TORAH

Deuteronomy 11:26-29 Behold, I set before you this day **a blessing and a curse**: The blessing, if you shall listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day, and the curse, if you shall not listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known. It shall happen, when the LORD your God shall bring you into the land where you go to possess it, that you shall set the blessing on Mount Gerizim, and the curse on Mount Ebal.

Joshua 8:30 Then **Joshua built an altar** unto the LORD God of Israel in Mount Ebal.

Deuteronomy 11:30 Aren't they beyond the Jordan, behind the way of the going down of the sun, in the land of the Canaanites who dwell in the Arabah, over against Gilgal, beside the **oaks of Moreh**?

Genesis 12:5-7 Abram took Sarai his wife, Lot his brother's son, all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls whom they had gotten in Haran, and they went to go into the land of Canaan. Into the land of Canaan they came. Abram passed through the land to the place of Shechem, **to the oak of Moreh**. The Canaanite was then in the land. The LORD appeared to Abram and said, I will give this land to your seed. He built an altar there to the LORD, who appeared to him.

Deuteronomy 12:2,3 You shall utterly destroy all the places, wherein the nations which you shall possess served their gods, on the high mountains, and on the hills, and under every green tree: And you shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their groves with fire, and you shall hew down the graven images of their gods, and destroy the names of them out of that place.

Deuteronomy 12:5 But unto **the place** which the **LORD your God shall choose** out of all your tribes to put his name there, even unto his habitation shall ye seek, and thither thou shalt come.

Deuteronomy 12:8 You shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatever is right in his own eyes.

Deuteronomy 13:18 When you shall listen to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all his commandments which I command you this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of the LORD your God.

Judges 21:25 In those days there was no king in Israel: Every man did that which was **right in his own eyes**.

Deuteronomy 12:10,11 But when you go over the Jordan and live in the land that the LORD your God is giving you to inherit, and when he gives you rest from all your enemies around, so that you live in safety, then to the place that the LORD your God will choose, to make his name dwell there, there you shall bring all that I command you: Your burnt offerings and your sacrifices, your tithes and the contribution that you present, and all your finest vow offerings that you vow to the LORD.

Deuteronomy 12:5 In all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

Genesis 22:2,3 And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah, and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

Genesis 22:4 Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes and saw the place afar off.

Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh יהוה ירא as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

Deuteronomy 12:28-32 Observe and hear all these words which I command you, that it may go well with you, and with your children after you forever, when you do that which is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God. When the LORD your God shall cut off the nations from before you, where you go to possess them, and you succeed them, and dwell in their land, Take heed to yourself that you be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before you, and that you inquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? Even so will I do likewise. You shall not do so to the LORD your God: For every abomination to the LORD, which he hates, have they done to their gods, for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: Thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it.

Deuteronomy 13:1-5 If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder, And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spoke unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them, Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: For the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him. And that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams, shall be put to death, because he hath spoken to turn you away from the LORD your God.

Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words, Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders, insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

2 Thessalonians 2:8,9 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan **with all power and signs and lying wonders**, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish, because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Deuteronomy 14:7,8 Nevertheless these ye shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof, as the camel, and **the hare**, and the coney: For they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof, therefore they are unclean unto you. And the swine, because it divideth the hoof, yet cheweth not the cud, it is unclean unto you: Ye shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcase.

Deuteronomy 14:11-21 Of all clean birds ye shall eat. But these are they of which ye shall not eat: The eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey, And the glade, and the kite, and the vulture after his kind, And every raven after his kind, And the owl, and the night hawk, and the cuckoo, and the hawk after his kind, The little owl, and the great owl, and the swan, And the pelican, and the gier eagle, and the cormorant, And the stork, and the heron after her kind, and the lapwing, and the bat. And every creeping thing that flies is unclean unto you: They shall not be eaten. **But of all clean fowls ye may eat. Ye shall not eat of anything that dies of itself: Thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it, or thou mayest sell it unto an alien:** For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God. Thou shalt not see the a kid in his mother's milk.

Leviticus 22:8 He shall not eat what dies of itself or is torn by beasts, and so make himself unclean by it: I am the LORD.

Deuteronomy 15:1,2 At the end of every seven years thou shalt make a release. And this is the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth ought unto his neighbour shall release it, he shall not exact it of his neighbour, or of his brother, because it is called the LORD's release.

Deuteronomy 15:7-9 If there be among you a poor man of one of your brothers within any of your gates in your land which the LORD your God gives you, you shall not harden your heart, nor shut your hand from your poor brother: But you shall open your hand wide to him, and shall surely lend him sufficient for his need, in that which he wants. Beware that there be not a thought in your wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand, and your eye be evil against your poor brother, and you give him nothing, and he cry to the LORD against you, and it be sin to you.

Matthew 6:22-24 The light of the body is the eye: If therefore your eye be single, your whole body shall be full of light. But if your eye be evil, your whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you be darkness, how great is that darkness! No man can serve two masters: For either he will hate the one, and love the other, or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

Proverbs 28:22 He that hastens to be rich has an evil eye and considers not that poverty shall come on him.

Proverbs 22:9 He that has a bountiful eye shall be blessed, for he gives of his bread to the poor.

Deuteronomy 16:1-3 Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover unto the LORD thy God: For in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night. And you shall offer the Passover sacrifice to the Lord your God, from the flock or the herd, at the place that the Lord will choose, to make his name dwell there. You shall eat no leavened bread with it. Seven days you shall eat it with unleavened bread, the bread of affliction for you came out of the land of Egypt in haste that all the days of your life you may remember the day when you came out of the land of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 16:15,16 Keep the feast to the Lord your God for seven days, in the place marked out by the Lord: Because the blessing of the Lord your God will be on all the produce of your land and all the work of your hands, and you will have nothing but joy. Three times in the

year let all your males come before **the Lord your God in the place named by him**, at the feast of unleavened bread, the feast of weeks, and the feast of tents: And they are not to come before the Lord with nothing in their hands.

SEPTUAGINT

What is it and how long did it take to write it?

The Septuagint was not written all at once, it was translated by **different anonymous scribes over roughly two to three centuries** (starting with the Torah around the mid-3rd century BCE). Different translators worked from whatever regional Hebrew manuscripts were available to them in Egypt or Palestine.

The Rabbis protested the translation declaring a fast day.

Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah.

Jeremiah 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with **the house of Israel**, After those days, saith the LORD, I will **put my Torah in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts, and will be their God and they shall be my people.**

Jeremiah 31:34b For they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Jeremiah 31:35-37 Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divides the sea when the waves thereof roar, The LORD of hosts is his name: If those ordinances depart from before me, saith the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me forever. Thus, saith the LORD, **If heaven above can**

be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, saith the LORD. By trading the ע (Ayin) for a ח (Chet), the translators in Egypt transformed a fiercely loyal Husband (בַּעַלְהִי) into an adversarial Judge who loathes and divorces His bride (בַּתְּלִי).

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Revelation 21:6 And he said unto me, **It is done.** I am Aleph and Tav, the beginning and the end.

Isaiah 46:10 Declaring **the end from the beginning**, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure.

Galatians 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son.

Luke 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things **concerning himself.**

Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spoke unto you, while I was yet with you, that **all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.**

God יהוה is a God of TIME

PRESENT – הוּהָ haya / PAST – הָיָה hoveh / FUTURE – יִהְיֶה yihiye

- **Adam and Eve** — Took before God's appointed time.
- **Abraham and Sarah** — Took Hagar to obtain the promised son before God's appointed time.
- **Saul** — Offered the sacrifice before Samuel arrived.
- **Israel** — Demanded a king "like the nations" before trusting God's rule.

- **David** — Refused to seize the throne before God's appointed time.
- **Solomon** — Did not become king until David publicly established him.
- **Abiathar** — Remained in office until God's providence removed him.

John 7:30 Then they sought to take him: But no man laid hands on him, because his hour was not yet come.

John 8:20 These words Yeshua spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple: And no man laid hands on him, for his hour was not yet come.

John 12:23 And Yeshua answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified.

Ecclesiastes 3:1,2a To **everything** there is a season, and **a time to every purpose** under the heaven: A time to be born, and a time to die.

1 John 1:5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light**, and in him is **no darkness** at all.

John 8:12 **I am the light** of the world: He that follows me shall not walk in **darkness**, but shall have the **light of life**.

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and **the Torah is light**.

Genesis 1:2 In the beginning God created **the heaven and the earth**. And the earth was without form, and void, **and darkness** was upon the face of the deep.

John 1:5 And the **light shineth in darkness**, and the darkness **comprehended** it not.

Luke 4:43 He said to them, I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because **for this purpose** I have been sent.

John 12:27 Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? ‘Father, save Me from this hour? **But for this purpose** I came to this hour. Father, glorify Your name.

Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the **determined purpose and foreknowledge of God**, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death.

Acts 4:27,28 For truly against Your holy Servant Yeshua, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together to do whatever Your hand and **Your purpose determined before to be done**.

Romans 9:17 For the Scripture says to the Pharaoh, For **this very purpose** I have raised you up, that I may show My power in you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth.

2 Timothy 1:9 God, who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but **according to His own purpose** and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus **before time began**.

Galatians 4:4 **But when the fulness of the time was come**, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman.

Ephesians 1:11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to **the purpose of Him** who works all things according to the counsel of His will.

1 Peter 1:20 He indeed was **foreordained before the foundation of the world**, but was manifest in these last times for you.

1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested**, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Revelation 17:17 For God has put it into their hearts **to fulfill His purpose**, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the **words of God are fulfilled**.

Genesis 18:14 At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

Exodus 9:5 And the LORD appointed a set time, saying, Tomorrow the LORD shall do this thing in the land.

Exodus 23:15 Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, **in the time appointed** of the month Abib; for in it thou came out from Egypt: And none shall appear before me empty.

2 Samuel 24:15 So the LORD sent a pestilence upon Israel from the morning even **to the time appointed**: And there died of the people from Dan even to Beersheba seventy thousand men.

Job 7:1 Is there not an **appointed time** to man upon earth?

Psalms 81:3 Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, **in the time appointed**, on our solemn feast day.

Jeremiah 8:7 Yea, the stork in the heaven knows **her appointed times**, and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming, but my people know not the judgment of the LORD.

Daniel 8:19 And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: For **at the time appointed** the end shall be.

Daniel 11:29 At the time appointed he shall return and come toward the south, but it shall not be as the former, or as the latter.

Daniel 11:35 And some of them of understanding shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: Because it is yet for **a time appointed**.

Habakkuk 2:3 For the vision is yet for **an appointed time**, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: Though it tarry, wait for it, because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

Galatians 4:2 But is under tutors and governors until **the time appointed** of the father.

Luke 19:44 And shall lay you even with the ground, and your children within you, and they shall not leave in you one stone upon another, because you knew not the time of your visitation.

Daniel 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the Most-High and shall wear out the saints of the Most-High and think to **change times and laws**: And they shall be given into his hand until a **time and times and the dividing of time**.

1 Thessalonians 5:1,4 But of the **times and the seasons**, brethren, you have no need that I write unto you. For you, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. The sun, moon, and stars were not created merely to mark astronomical cycles. **The lights are not merely astronomical objects**. They were appointed to mark the time when **God's purposes would be** intersecting in human history.

Why Did God Create Time?

Isaiah 1:2 Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: For the LORD hath spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me.

Isaiah 1:4 Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: They have forsaken the LORD.

Isaiah 1:14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hates: They are a trouble unto me, I am weary to bear them.

Isaiah 35:8 And a Highway shall be there, and a Way, and it shall be called: The Way of Holiness

MIXED SEED

Deuteronomy 22:9 You **shall not sow your vineyard** with **two kinds of seed**, lest the fulness of the seed which you have sown be forfeited together with the increase of the vineyard.

Leviticus 19:19 You shall not sow your field with mixed seed.

Matthew 7:18 It is NOT POSSIBLE for a good tree to give bad fruit, and a bad tree will not give good fruit.

Matthew 12:33 Make the tree good, and its fruit good, or make the tree bad, and its fruit bad, for by its fruit you will get KNOWLEDGE of the tree.
