King, Whose name is the LORD of hosts, Surely as Tabor is among the mountains And as Carmel by the sea, so he shall come. O you daughter dwelling in Egypt, Prepare yourself to go into captivity! For Noph shall be waste and desolate, without inhabitant. Egypt is a very pretty heifer, But destruction comes, it comes from the north. Also her mercenaries are in her midst like fat bulls, For they also are turned back, They have fled away together. They did not stand, For the day of their calamity had come upon them, The time of their punishment.

**Jeremiah 46:22-24** Her noise shall go like a serpent, For they shall march with an army And come against her with axes, Like those who chop wood. They shall cut down her forest, says the LORD, Though it cannot be searched, Because they are innumerable, And

more numerous than grasshoppers. The daughter of Egypt shall be ashamed, She shall be delivered into the hand Of the people of the north.

**Jeremiah 46:25,26** The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, says: Behold, I will bring punishment on Amon of No, and Pharaoh and Egypt, with their gods and their kings Pharaoh and those who trust in him. And I will deliver them into the hand of those who seek their lives, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon and the hand of his servants. Afterward it shall be inhabited as in the days of old, says the LORD.

**Jeremiah 46:27** But do not fear, O My servant Jacob, And do not be dismayed, O Israel! For behold, I will save you from afar, And your offspring from the land of their captivity, Jacob shall return, have rest and be at ease; No one shall make him afraid.

**Jeremiah 46:28** Do not fear, O Jacob My servant, says the LORD, For I am with you, For I will make a complete end of all the nations To which I have driven you, But I will not make a complete end of you. I will rightly correct you, For I will not leave you wholly unpunished.

**Jeremiah 47:1** The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Philistines, before Pharaoh attacked Gaza.

**Jeremiah 47:4,5** Because of the day that comes to plunder all the Philistines, To cut off from Tyre and Sidon every helper who remains, For the LORD shall plunder the Philistines, The remnant of the country of Caphtor. Baldness has come upon Gaza, Ashkelon is cut off With the remnant of their valley. How long will you cut yourself?

**Jeremiah 47:6,7** O you sword of the LORD, How long until you are quiet? Put yourself up into your scabbard, Rest and be still! How can it be quiet, Seeing the LORD has given it a charge Against Ashkelon and against the seashore? There He has appointed it.

**Jeremiah 48:1,2** Against Moab. Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Woe to Nebo! For it is plundered, Kirjathaim is shamed and taken, The high stronghold is shamed and dismayed No more praise of Moab. In Heshbon they have devised evil against her: Come and let us cut her off as a nation. You also shall be cut down, O Madmen! The sword shall pursue you.

**Jeremiah 48:6-8** “Flee, save your lives! And be like the juniper in the wilderness. For because you have trusted in your works and your treasures, You also shall be taken. And Chemosh shall go forth into captivity, His priests and his princes together. And the plunderer shall come against every city, No one shall escape. The valley also shall perish, And the plain shall be destroyed, As the LORD has spoken.

**Jeremiah 48:10** Cursed is he who does the work of the LORD deceitfully, And cursed is he who keeps back his sword from blood.

**Jeremiah 48:29-31a** We have heard the pride of Moab (He is exceedingly proud), Of his loftiness and arrogance and pride, And of the haughtiness of his heart. I know his wrath, says the LORD, But it is not right, His lies have made nothing right. Therefore, I will wail for Moab, And I will cry out for all Moab.

**Jeremiah 48:43,44** Fear and the pit and the snare shall be upon you, O inhabitant of Moab, says the LORD. He who flees from the fear shall fall into the pit, And he who gets out of the pit shall be caught in the snare. For upon Moab, upon it I will bring The year of their punishment, says the LORD.
