TORAH

Deuteronomy 26:1,2 And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and possess it, and live in it, you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the earth which you shall bring of your land that the LORD your God gives you, and you shall put it in a basket, and shall go to the place which the LORD your God shall choose to place His name there.

Deuteronomy 26:3,4 And thou shalt go unto the priest that shall be in those days, and say unto him, **I profess** this day unto the LORD thy God, that I am come unto the country which the LORD swore unto our fathers for to give us. And the priest shall take the basket out of thine hand, and set it down before the altar of the LORD thy God.

Deuteronomy 26:10 And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits ראשית of the land.

John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except **a grain** of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abides alone: But if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead and become the **firstfruits** of them that slept.

Leviticus 23:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest.

Psalms 30:1 I will extol thee, O LORD, for thou **hast lifted me up**, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

Psalms 30:3 O LORD, you have **brought up my soul from the grave**: You have kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

Deuteronomy 26:8-11 And the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders: And he hath brought us into this place, and hath **given us this land**, even a land that flows with milk and honey. And now, behold, I have brought **the firstfruits of the land**, which thou, O LORD, have given me. And you shalt set it before the LORD thy God, and worship before the LORD thy God: And you shall rejoice in every good thing which the LORD thy God has given to you, and to your house, you, and the Levite, and the stranger that is among you.

Deuteronomy 26:16-19 **Today** the LORD your God has commanded you to do these statutes and judgments. You therefore shall keep and do them with all your heart and with all your soul. You have **Today** said that the LORD is your God, and that you would **walk in His ways**, and keep His statutes and His commandments and His judgments, and listen to His voice. And the LORD has taken you **Today** to be His peculiar people, as He has promised you, and to keep all His commandments, and to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise and in name and in honor, and that you may be a holy people to the LORD your God, even as He has spoken.

Deuteronomy 27:9,10 And Moses and the priests the Levites spoke to all Israel, saying: Take heed and listen, O Israel. **Today you have become the people of the LORD your God**. You shall therefore obey the voice of the LORD your God, and do His commandments and His statutes which I command you **Today**.

***Hebrews 3:7** Wherefore (as the Holy Spirit saith, **Today if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation**.

***Hebrews 3:15** While it is said, **Today if ye will hear his voice**, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.

***Psalm 95:8** **Today if ye will hear his voice**, Harden not your heart, as in the provocation.

Deuteronomy 28:1,2 And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth: And all these **blessings** shall come on thee, **and overtake thee**, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

Deuteronomy 28:8,9 The Lord shall **command the blessing** upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto, and he shall **bless** thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee. The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if you shall keep the commandments of the Lord thy God, and walk in his ways.

Deuteronomy 28:13 And the Lord shall **make thee the head, and not the tail**, and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath, **if** that thou hearken unto **the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them**.

Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, **if thou wilt not hearken** unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day, that **all these curses shall come upon thee**, and overtake thee.

Deuteronomy 28:45-47 All these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and **overtake you** till you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. They shall be a sign and a wonder against you and your offspring forever. **Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joyfulness and gladness of heart**, because of the abundance of all things.

Galatians 3:10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: For it is written, **Cursed is everyone that continues not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them**.

Deuteronomy 27:25,26 Cursed be he that **taketh reward to slay an innocent person.** And all the people shall say, Amen. **Cursed be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them.** **And all the people shall say, Amen.**

Deuteronomy 27:19-24 Cursed be he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his father's wife, because he uncovereth his father's skirt. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with any manner of beast. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his sister, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that lieth with his mother in law. And all the people shall say, Amen. Cursed be he that smites his neighbor secretly. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 29:19,20 And it come to pass, when he **heareth the words of this curse**, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, **I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst:** The Lord will not spare him, but then the anger of the Lord and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the Lord shall blot out his name from under heaven.

Galatians 3:11 But that **no man is justified by the law** in the sight of God, it is evident: For, **The just shall live by faith.**

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: But the just shall live by his faith.

Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness.

Matthew 27:45 Now from the **sixth hour there was darkness over all the land** unto the **ninth hour.**

Amos 8:9,10 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down **at noon**, and I will darken the earth in the clear day: And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation, and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head, and I will make it as the mourning of **an only son**, and the end thereof as a bitter day.

Matthew 27:51-53 And, behold, **the veil of the temple was rent in twain** from the top to the bottom, and the **earth did quake, and the rocks rent**, And the **graves were opened**, and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Isaiah 60:1-3 Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the **darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people**: But the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

Isaiah 60:5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged, because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee, the **forces of the Gentiles** shall come unto thee.

Isaiah 60:11,12 Therefore thy gates shall be open continually, they shall not be shut day nor night, that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought. **For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee (Israel) shall perish, yea, those nations shall be utterly wasted.**

Isaiah 60:14 The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come **bending unto thee**, and all they that despised thee shall **bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet**, and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

Gentiles turning to torah is the current prophetic move and those who do will be noted forever as “the firstfruits” of Zion in fulfillment of this prophecy! So get on board!

TESTING THE SPIRITS

Matthew 21:23 By what authority do you do these things? Who gave you this authority?

(KJV) **2 Thessalonians 2:8** And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming.

(NKJV) And then the Lawless One will be revealed,

(BBE) And then will come the revelation of that Evil One

1 John 3:4 Every one that sins does lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.

Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall be multiplied, the love of the many shall wax cold.

Titus 2:13,14 Looking for the blessed hope and appearing of the glory of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us, that he might **redeem us from all iniquity**, and purify unto himself a people for his own possession, zealous of good works.

Matthew 13:41,42 The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness, and will cast them into the furnace of fire.

Matthew 23:28 Even so you also outwardly appear righteous to men, **but inside** you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

Acts 19:13-16 Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches. Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know, but who are you? Then the man in whom

the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

Romans 6:18,19 And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and **of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness**, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness.

Matthew 7:21-23 Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven, but he that **does the will** of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy by your name, and by your name cast out demons, and by your name do many mighty works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that **work Lawlessness**.

John 19:10,11 Then Pilate said to Him, Are You not speaking to me? **Do You not know that I have power to crucify You, and power to release You?** Yeshua answered, You could have **no power at all against Me** unless it had been given you from above. Therefore, the one who delivered Me to you has the greater sin.

Numbers 16:1-3 Now Korah the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, with Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab, and On the son of Peleth, sons of Reuben, **took men**, and they rose up before Moses with some of the children of Israel, **two hundred and fifty leaders of the congregation, representatives of the congregation, men of renown**. They gathered together against Moses and Aaron, and said to them, You take too much upon yourselves, for all the congregation is holy, every one of them, and the LORD is among them. Why then do you exalt yourselves above the assembly of the LORD?

1 Samuel 15:7,8 And Saul attacked the Amalekites, from Havilah all the way to Shur, which is east of Egypt. He also took Agag king

of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword.

Deuteronomy 13:1-3 If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, Let us go after other gods which you have not known and let us serve them, you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

2 Chronicles 26:16-18 But when he was strong his heart was lifted up, to his destruction, for he transgressed against the LORD his God by entering the temple of the LORD to burn incense on the altar of incense. So Azariah the priest went in after him, and with him were eighty priests of the LORD valiant men. And they withstood **King Uzziah**, and said to him, It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the LORD, but for the priests, the sons of Aaron, who are consecrated to burn incense. Get out of the sanctuary, for you have trespassed! You shall have no honor from the LORD God.

1 Kings 22:6-8 Then the king of Israel gathered **the prophets together**, about **four hundred** men, and said to them, Shall I go against Ramoth Gilead to fight, or shall I refrain? So they said, Go up, for the Lord will deliver it into the hand of the king. And Jehoshaphat said, Is there not still a prophet of the LORD here, that we may inquire of Him? So the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, There is still one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may inquire of the LORD, but I hate him, because he does not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say such things!

2 Samuel 6:6,7 And when they came to Nachon's threshing floor, Uzzah put out his hand to the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen stumbled. Then the anger of the LORD was aroused against Uzzah, and God struck him there for his error, and he died there by the ark of God.

1 Kings 13:16-18 And he said, I cannot return with you nor go in with you, neither can I eat bread nor drink water with you in this place. For I have been told by the word of the LORD, ‘You shall not eat bread nor drink water there, nor return by going the way you came.’ ” He said to him, I too am a prophet as you are, and an angel spoke to me by the word of the LORD, saying, Bring him back with you to your house, that he may eat bread and drink water. (He was lying to him.)

Judges 17:6 In those days there was no king in Israel, **everyone did what was right in his own eyes.**

1 Samuel 8:19 Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel, and they said, **No, but we will have a king over us, that we also may be like all the nations,** and that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles.

Romans 13:1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority?

Luke 11:53 And as He said these things to them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to assail Him vehemently, **and to cross-examine Him about many things.**

1 Corinthians 9:3 My defense to those **who examine me is this.**

1 Corinthians 11:28 But let a **man examine himself.**

2 Corinthians 2:5 **Examine yourselves** as to whether you are in the faith. **Test yourselves.**

Galatians 6:4 But let each one **examine his own work.**
