## TORAH

**Deuteronomy 21:10** When you go to war against your enemies.

**Deuteronomy 21:15-17** *If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated, and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath for he is the beginning of his strength.*

**Deuteronomy 22:1-3** You shall not see **your brother's ox** or his sheep go astray, and hide yourself from them: You shall in any case bring them again to your brother. And if **your brother be not near to you, or if you know him not,** then you shall bring it to your own house, and it shall be with you until your brother seek after it, and you shall restore it to him again. In like manner shall you do **with his ass,** and **so shall you do with his raiment,** and **with all lost things** of your brother's, **which he has lost, and you have found,** shall you do likewise: You **may not hide yourself.**

**Exodus 23:5** If you see **the ass** of him **that hates you** lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you **shall surely help** with him.

**Deuteronomy 22:4** You shall not see **your brother's ass or his ox** fall down by the way and **hide yourself** from them: You **shall surely help him** to lift them up again.

**Deuteronomy 22:6,7** If a bird's nest chance to be before you in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the dam sitting on the young, or on the eggs, you shall not take the dam with the young: But you shall in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to you, that it may be well with you, and **that you may prolong your days.**

**Luke 13:34,35** Jerusalem, Jerusalem, that kills the prophets, and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, **like a hen gathers her own brood** under her wings, and you refused! Behold, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me, until you say, Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!

**Deuteronomy 22:8** When you build a new house, then **you shall** make a battlement for your roof, that you bring not blood on your house, if any man fall from there.

**Deuteronomy 23:7,8** You shall not abhor an Edomite, for he is your brother! You shall **not abhor an Egyptian**, because you were a stranger in his land. The children that are begotten of them shall enter into the congregation of the LORD **in their third generation.**

**Deuteronomy 23:21–23** When you shall vow a vow to the LORD your God, you shall not slack to pay it: For the LORD your God will surely require it of you, and it would be sin in you. But if you shall forbear to vow, it shall be no sin in you. **That which is gone out of your lips you shall keep and perform,** even a freewill offering, according as you have vowed to the LORD your God, which you have promised with your mouth.

**Deuteronomy 23:24,25** When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, then you may eat grapes your fill at your own pleasure, but you shall not put any in your vessel. When you come into the standing corn of your neighbor, then you may pluck the ears with your hand, but you shall not move a sickle to your neighbor's standing corn.

**Matthew 12:1,2** At that time, Yeshua went on the Sabbath day through the grain fields. His disciples were hungry and began to pluck heads of grain and to eat. But the Pharisees, when they saw it, said to him, Behold, your disciples do what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath.

**Deuteronomy 24:9** Remember what the LORD your God did to Miriam by the way, after that you were come forth out of Egypt.

**Proverbs 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue: And they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

**Proverbs 15:2-4** The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright: But the mouth of fools pours out foolishness. **The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.** A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.

**Deuteronomy 24:14,15** You shall not oppress an hired servant that is poor and needy, **whether he be of your brothers, or of your strangers that are in your land within your gates: At his day you shall give him his hire, neither shall the sun go down on it, for he is poor, and sets his heart on it:** Lest he cry against you to the LORD, and it be sin to you.

**Deuteronomy 24:19-22** When you cut down your harvest in your field, and have forgot a sheaf in the field, you shall not go again to fetch it: It shall be for the **stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow**: That the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. When you beat your olive tree, you shall not go over the boughs again: It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow. When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, you shall not glean it afterward: **It shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.** And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt: Therefore I command you to do this thing.

**Deuteronomy 25:4** You shall **not muzzle the ox** when he treads out the corn.

**1 Timothy 5:17,18** Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine. For the scripture said, You shall **not muzzle the ox that treads out the corn.** And, The laborer is worthy of his reward.

**Deuteronomy 25:15,16** You shall have a **perfect and just weight**, a perfect and just measure, **that your days may be lengthened** in the land which the LORD your God is giving you. For all who do such things, all who behave unrighteously, are an abomination to the LORD your God.

**Deuteronomy 25:17-19** Remember what **Amalek** did to you by the way, when you were come forth out of Egypt, How he met you by the way, and smote the hindmost of you, even all that were feeble behind you, when you were faint and weary, and he feared not God. Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from all your enemies round about, in the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance to possess it, that you shall blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven, you shall not forget it.

**Isaiah 54:1-3** Sing, O barren, you that did not bear, break forth into singing, and cry aloud, you that did not travail with child: For more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, said the LORD. Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations: Spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes, For you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left, and your seed **shall inherit the Gentiles**, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

**Isaiah 54:5-7** For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name, and your Redeemer the Holy One **of Israel**, The God of the whole earth shall he be called. For the LORD has called you as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when you were refused, said your God. For a small moment have I forsaken you, but **with great mercies will I gather you**.

**Isaiah 54:8-10** In a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, said the LORD your Redeemer. For this is **as the waters of Noah** to me: For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills

be removed, but my kindness shall not depart from you, **neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, said the LORD that has mercy on you.**

**Malachi 3:7** Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. **Return unto me, and I will return unto you,** saith the LORD of hosts.

**Matthew 24:27,28** For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

**Matthew 24:7** For **nation shall rise against nation**, and kingdom against kingdom: And there shall be famines, and pestilences, and **earthquakes**, in divers places.

**Matthew 24:32-34** Now learn a parable of the fig tree, When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.**

### A QUESTION OF AUTHORITY

**John 2:4** Yeshua said to her, Woman, what have I to do with you? **My hour has not yet come.**

**John 7:6-8** Yeshua said to them, **My time is not yet come:** But your time is always ready. The world cannot hate you, but me it hates, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil. You go up to this feast: I am **not going up yet** to this feast, **for my time is not yet fully come.**

**John 7:30** Then they sought to take him: But **no man laid hands on him,** because **his hour was not yet come.**

**John 8:20** These words Yeshua spoke in the treasury, as he taught in the temple: And no man laid hands on him, for **his hour was not yet come.**

**John 12:23** And Yeshua answered them, saying, **The hour is come,** that the Son of man should be glorified.

**Luke 19:12** He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country **to receive for himself a kingdom,** and to return.

**Luke 18:17** Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not **receive the kingdom of God** as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.

**Matthew 25:34** Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, **inherit the kingdom** prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

**Philippians 2:5-7** Have this mind among yourselves, **which is yours in Messiah Yeshua,** who, though he was in the form of God, did not count **equality with God a thing to be grasped,** but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

***Uncircumcised ears, lips, hearts!!***

**Jeremiah 6:10** To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? Behold, **their ear is uncircumcised,** and they cannot hearken: Behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach, they have no delight in it.

**Exodus 6:30** And Moses said before the LORD, Behold, I am of **uncircumcised lips,** and how shall Pharaoh hearken unto me?

**Leviticus 26:41** And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies, if then their **uncircumcised hearts** be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity.

**Leviticus 19:23-25** And when ye shall come into the land and shall have planted all manner of trees for food, then ye shall count the fruit thereof as uncircumcised: Three years shall it be as uncircumcised unto you: It shall not be eaten of. But in the fourth year all the fruit thereof shall be holy to praise the LORD withal. And in the fifth year shall ye eat of the fruit thereof, that it may yield unto you the increase thereof: I am the LORD your God.

**Revelation 22:14** Blessed are they that **do his commandments**, that they may have right **to the tree of life**, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

**Proverbs 8:10** Receive my instruction, and not silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold.

**Proverbs 19:2** Also, the soul without knowledge, is not good.

**Proverbs 21:11** and when the wise is instructed, he receives knowledge.

### TREES BREATHE

**Psalms 1:3** And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season, his leaf also shall not wither.

**Mark 8:24** And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.

**Genesis 2:7** And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.

**Genesis 2:9** And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food, the tree of life also in the midst of the garden.

**Isaiah 5:1,2** My well-beloved hath a vineyard in a very fruitful hill: And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes.

**Isaiah 5:4** What could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it?

### **MIXED SEED**

**Deuteronomy 22:9** You shall not sow your vineyard with two kinds of seed, lest the fulness of the seed which you have sown be forfeited together with the increase of the vineyard.

**Leviticus 19:19** You shall not sow your field with mixed seed.

**Matthew 7:18** It is NOT POSSIBLE for a good tree to give bad fruit, and a bad tree will not give good fruit.

**Matthew 12:33** Make the tree good, and its fruit good, or make the tree bad, and its fruit bad, for by its fruit you will get KNOWLEDGE of the tree.
