TORAH

Numbers 16:1-3 Now **Korach**, קרח the son of *Izhar*, the son of *Kohath*, the son of *Levi*, and ***Dathan and Abiram***, the sons of *Eliab*, and **On**, the son of *Peleth*, ***sons of Reuben***, took men: And they rose up before Moses, with certain of the children of Israel, two hundred and fifty princes of the assembly, famous in the congregation, men of renown: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them, Ye take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation are holy every one of them, and the LORD is among them: Wherefore then lift ye up yourselves above the congregation of the LORD?

Numbers 14:35 I the LORD have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: In this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Numbers 14:39-42 And when Moses put these words before the children of Israel, the people were full of grief. And early in the morning they got up and went to the top of the mountain, saying, We are here and we will go up to the place which the Lord said he would give us: For we have done wrong. And Moses said, Why are you now acting against the Lord's order, seeing that no good will come of it? Go not up, for the Lord is not with you, and you will be overcome by those who are fighting against you.

Deuteronomy 14:1,2 You are the children of the LORD your God: **You shall not cut yourselves**, nor make any **baldness** קרחה between your eyes **for the dead**. For you are a **holy people** to the LORD your God, and the LORD has **chosen you to be a people for his own possession, above all peoples** who are on the face of the earth.

Numbers 16:4-7 When Moses heard it, he fell on his face: And he spoke to Korah and to all his company, saying, In the morning the LORD will show who are his, and who is holy, and will cause him to come near to him: Even him whom he shall choose he will cause to come near to him. Do this: Take censers, Korah, and all his

Company, and put fire in them, and put incense on them before the LORD tomorrow: And it shall be that the man whom the LORD chooses, he shall be holy. You have gone too far, you sons of Levi!

Numbers 16:10-12 And He has brought you near to him, and all your brothers the sons of Levi with you. And you seek the priesthood also? For which cause both **you and all your company are gathered against the LORD**. And what is Aaron, that you murmur against him? And Moses sent to call **Dathan and Abiram**, the sons of **Eliab** which said, **We will not come up.**

Numbers 16:13 Is it a small thing that you have brought us up out of a land flowing with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, but you must also make yourself a prince over us?

Exodus 2:13,14 He went out the second day, and behold, **two men of the Hebrews were fighting with each other**. He said to him who did the wrong, Why do you strike your fellow? He said, **Who made you a prince and a judge over us?** Do you plan to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? Moses was afraid, and said, Surely this thing is known.

Numbers 16:21-27 Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment. And they **fell on their faces**, and said, O God, the God of the spirits of all flesh, shall one man sin, and will you be wroth with all the congregation? And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the congregation, saying, **Get you up from about the tabernacle** of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram. And **Moses rose up** and went unto Dathan and Abiram, and the elders of Israel followed him. And he spoke to the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of theirs, lest ye be consumed in all their sins. So they got up from the tabernacle of Korah, Dathan, and Abiram, on every side: and Dathan and Abiram came out, and stood in the door of their tents, and **their wives, and their sons, and their little children.**

Numbers 16:30,31 But if the LORD make a new thing, and **the earth open her mouth** and swallow them up with all that appertain unto them, and they go down alive into the pit, then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD. And it came to pass, as he had made an end of speaking all these words, the ground clave asunder that was under them.

Numbers 16:33-35 They, and all that [appertained] to them, went down alive into the pit, and the earth closed upon them: and they perished from among the congregation. And all Israel that [were] round about them fled at the cry of them: for they said, Lest the earth swallow us up [also]. And there came out a fire from the Lord, and consumed the two hundred and fifty men that offered incense.

Revelations 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Psalms 106:13-18,24,25 They hurried and forgot His works, they did not wait for His counsel, but they lusted greedily in the wilderness, and tested God in the desert. And He gave them what they asked, but sent leanness into their soul. And they were jealous of Moses in the camp, and Aaron the saint of the LORD. The earth opened and swallowed up Dathan, and covered the company of Abiram. And a fire was kindled in their company, the flame burned up the wicked. And they despised the pleasant land, they did not believe His word, but murmured in their tents, and did not listen to the voice of the LORD.

Numbers 16:41 But on the next day all the congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron saying, *You have killed the LORD'S people!*

Numbers 16:44-48 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **Get away from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment!** They fell on their faces. Moses said to Aaron, Take your

censer, and put fire from off the altar in it, and lay incense on it, and carry it quickly to the congregation, and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone out from the LORD! The plague has begun. Aaron did as Moses said, and ran into the midst of the assembly; and behold, the plague has begun among the people: And he put on the incense, and made atonement for the people. He stood between the dead and the living; and the plague was stayed.

Numbers 16:49 Now they that **died in the plague** were fourteen thousand and seven hundred, beside them that died about the matter of Korah.

Numbers 17:12,13 And the children of Israel spoke to Moses, saying, Behold, we die, we perish, we all perish. Whoever comes any thing near to the tabernacle of the LORD shall die: shall we be consumed with dying?

Numbers 17:8-10 And it came to pass, that on the morrow Moses went into the tabernacle of witness, and, behold, the rod of Aaron for the house of Levi was budded, and brought forth buds, and bloomed blossoms, and yielded almonds. And Moses brought out all the rods from before the LORD to all the children of Israel: And they looked, and took every man his rod. And the LORD said to Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again *before the testimony*, to be kept for a token against the rebels, and you shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

Numbers 17:11 And Moses did so: As the LORD commanded him, so did he.

1 Corinthians 10:10,11 Neither **murmur** ye, as some of them also **murmured**, and **were destroyed** of the destroyer. *Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples:*

Numbers 26:11 Notwithstanding the children of Korah died not.

JEREMIAH 49-51

Jeremiah 48:46,47 Woe be unto thee, O Moab! The people of Chemosh perishes: For thy sons are taken captives, and thy daughters captives. Yet will I bring again the captivity of Moab in the latter days, saith the LORD. Thus far is the judgment of Moab.

Jeremiah 49:1,2 Concerning the Ammonites, thus saith the LORD, Hath Israel no sons? Hath he no heir? Why then doth their king inherit Gad, and his people dwell in his cities? Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will cause an alarm of war to be heard in Rabbah of the Ammonites; and it shall be a desolate heap, and her daughters shall be burned with fire: Then shall Israel be heir unto them that were his heirs, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 49:5,6 Behold, I will bring a fear upon thee, saith the Lord GOD of hosts, from all those that be about thee, and ye shall be driven out every man right forth, and none shall gather up him that wanders. And afterward I will bring again the captivity of the children of Ammon, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 49:7,8 Concerning Edom, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Is wisdom no more in Teman? Is counsel perished from the prudent? Is their wisdom vanished? Flee ye, turn back, dwell deep, O inhabitants of Dedan, for I will bring the calamity of Esau upon him, the time that I will visit him.

Jeremiah 49:13 For I have sworn by myself, saith the LORD, that Bozrah shall become a desolation, a reproach, a waste, and a curse, and all the cities thereof shall be perpetual wastes.

Jeremiah 49:17,18 Also Edom shall be a desolation: Everyone that goeth by it shall be astonished and shall hiss at all the plagues thereof. **As in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah** and the neighbor cities thereof, saith the LORD, no man shall abide there, neither shall a son of man dwell in it.

Jeremiah 49:21,22 The earth is moved at the noise of their fall, at the cry the noise thereof was heard in the Red sea. Behold, he shall come up and fly as the eagle and spread his wings over Bozrah: And at that day shall the heart of the mighty men of Edom be as the heart of a woman in her pangs.

Jeremiah 49:23,24 Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: For they have heard evil tidings: They are fainthearted, there is sorrow on the sea, it cannot be quiet. Damascus is waxed feeble, and turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on her: Anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

Jeremiah 49:28 Concerning Kedar, and concerning the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon shall smite, thus saith the LORD, Arise ye, go up to Kedar, and spoil the men of the east.

Jeremiah 49:30 Flee, get you far off, dwell deep, **O ye inhabitants of Hazor,** saith the LORD, for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath taken counsel against you, and hath conceived a purpose against you.

Jeremiah 49:34-36 The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet **against Elam** in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, I will break the bow of Elam, the chief of their might. And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven and will scatter them toward all those winds, and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.

Genesis 10:22 The children of Shem, Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram.

Ezekiel 32:24,25 There is Elam And all her multitude round about her grave, all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which are gone down uncircumcised into the nether parts of the earth, which caused their terror in the land of the living, yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit. They have set her a bed in the midst of the slain with all her multitude: Her graves are round about

him: All of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword: Though their terror was caused in the land of the living, yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit: He is put in the midst of them that be slain.

Daniel 8:2 And I saw in a vision, and it came to pass, when I saw, that I was at **Shushan in the palace, which is in the province of Elam**, and I saw in a vision, and I was by the river of Ulai.

Jeremiah 49:37-39 For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: And I will bring evil upon them, even my fierce anger, saith the LORD, and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them: And I will set my throne in Elam, and will destroy from thence the king and the princes, saith the LORD. But it shall come to pass in the latter days, that I will bring again the captivity of Elam, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 50:1,2 The word that the LORD spoke **against Babylon** and against the land of the Chaldeans by Jeremiah the prophet. Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard, publish, and conceal not: Say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces, her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

Jeremiah 50:4,5 In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: They shall go, and seek the LORD their God. They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant that shall not be forgotten.

Jeremiah 50:6,7 **My people hath been lost sheep:** their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: They have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their resting place. All that found them have devoured them: And their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.

Matthew 10:5,6 Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: But go rather **to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.**

Jeremiah 50:13-15 Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: everyone that goes by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues. Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: All ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: For she hath sinned against the LORD. Shout against her round about: She hath given her hand: Her foundations are fallen, her walls are thrown down: For it is the vengeance of the LORD: Take vengeance upon her, **as she hath done, do unto her.**

Jeremiah 50:17,18 Israel is a scattered sheep, the lions have driven him away: **First the king of Assyria** hath devoured him, and **last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon** hath broken his bones. Therefore, thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

Jeremiah 50:19,20 And I will bring Israel again to his habitation, and he shall feed on Carmel and Bashan, and his soul shall be satisfied upon mount Ephraim and Gilead. In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, **the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none, and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: For I will pardon them whom I reserve.**

Jeremiah 50:23,24 How is the hammer of the whole earth cut asunder and broken! How is Babylon become a desolation among the nations! I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, **O Babylon**, and thou was not aware: Thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD

Jeremiah 50:27,28 Slay all her bullocks, let them go down to the slaughter: Woe unto them! For their day is come, the **time of their visitation.** The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of

Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple.

Luke 19:44 And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee, and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another, **because you knew not the time of your visitation.**

Jeremiah 50:31,32 Behold, I am against thee, O thou most proud, saith the Lord GOD of hosts: For thy day is come, the time that I will visit thee. And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: And I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him.

Jeremiah 50:40 As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbor cities thereof, saith the LORD; so shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein.

Jeremiah 50:43 The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: Anguish took hold of him, and pangs as of a woman in travail.

Jeremiah 50:46 At the noise of the taking of Babylon the earth is moved, **and the cry is heard among the nations.**

Revelation 18:9,10 And **the kings of the earth**, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, **shall bewail her, and lament for her**, when they shall see the smoke of her burning, Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour is thy judgment come.

Jeremiah 51:1,2 Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will raise up against Babylon, and against them that dwell in the midst of them that rise up against me, a destroying wind, And will send unto Babylon fanners, that shall fan her, and shall empty her land: For **in the day of trouble** they shall be against her round about.

Jeremiah 51:5-7 For Israel hath not been forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; **though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel. Flee out of the midst of Babylon** and deliver every man his soul be not cut off in her iniquity; for **this is the time of the LORD's vengeance**; he will render unto her a recompence. **Babylon hath been a golden cup in the LORD's hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore, the nations are mad.**

Revelation 17:3-6 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: And I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet colored beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, **having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication**: And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. And I saw **the woman drunken** with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Yeshua and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

Jeremiah 51:8,9 Babylon is suddenly fallen and destroyed: Howl for her, take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed. We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: Forsake her and let us go everyone into his own country: For her judgment reaches unto heaven and is lifted up even to the skies.

Jeremiah 51:13 O thou that **dwellest upon many waters**, abundant in treasures, thine end is come, and the measure of thy covetousness.

Revelation 17:1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither, I will shew unto thee **the judgment of the great whore that sits upon many waters.**

Jeremiah 51:15,16 He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding. When he utters his voice, there is a

multitude of waters in the heavens, and he causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth: He maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures.

Jeremiah 51:19-21 The portion of Jacob is not like them, for he is the former of all things: And Israel is the rod of his inheritance: The LORD of hosts is his name. **You are my battle axe and weapons of war:** For with you will I break in pieces the nations, and with you will I destroy kingdoms, And with you will I break in pieces the horse and his rider, and with you will I break in pieces the chariot and his rider.

Jeremiah 51:24,25 And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the LORD. Behold, I am against you, **O destroying mountain**, saith the LORD, which **destroys all the earth**: And I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and **roll thee down from the rocks, and will make you a burnt mountain.**

Revelation 8:8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a **great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea**: And the third part of the sea became blood, And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died, and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

Jeremiah 51:29 And the land shall tremble and sorrow: For **every purpose of the LORD shall be performed against Babylon**, to make the land of Babylon a desolation without an inhabitant.

Jeremiah 51:36,37 Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, **I will plead your cause and take vengeance for you**, and I will dry up her sea and make her springs dry. And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwelling place for dragons, an astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.

Jeremiah 51:45-47 My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD. And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumor that shall be heard

in the land, a rumor shall both come one year, and after that in another year shall come a rumor, and violence in the land, ruler against ruler. Therefore, behold, the days come, that I will do judgment upon the graven images of Babylon: And her whole land shall be confounded, and all her slain shall fall in the midst of her.

Jeremiah 51:59 The word which Jeremiah the prophet commanded Seraiah the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah into Babylon in **the fourth year of his reign**. And this Seraiah was a quiet prince.

Jeremiah 51:60-64 So Jeremiah wrote in a book all the evil that should come upon Babylon, even all these words that are written against Babylon. And Jeremiah said to Seraiah, When thou come to Babylon, and shalt see, and shalt read all these words, Then shalt thou say, O LORD, thou hast spoken against this place, to cut it off, that none shall remain in it, neither man nor beast, but that **it shall be desolate forever**. And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, that thou shalt **bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates**: And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: And they shall be weary. Thus far are the words of Jeremiah.

Revelation 18:21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.
