TORAH

Numbers 19:1,2 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, This is the ordinance of the law which the LORD hath commanded, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring thee a **red heifer** without spot, wherein is no blemish, and upon which never came yoke.

Numbers 19:3,4 And ye shall give her unto Eleazar the priest, that he may bring her forth without the camp, and one shall slay her before his face. פניו (panay) And Eleazar the priest shall take of her blood with his finger, and sprinkle of her blood directly before the tabernacle of the congregation seven times.

Numbers 19:6-8 And the priest shall take cedar wood, and hyssop, and scarlet, and cast it into the midst of the burning of the heifer. Then the priest shall wash his clothes, and he shall bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp, and the priest shall be unclean until the even. And he that burneth her shall wash his clothes in water, and bathe his flesh in water, and shall be unclean until the even.

Leviticus 1:3 If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: He shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before פניו the LORD.

Numbers 19:13,14 Whosoever toucheth the dead body of any man that is dead, and purifieth not himself, defileth the tabernacle of the LORD, and that soul shall be cut off from Israel: Because the water of separation was not sprinkled upon him, he shall be unclean, his uncleanness is yet upon him. This is the law, **when a man dieth in a tent**: All that come into the tent, and all that is in the tent, shall be unclean seven days.

Ezekiel 36:24-28 For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own

land. Then will **I sprinkle clean water** upon you, and ye shall be clean: From all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: And I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Numbers 19:17,18 And for an unclean person they shall take of the ashes of the burnt heifer of purification for sin, and **running water** shall be put thereto in a vessel: And **a clean person** shall take hyssop, and dip it in the water, and sprinkle it upon the tent, and upon all the vessels, and upon the persons that were there and upon him that touched a bone, or one slain, or one dead, or a grave.

Numbers 20:1-5 Then came the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the **first month**: And the people abode in Kadesh, and Miriam מרים died there and was buried there. And there was no water for the congregation: And they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron. And the people chode with Moses, and spoke, saying, **Would God that we had died** when our brethren died before the LORD! And why have ye brought up the congregation of the LORD into this wilderness, that we and our cattle should die there? And wherefore have ye made us to come up out of Egypt, to bring us in unto this evil place? It is no place of seed, or of figs, or of vines, or of pomegranates, neither is there any water to drink.

Numbers 20:6-10 And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: And the glory of the LORD appeared unto them. And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto (the) rock before their eyes, and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: So thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him. And

Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, **ye rebels**, must we fetch you water out of this rock?

Numbers 20:11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: And the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: And that Rock was Messiah.

Numbers 22:2 Now **Balak** the son of Zippor saw all that Israel had done to the Amorites.

Numbers 22:3-5 And **Moab was exceedingly afraid** of the people because they were many, and Moab was **sick with dread** because of the children of Israel. So **Moab said to the elders of Midian**, Now this company will lick up everything around us, as an ox licks up the grass of the field. And Balak the son of Zippor was **king of the Moabites at that time**. Then he sent messengers **to Balaam** the son of Beor at Pethor, which is near the River in the land of the sons of his people, to call him, saying: Look, a people has come from Egypt. See, they cover the face of the earth, and are settling next to me!

Numbers 22:6 Therefore please come at once, curse this people for me, for they are too mighty for me. Perhaps I shall be able to defeat them and drive them out of the land, for I know that **he whom you bless is blessed, and he whom you curse is cursed.**

Numbers 22:7-12 So the elders of Moab and the elders of Midian departed with the fees for divination in their hand. And they came to Balaam and gave him Balak's message. And he said to them, Lodge here tonight, and I will bring back word to you, as the Lord speaks to me. So the princes of Moab stayed with Balaam. And God came to Balaam and said, Who are these men with you? And Balaam said to God, Balak the son of Zippor, king of Moab, has sent to me, saying, Behold, a people has come out of Egypt, and it covers the

face of the earth. Now come, curse them for me. Perhaps I shall be able to fight against them and drive them out. God said to Balaam, **You shall not go with them. You shall not curse the people, for they are blessed.**

Numbers 22:13 So Balaam rose in the morning and said to the princes of Balak, Go to your own land, for the Lord has refused to let me go *with you*.

Numbers 22:14 So the princes of Moab rose and went to Balak and said, **Balaam refuses to come with us.**

Numbers 22:15-20 Once again Balak sent princes, more in number and more honorable than these. And they came to Balaam and said to him, Thus says Balak the son of Zippor: Let nothing hinder you from coming to me, for I will surely do you great honor, and whatever you say to me I will do. Come, curse this people for me. But Balaam answered and said to the servants of Balak, Though Balak were to give me his house full of silver and gold, I could not go beyond the command of the Lord my God to do less or more. So you, too, please stay here tonight, that I may know what more the Lord will say to me. And God came to Balaam at night and said to him, If the men have come to call you, rise, **go with them**, but only **do** what I tell you.

Numbers 22:21 So Balaam rose in the morning and saddled his donkey and **went with** the princes of Moab.

Numbers 22:22 But God's anger was kindled because **he went**, and the angel of the Lord took his stand in the way as his adversary. **Now he was riding on the donkey, and his two servants were with him.**

Numbers 22:23-28 And **the ass saw the angel of the LORD** standing in the way, and **his sword drawn** in his hand: And the ass turned aside out of the way, and went into the field: And Balaam smote the ass, to turn her into the way. But the **angel of the LORD** stood in a path of the vineyards, a wall being on this side, and a wall on that side. And when **the ass saw the angel of the LORD**, she

thrust herself unto the wall, and **crushed Balaam's foot** against the wall: And he smote her again. And the angel of the LORD went further, and stood in a narrow place, where was no way to turn either to the right hand or to the left. And when **the ass saw the angel of the LORD**, she fell down under Balaam: And Balaam's anger was kindled, and he smote the ass with a staff. And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, **What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times?**

Numbers 22:29 And Balaam said unto the ass, **Because thou hast mocked me: I would there were a sword in mine hand, for now would I kill thee.**

Numbers 22:31-33 Then the LORD **opened the eyes** of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his **sword drawn in his hand**: And he bowed down his head, and fell flat on his face. And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Wherefore hast thou smitten thine ass these three times? Behold, I went out to withstand thee, because thy way is perverse before me: And the ass saw me, and turned from me these three times: Unless she had turned from me, surely now also I had slain thee, and saved her alive.

Revelation 2:12,14 And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write, These things saith he which hath **the sharp sword with two edges**, I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: And you hold fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth. But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

Numbers 25:6,7 And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his brethren a Midianitish woman **in the sight of Moses**, and **in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who were weeping before the door of the tabernacle of the**

congregation. And when **Phinehas**, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, saw it, he rose up from among the congregation, and took a javelin in his hand.

JEREMIAH 27, 28, 20, 21

Jeremiah 27:2,3 Thus saith the LORD to me, Make thee bonds and yokes, and put them upon thy neck, And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah.

Jeremiah 27:4,5 And command them **to say unto their masters**, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of **Israel**, Thus shall ye **say unto your masters, I have made the earth**, the man and the beast that are upon the ground, by my great power and by my outstretched arm, **and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto me.**

Jeremiah 27:6,7 And now have I given all these lands into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and the beasts of the field have I given him also to serve him. And all nations shall serve him, and his son, and his son's son, until the very time of his land come: And then many nations and great kings shall serve themselves of him.

Jeremiah 27:8 And it shall come to pass, that the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

Jeremiah 27:9,10 Therefore **hearken not ye to your prophets**, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon: For they prophesy a lie unto you, to remove you far from your land, and that I should drive you out, and ye should perish.

Jeremiah 27:11,12 But the nations that bring their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him, those will I let remain still in their own land, saith the LORD, and they shall till it, and dwell therein. I spoke also to Zedekiah king of Judah according to all these words, saying, Bring your necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him and his people, and live.

Jeremiah 27:13-15 Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon? Therefore, **hearken not unto the words of the prophets** that speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon: For they prophesy a lie unto you. For I have not sent them, saith the LORD, yet they **prophesy a lie in my name**, that I might drive you out, and that ye might perish, ye, and the prophets that prophesy unto you.

Jeremiah 27:16,17 Also I spoke to the priests and to all this people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; **Hearken not to the words of your prophets** that prophesy unto you, saying, Behold, the vessels of the LORD's house shall now shortly be brought again from Babylon: For they prophesy a lie unto you. Hearken not unto them, serve the king of Babylon, and live: wherefore should this city be laid waste?

Jeremiah 27:18 But if they be prophets, and if the word of the LORD be with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, **that the vessels which are left** in the house of the LORD, and in the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, go not to Babylon.

Jeremiah 27:19-22 For thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the pillars, and concerning **the sea**, and concerning the bases, and concerning the residue of the vessels that remain in this city, Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem, Yea, thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning the vessels that remain in the house of the LORD, and in the house of the king of Judah and of Jerusalem, **They shall be carried to Babylon**, and

there shall they be until the day that I visit them, saith the LORD, then will I bring them up, and restore them to this place.

Jeremiah 28:1-3 And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, **in the fourth year**, and in the **fifth month**, that **Hananiah** the son of Azur the prophet, which was of Gibeon, spoke unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying, Thus speaks the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon. Within **two full years** will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD's house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon:

Jeremiah 51:59,60 The word which Jeremiah the prophet commanded Seraiah the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah into Babylon in the fourth year of his reign. And this Seraiah was a quiet prince. So Jeremiah wrote in a book all the evil that should come upon Babylon, even all these words that are written against Babylon.

Jeremiah 51:63,64 And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, that thou shalt **bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates:** And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: And they shall be weary.

Revelation 18:21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

Ezekiel 1:1 Now it came to pass **in the thirtieth year, in the fourth month**, in the fifth day of the month, as I was among the captives by the river of Chebar, that the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God.

Ezekiel 8:1-3b And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me. Then I beheld, and lo a likeness as the appearance of fire: From the appearance of his loins even downward, fire, and from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the color of amber. And he put forth the form of a hand, and took me by a lock of mine head, and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem,

Ezekiel 20:1 And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month, that certain of the elders of Israel came to enquire of the LORD, and sat before me.

Ezekiel 24:1,2 Again in the ninth year, in the tenth month, in the tenth day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, write thee the name of the day, even of this same day: The king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

Ezekiel 29:1 In the tenth year, in the tenth month, in the twelfth day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying.

Ezekiel 29:17,18 And it came to pass in the seven and twentieth year, in the first month, in the first day of the month, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon caused his army to serve a great service against Tyrus.

Jeremiah 28:4-6 And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: For I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon. Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD, Even the prophet Jeremiah said, Amen: The LORD do so: The LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again the vessels of the LORD's house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place.

Jeremiah 28:7-9 Nevertheless hear thou now this word that I speak in thine ears, and in the ears of all the people, The prophets that have been before me and before you of old prophesied both against many countries, and against great kingdoms, of **war, and of evil, and of pestilence**. The prophet which prophesies of peace, when the word of the prophet shall come to pass, then shall the prophet be known, that the LORD hath truly sent him.

Jeremiah 28:10,11 Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck and brake it. And Hananiah spoke in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of **two full years**. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way.

Jeremiah 28:12-14 Then the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the prophet, after that Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying, Go and tell Hananiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD, You have broken the yokes of wood, but you shalt make for them yokes of iron. For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of **Israel**, I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and they shall serve him: and I have given him the beasts of the field also.

Jeremiah 28:15-17 Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah, The LORD hath not sent thee, but you make this people to trust in a lie. Therefore, thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will cast you from off the face of the earth: **This year you shalt die**, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. So Hananiah the prophet died the same year **in the seventh month**.

Jeremiah 21:1,2 The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when king Zedekiah **sent unto him, Pashur** the son of Melchiah, and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah the priest, saying, Enquire, I pray thee, of the LORD for us; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon makes war against us; if so be that the LORD will deal

with us according to all his wondrous works, that he may go up from us.

Jeremiah 21:3-6 Then said Jeremiah unto them, Thus shall ye say to Zedekiah: Thus saith the LORD God of **Israel**, Behold, **I will** turn back the weapons of war that are in your hands, wherewith ye fight against the king of Babylon, and against the Chaldeans, which besiege you without the walls, and **I will** assemble them into the midst of this city. And **I myself will fight against you** with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath. And **I will** smite the inhabitants of this city, both man and beast: they shall die of a great pestilence.

Jeremiah 21:7 And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: And he shall smite them with the edge of the sword, he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.

Jeremiah 21:8-10 And unto this people you shall say, Thus saith the LORD, **Behold, I set before you the way of life, and the way of death.** He that abides in this city shall die by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence: But he that goes out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be unto him for a prey. For I have set my face against this city for evil, and not for good, saith the LORD: It shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire.

Jeremiah 21:11-14 And touching the house of the king of Judah, say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O house of David, thus saith the LORD, Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver him that is spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings. Behold, I am against you, O inhabitant of the valley, and rock of the plain, saith the LORD, which say, Who shall come down against us? Or who shall enter into our habitations? **But I will** punish you

according to the fruit of your doings, saith the LORD: And **I will** kindle a fire in the forest thereof, and it shall devour all things round about it.

Jeremiah 20:1-3 Now **Pashur the son of Immer the priest**, who was also chief governor in the house of the LORD, heard that Jeremiah prophesied these things. Then Pashur smote Jeremiah the prophet and put him in the stocks that were in the high gate of Benjamin, which was by the house of the LORD. And it came to pass on the morrow, that Pashur brought forth Jeremiah out of the stocks. Then said Jeremiah unto him, The LORD hath not called your name Pashur, but Magormissabib..

Jeremiah 20:4 For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will make thee a terror to yourself, and to all thy friends: And they shall fall by the sword of their enemies, and your eyes shall behold it: And I will give all Judah into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall carry them captive into Babylon, and shall slay them with the sword.

Jeremiah 20:5,6 Moreover I will deliver all the strength of this city, and all the labors thereof, and all the precious things thereof, and all the treasures of the kings of Judah will I give into the hand of their enemies, which shall spoil them, and take them, and carry them to Babylon. And you, Pashur, and all that dwell in your house shall go into captivity: And you shall come to Babylon, and there you shall die, and shall be buried there, you, and all your friends, to whom you have prophesied lies.

Jeremiah 20:7,8 O LORD, you have deceived me, and I was deceived: You are stronger than I, and have prevailed: I am in derision daily, everyone mocks me. For since I spoke, I cried out, I cried violence and spoil; because the word of the LORD was made a reproach unto me, and a derision, daily.

Jeremiah 20:9,10 Then I said, I will not make mention of Him, nor speak any more in His name. But His word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay. For I heard the defaming of many, fear on every

side. Report, say they, and we will report it. All my familiars watched for my halting, saying, Peradventure he will be enticed, and we shall prevail against him, and we shall take our revenge on him.

Jeremiah 20:11,12 But the LORD is with me as a mighty terrible one: Therefore, my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: They shall be greatly ashamed, for they shall not prosper: Their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten. But, O LORD of hosts, that tries the righteous, and sees the reins and the heart, let me see your vengeance on them: for unto you have I opened my cause.

Jeremiah 20:13-17 Sing unto the LORD, praise ye the LORD: For he hath delivered the soul of the poor from the hand of evildoers. Cursed be the day wherein I was born let not the day wherein my mother bare me be blessed. Cursed be the man who brought tidings to my father, saying, A man child is born unto thee, making him very glad. And let that man be as the cities which the LORD overthrew and repented not: And let him hear the cry in the morning, and the shouting at noontide, Because he slew me not from the womb, or that my mother might have been my grave, and her womb to be always great with me.

Jeremiah 20:18 Wherefore came I forth out of the womb to see labor and sorrow, that my days should be consumed with shame?
