TORAH

Exodus 7:7 And Moses was **fourscore years old**, and Aaron fourscore and three years old, when they spoke unto Pharaoh.

Deuteronomy 1:3 And it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke unto the children of Israel, according unto all that the LORD had given him in commandment unto them;

Deuteronomy 31:1,2 And Moses went and spoke these words to all Israel. And he said to them, I am an hundred and twenty years old this day.

Deuteronomy 34:7 And Moses was an **hundred and twenty years old when he died**: His eye was not dim, nor his natural force abated. And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab **thirty days**: So the days of weeping and mourning for Moses were ended.

Joshua 1:10,11 Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying, Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within **three days ye shall pass over this Jordan**, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God giveth you to possess it.

Joshua 4:19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the **tenth day of the first month**, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Deuteronomy 29:10-15 You stand today, all of you, before the LORD your God, your captains of your tribes, your elders, and your officers, all the men of Israel, your little ones, your wives, and your **stranger** that is in your camp, from the cutter of your wood to the drawer of your water, so that **you should enter into covenant** with the LORD your God, and into His oath, which the LORD your God makes you today, that He may establish you today for a people to

Himself, and that He may be a God to you, as He has said to you, and as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. Nor do I make this covenant and this oath with you only, but with him who stands here with us *today* before the LORD our God, and also with him that is not here with us *today*.

Deuteronomy 29:19 And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst.

Deuteronomy 29:20,21 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law.

Deuteronomy 29:24-28 Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? What meaneth the heat of this great anger? Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt: For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: But those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children forever, that we may **do all the words of this law.**

Deuteronomy 30:1 And it shall be when all these things have come on you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and when you shall call them to mind לָבָב among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you,

Deuteronomy 30:2 and shall return שׁוּב to the LORD your God and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you today, you and your sons, with all your heart, and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 30:3,4 Then the LORD your God will **turn** שׁוּב your captivity. And He will have compassion on you and **will return** שׁוּב and gather you from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you. If you are driven out into the outermost parts of the heavens, the LORD your God will gather you from there, and He will bring you from there.

Deuteronomy 30:5 And the LORD your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. And He will do you good and multiply you above your fathers.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD your God **will circumcise your heart and the heart** of your seed, to love the LORD your God with **all your heart and with all your soul**, so that you may live.

Deuteronomy 30:7-10 And the LORD your God will **put all these curses on your foes and enemies who persecuted you.** And you shall again obey the voice of the LORD and keep all his commandments **that I command you today.** The LORD your God will make you abundantly prosperous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your cattle and in the fruit of your ground. For the LORD will again take delight in prospering you, as he took delight in your fathers, when you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when **you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.**

Deuteronomy 30:11-16 **For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off.** It is not in heaven, that you should say, Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it. See, I have

set before you today life and good, death and evil. If you obey the **commandments** of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his **commandments** and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deuteronomy 30:19,20 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you, life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore, choose life, that you and your offspring may live, loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

Deuteronomy 31:6-8 Be strong and of good courage, fear not, nor be affrighted at them, for the LORD thy God, He it is that doth go with thee, He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee And Moses called unto Joshua and said unto him in the sight of all Israel: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt go with this people into the land which the LORD hath sworn unto their fathers to give them, and thou shalt cause them to inherit it. And the LORD, He it is that doth go before thee, He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee; fear not, neither be dismayed.

Deuteronomy 31:10-12 And Moses commanded them, saying, At **the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the feast of tabernacles**, When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD your God **in the place which he shall choose**, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men and women, and children, **and your stranger** that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and **to do all the words of this law**.

Deuteronomy 31:17-19 Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and **I will hide** my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall come on them, so that they will say in that day, Haven't these evils come on us

because our God is not **among us**? **I will surely hide** my face in that day for all the evil which they shall have worked, in that they are turned to other gods. **Now therefore write this song for yourselves** and teach it to the children of Israel: Put it in their mouths, **that this song may be a witness for me** against the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 31:20-23 For when **I have brought them into the land** flowing with milk and honey, which I swore to give to their fathers, and **they have eaten and are full and grown fat**, they will turn to other gods and serve them and despise me and break my covenant. And when *many evils and troubles have come upon them*, this song shall confront them as a witness (for it will live unforgotten in the mouths of their offspring). **For I know what they are inclined to do even today, before I have brought them into the land that I swore to give.** So, Moses wrote this song the same day and taught it to the people of Israel. And he gave Joshua the son of Nun a charge and said: **Be strong and of good courage**, for thou shalt bring the children of Israel into the land which I swore unto them, and I will be with thee.

Deuteronomy 31:28-30 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them. **For I know that after my death** you will utterly corrupt yourselves and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you, and evil will befall you in the latter days, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands. And **Moses spoke in the ears of all the congregation of Israel the words of this song, until they were ended.**

THE CREATOR'S ORDER

Ecclesiastes 3:1 To everything there is a season, and a **(proper)** time to every purpose under the heaven.

Jeremiah 2:8 They that handle the law knew me not.

Isaiah 46:9,10 Remember the former things of old: For I am God, and there is none else, I am God, and there is none like me, **Declaring the**

end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and **I will do all my pleasure.**

Revelation 4:11 You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: **For you have created all things, and for your pleasure they are and were created.**

Romans 9:20 But, O man, who are you, to make answer against God? May the thing which **is made say to him who made it, Why did you make me so?**

Ecclesiastes 3:11 He hath made everything beautiful in his time.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Job 38:6 Where were you when **I laid the foundations** of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. Who determined its measurements? Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? To what were its foundations fastened? Or **who laid its cornerstone,**

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: **Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation, Whoever believes will not act hastily.**

Proverbs 6:6 Go to the ant, thou sluggard, consider her ways, **and be wise:** Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathers her food in the harvest.

Psalms 24:1,2 The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, **The world and those who dwell therein.** For He has founded it upon the seas And established it upon the waters.

Job 12:7-11 But now **ask the beasts**, and they will teach you, And **the birds of the air**, and they will tell you, Or **speak to the earth**, and it will teach you, And **the fish of the sea** will explain to you. **Who among all these does not know** That the hand of the LORD has done this, In whose hand is **the life of every living thing, And the breath**

of all mankind? Does not the ear **test words** And the mouth **taste its food?**

Colossians 1:16,17 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **All things were created by him, and for him:** And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

Genesis 1:24 And God said, Let the earth bring forth the **living creature** after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.

Proverbs 19:2 Also, that **the soul be without knowledge, it is not good,** and he that **hasteth with his feet sinneth.**

Psalm 8:3-8 When I consider your heavens, **the work of your fingers,** the moon and the stars, which you have ordained, **What is man,** that you are mindful of him? And **the Son of Man,** that you visit him? For **you have made Him a little lower than the angels** and have crowned Him with glory and honor. You made Him to have dominion over the works of your hands, **you have put all things under his feet: All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field, The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea.**

Hebrews 1:13,14 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? **Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?**

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man **in our image, after our likeness:** And let **them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.

1 John 1:5 God **is light**

Revelation 21:23 The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

Daniel 12:3 Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.

Matthew 13:43 Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father.

Exodus 34:29,30 Now when Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two stones in his hand, he was not conscious that **his face was shining** because of his talk with God. But when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, and **the shining of his face**, they would not come near him for fear.

Isaiah 61:10 For He has clothed me with the Garments of salvation.

Psalms 104:2 O LORD my God, You are very great: You are clothed with honor and majesty, Who **cover Yourself, with light as with a Garment**

Revelation 3:17,18 Because you say, I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing' and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, **poor, blind, and naked** I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich, and **white Garments, that you may be clothed,** that **the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed,** and **anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.**

Revelation 16:15 Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and **keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.**

Genesis 2:25 And they were both **naked**, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

*Adam and Eve are **naked and unashamed**—open, transparent, with **nothing being concealed.***

Genesis 3:7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked, and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings.

Genesis 1:31 Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So, the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground **the LORD God made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good for food.** The tree of life was also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of (right and wrong) (good and bad.)

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Genesis 2:19,20 Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name. So, Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper (A mate) comparable to him.

Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, **because I was naked,** and I hid myself.

Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was wiser than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made.

Proverbs 12:16 A fool's vexation is presently known, But a prudent man conceals shame.

Proverbs 12:23 A prudent man conceals knowledge: But the heart of fools proclaims foolishness.

Proverbs 13:16 Every prudent man works with knowledge, But a fool flaunts his folly.

Proverbs 14:8 The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way.

Proverbs 22:3 A prudent man sees the evil and hides himself, But the simple pass on and suffer for it.

Ezekiel 28:2-5 Thus saith the Lord GOD, Because thine heart is lifted up, and thou hast said, **I am a God, I sit in the seat of God**, in the midst of the seas, yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God: Behold, **thou art wiser** than Daniel, there is no secret that they can hide from thee: With **thy wisdom** and with thine understanding thou hast gotten thee riches, and hast gotten gold and silver into thy treasures: By **thy great wisdom** and by thy traffic hast thou increased thy riches, and thine heart is lifted up because of thy riches.

Ezekiel 28:12,13 Thus saith the Lord GOD, You seal up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty. **You have been in Eden the garden of God.**

Ezekiel 28:15 You were perfect in your ways from the day that you were created, till iniquity was found in you.

Ezekiel 28:17 Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty, **you had corrupted your wisdom** by reason of your brightness..

Matthew 10:16 Be wise as serpents and harmless as doves.
