Deuteronomy 1:1a These are the words which Moses spoke unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

Psalms 34:12,13 Who is the man who desires life, and loves many days, that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit.

Ephesians 4:29,31 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

The Israelites had constantly blamed Moses for their wilderness experience. In the end, they needed to face the hard truth: It wasn't Moses's fault, it was their fault. Their own negative attitudes and words kept them in the wilderness.

Deuteronomy 1:34,35 And the Lord heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I swore to give unto your fathers,

Deuteronomy 1:2,3 (There are **eleven days' journey from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.**) And it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the Lord had given him in commandment unto them.

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed unto yourselves, **lest ye forget the covenant** of the LORD your God, which he made with you, and make you a graven image, or the likeness of anything, which the LORD thy God hath forbidden thee.

Deuteronomy 4:9-13 Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, **lest thou forget** the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: But **teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons, Especially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD** thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and **I will make them hear my words**, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. And ye came near and stood under the mountain, and the mountain burned with fire unto the midst of heaven, with darkness, clouds, and thick darkness. And the **LORD spoke unto you out of the midst of the fire: Ye heard the voice of the words**, but saw no similitude, only ye heard a voice. And **he declared unto you his covenant**, which he commanded you to perform, **even ten commandments, and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.**

Deuteronomy 5:15 And **remember that you were a servant** in the land of Egypt, and that the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: Therefore, the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

Deuteronomy 7:17-19 If thou shalt say in thine heart, These nations are more than I, how can I dispossess them? Thou shalt **not be afraid of them**: But shalt well **remember** what the LORD thy God did unto

Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt, The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: So shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

Deuteronomy 8:2 And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provoked the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: From the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

Deuteronomy 24:9 Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 32:7-8 Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: Ask thy father, and he will shew thee, thy elders, and they will tell thee. When the most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 32:6 Is this your answer to the Lord, O foolish people and unwise? Is he not **your Father** who has given you life? He has made you and given you your place.

Deuteronomy 7:6-9 For you are an holy people unto the LORD your God: The LORD your God hath chosen you to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people, for ye were the fewest of all people: But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD

brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, **the faithful God**, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations.

Deuteronomy 1:22,23 And you came near to me every one of you, and said, We will send men before us, and they shall search us out the land, and bring us word again by what way we must go up, and into what cities we shall come. And the saying pleased me well: And I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe.

Deuteronomy 1:27 And ye murmured in your tents, and said, Because the Lord hated us, he hath brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us.

Matthew 25:24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew you that you are an hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not strewed.

Deuteronomy 1:29,30 Then I said unto you, Dread not, neither be afraid of them. The Lord your God which goes before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes.

Deuteronomy 1:31 And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the Lord thy God bare thee, as a man doth bear his son, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place. Yet in this thing ye did not believe the Lord your God.

Deuteronomy 1:32-35 Yet in this thing **you did not believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to show you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard **the voice of your words**, and was wroth, and swore, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this **evil generation** see that good land, which I swore to give unto your fathers,

Deuteronomy 1:39 Moreover **your little ones, that ye said should be a prey**, and your children, that this day have no knowledge of good or evil, they shall go in thither, and unto them will I give it, and they shall possess it.

Deuteronomy 1:45 And ye returned and **wept before the Lord, but the Lord would not hearken to your voice, nor give ear unto you.**

Deuteronomy 2:4,5 And command thou the people, saying, Ye are to pass through the coast of your brethren the **children of Esau**, which dwell in Seir, and they shall be afraid of you: Take ye good heed unto yourselves therefore: **Meddle not with them**, for I will not give you of their land, no, not so much as a foot breadth, because I have given mount Seir unto Esau for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:9 And the Lord said unto me, **Distress not the Moabites**, neither contend with them in battle: For I will not give thee of their land for a possession, because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:19 And when thou comes nigh over against the children of **Ammon, distress them not**, nor meddle with them: For I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon any possession, because I have given it unto the children of Lot for a possession.

Deuteronomy 2:10 The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims, but the Moabites call them Emims.

Deuteronomy 2:12 The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime, but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead, as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the Lord gave unto them.

Deuteronomy 2:20 (That also was accounted a land of giants: Giants dwelt therein in old time, and the Ammonites call them

Zamzummims, A people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims, but the Lord destroyed them before them, and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead.

Isaiah 1:1-4 The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. Hear, heavens, and listen, earth, for the LORD has spoken: I have nourished and brought up children, and **they have rebelled against me**. The ox knows his owner, and the donkey his master's crib, but Israel doesn't know, my people don't consider. Ah sinful nation, a people loaded with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken the LORD. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are estranged and backward.

JEREMIAH 32,33,39

Jeremiah 32:1,2 The word that came to Jeremiah from the **LORD in the tenth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, which was the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar**. For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem: And Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the **court of the prison**, which was in the king of Judah's house.

Jeremiah 32:3-5 For Zedekiah king of Judah had shut him up, saying, Wherefore dost thou prophesy, and say, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall take it, And Zedekiah king of Judah shall not escape out of the hand of the Chaldeans, but shall surely be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon, and shall speak with him mouth to mouth, and his eyes shall behold his eyes, And he shall lead Zedekiah to Babylon, and there shall he be until I visit him, saith the LORD: Though ye fight with the Chaldeans, ye shall not prosper.

Jeremiah 32:6-8 And Jeremiah said, The word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Behold, Hanameel the son of Shallum thine uncle shall come unto thee, saying, Buy thee my field that is in Anathoth: For the right of redemption is thine to buy it. So Hanameel mine uncle's son came to me **in the court of the prison** according to the

word of the LORD, and said unto me, Buy my field, I pray thee, that is in Anathoth, which is in the country of Benjamin: For the right of inheritance is thine, and the redemption is thine, buy it for thyself. Then I knew that this was the word of the LORD.

Jeremiah 32:9-12 And I bought the field of Hanameel my uncle's son, that was in Anathoth, and weighed him the money, even seventeen shekels of silver. And I subscribed the evidence, and sealed it, and took witnesses, and weighed him the money in the balances. So I took the evidence of the purchase, both that which was sealed according to the law and custom, and that which was open: And I gave the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, in the sight of Hanameel mine uncle's son, and in the presence of the witnesses that subscribed the book of the purchase, before all the Jews that sat in the **court of the prison**.

Jeremiah 32:13-15 And I charged Baruch before them, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Take these evidences this evidence of the purchase, both which is sealed, and this evidence which is open; and put them in an earthen vessel, that they may continue many days. For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Houses and fields and vineyards shall be possessed again in this land.

Jeremiah 32:16-19 Now when I had delivered the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, I prayed unto the LORD, saying, Ah Lord GOD! behold, You have made the heaven and the earth by your great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for you. You show lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompense the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, is his name, Great in counsel, and mighty in work: for thine eyes are open upon all the ways of the sons of men: to give every one according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings:

Jeremiah 32:20-22 Which hast set signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, even unto this day, and in Israel, and among other men, and hast made thee a name, as at this day, And hast brought forth thy

people Israel out of the land of Egypt with signs, and with wonders, and with a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with great terror, And hast given them this land, which thou didst swear to their fathers to give them, a land flowing with milk and honey.

Jeremiah 32:23-25 And they came in, and possessed it, but they obeyed not thy voice, neither walked in thy law, they have done nothing of all that you command them to do: Therefore thou hast caused all this evil to come upon them: Behold the mounts, they are come unto the city to take it, and the city is given into the hand of the Chaldeans, that fight against it, because of the sword, and of the famine, and of the pestilence: And what thou hast spoken is come to pass, and, behold, you see it. And thou hast said unto me, O Lord GOD, Buy thee the field for money, and take witnesses, for the city is given into the hand of the Chaldeans.

Jeremiah 32:26-28 Then came the word of the LORD unto Jeremiah, saying, Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: Is there anything too hard for me? Therefore, thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give this city into the hand of the Chaldeans, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and he shall take it.

Jeremiah 32:29,30 And the Chaldeans, that fight against this city, shall come and set fire on this city, and burn it with the houses, upon whose roofs they have offered incense unto Baal, and poured out drink offerings unto other gods, to provoke me to anger. For the children of Israel and the children of Judah have only done evil before me from their youth: For the children of Israel have only provoked me to anger with the work of their hands, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 32:31,32 For this city hath been to me as a provocation of mine anger and of my fury from the day that they built it even unto this day, that I should remove it from before my face, Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and of the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke me to anger, they, their kings, their princes, their priests, and their prophets, and the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jeremiah 32:33-35 And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: Though I taught them, rising up early and teaching them, yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction. But they set their abominations in the house, which is called by my name, to defile it. And they built the high places of Baal, which are in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire unto Molech, which I commanded them not, neither came it into my mind, that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.

Jeremiah 32:36-38 And now therefore thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning this city, whereof ye say, It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence, Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in mine anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath, and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely: And they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Jeremiah 32:39,40 And I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may fear me forever, for the good of them, and of their children after them: And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good, but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me.

Jeremiah 32:41-43 Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul. For thus saith the LORD, Like as I have brought all this great evil upon this people, so will I bring upon them all the good that I have promised them. And fields shall be bought in this land, whereof ye say, It is desolate without man or beast, it is given into the hand of the Chaldeans.

Jeremiah 32:44 Men shall buy fields for money, and subscribe evidences, and seal them, and take witnesses in the land of Benjamin, and in the places about Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, and in the cities of the mountains, and in the cities of the valley, and in the

cities of the south: for I will cause their captivity to return, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 33:1-3 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the second time, while he was yet shut up in **the court of the prison**, saying, Thus saith the LORD the maker thereof, the LORD that formed it, to establish it; the LORD is his name, Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

Jeremiah 33:4,5 For thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city, and concerning the houses of the kings of Judah, which are thrown down by the mounts, and by the sword, They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but it is to fill them with the dead bodies of men, whom I have slain in mine anger and in my fury, and for all whose wickedness I have hid my face from this city.

Jeremiah 33:6-8 Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth. And I will cause the captivity of Judah and the captivity of Israel to return, and will build them, as at the first. And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

Jeremiah 33:9 And it shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and an honor before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: And they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it.

Jeremiah 33:10,11 Thus saith the LORD, Again there shall be heard in this place, which ye say shall be desolate without man and without beast, even in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, that are desolate, without man, and without inhabitant, and without beast, The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: For the LORD is good, for his mercy

endures forever: And of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 33:12,13 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Again, in this place, which is desolate without man and without beast, and in all the cities thereof, shall be an habitation of shepherds causing their flocks to lie down. In the cities of the mountains, in the cities of the vale, and in the cities of the south, and in the land of Benjamin, and in the places about Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, shall the flocks pass again under the hands of him that tells them, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 33:14-16 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised unto the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David, and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land. In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: And this is the name wherewith **she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.**

Jeremiah 33:17-21 For thus saith the LORD; David shall never want a man to sit upon the throne of the house of Israel, **Neither shall the priests the Levites want a man before me to offer burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and to do sacrifice continually.** And the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD, If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season, Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne, and with the Levites the priests, my ministers.

Jeremiah 33:22-24 As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: So, will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me. Moreover, the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah, saying, Consider not what this people have spoken, saying, The two families which the LORD

hath chosen, he has even cast them off? Thus they have despised my people, that they should be no more a nation before them.

Jeremiah 33:25,26 Thus saith the LORD, If my covenant be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth, Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: For I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

Jeremiah 39:1,2 In the ninth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the tenth month, came Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon and all his army against Jerusalem, and they besieged it. And in the eleventh year of Zedekiah, in the fourth month, the ninth day of the month, the city was broken up.

Jeremiah 39:4 And it came to pass, that when Zedekiah the king of Judah saw them, and all the men of war, then they fled, and went forth out of the city by night, by the way of the king's garden, by the gate betwixt the two walls: and he went out the way of the plain.

Jeremiah 39:5-7 But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: And when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him. Then the king of Babylon slew the sons of Zedekiah in Riblah before his eyes: Also the king of Babylon slew all the nobles of Judah. Moreover, he put out Zedekiah's eyes, and bound him with chains, to carry him to Babylon.

Jeremiah 39:8-10 And the Chaldeans burned the king's house, and the houses of the people, with fire, and broke down the walls of Jerusalem. Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive into Babylon the remnant of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to him, with the rest of the people that remained. But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

Jeremiah 39:11-14 Now Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon gave charge concerning Jeremiah to Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard, saying, Take him, and look well to him, and do him no harm, but do unto him even as he shall say unto thee. So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard sent, and Nebushasban, Rabсарis, and Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, and all the king of Babylon's princes, Even they sent, and **took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison**, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: So he dwelt among the people.

Jeremiah 39:15-18 Now the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah, while he was shut up in the court of the prison, saying, Go and speak to Ebedmelech the Ethiopian, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Behold, I will bring my words upon this city for evil, and not for good, and they shall be accomplished in that day before thee. But I will deliver thee in that day, saith the LORD: And thou shalt not be given into the hand of the men of whom thou art afraid. For I will surely deliver thee, and thou shalt not fall by the sword, but thy life shall be for a prey unto thee: Because thou hast put thy trust in me, saith the LORD.
