Numbers 23:26-30 But Balaam answered and said unto Balak, Told not I thee, saying, All that the **LORD** Speakes, that I must do? And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will **bring thee unto another place**, peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence. And Balak brought Balaam unto the top of Peor, that looketh toward Jeshimon. And Balaam said unto Balak, Build me here **seven altars**, and prepare me here **seven bullocks and seven rams**. And Balak did as Balaam had said, and **offered a bullock and a ram on every altar**.

Numbers 25:6,7 And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his brethren a **Midianitish woman** in the sight of Moses, and **in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who were weeping before the door** of the tabernacle of the congregation. And when **Phinehas**, the son of Eleazar, the **son of Aaron the priest**, saw it, he **rose up from among the congregation**, and took a javelin in his hand.

Exodus 2:16,17 Now the priest of Midian had **seven daughters**, and they came and drew water and filled the troughs to water their father's flock. The shepherds came and drove them away, but Moses stood up and saved them, and watered their flock.

Exodus 18:1 And Jethro, **the priest** of Midian, Moses' father-in-law,

Exodus 2:18 When they came home to their father **Reuel**, he said, How is it that you have come home so soon today?

Judges 4:11 Now Heber the Kenite, which was of the children of **Hobab the father in law of Moses**, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which is by Kedesh.

Exodus 6:23 And Aaron took him Elisheba, the daughter of Amminadab, the sister of Nahshon, to wife; and she bore him Nadab and Abihu, **Eleazar** and Ithamar.

Fatness of God

Exodus 6:25 **Eleazar**, Aaron's son, took as his wife **one of the daughters of Putiel**, and she bore him Phinehas.

Numbers 25:8,9 And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel. And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.

Numbers 25:10-13 And the LORD spoke unto Moses, saying, **Phinehas**, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, hath turned my wrath away from the children of Israel, while he was zealous for my sake among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in my jealousy. Wherefore say, Behold, I give unto him my covenant of peace: And he shall have it, and his seed after him, even **the covenant of an everlasting priesthood**, because he was zealous for his God, and made an atonement for the children of Israel.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: And the government shall be upon his shoulder: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, **The Prince of Peace**.

Numbers 25:14,15 The name of the slain man of Israel, who was killed with the Midianite woman, was Zimri the son of Salu, chief of a father's house belonging to the Simeonites. And the name of the Midianite woman who was killed was **Cozbi the daughter of Zur**, who was **the tribal head** of a father's house in Midian.

Numbers 31:8 They killed **the kings of Midian** with the rest of their slain, Evi, Rekem, **Zur**, Hur, and Reba, **the five kings of Midian**. And they also **killed Balaam** the son of Beor with the sword.

Numbers 4:35 From **thirty years old and upward even unto fifty years old**, everyone that enters into the service, for the work in the tabernacle of the congregation:

1 Chronicles 24:1-4 Now these are the divisions of the sons of Aaron. The sons of Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, **Eleazar**, and Ithamar. **But Nadab and Abihu died before their father, and had no children**: Therefore Eleazar and Ithamar executed the priest's office. And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service. And **there were more chief men found of the sons of Eleazar than of the sons of Ithamar**, and thus were they divided. Among the sons of Eleazar there were **sixteen chief men** of the house of their fathers, and **eight among the sons of Ithamar** according to the house of their fathers.

1 Chronicles 6:4-8a Eleazar begot Phinehas, Phinehas begot **Abishua**, and Abishua begot(*6 generations and then*) (**Ahitub begot Zadok**)

Ezra 7:1,2 Now after these things, in the reign of Artaxerxes king of Persia, **Ezra** the son of Seraiah, the son of Azariah, the son of Hilkiah, The son of Shallum, the **son of Zadok, the son of Ahitub**.

Ezra 7:5 The son of **Abishua, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the chief priest**.

Ezekiel 44:15,16 But the priests the Levites, **the sons of Zadok**, that kept the charge of My sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from Me, they shall come near to Me to minister unto Me, and they shall stand before Me to offer unto Me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD, they shall enter into My sanctuary, and they shall come near to My table, to minister unto Me, and they shall keep My charge.

Judges 20:27,28 And the children of Israel enquired of the LORD, (for the ark of the covenant of God was there in those days, And **Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, stood before it in those days,**) saying, Shall I yet again go out to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother, or shall I cease?

Romans 10:2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.

2 Samuel 21:1,2 Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year, and David enquired of the Lord. And the Lord answered, It is for Saul, and for his bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites. And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them, (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites, and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: And Saul sought to slay them **in his zeal** to the children of Israel and Judah.)

2 Kings 10:15-17 And when Jehu was departed thence, he lighted on Jehonadab the son of Rechab coming to meet him: And he saluted him, and said to him, Is thine heart right, as my heart is with thy heart? And Jehonadab answered, It is. If it be, give me thine hand. And he gave him his hand, and he took him up to him into the chariot. And he said, Come with me, and see **my zeal for the Lord**. So they made him ride in his chariot. And when he came to Samaria, he slew all that remained unto Ahab in Samaria, till he had destroyed him, according to the saying of the Lord, which he spake to Elijah.

2 Kings 10:28-31 Thus Jehu destroyed Baal out of Israel. Howbeit from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, to wit, the golden calves that were in Bethel, and that were in Dan. And the Lord said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing that which is right in mine eyes, and hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that was in mine heart, thy children of the fourth generation shall sit on the throne of Israel. **But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the Lord God of Israel with all his heart:** For he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

Genesis 12:6 And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Shechem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land.

18. And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and **Yaakov** the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the **Canaite** [the man from Cana],

1 Kings 19:7-14 And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise and eat; because the journey is too great for thee. And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat **forty days and forty nights** unto **Horeb the mount of God**. And there he went into a (The) cave, and spent the night in that place, and behold, the word of the LORD came to him, and He said to him, **What are you doing here, Elijah?** And he said, I have been very zealous for Jehovah the God of Hosts. For the sons of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, thrown down Your altars, and have slain Your prophets with the sword. And I, I alone, am left. And they seek to take my life away. And He said, Go forth and stand on the mountain before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind tore the mountains, and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD. But the LORD was not in the wind. And after the wind was an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake. And after the

earthquake was a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire was a still, small voice. And it happened when Elijah heard, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out, and stood at the cave entrance. And behold, a voice came to him and said, **What are you doing here, Elijah?** And he said, I have been very(zealously) **zealous for Jehovah, God of Hosts**, because the sons of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, have thrown down Your altars, and have slain Your prophets with the sword. And I, I alone, am left. And they seek to take my life away.

Exodus 13:20,21 And they moved on from Succoth and encamped at Etham, on the edge of the wilderness. And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night.

Exodus 33:22 And it shall come to pass, while my glory passes by, that I will put thee in a cleft of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by.

Acts 21:20 And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe, and they are all zealous of the law.

Numbers 28:1,2 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Command the people of Israel and say to them, My offering, My food for My food offerings, My pleasing aroma, **you shall be careful** to offer to Me at its appointed time.

Jeremiah 34,37,38

Jeremiah 34:1-3 The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and all his army, and all the kingdoms of the earth of his dominion, and all the people, fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities thereof, saying, Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, Go and speak to Zedekiah king of Judah, and tell him, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire: And thou shalt not

escape out of his hand, but shalt surely be taken, and delivered into his hand, and thine eyes shall behold the eyes of the king of Babylon, and he shall speak with thee mouth to mouth, and thou shalt go to Babylon.

Jeremiah 34:4-7 Yet hear the word of the LORD, O Zedekiah king of Judah, Thus saith the LORD of thee, Thou shalt **not die by the sword:** **But thou shalt die in peace:** And with the burnings of thy fathers, the former kings which were before thee, so shall they burn odors for thee, and they will lament thee, saying, Ah lord! for I have pronounced the word, saith the LORD. Then Jeremiah the prophet spoke all these words unto Zedekiah king of Judah in Jerusalem, When the king of Babylon's army fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities of Judah that were left, against Lachish, and against Azekah: For these defended cities remained of the cities of Judah.

Jeremiah 34:8,9 This is the word that came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, after that the **king Zedekiah had made a covenant** with all the people which were at Jerusalem, **to proclaim liberty** unto them, That every man should let his manservant, and every man his maidservant, being an Hebrew or an Hebrewess, go free, that none should serve himself of them, to wit, of a Jew his brother.

Jeremiah 34:10,11 Now when all the princes, and all the people, which **had entered into the covenant**, heard that everyone should let his manservant, and everyone his maidservant, go free, that none should serve themselves of them anymore, then they obeyed, and let them go. **But afterward they turned**, and caused the servants and the handmaids, whom they had let go free, to return, and brought them into subjection for servants and for handmaids.

Jeremiah 34:12-14 Therefore the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying, Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, I made a covenant with your fathers in the day that I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondmen, saying, **At the end of seven years** let ye go every man his brother an Hebrew, which hath been sold unto thee, and when he hath served thee six years, thou shalt let him go free from thee: But your fathers hearkened not unto me, neither inclined their ear.

Jeremiah 34:15,16 And ye were now turned, and had done right in my sight, **in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbor, and ye had made a covenant before me in the house which is called by my name:** **But ye turned and polluted my name,** and caused every man his servant, and every man his handmaid, whom ye had set at liberty at their pleasure, to return, and brought them into subjection, to be unto you for servants and for handmaids.

2 Chronicles 36:13 He also rebelled against King Nebuchadnezzar, **who had made him swear by God.**

Ezekiel 17:11 Then the word of the LORD came to me: Say now to the rebellious house, Do you not know what these things mean? Tell them, behold, the king of Babylon came to Jerusalem, and took her king and her princes and brought them to him to Babylon. And he took one of the royal offspring **and made a covenant with him,** putting him under oath (the chief men of the land he had taken away), that the kingdom might be humble and not lift itself up, and keep his covenant that it might stand. **But he rebelled against him by sending his ambassadors to Egypt, that they might give him horses and a large army.** Will he thrive? Can one escape who does such things? Can he break the covenant and yet escape?

Jeremiah 34:17-19 Therefore thus saith the LORD, **Ye have not hearkened unto me, in proclaiming liberty, everyone to his brother, and every man to his neighbor: Behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, saith the LORD, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the famine,** and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth. And I will give the men that have transgressed my covenant, which have not performed the words of the covenant which they had made before me, when they cut the calf in twain, and passed between the parts thereof, The princes of Judah, and the princes of Jerusalem, the eunuchs, and the priests, and all the people of the land, which passed between the parts of the calf.

Jeremiah 34:20,21 I will even give them into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life: And their dead bodies shall be for meat unto the fowls of the heaven, and to the beasts of the earth.

And Zedekiah king of Judah and his princes will I give into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life, and into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which are gone up from you.

Jeremiah 34:22 Behold, I will command, saith the LORD, and cause them to return to this city, and they shall fight against it, and take it, and burn it with fire: and I will make the cities of Judah a desolation without an inhabitant.

Jeremiah 37:4,5 Now Jeremiah came in and went out among the people: For they had not put him into prison. **Then Pharaoh's army came forth out of Egypt: And when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.**

Jeremiah 37:6-8 Then came the word of the LORD unto the prophet Jeremiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, Thus shall ye say to the king of Judah, that sent you unto me to enquire of me, Behold, Pharaoh's army, which is come forth to help you, **shall return to Egypt into their own land. And the Chaldeans shall come again, and fight against this city, and take it, and burn it with fire.**

Jeremiah 37:9,10 Thus saith the LORD, **Deceive not yourselves, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: For they shall not depart.** For though ye had smitten the whole army of the Chaldeans that fight against you, and there remained but wounded men among them, yet should they rise up every man in his tent and burn this city with fire.

Jeremiah 37:11,12 And it came to pass, that **when the army of the Chaldeans was broken up from Jerusalem for fear of Pharaoh's army,** Then Jeremiah went forth out of Jerusalem to go into the land of Benjamin, to separate himself thence in the midst of the people.

Jeremiah 37:13-15 And when he was in the gate of Benjamin, a captain of the ward was there, whose name was **Irijah, the son of Shelemiah,** the son of Hananiah, and he took Jeremiah the prophet, saying, You are falling away to the Chaldeans. Then said Jeremiah, It is false, I fall not away to the Chaldeans. But he hearkened not to him: So, Irijah took

Jeremiah and brought him to the princes. Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, **and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe**: For they had made that the prison.

Jeremiah 37:16,17 When Jeremiah was entered into the dungeon, and into the cabins, and Jeremiah had remained there many days, Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king **asked him secretly in his house**, and said, Is there any word from the LORD? And Jeremiah said, There is: For, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon.

Jeremiah 37:18,19 Moreover Jeremiah said unto king Zedekiah, What have I offended against thee, or against thy servants, or against this people, that ye have put me in prison? Where are now your prophets which prophesied unto you, saying, The king of Babylon shall not come against you, nor against this land?

Jeremiah 37:20,21 Therefore hear now, I pray thee, O my lord the king: Let my supplication, I pray thee, be accepted before thee, that thou **cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there.** Then Zedekiah the king commanded that they should commit Jeremiah into **the court of the prison**, and that they should give him daily a piece of bread out of the bakers' street, until all the bread in the city were spent. Thus, Jeremiah **remained in the court of the prison.**

Jeremiah 38:1-3 Then Shephatiah the son of Mattan, and Gedaliah the son of Pashur, and Jucal the son of Shelemiah, and Pashur the son of Malchiah, heard the words that Jeremiah had spoken unto all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD, He that remains in this city shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: But he that goeth forth to the Chaldeans shall live, for he shall have his life for a prey, and shall live. Thus saith the LORD, **This city shall surely be given into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which shall take it.**

Jeremiah 38:4 Therefore the princes said unto the king, We beseech thee, let this man be put to death: For thus he weakens the hands of the men of war that remain in this city, and the hands of all the people, in

speaking such words unto them: **For this man seeks not the welfare of this people, but the hurt.**

Jeremiah 38:5,6 Then Zedekiah the king said, **Behold, he is in your hand: For the king is not he that can do anything against you.** Then took they Jeremiah and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that was **in the court of the prison:** And they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon, there was no water, but mire: So Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

Jeremiah 38:7-9 Now when Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, one of the eunuchs which was in the king's house, heard that they had put **Jeremiah in the dungeon,** the king then sitting in the gate of Benjamin, Ebedmelech went forth out of the king's house, and spoke to the king, saying, My lord the king, these men have done evil in all that they have done to Jeremiah the prophet, whom **they have cast into the dungeon,** and he is like to die for hunger in the place where he is: For there is no more bread in the city.

Jeremiah 38:10-13 Then the king commanded Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, saying, Take from hence thirty men with thee, and take up Jeremiah the prophet out of the dungeon, before he dies. So Ebedmelech took the men with him and went into the house of the king under the treasury and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah. And Ebedmelech the Ethiopian said unto Jeremiah, Put now these old cast clouts and rotten rags under thine armholes under the cords. And Jeremiah did so. So, they drew up Jeremiah with cords and took him up out of the dungeon: And Jeremiah remained **in the court of the prison.**

Jeremiah 38:14-16 Then Zedekiah the king sent and took Jeremiah the prophet unto him into the third entry that is in the house of the LORD: And the king said unto Jeremiah, I will ask thee a thing, hide nothing from me. Then Jeremiah said unto Zedekiah, If I declare it unto thee, wilt thou not surely put me to death? And if I give thee counsel, wilt thou not hearken unto me? So, Zedekiah the king swore secretly unto Jeremiah, saying, As the LORD lives that made us this soul, I will not put thee to

death, neither will I give thee into the hand of these men that seek thy life.

Jeremiah 38:17,18 Then said Jeremiah unto Zedekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel, If thou wilt assuredly go forth unto the king of Babylon's princes, **then thy soul shall live, and this city shall not be burned with fire, and thou shalt live, and thine house:** But if thou wilt not go forth to the king of Babylon's princes, then shall this city be given into the hand of the Chaldeans, and they shall burn it with fire, and thou shalt not escape out of their hand.

Jeremiah 38:19,20 And Zedekiah the king said unto Jeremiah, **I am afraid** of the Jews that are fallen to the Chaldeans, lest they deliver me into their hand, **and they mock me.** But Jeremiah said, They shall not deliver thee. Obey, I beseech thee, the voice of the LORD, which I speak unto thee: So it shall be well unto thee, and thy soul shall live.

Jeremiah 38:21-23 But if thou refuse to go forth, this is the word that the LORD hath shewed me: And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house shall be brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those women shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: Thy feet are sunk in the mire, and they are turned away back. So, they shall bring out all thy wives and thy children to the Chaldeans: And thou shalt not escape out of their hand, but shalt be taken by the hand of the king of Babylon: And **thou shalt cause this city to be burned with fire.**

Jeremiah 38:24-26 Then said Zedekiah unto Jeremiah, Let no man know of these words, and thou shalt not die. But if the princes hear that I have talked with thee, and they come unto thee, and say unto thee, Declare unto us now what thou hast said unto the king, hide it not from us, and we will not put thee to death, also what the king said unto thee: Then thou shalt say unto them, I presented my supplication before the king, that **he would not cause me to return to Jonathan's house, to die there.**

Jeremiah 38:27,28 Then came all the princes unto Jeremiah and asked him: And he told them according to all these words that the king had commanded. So, they left off speaking with him, for the matter was not perceived. So, Jeremiah abode **in the court of the prison** until the day that Jerusalem was taken and he was there when Jerusalem was taken.
